### Runs

The Braves scored 10 more times last night to stretch their N.L.-leading run total to 209.

The Braves are averaging 5.50 runs per game this season...That would be the second-highest per game average in the franchise's modern era...The 2003 club set the record with a 5.60 mark on their way to 101 wins and a N.L. East title.

The club's run differential per game mark of +1.48 would also be the second-highest in the team's modern era...The 1998 holds the record of +1.51.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Braves and Marlins finish a four-game set today with the sixth game of the Braves' third road trip of the season...This is the first meeting between the clubs this season...The teams will play again next weekend in Atlanta, May 18-May 20.

*A* The Braves went 11-8 against the Marlins last season, including 4-5 at Marlins Park...The four wins tied for the fewest the Braves ever recorded at the park in a single season since its opening in 2012 (also went 4-5 in 2014)...The Braves are 37-20 at Marlins Park and have the second-best winning percentage (.649) at the park by a N.L. team.

*A* LHP Sean Newcomb is set to make his third career start against Miami...He went 0-1 with a 4.91 ERA (6 ER/11.0 IP) in two games, two starts, against the Marlins last season...Newcomb has never pitched at Marlins Park as both of the starts came at SunTrust Park.

*A* RHP José Ureña has gone 2-0 with a 2.70 ERA (7 ER/23.1 IP) in his last four starts against Atlanta...Prior to this stretch, was 0-3 with a 10.29 ERA (16 ER/14.0 IP) over six career appearances, three starts, against the Braves.

**HOME RUNS:** The Braves hit a season high-tying four home runs last night (also May 3 at New York-NL), giving them 48 this season, tied for the third most in the National League...Only Colorado (51) and Washington (50) have more.

*A* Last night was the Braves' 38th game of the season...Only five other teams in Atlanta franchise history reached 48 home runs in a season quicker than season's team: 1966, 1970, 1994, 1998 and 2013.

*A* The Braves 1.26 home runs per game is the sixth-highest ratio in Atlanta franchise history...The 2003 hit 1.45 homers per game.

*A* The Braves have not been totally reliant on the home run, however, as they have scored 82 runs this season via homer, or 39.2% of their N.L.-leading run total (209 total runs)...Last season, only five teams scored a lesser percentage of their runs via a homer, with the league average finishing at 42.3%.

**THE OFFENSE:** The Braves offense leads all of the majors in batting average (.270) and on-base percentage (.338), while leading the N.L. in slugging percentage (.445), runs (209), hits (368), doubles (80) and extra-base hits (135).

*A* They also rank second in the N.L. with a +55 run differential, one off the lead of the Chicago Cubs...The Philadelphia Phillies are third at +37.

*A* A Braves player holds or shares the league lead in hits (Nick Markakis, 1st, 53), home runs (Ozzie Albies, T1st, 12), runs (Albies, 1st, 37), stolen bases (Ender Inciarte, 1st, 17), and extra-base hits (Albies 1st, 26).

**TWO HOME RUNS:** 1B Freddie Freeman hit two home runs off LHP Jarlin García last night for his second multi-homer game this season and the 13th of his career...Freeman had never hit two home runs off a lefty in the same game...He now has the seventh most multi-home games in Atlanta franchise history.

*A* Since the start of the 2016 season, Freeman has homered on average every 16.77 at-bats, the seventh-best mark in the N.L.

*A* After hitting four home runs in his first 30 games, Freeman has four home runs in his last eight games.

**SCORELESS:** LHP Sean Newcomb has thrown 14.0 consecutive scoreless innings, the longest such streak of his career and the fifth longest in the majors...Teammate Julio Teheran has currently tossed 15.0 consecutive scoreless frames.

*A* Newcomb ended his start on April 26 at Cincinnati with 1.0 scoreless frame before tossing 7.0 scoreless innings and allowing just two hits, May 2 at New York (NL)...Threw 6.0 scoreless innings with just two hits allowed in his last turn, May 8 at Tampa Bay.

*A* He became the first Braves starter since Greg Maddux (June 27 and July 2, 1999) to log consecutive scoreless starts of at least 6.0 innings with two or fewer hits allowed.

**WITH TWO OUTS:** The Braves scored six more runs last night with two outs and now have a MLB-most 105 two-outs runs this season...They also lead the majors with 148 hits, a .308 batting average, a .528 slugging percentage and a .390 on-base percentage in these situations.

*A* The club's .918 OPS with two outs is tops in the majors...The next closest team is Los Angeles (AL) at .846

**DAY GAME:** The Braves are 9-2 in day games this season, while averaging 7.00 (77 total) runs per game...They have averaged 4.89 (132 total) runs in their 27 night games.

