## LOS ANGELES ANGELS (69-72) at CHICAGO WHITE SOX (56-85)

#### WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have lost three consecutive games but won eight of their last 14 games, 14 of 23 and 19 of 34 as they continue a 10-game, 11-day homestand tonight vs. the Angels
- RHP James Shields, who has worked at least 6.0 IP in 23 starts this season, is scheduled to start for the White Sox.
- The Sox are 3-5 on the homestand, suffering the defeat in last night's series opener vs. Los Angeles-AL after losing two of three vs. Detroit and splitting a four-game series vs. Boston.
- Following this three-game weekend series vs. the Angels, Chicago will take a nine-game. 11-day trip to Kansas City (8/10-12), Baltimore (8/14-16) and Cleveland (8/18-20).
- The Sox went 5-2 on their last trip to Detroit (3-1) and New York-AL (2-1) from 8/23-29, including their first series win at Yankee Stadium since 2005.

#### **TONIGHT'S STORYLINES**

- The White Sox have lost three consecutive games, their longest losing streak since 8/11-13 ... they have not lost four-plus in a row since 7/4-10 (six straight).
- Chicago needs to win tonight and tomorrow to secure just its second season-series win vs. Los Angeles-AL since 2011 (1-6 season mark during that span) ... the Sox have lost three consecutive games to the Angels by a 28-13 margin.
- The White Sox starters have allowed 15 earned runs on 19 hits, including five home runs and eight walks over the last three games (9.1 IP), and failed to work into the sixth inning.
- The Sox have scored four runs or less in each of the last four games (2.8 R/G), batting .205/.261/.315 with four home runs.
- James Shields is 4-2 with a 2.43 ERA (11 ER/40.2 IP), 35 strikeouts, a .208 .opp average and 1.03 WHIP over his last six home starts ... he has allowed two earned runs or less four times.

#### **ROSTER MOVES**

- Prior to tonight's game, the White Sox placed RHP Michael Kopech on the 60-day disabled list with an ulnar collateral ligament sprain in his right elbow and purchased the contract of RHP Rob Scahill from Class AAA Charlotte
- Scahill went 3-4 with a 5.64 ERA (38 ER/60.2 IP), 71 strikeouts and five saves in 52 relief appearances this season with Charlotte.
- Scahill is a native of Lombard, resides in Villa Park, attended Bradley Univ. in Peoria and is a graduate of Willowbrook H.S.
- Kopech yesterday was shut down for the season following an examination of his right ulnar collateral ligament.
- Kopech went 1-1 with a 5.02 ERA (8 ER/14.1 IP), 15 strikeouts, and two walks in his first four MLB starts this season.

### LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

- Shohei Ohtani capped a four-run third inning with a three-run home run off Carlos Rodón in the Angels' 5-2 win.
- Los Angeles-AL loaded the bases with nobody out in the third before Justin Upton tied the game with a sacrifice fly and Ohtani added his 19th homer of the season.
- The White Sox were limited to four hits over the final five innings, went 1-5 with RISP, left six on base and walked just once.
- Rodón fell to 6-5 after allowing four runs on six hits with five walks and four strikeouts over 4.2 IP ... he failed to make a quality start for the second straight outing after making nine consecutive.
- Avisaíl García hit a solo homer in the second and recorded the Sox only multihit effort ... Omar Narváez was 1-3 with a RBI.

## **GUARANTEED HALF DOZEN**

- RHP James Shields has worked at least 6.0 IP 23 times this season, the third-most in the American League and sixth-most in MLB ... Max Scherzer leads MLB with 27 such starts
- He has gone 6-10 with a 3.57 ERA (60 ER/151.1 IP), .220 opp. average and 1.14 WHIP in the 23 outings (17 QS).
- By comparison, made 23 starts of 6.0-plus IP over his first 43 outings with the White Sox from 6/8/16-9/25/17.

