## NATIONALS NEWS

### WE'RE IN THE ROCKIES

The Washington Nationals dropped the first game of this final series of the 2018 season on Friday night, 5-2, to the Colorado Rockies...With one win this weekend, the Nationals will secure their seventh straight season with a winning record dating to 2012...With two more wins, Washington will finish with a road record over .500 for the third consecutive year dating to 2016.

### ROLLIN' ROBLES

**Victor Robles** is 6-for-10 (.600) with two doubles, one homer, five RBI, two stolen bases and one run scored in his last two games...In his last nine starts, Robles is hitting .357 (15-for-42) with seven extra-base hits and 10 RBI...Eight of his 10 RBI and five of his seven extra-base hits (2 2B, 3B, 2 HR) have come in his last three starts...He has hit safely in each of the nine starts.

- On Wednesday afternoon against the Marlins, Robles went 4-for-5 with a double, home run, five RBI and a run scored...Since 2000, only six players 21 years of age or younger have recorded a game with at least four hits, a home run and five RBI: BOS **Rafael Devers** (9/26/18), WSH **Victor Robles** (9/26/18), WSH **Juan Soto** (6/29/18), LAA **Mike Trout** (5/21/13), ARI **Justin Upton** (5/20/09) and LAD **Adrian Beltre** (7/27/00).

### TONY TWO BAGS

**Anthony Rendon** has hit safely in 12 of his last 13 games, going 23-for-50 (.460) with five doubles, five homers, 20 RBI, six walks and 10 runs scored...He has struck out just five times during this stretch.

- On the season, Rendon ranks in the NL in doubles (T1st, 44), average (3rd, .311), OPS (4th, .913), slugging percentage (6th, .537), extra-base hits (T9th, 69) and on-base percentage (9th, .376).
- According to FanGraphs.com, Rendon ranks second in the NL in Wins Above Replacement (6.1).
- Rendon's 44 doubles and 69 extra-base hits are new career highs.
- He reached base safely in a career-high 33 straight games from Aug. 21 to Sept. 25...It was the longest active streak in Major League Baseball and is the third-longest streak in the National League this season...STL **Matt Carpenter** is second on the list with a 35-game streak (7/8-8/17) and PHI **Odubel Herrera** had the longest streak in the NL this year (40 G, 3/30-5/19)...During the streak, Rendon hit .369 with a .454 on-base percentage and a .662 slugging percentage.

### EVERYDAY TREA

**Trea Turner** has played in each of Washington's 160 games this season, making 156 starts and four appearances off the bench...The only player in Nationals history (2005-pres.) to appear in all 162 games in a season was **Ryan Zimmerman**, who started all 162 games in 2007.

- If Turner starts each of the last two games left on the schedule, he will tie **Alfonso Soriano** (158 in 2006) for second on the list behind Zimmerman's 162 starts in 2007.
- Turner leads MLB with 43 stolen bases and ranks in the NL in runs (T5th, 101) and hits (T6th, 176).

### 100-100-100

**Bryce Harper** has scored 101 runs, recorded 100 RBI and 129 walks in 2018...He is the first player in Nationals history (2005-pres.) and the seventh player since 2014 to record at least 100 runs, RBI and walks in a season, joining CLE **Jose Ramirez** (2018), CIN **Joey Votto** (2017), NYY **Aaron Judge** (2017), LAA **Mike Trout** (2016), ARI **Paul Goldschmidt** (2015) and TOR **Jose Bautista** (2015, 2014).

- He is just the 23rd player in baseball history to put together a season of at least 100 runs, 100 RBI and 125 walks.
- On the season, Harper ranks in the National League in HR (T3rd, 34), OBP (5th, .391), runs (T5th, 101), RBI (7th, 100) extra-base hits (11th, 66) and OPS (12th, .885).

### BEST OF THE BEST

Since the All-Star break, Washington's offense ranks in the National League in on-base percentage (1st, .351), batting average (1st, .266), doubles (1st, 129), stolen bases (1st, 51), runs (1st, 342), walks (2nd, 270), OPS (1st, 793), slugging percentage (3rd, .441) and home runs (T5th, 77).

- Washington's second-half surge has placed them among the top five NL offenses in 2018 in on-base percentage (1st, .334), OPS (3rd, .752), runs (3rd, 759), home runs (5th, 189) and slugging percentage (5th, .418).

## NATIONALS HISTORY

### September 29 (5-4 on this date)

2017 - **Ryan Zimmerman** led the Nationals over the Pirates, 6-1, with his seventh multi-homer game of the season. He went 4-for-4 with a career-high four extra-base hits (2 2B and 2 HR) and matched a career-best with 12 total bases in the game. **Stephen Strasburg** turned in 7.2 scoreless innings of work and surpassed the 200-strikeout mark for just the second time in his career.

## DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.