*A* The Braves have 21 home runs in their 11 day games...They have 27 in their 27 night games.

**THE BULLPEN:** The Braves bullpen tossed 4.1 more scoreless innings last night, bringing its season ERA to 3.50, the eighth-best mark in the majors.

*A* RHP Dan Winkler ran his scoreless outings streak to 11 straight with a scoreless inning last night...Winkler has thrown 8.2 innings over this stretch with 12 strikeouts and two hits allowed.

*A* RHP Shane Carle has not allowed an earned run over his last 11 appearances after going 1.2 shutout innings last night...His streak spans 11.2 innings.

*A* RHP Arodys Vizcaino tossed a perfect ninth last night and since failing to convert his only save chance on April 11 in Washington, owns 0.75 ERA and a .146 batting average against.

#### Today's Game

- A* Set for his eighth start of the season and the 27th of his career.
- A* Has thrown 14.0 consecutive scoreless innings, the longest such streak of his career and the fifth longest in the majors...Teammate Julio Teheran has currently tossed 15.0 consecutive scoreless frames.
- A* Ended his start on 4/26 at CIN with 1.0 scoreless frame before tossing 7.0 scoreless innings and allowing just two hits, 5/2 at NYM...Threw 6.0 scoreless innings with just two hits allowed in his last turn, 5/8 at TB.
- A* Became the first Braves starter since Greg Maddux (6/27 and 7/2/99) to log consecutive scoreless starts of at least 6.0 innings with two or fewer hits allowed.
- A* Pitched to a 3-0 record with a 1.98 ERA (8 ER/36.1 IP) over his last six starts dating to 4/8 at COL...Allowed five runs over 4.1 innings in his season debut.
- A* Since his start on 4/8, his 1.98 ERA is the lowest by a left-handed pitcher in the National League and the second lowest by a southpaw in the majors.
- A* Completed at least 6.0 innings in each of his last four starts, his longest such streak since opening his career with four consecutive "quality" turns (6/10-27/17).
- A* Made two starts against Miami during his debut campaign last season, going 0-1 with a 4.91 ERA (6 ER/11.0 IP)...Fanned eight.
- A* Both of his starts last season occurred at home...Has never pitched at Marlins Park.

#### 2018 Recap

- A* Allowed two hits and three walks over 6.0 scoreless innings, 5/8 at TB...Turned in consecutive scoreless starts for the first time in his career.
- A* Tampa Bay logged just two hits, both of which were singles...Newcomb became the first Braves starter since Greg Maddux (6/27 and 7/2/99) to log consecutive scoreless starts of at least 6.0 innings with two or fewer hits allowed.
- A* Tossed a career-most 7.0 innings, 5/2 at NYM, and held the Mets to just two hits and one walk while fanning eight...The outing was his second scoreless start of at least 6.0 innings in his last five appearances after entering the season with just one such start in his career.
- A* Completed 6.0 innings for the third consecutive start, his first time doing so since opening his career with four consecutive "quality" starts, 6/10-27/17.
- A* Went 6.0 innings, 4/26 at CIN, and held the Reds to five hits and four runs while striking out seven...All four runs he allowed came in the fifth inning, including three on a home run by Joey Votto.
- A* Limited the Mets to six hits and three runs, two earned, 4/20 at SunTrust Park...Walked three and struck out five in a 5-3 Atlanta loss.
- A* Has 27 strikeouts in 22.2 career innings against New York (10.72 SO/9.0 IP)...Among qualified pitchers over the last two seasons, only Yu Darvish (11.93) and Max Scherzer (11.57) have fanned more Mets per 9.0 innings than Newcomb.
- A* Went 5.1 innings, 4/14 at CHI, and held the Cubs to six hits and three runs, two earned...Was the 14th start in his last 17 turns dating to 7/23/17 in which he allowed three or fewer runs.
- A* Earned his first win of the season, 4/8 at COL, after allowing just five hits in 6.0+ scoreless innings...Did not walk a batter for the first time in his career...Pitched into the seventh for the third time in his career after facing two batters to open the inning.
- A* Walked at least one batter in each of his first 20 career games...Since the Braves moved to Atlanta in 1966, only two other pitchers opened their careers with longer streaks of walking at least one batter - Pete Smith (29 games) and Tom Glavine (27 games).
- A* Matched his career high with nine strikeouts, tied for most by a Braves starter this season...Eight of his nine strikeouts were swinging.
- A* Went 4.1 innings in his season debut, 4/2 vs. WSH...Allowed five hits, six runs (five earned) and four walks to take the loss...Struck out six.
- A* Failed to complete 6.0 innings for the eighth consecutive start, dating to 8/20 of last season...Over that stretch went 3-3 with a 4.73 ERA (21 ER/40.0 IP) and 24 walks.

