### 2017:

- **The Totals** – Batted .160 with 1 double, 1 RBI and 4 walks in 14 games with the Diamondbacks after being selected from Triple-A Reno on Sept. 1...was his first Major League appearance since 2015 (with Cincinnati).
- **Versatile** – Made 5 appearances at shortstop (3 starts), 5 in left field (2), 2 at first base (1) and 1 at second.
- **Ace of Spades** – In 120 games for the Reno Aces, he hit .300 with 17 doubles, 11 triples, 13 homers and 64 RBI.

**PERSONAL:** Kristopher David Negrón...married to Allison...resides in Napa, Calif...graduated from Vanden HS (CA)...during his college career with Consumnes River College, was named the California Community College Baseball Conference Most Valuable Player in 2007.

**CAREER:** Selected by Boston in 7th round of the 2006 MLB First-Year Player Draft...made his Major League debut with the Reds on June 7, 2012 vs. Pittsburgh...in parts of 5 Major League seasons with Cincinnati (2012, 2014-15) and Arizona (2017-18), is a career .216 hitter (58x269) with 13 doubles, 1 triple, 6 home runs and 21 RBI in 112 games...has appeared in the Majors at every position except pitcher and catcher, making starts at the other 7 positions on the field.

**2006:** Began his professional career with the GCL Red Sox, where he hit .261 (37x142) with 19 runs, 6 doubles, 2 triples, 2 home runs and 16 RBI in 41 games...transferred to Single-A Lowell on Aug. 26, batting .393 (11x28) with 8 runs, 2 doubles, 1 triple and 5 RBI in 9 games.

**2007:** Started the season in Single-A Greenville, batting .226 (91x403) with 61 runs, 11 doubles, 4 triples and 3 home runs in 112 games...appeared in 3 games with Single-A Lancaster, hitting .182 (2x11) with 3 runs...was named Red Sox Minor League Base Stealer of the Month for May after stealing 8 bases in 9 attempts, and finished the season with 31 stolen bases (second among all Red Sox minor leaguers).

**2008:** Appeared at three levels in the Red Sox organization...in 92 games with Single-A Greenville, hit .244 (76x311) with 50 runs, 15 doubles, 5 triples, 1 home run and 27 RBI...transferred to AA Portland on July 11, where he appeared in 4 games, batting .143 (1x7) with 1 double...finished the season in Single-A Lancaster, hitting .328 (38x116) with 23 runs, 8 doubles, 3 triples, 7 home runs and 19 RBI...ranked among Red Sox minor league leaders in games played (129, 2nd), triples (8, T2nd), stolen bases (31, 3rd) and runs scored (73, 10th).

**2009:** Began the season in the Boston organization before being traded to Cincinnati for Álex González (inf) and cash considerations on Aug. 14, 2009...between Single-A Salem (BOS), Single-A Sarasota (CIN) and AA Carolina (CIN), hit a combined .259 (126x560) with 19 doubles, 4 triples, 6 home runs and 41 RBI.

**2010:** Spent the majority of the season with AA Carolina, but made 7 appearances in two stints with AAA Louisville...combined to hit .269 (132x491) with 20 doubles, 6 triples, 11 home runs, 41 RBI and 35 stolen bases (2nd among all Reds minor leaguers)...following the season, played for Peoria in the Arizona Fall League, where he was named AFL Player of the Week Nov. 8-14 after batting .368 with 2 home runs and 5 RBI.

**2011:** Spent full season at AAA Louisville, batting .216 (90x417) with 16 doubles, 4 triples,

9 home runs, 45 RBI and 11 stolen bases...ranked second on the club in games played with 123... hit an inside-the-park home run on Aug. 10 at Toledo, Louisville's only inside-the-park home run of the season.

**2012:** Made his Major League debut with Cincinnati on June 7 vs. Pittsburgh as a pinch-runner, appearing in 4 games from June 6-17 and hitting .250 (1x4) with 2 runs...spent the rest of the season with AAA Louisville, where he hit .218 (62x284) with 13 doubles, 2 triples, 6 home runs, 20 RBI in 74 games before suffering a season-ending knee injury on July 5.

**2013:** Spent season at AAA Louisville, leading the club in starts at shortstop with 69...also played 22 games in the outfield, 12 games at third base and 7 games at second base...batted .225 (75x334) with 14 doubles, 1 triple, 5 home runs, 30 RBI and 11 stolen bases in 116 games...connected for a grand slam on April 30 vs. AAA Lehigh Valley.

**2014:** Appeared in a career-high 49 games at the Major League level after being recalled from AAA Louisville July 10...hit .271 (39x144) with 10 doubles, 1 triple, 6 home runs and 17 RBI with Cincinnati...began the season in Louisville, appearing in 75 games and batting .269 (59x219) with 15 doubles, 3 triples, 3 home runs and 25 RBI...made his only professional pitching appearance May 27 vs. AAA Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, tossing a scoreless inning...named Most Outstanding Player in the Ohio Cup (series against Cleveland) after batting .538 with 2 doubles, 1 home run, 5 RBI and 5 runs scored.

**2015:** Split time between AAA Louisville and Cincinnati, making the Reds Opening Day roster and appearing in 102 total games between the two teams...made starts at every position for Cincinnati except for pitcher and catcher...posted a .970 fielding percentage with Cincinnati, committing 3 errors in 90 chances...batted .140 (13x93) with 5 runs, 2 doubles, 2 RBI and 2 stolen bases...at AAA Louisville, hit .216 (44x204) with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 4 home runs and 15 RBI in 59 games.

**2016:** Signed by Chicago-NL as a minor league free agent on Jan. 15 and was a non-roster invitee to Spring Training...spent the entire season with AAA Iowa, hitting .256 (96x375) with 20 doubles, 4 triples, 9 home runs, 46 RBI and 23 stolen bases...appeared in 48 games at shortstop, 27 at third base, 25 at second base, 15 at first base, 12 in left field and 1 in right field.

**POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE:** Was named to the Diamondbacks' Wild Card and DS roster but did not make an appearance.
