TRIBE HEADLINES

» Cleveland has won each of its last nine games against the A.L. Central (27-13 overall), their longest divisional win streak since a run of 15 straight wins from August 25-September 14, 2017 (Cleveland's longest since divisional realignment in 1994).

» **TREVOR BAUER** is 5-3 with a 2.17 ERA (15ER/62.1IP) in nine starts vs. the A.L. Central this season...his 81 strikeouts in divisional outings are the most by any MLB pitcher against a single division.

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** leads the American League with 50 extra-base hits, 74 runs scored and 35 multi-hit games (T1st)...he is batting .380 (19-50) over his past 13 games with seven homers, four doubles, 17 RBI and 20 runs scored.

» The Indians have hit eight grand slams in 2018, 2nd-most in MLB (Cincinnati - 9)...on the season, Cleveland is batting an MLB-best .397 (27-68) with the bases loaded.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians won their ninth straight game against A.L. Central opponents, securing a series win with a 6-4, come-from-behind victory at Kansas City...increased the Tribe's division lead to a season-high 10.5 games and moved Cleveland to its high-water mark of 10 games above .500 for the second time (also 43-33 on June 24).

» With Cleveland trailing 4-2 in the top of the 6th inning, **YAN GOMES** hit a go-ahead grand slam to provide the Tribe's margin of victory...**YONDER ALONSO** went 3-for-3 with an RBI and a run scored, while **FRANCISCO LINDOR** (2-4) notched his 35th multi-hit game of the season.

» **SHANE BIEBER** allowed four runs over his first 2.0 innings of work, but finished his outing with 4.0 scoreless frames to earn his fourth win of the season...Bieber became just the third Tribe pitcher in the *Baseball Reference* Play Index era (1908-) to collect four wins over his first five career appearances, joining **John Farrell** (1987) and **Scott Lewis** (2008-09).

» **CODY ALLEN** worked a four-out save, the 139th of his MLB career...moved him into a tie with **Bob Wickman** for the most saves in Cleveland franchise history.

YOU'RE A GRAND OLD FLAG

» **YAN GOMES's** go-ahead 6th-inning grand slam marked the fourth go-ahead slam by Cleveland (most in MLB) and the eighth overall by an Indians batter this season...after leading the Majors with seven grand slams in Spring Training, the Tribe's eight slams in the regular season rank 2nd in MLB (Cincinnati has nine).

» Paired with **FRANCISCO LINDOR's** slam on Monday, the Indians have hit grand slams on consecutive days for the first time since August 29-30, 2015 vs. Los Angeles-AL (Gomes, Almonte).

» Marks the Tribe's most grand slams in a season since 2006, when they hit a club-record 14...Cleveland's eight grand slams before the All-Star break match their pace from the 2006 campaign.

» Cleveland is batting an MLB-best .397 (27-68) this season with the bases loaded, driving in 83 runs (2nd to CIN - 94) and collecting 18 extra-base hits (most in MLB).

YAN AND YONDER

» **YAN GOMES** powered the Tribe offense last night with his third career grand slam (also doing so August 29, 2015 vs. LAA and August 27, 2017 vs. KC)...over his past 15 games, Gomes is batting .308 (16-52) with two homers, six doubles, 10 RBI and nine runs scored...Gomes, who currently ranks 5th in All-Star voting, owns a 1.4 fWAR this season, tops among all American League catchers.

» **YONDER ALONSO** is batting .378 (14-37) across his last nine games with a homer, three doubles and nine RBI...he has four multi-hit games over that span (including a four-hit effort and two three-hit contests), raising his batting average to .261, his highest clip since sitting at .286 (4-14) on April 2.

ROYAL WELCOME

» Cleveland has gone 6-2 thus far against the Royals, taking two of three games in a pair of series at Progressive Field (April 6-8, May 11-13)...the Indians went 12-7 against Kansas City in their 2017 slate, including a record of 5-4 at Kauffman Stadium.

» In a rivalry that dates back to 1969, the Indians own an all-time record of 364-330 (.526) vs. the Royals, as well as a 61-42 (.592) mark since **Terry Francona** became Tribe manager in 2013.

1921: The Indians sweep an Independence Day doubleheader vs. the Chicago White Sox at League Park, winning the contests 6-4 and 11-10...Tribe pitcher **Guy Morton** worked 9.2 combined innings of relief (4H, 2R/OER) and was the winning pitcher in both ballgames...the Cleveland offense combined for 29 hits across the two contests, slugging eight doubles and two triples.

