REDBIRD RUNDOWN: The Cardinals continue play on their first homestand post All-Star Break with seven games. Tonight, the Cardinals play the third of four games against the Colorado Rockies...the Cardinals went 12-14 in the month of July...they are 6-7 post All-Star Break and 7-7 under interim manager **Mike Shildt** since he took the post on July 15.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals enter today in 4th place in the National League Central, 7.5 games out of first place and 4.5 games out of the second Wild Card position. St. Louis has 55 games remaining on their schedule with 21 against N.L. Central opponents.

SCALING THE ROCKIES: Last night, the Cardinals lost their first home game to the Rockies since May 19, 2016, snapping a six-game home winning streak vs. Colorado. The Cardinals are 32-13 (.711) against the Rockies at Busch Stadium III, which is the Cardinals 2nd-best home record against any National League opponent (Washington, 1st, 26-10, .722) at the ballpark; but the .289 winning pct. by the Rockies at Busch Stadium III, marks their lowest winning percentage at any current National League park.

LATE DATES: The Cardinals are playing the Colorado Rockies for the first time during the 2018 season and July 30 is the latest they have begun a season series with their Rocky Mountains western 1-70 opponent since the club's inception in 1993. The previous latest date for a first game between the two clubs was July 6, 2010. The Cardinals latest opponent this season is the Los Angeles Dodgers with the Cardinals first game scheduled for August 20 at Dodger Stadium.

CARP PASSES LOU: **Matt Carpenter** led off last night's game with his 22nd career lead-off home run, passing Hall of Famer **Lou Brock (21)** for the Cardinals franchise record for leading off a game with a home run. The home run was his 7th lead-off home run of the season, extending his own Cardinals single-season mark which also leads all of Major League Baseball. Carpenter leads all National League batters with 20 home runs batting No. 1 and trails only **Francisco Lindor (26)** and **Mookie Betts (25)** in MLB.

SECRET SALSA: **Matt Carpenter** is ranked for 2nd in the National League in home runs with 26 (**Nolan Arenado, COL, 28**). Carpenter is two shy of his career high of 28 home runs in 2015. He's four shy of becoming the 15th Cardinals left-handed hitter to whack 30 home runs in a single season and the first since **Jim Edmonds** hit 42 in 2004. Carpenter's 16 home runs hit on the road this season are tied for the most in the National League with **Paul Goldschmidt**. Carpenter's 11 home runs in July led all of Major League Baseball.

AWESOME AUGUST?: Despite posting sub .500 marks in June (12-15) and July (12-14), the Cardinals have posted winning records in August in every season dating back to 2011 (*box to the right*).

THIS BEAR EATS HOME COOKING: **Marcell Ozuna** homered in three straight games twice this season (July 28-30 & June 13-16). The "Big Bear" homered in a career-best in four straight games Sept. 11-14, 2014, while with Miami. Ozuna leads St. Louis with a .309 batting average at home (9th N.L.), and leads the team with 34 home RBI (T10th NL) and is 2nd on the team with nine home round-trippers behind **Matt Carpenter (10)**. The Cardinals lead the National League with 80 home runs hit on the road (Dodgers, 2nd, 70) as opposed to 55 at home.

PITCHING IN: With **Tyler Webb's** appearance Monday night, the Cardinals set a season record with 27 different pitchers participating in a single season. Previously, the record was 26 established in the 2002 season. Newly acquired southpaw **Chasen Shreve**, from the Yankees, appeared in a game last night giving the Cardinals 28 this season, shattering the mark, and matched the 2002 mark which does not include position players. (*The 2018 mark includes pitching appearances by Greg Garcia and Jedd Gyorko.*)

HE GETS ON BASE: **Dexter Fowler** has walked seven times over his last seven games with three multi-walk games including last night. The seven walks ties his most over a seven-game period this season. His seven walks since 7/24 are T2nd most in the National League.

COLORADO CONNECTIONS

Cardinals President of Baseball Operations **John Mozeliak** began his baseball career with the Rockies...initially served as a left-handed batting practice pitcher in 1993 and worked in a variety of positions in the home clubhouse and in baseball operations...joined St. Louis as an assistant in scouting operations following the 1995 season...graduated from Fairview High School in Boulder, Colo., where he was a first baseman and pitcher...graduated from University of Colorado at Boulder.

Cardinals Senior Special Assistant to the GM **Bob Gebhard** served as the Rockies' first General Manager from 1991-99...hired **John Mozeliak** in 1993...worked as a special assistant to former Cardinals General Manager **Walt Jocketty** in St. Louis after leaving the Rockies in 1999...resides in nearby Centennial, Colo.

Cardinals Scouting Director **Randy Flores** pitched in a combined 82 games in three seasons (2002, '09-10) over two stints with Colorado.

Cardinals infielder **Greg Garcia** served as a Rockies bat boy in 2001...his grandfather, **Dave Garcia**, was a bench coach with the Rockies from 2000-02 working under manager **Buddy Bell**.

