## TRIBE TOP THREE

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** extended his hit streak to 12 games last night, marking the longest by a Tribe batter this season and tied for the second-longest active streak in MLB.

» **MIKE CLEVINGER** will take the mound today for Cleveland... he pitched into the 8th inning in his last start against the Royals on April 8 at Progressive Field, allowing just one run on 10 hits over 7.1 innings (2BB, 4K)...Clevinger is 3-0 in six career appearances (five starts) against the Royals with a 2.12 ERA (7ER/29.2IP).

» **TYLER NAQUIN** has been placed on the 10-day Disabled List with a left hamstring strain after injuring it on his two-run double last night...**TYLER OLSON** has been activated from the paternity list.

## YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians saw a 9-4 lead slip away as they fell, 10-9, in the opener of their three-game home series vs. Kansas City.

» The Tribe hit three home runs, receiving a pair of 1st-inning blasts from **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** and **YONDER ALONSO**...**MICHAEL BRANTLEY** capped a six-run 4th inning with a grand slam, his second of the season (T1st in MLB)...**FRANCISCO LINDOR** extended his club-high hit streak to 12 games with a single in the 6th inning.

» **TREVOR BAUER** did not factor into the decision after allowing five runs (four earned) on 11 hits over 4.2 innings...**ANDREW MILLER** took the loss in his first game since April 26 (DL, left hamstring strain), allowing a go-ahead two-run homer to **Salvador Pérez**.

## GRAND FUNK

» **MICHAEL BRANTLEY**'s 4th-inning grand slam was his second of the year (also May 1 vs. Texas) and the third by an Indians batter this season (**Yonder Alonso** - March 31 at Seattle)...Brantley is tied with Boston's **Xander Bogaerts** and Houston's **Josh Reddick** for the most grand slams in MLB this season.

» Brantley is the first Indians batter with two grand slams in a season since **Travis Hafner** and **Shin-Soo Choo** had two each in 2010...the last Tribe batter with two grand slams in a single calendar month was also **Hafner**, who had two in July 2006.

## ROYAL TEETH

» The Indians and Royals are squaring off this weekend in the second of six series between the clubs...nine of the 19 games are scheduled to be played here at Progressive Field...Cleveland and Kansas City have split the first four contests in the season series.

» The clubs previously met this season in a three-game series in Cleveland from April 6-8, with the Tribe taking two of the three contests...the Indians won the home opener, 3-2, and lost the April 7 game, 1-0...on April 8, the Indians won in walk-off fashion, as a two-run homer by **YAN GOMES** gave Cleveland a 3-1 victory.

» Cleveland has posted a 14-9 (.609) record against the Royals since the start of 2017, as well as a mark of 57-42 (.576) since **Terry Francona** became Tribe manager in 2013...the two clubs have combined to win each of the last three A.L. Central titles.

» Dating back to August 18, 2017, the Indians have held Kansas City to two-or-fewer runs in 11 of their last 15 meetings...Cleveland has gone 11-4 in that span with a 2.07 ERA (31ER/135.0IP).

## JOY DIVISION

» The Tribe is in the midst of its fourth series against a divisional opponent, having gone 7-3 in their first nine games against the A.L. Central (6-2 at Progressive Field).

» Since July 1, 2017, the Indians have posted a 38-11 record (.776) against A.L. Central teams...in their most recently completed divisional series, the Tribe split a two-game set with Minnesota in Puerto Rico...the draw snapped the Indians' 14-series win streak against intra-divisional opponents, which was the longest by any team in MLB's divisional era (1969-, STATS LLC)...Cleveland has not lost a series against an A.L. Central team since being swept at home by the Minnesota Twins from June 23-25, 2017.

» Despite last night's setback (7ER/9.0IP), Tribe pitching has been dominant against the A.L. Central, posting a 1.84 ERA (64ER/313.0IP) in their last 34 divisional games and allowing two-or-fewer earned runs in 26 of those contests.

» The Indians enter this series with a half-game lead in the A.L. Central over second-place Minnesota (16-18)...the Tribe has held the outright divisional lead for each of the last 21 days.

Melky Cabrera was 3-for-5 with two doubles and two runs scored...Brandon Barnes (1-3) had a double and four RBI. Connor Marabell was 2-for-4 with a double and a run...Ka'ia Tom collected a sac fly and scored the other Akron run. Li-Jen Chu (2-3) had two RBI and two runs scored...Anderson Polanco & Billy Strobe threw 2.1 scoreless innings each. José Vicente went 2-for-4 with a pair of singles...Austen Wade drew two walks and scored the lone Captains run.

