Daniel Vogelbach is running a .526/.654/1.105 slash line in 8 games this spring...among players with at least 15 at-bats this spring, Vogelbach's .526 (10x19) average is 4th-best...he trails Mike Freeman-CHC (.560/14x25), Scott Schebler-CIN (.550/11x20) and Nick Markakis-ATL (.533/8x15).

The spring roster is currently at 52 players (36 roster, 16 non-roster)...the camp breakdown by position is the following: 24 pitchers (6 non-roster), 4 catchers (1 non-roster), 11 infielders (3 non-roster) and 13 outfielders (6 non-roster).

TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners continue their 42nd spring training with a Cactus League match-up tonight against the Cincinnati Reds at Goodyear Ballpark...tonight's game is the 16th of a 32-game Cactus League schedule for the Mariners that concludes March 27 vs. the Colorado Rockies at Salt River Fields...the Mariners will open the 2018 season March 29 vs. Cleveland at Safeco Field.

BRINGING VOGELBACH...**Daniel Vogelbach** has reached base safely in 7 of his last 8 plate appearances, dating back to the 4th inning on March 7 vs. Oakland...he is 5-for-6 with 4 doubles, 1 home run and 2 walks during that span...Vogelbach went 3-for-4 with 1 run, 2 doubles, 1 home run and 1 RBI yesterday at San Francisco and is now batting .526 (10x19) with 4 runs, 5 doubles, 2 home runs, 4 RBI and 6 walks in 8 games this spring...among Spring Training leaders, his 5 doubles are T2nd-most (also: 5 others), trailing only Boston's Blake Swihart (7).

THE HALFWAY POINT...tonight's game marks the midway point of the Mariners 32-game Cactus League schedule this spring...following tonight's match-up against the Reds, Seattle will play 16 games in 17 days before opening the 2018 regular season on Thursday, March 29 vs. the Cleveland Indians at Safeco Field...of the Mariners remaining 16 Cactus League games after tonight, 9 will be played in Peoria (8 home games, 1 "road" game vs. San Diego), 9 will be played during the day, and 9 will be played against American League opponents, including 6 vs. AL West foes.

HEALING UP...**Mitch Haniger** is slated to make his 2018 Cactus League debut tonight at Cincinnati, batting 2nd and playing right field...Haniger has been rehabbing from inflammation in his right hand...he is the 3rd Mariners player to make their Cactus League debut in the 8 days, joining **Guillermo Heredia** (3/2 at MIL) and **David Phelps** (3/3 vs. LAA).

ROSTER MOVES...the Mariners made the following roster moves today: optioned to AAA Tacoma - RHP **Andrew Moore** and RHP **Nick Rumbelow**...reassigned to minor league camp - RHP **Johendi Jiminian**...placed on waivers for purpose of unconditional release - RHP **Tony Zych**.

VS. THE REDS...the Mariners and Reds meet tonight in the first of two Cactus League match-ups this spring (also: tomorrow in Peoria)...the Mariners went 2-0 against the Reds during Cactus League play last season...Seattle has dominated the all-time regular season series between the two clubs, going 13-2 in 15 meetings...the Mariners and Reds will not meet during the 2018 regular season.

GAME TIME CHANGE...the Mariners Cactus League finale, March 27 vs. Colorado, will now start at **12:10 p.m.**...it was originally slated for a 1:10 p.m. first pitch.

THE HITTERS...Mariners hitters are batting .265 (135x509) with 67 runs, 21 doubles, 5 triples, 16 home runs, 60 RBI, 13 stolen bases, a .335 on-base percentage and a .420 slugging percentage in 15 games this spring...among Spring Training leaders, the Mariners rank T7th in triples and T10th in stolen bases...Seattle is averaging 4.47 runs per game (67 R, 15 G).

THE PITCHERS...Mariners pitchers have combined for a record of 5-9-1 with a 5.11 ERA (75 ER, 132.0 IP) with 133 strikeouts and 44 walks in 15 games this spring...Seattle pitchers have allowed 141 hits, including 25 home runs...**Dan Altavilla**, **Wyatt Mills**, **Sam Moll**, **Mike Morin** and **Ljay Newsome** have each recorded 1 save for Seattle...among Spring Training leaders, the Mariners rank T4th in saves, T4th in fewest walks allowed and 12th in strikeouts.

WELCOME BACK, ICHIRO...the Mariners agreed to terms with free agent outfielder **Ichiro Suzuki** on Wednesday...Ichiro is the active Major League hits leader, ranking 22nd all-time in MLB history with 3,080 career hits...after amassing 1,278 hits during a 9-year career (1992-2000) with the Orix Blue Wave, Ichiro has totaled 4,358 between MLB and Japan...Ichiro has appeared in 17 Major League seasons with Seattle (2001-12), New York-AL (2012-14) and Miami (2015-17).

WHAT TIME IS IT ANYWAY?...Arizona is currently one hour ahead of Seattle time...when the clocks change for Daylight Saving Time tonight, Seattle and Peoria will be on the same time...so tonight's game starts at 5:05 pm in Seattle (5:05 pm in Goodyear).

PLAY-BY-PLAY...all radio broadcasts, including tonight's game at the Reds, can be heard live on Mariners.com...tonight's broadcast will also be aired live on **710 ESPN Seattle** beginning at 5:00 p.m. PT...**Aaron Goldsmith** and **Mike Blowers** will call the action tonight.

HEY MIKE, AS YOU MAY KNOW...**Daniel Vogelbach** is running a 1.105 slugging percentage in 8 Cactus League games this spring...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...that among players with at least 15 at-bats this spring, Vogelbach's 1.105 slugging mark ranks 7th-best in all of Spring Training?...he trails only Jason Kipnis (1.364), Kyle Jensen (1.313), Ian Happ (1.190), Austin Hedges (1.125), Whit Merrifield (1.120) and Trevor Story (1.118).

