WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have lost five of the last seven games and 12 of the last 17 as they continue their final homestand of the season tonight with the series opener vs. Cleveland.
- RHP Dylan Covey, who is looking for his first win as a starter since 7/21 at Seattle, takes the mound for the White Sox.
- The Sox are currently in fourth place in the American League Central, 1.5 games behind third-place Detroit (63-93).
- The White Sox opened this six-game homestand by losing two of three to the Cubs in the Crosstown Cup over the weekend.
- Following this series vs. Cleveland and Thursday's off day, the Sox will finish 2018 with four games at Minnesota (DH on 9/28).
- The White Sox went 4-5 on their last trip at the Indians (1-2), Baltimore (2-1) and Kansas City (1-2), and 3-7 on their last homestand vs. Boston (2-2), Detroit (1-2) and the Angels (0-3).

TONIGHT'S STORYLINES

- The White Sox need to win two of their final seven games to avoid the fourth 100-loss season in franchise history.
- The Sox have lost seven of their last eight games at Guaranteed Rate Field, and have been outscored, 54-24.
- Chiago has lost eight of the last 10 games and 21 of the last 27 vs. Cleveland ... the White Sox have been outscored, 149-69, during the 27-game span (scored three runs or less 21 times).
- Dylan Covey is 2-5 with a 5.17 ERA (27 ER/47.0 IP), .281 average and 1.55 WHIP in nine home starts (two QS) this season.
- Daniel Palka has homered in four of his last seven games, and has hit eight home runs with 10 RBI over his last 17.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

- The Cubs scored in each of the first three innings, and limited the White Sox to four hits, in their 6-1 win.
- Anthony Rizzo, Albert Almora Jr. and David Bote each drove in a run in the first ... Kyle Schwarber hit a solo HR in the second.
- Carlos Rodón fell to 6-7 after allowing six runs on nine hits with three strikeouts over 2.1 IP ... four Sox relievers combined to allow six hits with four walks and six strikeouts over 6.2 scoreless IP.
- Tim Anderson (2-3) drove in the White Sox only run with a RBI double in the fifth ... Wellington Castillo was 2-3 with a double.
- The Sox did not walk, went 1-4 with RISP, left three runners on base and were limited to one hit over the last four frames.

YES! YES! YES! HISTORY!

- Chicago White Sox Charities Sox Split on 9/22 vs. the Cubs generated a total jackpot of \$344,063, the largest 50/50 jackpot at a sporting event in U.S. history (source: 50/50 Central).
- CWSC started the Sox Split jackpot at \$50,000 on Saturday.

(DIS)COMFORT OF HOME

- The White Sox have lost seven of their last eight games at Guaranteed Rate Field and are 29-49 (.372) at home this season, tied with San Diego for the second-worst mark in MLB.
- This season marks the Sox fourth-worst home record in club history, ahead of 1948 (27-48), 1932 (28-49) and 1970 (31-53).
- Chicago will finish with a sub-.500 record at home for the fifth time in the last six seasons (45-36 in 2016).

WELCOME TO CHICAGO

- Nick Madrigal, the White Sox first-round pick (fourth overall) in the 2018 draft out of Oregon State, will be at the park today.
- He will visit with Sox players and coaches, meet with the media at 4:30 in the dugout and throw out a ceremonial first pitch.
- Madrigal hit .303/.353/.348 with seven doubles, 16 RBI, seven walks, eight steals and 25 runs scored in 43 games between the AZL White Sox, Class A Winston-Salem and Class A Kannapolis.

- The Sox will celebrate Fan Appreciation Day on 9/26 ... all fans in attendance will receive a ticket voucher for an April/May 2019 home game (excludes Opening Day and Boston series).
- In addition, fans will receive discounted parking (\$10) and chances to win prizes, including a 20-person patio party in 2019 (excluding OD and Cubs series), SoxFest 2019 passes (Sunday only), two round-trip tickets from United Airlines, autographed Sox memorabilia and Beggars Pizza for a year.
- The night will conclude with a postgame fireworks show.