#### 2017 Recap

- A* In his second season in the Atlanta organization, made his major league debut after beginning the season with Triple-A Gwinnett.
- A* Finished with 108 strikeouts in 100.0 major league innings...His 9.72 K/9 was the second highest mark by a rookie starter in Atlanta franchise history (minimum 75.0 innings)...Only Brandon Beachy's 10.74 rate in 2011 was higher.

#### Career Recap

- A* Selected by the Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim in the first round (15th overall) of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft.
- A* Acquired by the Atlanta Braves along with SS Erick Aybar, RHP Chris Ellis and cash considerations, from the Los Angeles of Anaheim in exchange for SS Andrelton Simmons and C Jose Briceno on 11/12/15.

### Ronald Acuña Jr. • OF • 6-0 • 205 • 20 yrs • #13

**MIA Series:** .143 (2-14) **Last HR:** 5/8 at TB (Snell)  
**Road Trip:** .143 (3-21), HR **Current Streak:** 1 game (1-5, .200)  
**Season Long Streak:** 3 games, 4/25-4/27 (6-13, .462, HR)

- Has five hits in his last 33 at-bats over an eight-game span dating to 5/4.
- Became the youngest player (20 years, 141 days) to homer in a 1-0 game (5/8 at TB) since 1935, when the Cubs' Phil Cavarretta did it at 19 years, 68 days.
- Became the youngest player to homer for the Braves since Andruw Jones in 1997, hitting a solo shot off Homer Bailey for his first career homer on 4/26 at CIN.
- Atlanta selected his contract from Triple-A Gwinnett, 4/25, for his first appearance on a major league roster...Is the youngest player in baseball.
- Opened the season with Gwinnett and batted .232/.321/.304 over 17 games...Had 11 hits, seven runs, two extra-base hits and three steals in his last eight games.
- Entered the 2018 season tabbed as Atlanta's top overall prospect by both Baseball America and MLB.com, and as the top overall outfield prospect in the minors... MLB.com named him as the No. 2 prospect overall in the minor leagues.
- Named Minor League Player of the Year by both Baseball America and USA Today, Hitting Prospect of the Year by MLB Pipeline.com and Organizational Player of the Year by the Braves last season.

### Ozzie Albies • INF • 5-8 • 165 • 21 yrs • #1

**Season Long Streak:** 8 games, 5/3-5/11 (11-36, .306, 3 HR)

- Leads the N.L. in extra-base hits (26), runs (37) and total bases (97)...Is tied for first in doubles (13) and home runs (12), tied for fifth in hits (46) and is sixth in slugging percentage (.581).
- Is hitting a .447 (17-for-38) in the first inning this season...His 17 hits, 12 runs and nine extra-base hits in the first inning are all the most in the majors, while his five home runs are tied for the most.
- Set the franchise record for most extra-base hits (22) by the end of April and tied for the second most in MLB history...Broke the Atlanta record of 17 held by Dale Murphy, Chipper Jones and Justin Upton...Finished one shy of Jermaine Dye's 2000 record.
- Hit his first career grand slam, 5/10 at MIA, becoming the youngest Braves player (21 years, 123 days) to hit one since fellow Curaçao native Andruw Jones on 8/31/97 at BOS.

- Hit his first home run with the Braves last night, 5/13 at MIA, to snap a 0-for-13 skid.
- Has gone 4-for-24 (.167) in eight games with the Braves after making his ATL debut on 5/4 when the club selected his contract from Triple-A Gwinnett...The club signed him to a minor league deal on 4/18.
- Appeared in 12 minor league games, going 11-for-43 (.256) with one home run, five RBI and eight walks.
- Started with Single-A Florida, appearing in two games and collected two hits in seven at-bats...Made his Strippers debut on 4/23 and hit .250 (9-for-36) with his lone home run.
- Appeared in 157 games with Toronto last season, hitting .203 (119-for-587) with 23 home runs and a .308 on-base percentage.
- Played third base eight times last season, making four starts there...Entering this season, played 394 career games at third base, 349 starts.

- Is 1-for-4 (.250) with one walk as a pinch hitter.
- Returned from his rehabilitation assignment, 4/18 and struck out as a pinch hitter... Missed 16 games with a right oblique muscle strain.
- Went 3-for-5 for Triple-A Gwinnett on 4/18 to become the first player to play in both a minor league and major league game on the same day since Lane Adams did it for the Braves last June 7.
