STAYIN' ALIVE, STAYIN' ALIVE: The Padres fell 5-2 to the St. Louis Cardinals in Game 1 of the three-game set...San Diego has won three of its last five games and nine of their last 13...tonight, the Friars hope to force a rubber match on Wednesday and are in danger of snapping their four-series winning streak, their longest series winning stretch since Aug. 10-23, 2015.

- Starter **Jordan Lyles** worked 6.0 innings last night, allowing a season-high-tying 11 hits...he relinquished four runs (earned) with two strikeouts and no walks...left-handed batters went 0-for-7 against him last night, and lefties have now hit just .198 vs. Lyles this season.
- **Cory Spangenberg** hit his sixth homer of the season and his third his past seven games...in that time since June 3, he's hit .333 (8-for-24) with two triples, three homers and six RBI.

STARTING OFF STRAHM: LHP **Matt Strahm** gets his third start of the season tonight, and in his last start on June 6 vs. ATL, he worked a season-high 2.1 innings of two-hit and one-run ball...he's allowed just a one run in 4.1 innings of work as a starter for a 2.08 ERA, and opposing bats are hitting .267 against him as a starter...overall in '18, he owns a 1.30 WHIP with a .192 opponent average.

WORKHORSES: Padre relievers have pitched 257.0 innings this season, the fourth-most of any bullpen...they have fanned 266 batters (also the fourth-most) and have a 3.06 strikeout to walk ratio (fifth-highest in the majors).

CALL IN THE BACKUP: On the road this season, Padres pitchers have received just 102 runs of support, which are the fewest of any team this season as a visitor...they've got 3.71 runs of support per nine innings on the road, and opposing bats are hitting only .244 in grey.

RIGHT?!: Prior to being placed on the disabled list on April 24, **Hunter Renfroe** was hitting .143 vs. right-handed pitchers in 2018...since being reinstated on May 28, he's hit .393 vs. righties with four doubles and a home run...overall, in 13 games since being reinstated, he's slashed .333/.415/.556 with five doubles, a homer, eight RBI and five walks.

JUNE BLOOM: In 10 games in the month of June, the Padres relief crew has held opponent bats to a .203 clip, the fifth-best opponent average of any NL club.

THE BUCK STOPS HERE: Padres relievers have inherited 76 runners this season, allowing 14 of them to score...their 18.4 IR scoring percentage is the best of any team in the majors...since the start of the 2017 season, the Friar bullpen have inherited 11 Cardinal runners, and they haven't allowed any of them to score.

IT'S IN THE CARDS: In 2016, the Padres went 1-6 vs. the Cardinals, with St. Louis batting .339 with RISP and with an average of 6.1 runs per game...since the start of the 2017 season, the Padres are 5-7 vs. STL, holding Redbird bats to a .184 mark with RISP and with a 3.44 ERA and 9.1 strikeouts per nine innings.

PADRES ON DECK: Seven Padres prospects from Lake Elsinore (A) were named to the Southern Division team in the California League All-Star Game (OF **Buddy Reed**, OF **Edward Olivares**, 3B **Hudson Potts**, RHP **Chris Paddack**, RHP **Reggie Lawson**, RHP **Elliot Ashbeck** and LHP **Adrian Morejon**)...last night for Lake Elsinore (A), RHP **Michel Baez** (after being named California League Pitcher of the Week) allowed two runs on eight hits and a walk with six strikeouts over 5.1 innings on Monday night...Baez has a 2.91 ERA on the season.

STARTING PITCHER NOTES

#55 LHP MATT STRAHM (1-2, 3.07 ERA)

MATT'S MOUND: 26-year-old LHP **Matt Strahm** is set to make his third start of the season today and the sixth of his career...it will be his second appearance (first start) against the Cardinals this season.

LAST TIME OUT: His last appearance came in a start on 6/6 vs. ATL, working a season-high 2.1 IP of one-run ball in the Padres' eventual 3-1 victory.

PHEW, WHAT A RELIEF: Owns a 3.48 ERA (4 ER, 10.1 IP) in eight appearances out of the 'pen this season and is limiting opposing hitters to a .162 average (6-for-37).

STARTING OFF STRAHM: Strahm has allowed just a single run in 4.1 innings of work as a starter this season for a 2.08 ERA (has a 3.48 ERA this year in relief)... opposing bats are hitting .267 against him as a starter... three relievers were used in his first start of the year on May 27 at LAD, and four were used on June 6 vs. ATL.

GOT IT OUT OF THE WAY: Since his first appearance this season on May 7 vs. WSH (in which he allowed three earned runs and three walks in 2.0 innings), Strahm has fostered a 1.42 ERA (2 ER, 12.2 IP) in nine appearances...opponents have hit just .178 against him in that time, and he's allowed just three extra-base hits in 52 batters faced (two doubles and one homer).

QUICK RECAP: Began the 2018 season on the 10-day disabled list recovering from his torn left patellar tendon...made nine rehab appearances (two starts) for San Antonio (AA), going 1-0 with a 2.51 ERA (4 ER, 14.1 IP) with 22 strikeouts and four walks...activated from the 10-day DL on May 7.

FAR FROM THE COMFORTS OF HOME: Opposing bats have hit just .121 against Strahm at home this season and have hit .316 on the road.

COMING UP CLUTCH: Strahm has limited hitters to a .192 batting average (5-for-26) with runners on base and a .192 clip (10-for-52) overall on the season...has held opponents scoreless in six of his 10 outings this season.

STRAHMCAST: This season, he has relied primarily on four pitches: four seamer (64.4%), slider (17%), changeup (9.3%) and curve (9.3%)...opponents have hit just .100 against his slider, .111 vs. his changeup and .231 vs. his fastball in 2018.

GETTING AHEAD: Has thrown a first-pitch strike to 37 of his 62 total batters he's faced this season, 59.7 percent of the time.

COME AND GET IT: This season, he's induced a career-high 28.4 chase percentage, per Statcast.

WELCOME TO FRIARHOOD: The Padres acquired Strahm on July 24, 2017, along with **Travis Wood**, infielder **Esteury Ruiz** and cash considerations from the Kansas City Royals in exchange for right-handed pitchers **Trevor Cahill** and **Brandon Maurer** and left-handed pitcher **Ryan Buchter**.

TOMORROW'S STARTER

LAUER HOUR: LHP **Eric Lauer** is set to make his ninth career start and second this season against the St. Louis Cardinals.

- Tagged with the loss in his last outing on 6/8 vs. MIA, tossing career highs in pitches thrown (111) and walks (seven) across 5.0 IP of three-run ball.
- Collected his second career win on 6/4 vs. CIN, working 5.0 IP of one-run ball in SD's 8-2 win.

- Made two starts for the Padres in 2018...is the longest tenured pitcher who has appeared for the Padres at the big league level.

- 51.1% of his pitches this season have been sliders...13.8% of his sliders have been called strikes, the highest percentage across active relievers.
- Was named the National League Reliever of the month for May, the second such honor of his career (also, July 2017)...pitched to a 0.61 ERA (1 ER, 14.2 IP) during May with a 0.89 WHIP, 22 strikeouts and a .120 opponent average.