## **MAJOR MINOR HONORS**

- Class AA Birmingham RHP Dylan Cease has been named the Pitcher of the Year by MLBPipeline.com.
- Cease went 12-2 with a 2.40 ERA (33 ER/124.0 IP), 160 strikeouts (11.6 per 9.0 IP) and a 1.07 WHIP over 23 starts between Birmingham and Class A Winston-Salem this season.
- Cease and Class AAA Charlotte OF Eloy Jiménez were named to the MLBPipeline.com Prospect Team of the Year ... Winston-Salem RHP Tyler Johnson was named to the Second-Team.

### **GRAB SOME BENCH**

- The White Sox have struck out 1,361 times this season, the most in the major leagues ... they are 36 shy of tying the franchise record of 1,397 set in 2017.
- Yoán Moncada leads MLB with 191 strikeouts in 2018.

#### WHITE SOX VS. LOS ANGELES ANGELS

- The White Sox are 2-3 vs. the Angels this season despite being outscored by a 33-22 margin.
- The Sox are hitting .233/.303/.443 with 10 home runs, own a 6.91 ERA (33 ER/43.0 IP) and have made two quality starts.
- Chicago has won five of the last nine games but are 5-11 in the last 16 ... the club is 9-4 over the last 13 games at Guaranteed Rate Field, compared to 3-16 in the last 19 at Angel Stadium.
- The Sox went 3-4 vs. Los Angeles-AL in 2017 (3-1 at home). Chicago has lost six of the last seven season series dating back to 2011 ... 2015 marked the only victory (4-3).
- The White Sox trail in the all-time series, 363-371. 194-170 at home (68-59 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 169-201 on the road (147-178 at Angel Stadium).

#### WINNING WAYS

- The White Sox have gone 14-9 (.609) since 8/14, tied for the third-best record in the American League.
- The Sox are 19-15 since 8/2, moving from 9.0 games behind Detroit to within two games of the Tigers in the AL Central.
- Chicago is 23-23 in the second half, including a 17-12 mark in August, its most wins in a month since May 2012 (18-11) ... the club is 9-7 since José Abreu was placed on the DL on 8/22.

#### WILD WILD WEST

- The White Sox are 10-22 vs. the American League West in 2018, going 6-9 at home and 4-13 on the road ... they have been outscored, 78-56, in the 14 road games.
- The Sox have lost nine of the last 12 games, 11 of the last 15 and 16 of the last 25 ... the White Sox have won consecutive games vs. the division just twice this season.
- Chicago has lost 13 of 17 games and 19 of 26 on the road ... the club has allowed seven-plus runs 14 times in the last 26.
- The Sox are 188-176 vs. the West since 2008 (80-102 on road).

## 35TH AND SHIELDS

- James Shields has allowed three earned runs or less in 12 of his last 13 home starts, going 5-5 with a 2.71 ERA (26 ER/86.1 IP), .204 opp. average, 1.03 WHIP and 11 quality starts.
- Has worked 7.0-plus IP eight times, allowed two earned runs or less eight times and surrendered five or fewer hits nine times.
- Shields is receiving a 4.07 run support average (39 RS) during the 13-start span ... the White Sox have scored zero runs four times, one run twice and five or more five times.

### **PALKA POWER**

- Daniel Palka, who was claimed off waivers from Minnesota on 11/4/17, ranks among the American League rookie leaders in home runs (3rd, 21), RBI (3rd, 55), extra-base hits (3rd, 38), runs scored (T4th, 47) and total bases (5th, 167).
- Palka's 21 homers are the second-highest total in Sox history by a LH rookie, one behind Pete Ward's club record of 22 in 1963.
- His three pinch-hit homers this season are tied with Oscar Gamble (1977), John Romano (1959) and Ron Northey (1956) for the White Sox franchise record, and his nine RBI are the most by a Sox pinch-hitter since Jerry Hairston in 1987 (10).

