- LHP Tommy Shirley (2ER/5.2IP) took the loss while the Grizzlies bullpen threw 2.1 scoreless innings: LHP Reymin Guduan (0.2IP), RHP Jandel Gustave (0.2IP) and RHP James Hoyt (1IP)...Hoyt has been scoreless in 14 of 18 outings this year (2.21 ERA).
- C Max Stassi highlighted the offense for Fresno by going 2x4 with a triple and a run scored...has had multiple hits in 3 of his 7 games since returning to Fresno.
- RF Preston Tucker went 1x4 in his 1st game since getting optioned to Triple A.

TODAY'S GAME: Corpus Christi Hooks at San Antonio Missions, 11:05 a.m. CT | **PROBABLE STARTERS:** RHP Cy Sneed (1-1, 3.42 ERA)

- DH Trent Woodward (1x6, HR, RBI) snapped an 0-for-24 streak, hitting a solo homer in the top of the 13th inning last night that propelled Corpus Christi to a 2-1 win over San Antonio...the Hooks have won 13 of their last 16 games and a season-high 8 games in a row.
- After a rough 5-start stretch (17ER in 15.2IP), RHP Francis Martes (1ER/6IP) bounced back with a stellar outing...the Texas League's youngest pitcher (20 years old) allowed 1 run on 4 hits (all singles) in 6.0 innings, walking 1 with 5 strikeouts.
- RHP Aaron West (0ER/3IP) went 3.0 scoreless for his 1st win, while RHP Brendan McCurry (0ER/1IP) worked around 3 hits in the 13th for his 6th save of the year...is tied for the Texas League-lead in saves.
- SS Alex Bregman went 1x5 with a walk and an RBI...leads the Texas League in OBP (.432), ranks 2nd in OPS (1.099) and SLG (.667), and 5th in batting average (.323).

- LF Bobby Boyd (3x4) paced the offense with 3 hits, including a double and 2 runs scored...2B Brooks Marlow (1x4, 2RBI) broke the 3-3 tie in the 8th with a 2-out, 2-run double.
- C Garrett Stubbs (2x4, 2RBI) has hit in 14 consecutive games at a .347 (17x49) clip.

• IF **Bobby Wernes**, the Astros 30th round pick in the 2015 draft out of Arkansas, won the New York-Penn League batting title with a .346 (65x188) batting average...Wernes also posted a league-leading .434 on-base percentage...led all 3rd basemen in fielding percentage (.976).

• OF **Dexture McCall** was a New York-Penn League Midseason All-Star, batting .295 (59x200) with 9 doubles, 4 HR, 37 RBI and a .376 on-base percentage in 59 games...was named the **MVP of the All-Star Game** after hitting a 2-run double.

• The Greeneville Astros captured their 2nd Appalachian League Championship title in the history of the franchise in 2015...it marked their first title since their inaugural season in 2004...the club finished in 2nd place in the regular season before tearing through the playoffs and defeating Princeton, 2-1, in the championship.

• OF **Kyle Tucker**, the 5th overall selection in the 2015 draft, played a key role in Greeneville's postseason run...batted .375 (9x24) with 3 home runs, driving in 6 total runs in the postseason...hit a crucial, 3-run homer in the final game of the Appalachian League Championship Series.

• In 30 games in the GCL, OF **Daz Cameron** hit .272 (28x103) with 2 doubles, 3 triples, 11 steals and a .372 on-base percentage.