## FRANKIE GOES TO HOLLYWOOD

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** extended his hit streak to 12 games last night with a single in the bottom of the 6th inning...marks the longest streak by an Indians batter this season, and is also tied for the 2nd-longest active streak in MLB...there have been five hit streaks of 12-or-more games by Indians players since the start of 2017, and Lindor has been responsible for four of those streaks.

» Lindor is batting .418 (23-55) across the streak with six homers, five doubles, 12 RBI and 14 runs scored...in that span of 13 days, he ranks 1st in MLB in hits (23), T1st in runs scored (14), T3rd in extra-base hits (11) and T3rd in home runs (6).

» Lindor enters play today ranked T6th in the American League in home runs (10), T4th in multi-hit games (15), 6th in runs scored (29), T6th in total bases (87), T5th in extra-base hits (21) and 8th in batting average with runners in scoring position (.387).

## RAM JAM

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** put the Indians on the board last night with a two-run homer, his team-high 11th of the season...Ramírez enters play today with the 5th-most home runs in the American League.

» Ramírez is the fastest Indians player to reach 11 homers (37 team games) since **Mark Reynolds** hit his 11th home run in the Tribe's 32nd game of the 2017 season...Ramírez is the quickest switch-hitter in franchise history to reach 11 homers.

» Since April 29 (11 games), Ramírez is batting .383 (18-47) with four homers, eight doubles, 12 RBI and 12 runs scored...over that span, he ranks T1st in MLB in extra-base hits (12), T1st in doubles (8), T5th in runs scored (12) and T8th in hits (18).

## KC AND THE SUNSHINE BAND

» **MIKE CLEVINGER** will make his 8th start of 2018 this afternoon in the middle contest of this three-game set.

» Clevinger was dominant in his last start, which came on May 6 at New York-AL...held the Yankees to two runs on just one hit over 7.1 innings of work, striking out a career-high 10 batters...did not allow a hit until the 5th inning and kept New York-AL scoreless through 7.0 innings before a pair of 8th-inning walks came around to score as inherited runners.

» Clevinger will be making his second start this season against the Royals, following an April 8 outing at Progressive Field...did not factor into the decision of the Tribe's 3-1 walk-off victory, allowing one run and scattering 10 hits over 7.1 innings of work (2BB, 4K)...owns a career record of 3-0 against the Royals with a 2.12 ERA (7ER/29.2IP) in six appearances (five starts).

» Has excelled in daytime starts this season, posting a record of 1-0 with a 1.14 ERA (3ER/23.2IP) in three starts, the 5th-lowest day ERA in the American League...most notably, Clevinger tossed his first career complete-game shutout on April 21 at Baltimore in a similar 4:05 pm start.

## TYLER, THE CREATOR

» **TYLER NAQUIN** has been placed on the 10-day Disabled List with a left hamstring strain...in a corresponding move, **TYLER OLSON** has been activated off the paternity list.

» Naquin left last night's game after hitting a two-run double in the 4th inning...the double extended his hit streak to eight games, matching a career-best (also eight games, April 16-27, 2016)...Naquin's .333 (25-75) batting average this season leads all Indians batters and ranks 7th in the American League (min. 75 PA).

» Olson has posted an 0-1 record in 15 appearances this season with a 6.75 ERA (9ER/12.0IP)...he and his wife, Shayna, welcomed their son, Maddox Ray, yesterday.

## MOBB DEEP

» The Indians hit three home runs last night which were responsible for seven of their nine runs...Cleveland enters play today ranked T2nd in MLB with 55 homers (LAA - 56, TOR-55).

» The Indians are one of just two teams (New York-AL) boasting four players with at least nine home runs this season...**JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** (11), **FRANCISCO LINDOR** (10), **YONDER ALONSO** (9) and **EDWIN ENCARNACION** (9) are the first foursome of Tribe batters with nine-or-more homers through 37 games since 1995, when **Paul Sorrento** (12), **Manny Ramirez** (12), **Jim Thome** (10) and **Eddie Murray** (9) also turned the trick.

## THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

**2008:** In Game 2 of the Tribe's doubleheader vs. Toronto, **Asdrúbal Cabrera** turns the 14th unassisted triple play in Major League Baseball history, catching a 5th-inning line drive from Lyle Overbay before stepping on second base to retire Kevin Mench and tagging out Marco Scutaro...Cabrera became the third Indians player to achieve the feat, following Neal Ball (7/19/1909) and Bill Wambsganss (10/10/1920, World Series Game 5).