Cardinals outfielder **Dexter Fowler** played six seasons with the Rockies (2008-13) and made his Major League debut...originally selected by Colorado in the 14th round of the 2004 MLB Draft...is the Rockies franchise record holder in career triples (53)...later traded by Colorado with cash to the Astros for outfielder **Brandon Barnes** and pitcher **Jordan Lyles** (December 3, 2013).

Cardinals infielder **Paul DeJong** made his Major League debut at Colorado (May 28, 2017)...became the 9th player in Cardinals history to homer in his first MLB at-bat, a pinch-hit 9th inning solo home run off **Greg Holland**.

Cardinals outfielder **Harrison Bader** (July 25, 2017) and pitcher **John Brebbia** (May 28, 2017) both made their MLB debuts against the Rockies.

Rockies pitcher **Seung-hwan Oh** and Korean Interpreter **Eugene Koo** spent two seasons with the Cardinals (2016-17).

Rockies pitcher **Adam Ottavino** was selected by St. Louis in the first round (30th overall) in the 2006 MLB Draft...pitched in five games for St. Louis in 2010...selected off waivers by Colorado Rockies (April 3, 2012).

Rockies manager **Bud Black** previously managed Cardinals infielder **Jedd Gyorko** (2013-15) and pitchers **Miles Mikolas** (2012-13) and **Luke Gregerson** (2009-13) while in San Diego...all three made their MLB debuts under Black.

Rockies bullpen coach **Darren Holmes** pitched in five games for St. Louis during the 2000 season.

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter **Derrick Goold** is originally from nearby Boulder, Colo...attended Centaurus High School in Lafayette, Colo...previously worked as a staff writer for the Rocky Mountain News (2000-01).

St. Louis Post-Dispatch columnist writer **Benjamin Hochman** previously worked as a sports writer and columnist for the Denver Post (2007-15).

FOX Sports Midwest reporter **Erica Weston** is originally from Highlands Ranch, Colo...attended Colorado State University.

Rockies Vice President Ticket Sales, Operations & Services **Sue Ann McClaren** worked 15 seasons (1978-92) in the Cardinals sales department before joining the Rockies in 1992.

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Will make his team-leading 22nd start of the season and 40th of his career (44th app.).
- Looking to even his career record (14-15) with a win.
- A win tonight will match his single-season high of 7 in 2017.
- Has not thrown over 100 pitches in any of his last five starts. Last: 104 at MIL (6/24).
- The Cardinals are 10-11 in his 21 starts: 3-6 at Busch Stadium and 7-5 on the road.
- Ranks 2nd on the Cardinals in strikeouts (103), while his 9 losses and 15 home runs allowed lead the team.
- Has been involved in the decision in his last six outings (6/24-present).

LAST TIME OUT

- Made team-leading 21st start and earned a 5-2 win over the Cubs in Friday's homestand opener at Busch Stadium. Marked his first career win over Chicago in six career starts. Was his first win at Busch Stadium since 9/14/17.
- Both runs allowed came on solo homers from Anthony Rizzo and Javier Báez.

- Has recored 100 strikeouts in a season for the first time in his MLB career.
- Has five wins on the road, 2nd-most among Cardinals pitchers (Mikolas - 6) and ranks T8th among National League pitchers.
- Threw 6.0 innings vs. CHI (7/27) for the win in his last start, his first career win vs. CHI and his first appearance of more than 4.0 innings vs. the Cubs in six starts.
- Of his 61 runs allowed, 16 (26%) have come in the 5th inning and 15 in the 2nd (25%).
- Has thrown 100+ pitches three times, including season-high 104 on 6/24 at MIL.
- Optioned to Memphis (AAA) with RHP John Brebbia on 7/13 when RHP Luke Gregerson and LHP Tyler Lyons were activated from the 10-day disabled lists.

CAREER

- Is lifetime 5-1 (Cardinals are 7-1) in starts when he does not issue a walk.
- Averaging 9.44 K/9 IP over his career 209.2 Major League innings.
- His 220 career strikeouts are 3rd behind Rick Ankiel (249) and Vinegar Bend Mizell (221) for the highest total all-time among Cardinals through their first 43 career games.
- Has three double-digit strikeout games in his first 43 games, trailing only Rick Ankiel (6) and tied with four others on the Cardinals all-time list.
- Won team-leading seven consecutive 2017 starts (8/2-9/20/17), was the 4th-longest in the National League and longest by a MLB rookie in 2017...he was the first Cardinals rookie to achieve the feat since Ted Wilks (1944) & Johnny Beazley (1942) (*Elias*).
- Became the fifth rookie pitcher in the last 70 years to allow two runs or fewer over seven consecutive winning starts, joining Fernando Valenzuela (eight straight in 1981), Cal Eldred (1992), Jered Weaver (2006) and Steven Matz (2016) (*Elias*).