WHITE SOX VS. CLEVELAND

- Cleveland leads the season series, 12-4 ... Chicago is 3-4 at Guaranteed Rate Field and 1-8 at Progressive Field, and has been outscored, 86-43, in 2018.
- The White Sox are batting .194/.254/.337 with 16 home runs, and own a 4.88 ERA (75 ER/138.1 IP) with six quality starts.
- The Sox have lost eight of the last 10 games overall, and eight of the last 11 at Guaranteed Rate Field ... they are 6-21 overall in their last 27 games vs. the Indians dating back to 6/11/17.
- Chicago has lost five of the last six season series dating back to 2013 (10-9 in 2015), going 39-72 during that span.
- The White Sox lead the all-time series, 1,084-1,072 ... they are 572-503 at home (115-115 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 512-569 on the road (97-111 at Progressive Field).

TOUGH PROGRESSIVE RATES

- Chicago went 1-8 at Progressive Field in 2018, snapping a nine-game losing streak in its last game on 9/20 (5-4 win).
- The losing streak was the second-longest at Cleveland in franchise history (11 in a row from 5/25/31-5/30/32).
- The Sox were outscored, 61-20, scored three runs or less eight times, and made just two QS during the losing streak.
- Chicago avoided going winless on the road vs. a single opponent in nine games or more for just the second time in franchise history (0-10 at the Boston Americans in 1901; STATS LLC).

LACK OF CENTRAL COMMAND

- Chicago is 29-40 against the American League Central in 2018, going 13-21 at Guaranteed Rate Field and 15-20 on the road.
- The White Sox will record a losing record vs. the AL Central for the sixth consecutive season.
- The Sox have lost six of the last eight but won 12 of 21.
- Chicago is 10-10 in the last 20 games vs. the division at home.
- The White Sox are 319-418 vs. the AL Central since 2009, posting a losing record every season except 2012 (37-36).

HOMER HAPPY

- The White Sox have hit 95 home runs since 7/2, the fourth-highest total in the American League and seventh-most in MLB.
- The Sox feature six players with 17-plus home runs this season, tied for the second-most in MLB behind the Dodgers (eight).
- Chicago has hit 98 HRs on the road, compared to 81 at home.

POWER AND SPEED

- Tim Anderson (20 HR/26 SB) on Friday became the first White Sox shortstop to record a 20-HR/20-SB season ... he is four steals shy of joining Alex Ríos (2010) and Tommie Agee (1966) as the only Sox to post 20 homers and 30 steals in one season.
- Anderson, Boston's Mookie Betts, Cleveland's José Ramírez and Colorado's Trevor Story are the only players in MLB with at least 20 home runs and 25 stolen bases this season.

PALKA POWER

- Daniel Palka is tied with Zeke Bonura (1934) for third place in White Sox single-season history among rookies with 27 home runs in 2018 ... he is eight shy of Ron Kittle (35 in 1983) for second ... the 27 homers are the most by a Sox left-handed rookie.
- He ranks among MLB rookie leaders in homers (1st, 27), RBI (4th, 64), extra-base hits (T5th, 44) and total bases (7th, 195).
- Palka is trying to become the first White Sox rookie to lead all MLB rookies in home runs since José Abreu (36) in 2014.
- His four pinch-hit HRs are the most in a season in Sox history.

YOUNG AND PRODUCTIVE

- Yoán Moncada needs two doubles to become the fifth player in White Sox history, age 23 or younger, to record 30-plus doubles, 15-plus home runs and 60-plus RBI in a single season.
- He would join Chet Lemon (1977), Frank Thomas (1991), Paul Konerko (1999) and Carlos Lee (1999) ... also would be the first Sox, 23 or younger, with a 30+ 2B/15+ HR/60+ RBI/10+ SB season.

GRAB SOME BENCH

- Chicago has struck out 1,511 times in 2018, the most in MLB and the most in a single season in franchise history.
- Yoán Moncada leads MLB with 210 strikeouts ... he is 12 shy of tying Adam Dunn (222 in 2012) for the club record.

QUALITY AND QUANTITY

- The White Sox have made 1,387 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, tied with the New York Mets (1,387) for the most in MLB during that span, and 56 more than Oakland (1,331), the next-closest American League team.
- The Sox rank third in the AL with 72 quality starts in 2018 ... RHP James Shields is tied for sixth in the AL with 19 QS, and RHP Reynaldo López is tied for 10th.