52 MIKE CLEVINGER RHP (2-0, 2.76 ERA)

TODAY'S START

The 27-year-old right-hander is scheduled to start this afternoon in the middle game of this three-game weekend series vs. the Kansas City Royals...will mark his 52nd career appearance and 39th career start. Will be pitching on extended five days' rest after making his last start on May 6 at New York-AL...struck out a career-high 10 batters but did not factor into the decision in the Tribe's 7-4 loss...tossed 7.1 innings (1H, 2R/ER, 4BB). Makes his second start of the season against the Royals, after facing them on April 8 at Progressive Field...did not factor into the decision, tossing 7.1 innings (10H, 1R/ER, 2BB, 4K)...owns a career 3-0 record and 2.12 ERA (7ER/29.2IP) in six outings (five starts) vs. Kansas City. Is 1-0 with a 1.14 ERA (3ER/23.2IP) in three starts in day games this season...his day ERA ranks 5th in the American League entering today's game. Over his last 15 appearances (11 starts), dating back to August 26, 2017, has gone 8-1 with a 1.94 ERA (17ER/79.0IP)...in that span, has allowed two-or-fewer runs in 11 of those 15 appearances.

LAST TIME OUT

Struck out a career-high 10 batters in his last start on May 6 at New York-AL, marking his first career game with 10-plus strikeouts...also tossed a career-high 116 pitches. Held the Yankees to one hit through through 7.0 scoreless innings, but departed after walking two batters with one out in the 8th...both of those inherited runners later scored. Has allowed just two earned runs across three road starts this season (21.2IP) and his 0.83 road ERA ranks 3rd in the American League. The Indians starting pitching staff has recorded five games with 10-plus strikeouts this season, which ranks 2nd in the American League and 3rd in MLB, behind Houston (11) and Washington (8).

VS. KANSAS CITY | DIVISION RECORD

Clevinger makes his second start of the season vs. the Royals...did not factor into the decision on April 8 at Progressive Field, allowing one run on 10 hits over 7.1 innings, with two walks and four strikeouts. Owns a career record of 3-0 with a 2.12 ERA (7ER/29.2IP) in six game (five starts) against the Royals...Clevinger's three wins vs. KC are his second-most against any team in the A.L. Central, behind his four career victories against Detroit. Four of his five career starts vs. KC have come at home and he is 1-0 with a 2.70 ERA (7ER/23.1IP) in those outings. His start vs. Kansas City on April 8 is his only outing against the A.L. Central so far this season...has compiled a career record of 8-5 with a 3.09 ERA (32ER/93.1IP) in 23 intradivisional appearances (16 starts), after going 7-3 against the A.L. Central in 2017 with a 2.13 ERA (13ER/55IP) in 13 games (9 starts).

HOME COOKING

Has posted a 0-0 record and 4.50 ERA (12ER/24.0IP) in four starts at Progressive Field this season...both of his victories this season have come on the road. Did not factor into the decision in his last home start on May 1 vs. Texas (6.2IP, 7H, 3R/ER, 1HR, 1BB, 7K)...has gone 6.0-or-more innings in three of his four home starts. Owns a career 7-4 record and 3.88 ERA (48ER/111.1IP) in 27 games (19 starts) at home...in 2017, went 5-3 with a 3.79 ERA (25ER/59.1IP) in 15 games (10 starts) at Progressive Field.

COMPLETE CLEVINGER

Clevinger tossed his first career complete-game shutout on April 21 at Baltimore on April 21...held the Orioles to two hits and two walks, with three strikeouts. His two hits allowed in the game marking the fewest such hits in a complete-game shutout by an Indians starting pitcher since Carlos Carrasco allowed one hit in a CGSO at Kansas City on September 25, 2015 (9.0IP, 2BB, 15K). Set a new career-high in innings pitched for the second time this season, after breaking his previous career best with 7.1 innings pitched on April 8 vs. Kansas City.

