TODAY'S GAME: The Giants and Cardinals play the final game of their season series this afternoon with San Francisco aiming to avoid being swept in St. Louis in a three-game series for the first time since September 11-13, 1995, also the last time St. Louis swept any three-game series from SF...the Giants are 7-8 in the regular season at Busch Stadium since 2014 and with yesterday's loss have not won a season series with St. Louis since 2014 (4-3).

ON THE MOUND: LHP Andrew Suárez will take the ball for the Giants this afternoon aiming for his eighth win of the season...he ranks among NL rookie leaders in innings pitched (first, 153.0), wins (tied for third, seven) and strikeouts (fourth, 125) entering play today...is 3-2 with a 2.67 ERA (10er, 33.2ip) over his last five starts dating to August 25...last pitched Monday in San Diego, twirling 7.2 innings of two-run ball in the Giants' 4-2 win at PETCO Park.

TOUGH FINISHES: The Giants have now suffered 22 losses in which the opponent has won the game in their last at-bat, the most such losses in the Majors... yesterday's walk-off loss was the Giants' seventh of the season.

ROAD INFO: The Giants enter their final road game with a 31-49 (.388) road record, the third-lowest road winning percentage in the NL...SF will need to win its final road game this afternoon to avoid having consecutive seasons with 50 or more road losses for the first time since 1984 (31-50) and 1985 (24-57)...the Giants lost 55 games on the road in 2017.

GIANTS PITCHERS: Beginning June 1, the Giants have posted a 3.40 ERA, which ranks as the second-best figure in the Majors behind Los Angeles-NL (3.29)...the starting staff has fashioned a 3.52 ERA in that span, the fifth-best in the Majors behind Los Angeles-NL (3.17), Tampa Bay (3.32), Cleveland (3.44) and New York-NL (3.51)...the bullpen has combined for a 3.19 ERA, second-best in MLB behind Houston (3.18) in that time.

SOUTHPAW STATS: With LHP Andrew Suárez scheduled to start today, the Giants will have 90 starts from a left-handed pitcher this season, tied for the third-most in team history for a single season (see chart, courtesy of STATS, LLC).

FIRST IMPRESSIONS: C Aramis Garcia turned in four hits yesterday and has hit safely in 10 of his 12 games this season and is hitting .368 (14-for-38)...the last Giants' catcher to turn in a four-hit game during his rookie season was Hector Sanchez, who went 4-for-6 on July 14, 2012 vs. Houston.

ON THE CASE: LHP Tony Watson made his 70th appearance of the season yesterday, tossing 1.0 scoreless inning...in doing so, he became the only reliever in the Majors with 70 or more appearances in each of the last four seasons.

CENTRAL OVEREXPOSURE: Entering play this afternoon, the Giants have lost each of their last nine road games to NL Central division opponents dating to May 27...SF's last win against an NL Central team on the road came May 26 at Chicago-NL...the Giants are 2-12 on the road this year vs. NL Central foes.

CLOSE CALLS: The Giants have played 107 games this season that have been decided by just three runs or fewer, the most such games of any MLB team this year...SF is 51-56 (.477) in such contests.

SCORE AT LEAST FOUR: San Francisco is 21-64 (.247) when scoring three runs or fewer compared to 51-19 (.729) when plating four-or-more runs.

This Date in Giants History: September 23, 1970

The Giants scored four runs in the ninth inning on this date in 1970 to help down the Dodgers, 14-10 in a comeback win at Dodger Stadium...Frank Johnson brought in Bobby Bonds with a groundout for the go-ahead run in the ninth before a three-run homer by Ken Henderson sealed the win.

#59 LHP Andrew Suárez
6-0, 187, 26 years old (September 11, 1992)
7-11 Record, 4.24 ERA

- The 26-year-old is slated to make his 28th career Major League start...has gone 7-11 with a 4.24 ERA (72er, 153.0ip) in 27 outings, with the Giants going 12-15 in those games.
- Among NL rookie qualifiers he ranks first in innings pitched (153.0), fourth in strikeouts (125), sixth in ERA (4.24) and seventh in opponents' batting average against (.263).
- His 125 strikeouts rank as the seventh-most in SF-era history (since 1958) by a rookie pitcher.
- Threw a career-high 7.2 innings in the Giants' 4-2 win at San Diego on Monday...allowed two runs on four hits with three walks, four strikeouts and a home run as he earned his seventh victory of the season.
- Has a 2.28 ERA (15er, 59.1ip) in the 10 one-run games he's pitched in...opponents have three hits in 18 at-bats (.167) off him in close and late situations.
- Is holding opponents to a .159 average (7-for-44) with RISP and two outs.
- Has received three or fewer runs of support in 20 of his 27 starts.
- Has a 5.38 ERA (44er, 73.2ip) in 14 starts on the road compared to a 3.18 ERA (28er, 79.1ip) in 13 starts at home.
- Lefties are hitting .213 (32-for-150) off him with just seven extra-base hits (four doubles, two triples, one home run).
- Has never faced the Cardinals...is 1-4 with a 6.67 ERA (22er, 29.2ip) in six starts against the NL Central this season.
- Was selected in the second round of the 2015 MLB Draft by San Francisco (No. 61 overall).

NOTES: The 31-year-old left-hander is scheduled to make his 34th appearance of the season (30th start)...Holland has gone 7-8 with a 3.57 ERA (65er, 163.2ip) over his 33 appearances...faced the Padres in his last start on July 18...threw 5.0 innings, allowing four runs on five hits and two walks with six strikeouts in the Giants' 5-4 victory over San Diego...his four earned runs allowed were the most he had given up in a game since allowing five runs (four earned) on Aug. 10 vs. PIT...has allowed two-run-or-fewer in 10 of his last 12 starts, posting a 2.65 ERA (20er, 68.0ip)...has made five career starts against the Padres, going 1-1 with a 6.39 ERA (18er, 25.1ip)...in four starts this season, he's posted a 1-0 record with a 5.49 ERA (12er, 19.2ip).
