THE LOSS: The Royals have lost five straight games for the first time since last Aug. 24-28, dropping to 3-10, their worst 13-game start since 2012 (3-10).
 + Relievers **Brian Flynn** (2.1 IP) and **Burch Smith** (2.0 IP) combined to record 4.1 innings of relief, allowing just run *unearned* run on two hits and one walk.
 + **Mike Moustakas** hit the Royals' fifth home run of the season—his third—in the eighth inning...he and **Lucas Duda** (2) have accounted for all of the club's HR through 13 games...Kansas City is the only team in the Majors without a HR from a right-handed batter.

JAKOB JUNIS: Suffered his first career loss at home...entered 4-0 with a 2.96 ERA (17 ER in 51.2 IP) in 10 outings (eight starts) at Kauffman Stadium.
 + Surrendered a solo HR to **Luis Valbuena** to leadoff the third, the first run he's allowed in 2018...his 16.0 scoreless innings was the longest *active* streak in the Majors, and the second longest this season overall, trailing only **Gerrit Cole** (19.0 IP)...it was the fourth-longest streak by a Royal *to begin a season*, trailing only **Zack Greinke** (24.0 IP in 2009), **Wade Davis** (22.0 IP in 2015) & **Danny Jackson** (18.0 IP in 1985)...the last Royal with a longer scoreless-innings streak was **Matt Strahm** (16.1 IP) from Aug. 2-Sept. 10, 2016...the last longer streak *by a starter* was **Danny Duffy** (17.1 IP) from July 5-19, 2015.
 + Allowed a solo home run to leadoff the fourth (**Justin Upton**) before stranding a one-out single...was charged with two runs in the fifth, going: walk, two-run home run (**Mike Trout**), single, double, all with two outs...exited after 4.2 innings, trailing 4-0, in relief of **Brian Flynn**, who stranded both inherited runners...pitch count by inning: 11 (1st), 18 (2nd), 20 (3rd), 20 (4th), 29 (5th), 98 total...threw first-pitch strikes to 10 of his first 11 batters, but went 4-for-11 after that.
 + Matched a career high with three home runs allowed (also: June 11, 2017 at San Diego and June 29, 2017 at Detroit).

BURCH SMITH: Struck out **Mike Trout** in the ninth inning in a 14-pitch plate appearance, eight of which were fouled off.

MIKE MOUSTAKAS: Hit a solo home run in the eighth inning, extending his hitting streak to seven games, in which he's batting .448 (13-for-29) with three HR.

WHIT MERRIFIELD: Made his first career start in center field, his fourth different starting *defensive* position this season (also: first base, second base and right field)...that matches **Marwin Gonzalez**, **Ben Zobrist**, **Hernan Perez** and **Scott Kingery** for most in the Majors this season...he's the only player in the Majors to make starts at five different positions, including DH.

ANGELS: Have won 10 of 11 & seven straight, their longest win streak since Sept. 22-29, 2015...they're 13-3, setting a new club record for the best 16-game start.
 + They've won nine straight road games—including six on this seven-game trip—their longest since winning 10 straight away from home from May 22-June 11, 2012...their 9-1 record marks their best 10-game start on the road in club history (*STATS*)...they've outscored opponents 65-28 in 10 road games.
 + They've outscored opponents 103-55 (+48) in 16 games overall...entered with the best run differential in the Majors, 13 runs better than Boston.
 + Won without a hit in scoring situations (0-for-2) for the second time this season (also: March 30 at Oakland)...had six such wins in 2017.

GARRETT RICHARDS: Snapped a 10-start winless streak on the road (last: Sept. 19, 2015 at Minnesota), despite a 2.92 ERA (16 ER in 49.1 IP) during that stretch.
 + Allowed one hit for the second time this season (also: April 3 vs. Cleveland)...only Angel with *more* such starts (min. 5.0 IP) in one season is **Nolan Ryan** (1973).
 + Retired his first 12 batters before issuing a leadoff walk in the fifth, followed by wild pitch, a one-out single and then a pair of wild pitches to score the Royals' first run, becoming the first Angel to record three wild pitches in one inning since **C.J. Wilson** on Sept. 27, 2013 at Texas (third inning)...he issued a one-out walk before inducing an inning-ending double play...walked the first batter in the sixth before exiting after 5.0 innings (plus one batter), leading 5-1...pitch count by inning: 15 (1st), 13 (2nd), 10 (3rd), 10 (4th), 20 (5th), 5 (6th), 73 total...he's 2-0 for the third time in his career (started 4-0 in 2014 and 2-0 in 2012).

ALBERT PUJOLS: Had a two-out double in the fifth, chasing **Jakob Junis** from the game...he's now 12 hits shy of becoming the 32nd player with 3,000 hits.
 + Batting .312/.398/.572 (115-for-369) in 95 career games vs. Kansas City with 24 HR and 80 RBI...among active players, only **Miguel Cabrera** and **Carlos Santana** (27 each) have more HR vs. the Royals.

ZACK COZART: Walked and scored on **Mike Trout's** home run in the fifth, extending his streak of games with a run to a career-high nine, breaking a tie with **Mookie Betts** for the longest active streak in the Majors...it's the longest streak in the Majors since **Brian Dozier** scored in 10 straight from Sept. 19-Oct. 1, 2017 and the longest by an Angel since **Kole Calhoun** also scored in nine straight from Sept. 5-13, 2014.

MIKE TROUT: Hit a two-run home run in the fifth inning, his fourth in the last seven games...it was the 207th HR of his career, two shy of **Jose Canseco** for sixth most all-time by an American League player before his age-27 season.

LUIS VALBUENA: Hit a solo home run to leadoff the third inning, snapping **Jakob Junis'** scoreless-innings streak to begin the season at 16.0...28 of his last 30 HR dating back to June 29, 2016 have come vs. right-handed pitchers...he's 12-for-his-last-31 (.387) after starting the season 4-for-24 (.167).

JUSTIN UPTON: Hit a solo home run to leadoff the fourth inning...nine of the 11 HR he's hit since being acquired by the Angels last Aug. 31 have been solo.
 + He's reached safely in his last 11 games vs. Kansas City, batting .356/.420/.533 (16-for-45)...batting .336/.393/.549 (41-for-122) in 31 career games at The K.