2017 HIGHLIGHTS

Posted career-highs in nearly every pitching category in 2017, including wins (12), strikeouts (137), ERA (3.11), innings pitched (121.2), games (27) and games started (21)...overall, went 12-6 with a 3.11 ERA (42ER/121.2IP) in 27 games (21 starts) at the Major League level. His 3.11 ERA ranked 8th among American League starting pitchers with at least 100.0 innings, and his .211 average against ranked 5th...also finished 4th on the Tribe in wins. Tossed a career-high 7.0 innings on May 20 at Houston, a feat he went on to replicate on August 12 at Tampa Bay...struck out nine batters on June 27 against Texas, a new career best...matched his strikeout feat again on Aug. 12 at Tampa Bay and Aug. 26 vs. Kansas City. Made four starts in the Tribe's historic 22-game win streak, allowing one earned run in those appearances and posting a 4-0 record and 0.38 ERA (1ER/23.2IP), while holding opposing hitters to a .186 (16-for-86) batting average...also became the first Indians pitcher since John Denny in 1981 to have three consecutive starts of 6.0-or-more scoreless innings. Won his final five starts of the season, marking a new career-long streak, and compiled a 5-0 record with a 0.61 ERA (2ER/29.2IP) in that span. Made three appearances out of the bullpen to end the season, from September 26-30 (3.2IP, 3H, 1ER, 4K). Began the season with Triple-A Columbus and spent three stints with the Indians (May 7-June 6, June 17, June 22-end)...ranked 5th in the International League in ERA at the time of his first recall on May 7...in seven starts with the Clippers, went 3-2 with a 2.65 ERA (10ER/34.0IP).

CAREER SNAPSHOT

Clevinger is in his fourth season with the Indians organization...was selected in the 4th round (135th overall) by Los Angeles-AL in the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Seminole State College of Florida...acquired by the Indians in exchange for reliever Vinnie Pestano on Aug. 7, 2014...was added to Cleveland's 40-man roster on November 20, 2015. Was ranked as the 7th-best prospect in the Indians organization entering the 2015 & 2016 seasons by Baseball America...split 2016 between Triple-A Columbus and Cleveland, going 11-1 with a 3.00 ERA in 17 starts for the Clippers and making 17 appearances for the Tribe throughout the season...began the year 9-0 in Columbus, did not lose a game until July 18 (15th start)...tossed a scoreless inning in the Triple-A All-Star Game on July 13 (2K). Made his Major League debut on May 18, 2016 against Cincinnati...did not factor into the decision, tossing 5.1 innings (5H, 4R/ER, 1HR, 1BB, 5K) in the Tribe's 8-7 win over the Reds...struck out Joey Votto in the first inning for his first career MLB punchout...went 3-3 with a 5.26 ERA 31ER/53.0IP) in 17 games (10 starts) across three stints with the Indians. Named Tribe's organizational Pitcher of the Year in 2015...went 9-8 with a 2.73 ERA in 27 games/26 starts with Akron, tallying the 3rd-most strikeouts, the second-lowest WHIP and the 4th-lowest average against in all of Double-A (.219). 2017 POSTSEASON RECAP: Appeared in relief in Game 2 & Game 4 of the 2017 American League Division Series against the New York Yankees. Allowed two earned runs on one hit (one home run) on 0.2 innings (2BB, 2K) in the Tribe's 9-8 victory in Game 2 at Progressive Field...tossed 0.2 innings again in Game 4 in The Bronx (1H, 1R, 2BB, 1K), as the Indians lost 7-3. Has no record and a 6.43 ERA (5ER/7.0IP) in six career postseason appearances.

TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTER: RHP COREY KLUBER (5-2, 2.62 ERA). The 32-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his ninth start of the season tomorrow afternoon in the finale of this three-game weekend series vs. the Kansas City Royals...will mark his 177th career appearance and 172nd start. Kluber will be pitching on regular four days' rest, after making his last start of the season on May 8 at Milwaukee...recorded another Quality Start but took the loss in his first career start against the Brewers, allowing three runs on five hits (two home runs) over 6.0 innings (1BB, 4K). Extended his season-opening Quality Start streak to eight starts, the longest such streak by an Indians pitcher since Josh Tomlin had a nine-start streak in 2011. Kluber will face the Royals for the first time this season tomorrow...went 2-0 with a 0.73 ERA (1ER/12.1IP) in two starts against them last season and owns a career 9-6 record and 2.98 ERA (43ER/130.0IP) in 20 starts vs. Kansas City. His 2.98 ERA against the Royals is his lowest career ERA against any A.L. Central division opponent...last faced Kansas City on September 17, 2017 at Progressive Field, tossing 7.0 shutout innings (3H, 0BB, 9K). In 2017, Kluber became the first pitcher in Indians franchise history to win the A.L.