### POWER AND SPEED ...

- Tim Anderson (18 HR/25 SB) is one of five players in the major leagues with at least 18 home runs and 25 stolen bases, joining Boston's Mookie Betts, Pittsburgh's Starling Marte, Cleveland's José Ramírez and Colorado's Trevor Story
- Anderson is attempting to become the first White Sox shortstop to record a 20-HR/20-SB season, and could join Alex Ríos (2010) and Tommie Agee (1966) as the only players in franchise history to post 20 homers and 30 steals in one season.

## **QUALITY AND QUANTITY**

- The White Sox have made 1,379 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, one behind the New York Mets (1,380) for the highest total in the major leagues and 51 more than Oakland (1,328), the next-closest American League team.
- The Sox are tied with Boston for third in th AL with 64 quality starts this season ... RHP James Shields is tied for seventh in the AL with 17 QS in 2018.

## RACE FOR THE PRIZE

- Class A Winston-Salem last night lost to Buies Creek, 6-5, capping a three-game sweep in the Carolina League semis.
- Class A Kannapolis last night was no-hit in their season-ending loss to Lakewood ... the Intimidators lost both games in the bestof-three, South Atlantic League semifinals.
- Advanced Rookie Great Falls earned a 3-2 win at Billings in Game 1 of the best-of-three, Pioneer League semis ... the Voyagers host Game 2 tonight looking to advance to the championship.

#### SHIELDS AT A GLANCE

- Is scheduled to make his 31st appearance (30th start), 18th start at Guaranteed Rate Field and second vs. Los Angeles-AL ... is looking to record his sixth win in Chicago, compared to just one on the road (Opening Day).
- Today marks the 402 start of his career ... is tied with Felix Hernandez (2005-18) for 131st place in MLB history ... Washington's Max Scherzer leads the majors with 27 such starts.
- $\bullet~$  Has worked 6.0-plus IP in 23 starts this season, the third-most in the American League and sixth-most in MLB.
- His 15 losses are tied with Alex Cobb and Tanner Roark for the most in MLB this season.
- Has worked at least 6.0 IP in 21 of his last 25 starts since 4/25 ... is 5-13 with a 4.13 ERA (73 ER/159.0 IP), 1.23 WHIP, .233 opponents average and 3.85 RSA (68 RS) during the 25-start span.
- Is 15-34 with a 5.29 ERA (243 ER/413.2 IP), 322 strikeouts, 85 home runs allowed and a 1.45 WHIP over 73 appearances (72 GS/34 QS) since being acquired by the White Sox from the Padres in a trade on 6/4/16.
- Ranks among the active MLB leaders since 2007 in starts (2nd, 380),
   IP (2nd, 2,469.0), pitches thrown (2nd, 38,879), quality starts (T4th, 233),
   opponents GIDP (6th, 198), strikeouts (7th, 2,117) and wins (12th, 138).

#### LAST START

- Recorded his sixth win of the season on 9/2 vs. Boston after tossing 6.0 scoreless IP, walking two and striking out six.
- Surrendered just four hits, singles to Xander Bogaerts (first and fifth innings), Blake Swihart (second) and J.D. Martinez (sixth).
- Left with the White Sox leading, 7-0, after tossing 93 pitches (57 strikes) ... the White Sox went on to win, 8-0 ... Chicago shutout the Red Sox at home for the first time since 4/10/94.

#### BITTEN BY THE BIG INNING (LEAVE THIS ONE)

- Has allowed 30 of his 89 earned runs (33.7 percent) over the span of eight individual innings (7.0 IP) in eight starts in 2018 ... his season ERA would be 3.14 (59 ER/169.1 IP) without the below eight innings.

### **LOW AND SLOW**

- Opponents are hitting just .232 (133-573) since 5/1, the ninth-lowest mark in the American League (Blake Snell's .189 average is the lowest)... his .173 opponents average in May was the fourth-lowest in the AL.
- Is limiting opponents to the following averages: .216 (71-329) at night, .209 (72-344) vs. left-handers, .208 (92-442) with nobody on base and .222 average (90-405) at Guaranteed Rate Field.