COVEY AT A GLANCE

- The 27-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 20th start of the season, 10th at home and sixth career against Cleveland.
● Is 0-6 with a 7.15 ERA (27 ER/34.0 IP) over his last seven starts and 1-8 with an 6.53 ERA (37 ER/51.1 IP) over his last 10 starts.

LAST START

- Received a no decision on 9/19 at Cleveland after tossing 6.0 scoreless IP, allowing just two hits with three walks and five strikeouts.
● Recorded his first quality start since 7/21 at Seattle (0 ER/8.1 IP).

FIRST TIME THROUGH

- Is limiting opponents to a .216 (41-190) average the first time through the lineup, compared to a .307 (46-150) mark the second time and .307 (27-88) average the third time.

STRUGGLES AT HOME

- Is 2-5 with a 5.17 ERA (27 ER/47.0 IP), three home runs allowed, 19 walks, 41 strikeouts and a .281 (54-192) opponents average over nine home starts this season.
● Has gone 0-5 with a 7.50 ERA (20 ER/24.0 IP), two home runs allowed, 11 walks, 20 strikeouts and a .314 (32-102) opponents average over his last five home starts.

WHERE'S THE RUN SUPPORT?

- Is receiving a 3.15 run support average over his last 15 starts ... has received two runs of support or less in 11 of those starts.
● Has received one or no runs of support in 16 of his 31 career starts ... his career run support breakdown: zero (four), one (12), two (seven), three (three) and four-plus (five).

FOURTH INNING STRUGGLES

- Owns a 6.38 ERA (13 ER/18.1 IP) in the fourth inning this season, allowing runs in the fourth frame in six of his last 10 starts.
● His 13 runs allowed in the fourth are tied for the 18th-most among American League pitchers in 2018.

2018 MINOR LEAGUE STARTS

- Went 3-1 with a 2.33 ERA (10 ER/38.2 IP), 36 strikeouts and a .226 (32-141) opponents average over seven starts with Class AAA Charlotte this season.
● Did not receive a decision in his last start with Charlotte on 5/15, allowing one unearned run on four hits with one walk and six strikeouts over 6.0 IP.

COVEY'S COVER STORY

- Originally was selected by Milwaukee in the first round (14th overall) of the June 2010 First-Year Player Draft ... following his post-draft physical and before signing a contract, was diagnosed with Type 1 diabetes.
● Following the diagnosis, elected not to sign with the Brewers and committed to play at the University of San Diego ... was teammates with Chicago Cubs third baseman and 2016 National League Most Valuable Player Kris Bryant.

VS. AMERICAN LEAGUE CENTRAL

- Is scheduled to make his 22nd career appearance (16th start) against the American League Central.
● Has gone 1-11 with a 5.56 ERA (56 ER/90.2 IP), nine home runs allowed, 50 walks, 50 strikeouts and a .271 (92-339) opponents average against the division lifetime.

VS. CLEVELAND INDIANS

- Is scheduled to make his eighth career appearance (sixth start) against Cleveland.
● Has gone 1-2 with a 5.04 ERA (14 ER/25.0 IP), 18 strikeouts and a .294 (30-102) opponents average in five starts, compared to 0-0 with a 3.00 ERA (1 ER/3.0 IP), two strikeouts and a .125 (1-8) opponents average in relief.
● Suffered the loss in his last start vs. the Indians on 8/12 at Guaranteed Rate Field after allowing six runs on seven hits with two walks and three strikeouts over 2.2 IP.

TOMORROW'S SCHEDULED STARTER

- RHP James Shields (7-16, 4.48 ERA) is scheduled to make his 33rd start of the season, 19th at home and 24th career vs. the Indians.
● Is 2-1 with a 3.86 ERA (12 ER/28.0 IP), .257 opp. average, 1.32 WHIP, 16 strikeouts and seven homers allowed over his last five starts (three quality).
● Received a no decision in his last start on 9/20 at Cleveland ... allowed two runs on five hits, two home runs, three walks and one strikeout in 6.0 IP.
● Has gone 5-8 with a 3.76 ERA (59 ER/141.1 IP), .253 opp. average, 1.25 WHIP and 136 strikeouts in 23 career starts vs. Indians.