2018 Spring Training - 1-0, 3.60 ERA (2 ER, 5.0 IP) in 2 GS...W#1 in Cactus League debut on 2/23 at SD (2.0,2,1,1,2,1)...ND in start on 2/28 at CLE (3.0,4,1,1,1,3).

- **Last Season** - Went 8-7 with 5.12 ERA (91 ER, 160.0 IP) with 137 strikeouts in 31 games, including 29 starts, with the Mariners.
- **Leader** - Led Seattle in starts and innings while ranking 2nd in wins and strikeouts.
- **Strong Start** - Was 7-4 with 4.31 ERA (58 ER, 121.0 IP) with 98 strikeouts in first 21 starts...in final 10 games, including 8 starts, was 1-3 with 7.62 ERA (33 ER, 39.0 IP).
- **No Hits for You** - Limited opponents to .233 (140x600) average, 7th-best in AL (min. 150 IP).
- **Home Sweet Home** - Was 3-3 with a 3.95 ERA (37 ER, 84.1 IP) with 72 strikeouts in 14 games (13 GS) at home...5-4 with a 6.42 ERA (54 ER, 75.2 IP) in 17 games (16 GS) on road.
- **Longball** - Allowed 37 home runs, 2nd-most in MLB (Rick Porcello-BOS, 38)...also 2nd-most in club history (Jamie Moyer, 44, 2004).
- **You Complete Me** - Earned his 6th win of the season in the Mariners 7-1 win over Tampa Bay on June 4 at Safeco Field, his first career complete game...allowed 1 run on 4 hits while walking 1 and striking out 9 over 9.0 innings.
- **The Trade** - Acquired by the Mariners from Baltimore in exchange for LHP Wade Miley on July 31, 2016.
- **Career** - Played for seven seasons in Cuba before signing with Baltimore as a minor league free agent on May 2, 2015...made his Major League debut last season with the Orioles on July 3, 2016 at Seattle.

#53 — Dan Altavilla (RHP):

2018 Spring Training: 0-0-1, 0.00 ERA (0 ER, 4.0 IP) in 4 G...has struck out 6 of 10 BF in 3 G...struck out the side in the 9th inning to earn SV#1 in Cactus League debut on 2/23 at SD...struck out 2 in 1.0 IP on 2/26 at CHI...tossed scoreless 5th inning on 3/2 at MIL (1.0,1,0,0,0,1)...2 K's in 1-2-3 5th inning 3/6 vs. COL.

- **Totals** - Went 1-1, 4.24 (22 ER, 46.2 IP) with 52 strikeouts in 41 games with Seattle.
- **Strong Finish** - In his final 16 MLB appearances (June 24-end of season), he posted a 1.74 ERA (4 ER, 20.2 IP) with 19 strikeouts.
- **Tale of Two Seasons** - Posted a 3.13 ERA (11 ER, 31.2 IP) with 34 strikeouts in his final 25 appearances of the season...posted 6.60 ERA (11 ER, 15.0 IP) with 18 strikeouts in his first 16 games of the year.
- **Yer Out** - Had 10.03 strikeouts per 9.0 innings (52 K, 46.2 IP)...one of 11 rookie relievers in club history with 10.0+ K per 9.0 IP.
- **Tacoma Time** - Was 2-0 with 6 saves and a 1.54 ERA (4 ER, 23.1 IP) with 36 strikeouts and 15 walks in 20 relief appearances with AAA Tacoma.
- **Drafted** - Selected by Seattle in the 5th round of the 2014 MLB Draft.

#56 — Christian Bergman (RHP):

2018 Spring Training: 0-1, 15.00 ERA (5 ER, 3.0 IP) in 2 G...allowed 2 H and 2 K in 2.0 scoreless inning on 2/23 at SD...allowed 5 R on 6 H (1 HR) in 4th inning on 2/27 vs. SD.

- **Last Season** - Went 4-5 with a 5.00 ERA (30 ER, 54.0 IP) in 13 games, including 8 starts, over 3 stints with Seattle (5/7-6/20, 8/12-13 & 8/28-9/1).
- **Starter/Reliever Breakdown** - As a reliever, was 0-1 with 2.38 ERA (3 ER, 11.1 IP) in 5 relief appearances...as a starter, he was 4-4 with a 5.70 ERA (27 ER, 42.2 IP) with 28 strikeouts in 8 starts.
- **In a Leading Role** - Made two starts of 7.0+ innings while allowing zero runs (7.1 on May 17 vs. OAK & 7.0 on May 28 at BOS).

- **Seattle-Bound** - Claimed off waivers from Pittsburgh on Nov. 30, 2017.
- **Last Season** - Posted a 10.80 ERA (8 ER, 6.2 IP) in 11 games with Oakland.
- **Minor Totals** - In 50 games with AAA Albuquerque (COL) and AAA Nashville, was 3-2 with 3.64 ERA (22 ER, 54.1 IP) with 47 strikeouts.
- **Limiting Damage** - Allowed 4 home runs in 54.1 innings in minors (0.66/9.0 IP).

- **Last Season** - Went 2-2 with 1 save and a 4.02 ERA (14 ER, 31.1 IP) with 25 strikeouts in 64 relief appearances with the Mariners.
- **Dependable** - His 64 relief appearances were 3rd on the club behind Nick Vincent (69) and Edwin Diaz (66).
- **Stranded** - Stranded 85% (44 of 52) of inherited base runners; best mark in MLB (min. 50 inherited runners).
- **In a Holding Pattern** - His 20 holds ranked T12th in the American League.
- **Career** - Enters his 10th Major League season...selected by Toronto in the 5th round of the 2007 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of UC Riverside.