### A TALE OF TWO STRETCHES

- Owns an 9-19 record in 40 appearances (39 starts) since 8/5/17 despite recording a 4.38 ERA (118 ER/242.2 IP), .237 opp. average and 22 quality starts ... has allowed three earned runs or less 28 times.
- By comparison, went 6-15 with a 6.58 ERA (125 ER/171.0 IP), .290 opponents average and 46 home runs allowed in his first 33 starts with the White Sox ... made his Sox debut on 6/8/16 vs. Washington.

### 35TH AND SHIELDS

- His 17 starts (T1st) and 109.0 IP (3rd) at home rank among the MLB leaders this season.
- Has allowed three earned runs or less in 12 of his last 13 home starts, going 5-5 with a 2.71 ERA (26 ER/86.1 IP), 1.03 WHIP, 204 average and 70 strikeouts (11 QS) ... worked 7.0-plus IP eight times.
- Is 13-18 with a 4.46 ERA (124 ER/250.0 IP), 232 hits allowed (46 homers), 100 walks, 198 strikeouts, a 242 opp. average and 1.33 WHIP in 42 starts (25 quality) at Guaranteed Rate Field with the White Sox.
- Prior to joining the White Sox, was 4-1 with a 3.00 mark (24 ER/72.0 IP), 1.33 WHIP, 47 strikeouts and nine home runs allowed over 11 starts (nine quality starts) as a visitor at Guaranteed Rate Field.

### HELP WANTED

- Owns a 4.21 run support average as a starter in 2018 ... received two runs or less of support in 16 of his last 24 starts (one or less 10 times) and three or less in 19 of the last 27 (3.59 RSA; 68 RS/170.2 IP) since 4/11... the club scored 17 runs in his first two outings.
- His 11-start stretch of three runs or less of support from 4/11-6/7 was his longest since 9/27/15-6/8/16 (13).
- Owns a 4.51 RSA (207 RS/413.0 IP) as a starter since joining the White Sox (72 starts), receiving the following run support marks: zero runs (17x), one (12x), two (13x), three (7x), four (5x), five (6x) and six-plus (12x) ... has received two runs or less of support in 58.3 percent (42-72) of his outings with the Sox.

### NOT DIGGING THE LONG BALL

- Has surrendered 27 home runs this season, including 23 in his last 18 starts ... allowed three homers
  in each outing on 6/2 vs. Milwaukee and 6/7 at Minnesota after going 14 consecutive appearances without
  allowing multiple homers from 9/20/17-5/27/18, the second-longest stretch of his career.
- Has allowed 94 homers since 2016 and 127 since 2015 ... the 127 home runs allowed since 2015 are the most in MLB, and his 1.67 homers-per-9.0 IP mark since 2015 (683.1 IP) is the fourth-highest.

### VS. LOS ANGELES ANGELS

- Is 7-5 with a 3.48 ERA (42 ER/108.2 IP), 100 strikeouts, a 1.24 WHIP and .272 opponents average in 16 career starts ... 12 of the starts have been quality and has allowed two runs or less eight times.
- His 3.48 ERA vs. the Angels is his second-lowest vs. an American League team (2.61 vs. Texas)
- Has gone 3-2 with a 3.81 ERA (22 ER/52.0 IP), 59 strikeouts and eight home runs allowed over his last eight outings (six QS).
- Suffered the loss in his last start on 7/25 at Angel Stadium, allowing six runs on seven hits with seven strikeouts over 4.0 IP ... earned the win in his last outing at Guaranteed Rate Field on 9/25/17 (2 ER/7.0 IP).
- Is 5-1 with a 1.72 ERA(11 ER/57.2 IP) and two homers allowed in eight careers starts (all quality) at home.