TONIGHT'S START

» The 27-year-old right-hander is due to make his 18th start of the year in tonight's series finale in Kansas City...will mark his 150th career appearance (141st start), as well as his first career outing on the 4th of July.
 » Will be pitching on regular four days' rest after taking the loss in his last start on June 29 at Oakland...allowed just two runs on six hits over 6.2 innings and struck out eight batters, recording his 14th quality start of the season in the Tribe's 3-1 loss.
 » Bauer is due to face the Royals for the third time this season tonight...last faced Kansas City on May 11, taking a no-decision in the Tribe's 10-9 loss (4.2IP, 11H, 5R/4ER, 2BB, 3K)...has posted a 0-1 mark & 3.55 ERA (5ER/12.2IP) in his two starts.
 » **Bauer has struck out 81 batters against the A.L. Central this season, the most by any pitcher vs. a single division.**
 » He has also struck out eight-or-more batters in each of his last seven starts, dating back to May 27...streak marks a career-long run for Bauer and the longest such run by an Indians pitcher since COREY KLUBER's 14-start streak from June 1-Aug. 1, 2017.
 » Entering tonight's game, Bauer ranks among the American League pitching leaders in strikeouts-per-9.0IP (11.7, 3rd), strikeouts (148, 3rd), opponent slugging percentage (.312, 4th), night ERA (2.32, 4th), ERA (2.45, 5th), innings pitched (113.2, T5th), road ERA (2.40, 7th) and opponent batting average (.208, 9th).

VS. KANSAS CITY | A.L. CENTRAL

» Bauer is due to make his third start of the season vs. the Royals...is 0-1 with a 3.55 ERA (5ER/12.2IP) across his two prior starts...in 12 career starts against Kansas City, owns a 2-4 mark and 3.39 ERA (26ER/69.0IP).
 » Last faced the Royals on May 11 at Progressive Field...did not factor into the decision in the Tribe's 10-9 loss (4.2IP, 11H, 5R/4ER, 2BB, 3K)...also took the loss to Kansas City on April 7 at home, allowing just one run on three hits over 8.0 innings (2BB, 7K).
 » Tonight will mark Bauer's seventh career start at Kauffman Stadium...has compiled a 2-1 record and 2.27 ERA (8ER/31.2IP) in his six prior starts...last pitched here on August 15, 2017, earning the win after scattering seven hits over 6.1 shutout innings (2BB, 4K)...**Bauer's 2.27 ERA at Kauffman Stadium is his lowest in any ballpark in which he has made at least four starts.**
 » Bauer is due to make his 10th start vs. an A.L. Central opponent tonight...has pitched well in division play this year, posting a 5-3 record and 2.17 ERA (15ER/62.1IP).
 » **His ERA is the 2nd-lowest against the Central (min. 40.0IP), behind teammate COREY KLUBER (1.68 ERA)...****Bauer's 81 strikeouts vs. the Central are the most by any pitcher against a single division this season.**

ON THE ROAD

» Tonight marks Bauer's 10th road start of the year...is 3-5 with a 2.40 ERA (14ER/53.1IP) and enters tonight 7th in the American League in road ERA.
 » He has also allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in each of his last 14 road starts, dating back to August 14, 2017...marks the longest such streak of his career and is 7-5 with a 2.24 ERA (23ER/92.1IP) in that span...streak is also the longest by an Indians pitcher since **Ubaldo Jimenez** had a similar 14-start run from April 29-Sept. 29, 2013.
 » Bauer owns a career record of 23-26 with a 3.96 ERA (165ER/375.1IP) in 70 road appearances (65 starts).

LAST TIME OUT & 2018 RECAP

» Bauer finished the month of June with a 2.18 ERA (10ER/41.1IP), marking his 3rd-lowest ERA in a single month in his career (min. 4GS), behind March/April 2015 (1.80 ERA) and June 2016 (2.01 ERA)...**he also led MLB with 62 strikeouts in June.**
 » On June 23 vs. Detroit, Bauer fanned 11 batters over 6.1 innings, allowing one run on five hits (2BB)...**he has struck out 10-or-more batters in a seven starts this season, which is the tied with Boston's Chris Sale and Seattle's James Paxton for the 2nd-most such starts in MLB behind Washington's Max Scherzer (10).**
 » Bauer has thrown 100-or-more pitches in each of his 17 starts so far this season, which is the longest such streak of his career and the longest active run in MLB...streak is also the longest streak of consecutive starts with 100-plus pitches by an Indians pitcher since 1988, the most recent year that Baseball Reference has accurate pitch count data available...streak marks the longest such run in MLB since Tampa Bay's **Chris Archer** had a 24-game run from August 12, 2016 - June 16, 2017.
 » Recorded a streak of 10-or-more strikeouts in four consecutive starts from May 27 to June 13...streak the longest such run in MLB this season...**marked just the third pitcher in Indians franchise history to record a streak of four-or-more starts with 10-or-more strikeouts, joining teammate COREY KLUBER (two streaks of five starts in 2017) and Hall-of-Famer Bob Feller (one streak of four starts from 1938-39).**

2017 REGULAR SEASON HIGHLIGHTS & POSTSEASON RECAP

» Had a career year in the Indians rotation last year, posting his lowest full-season ERA (4.19) while also recording career highs in wins (17), strikeouts (196), innings pitched (176.1) and strikeouts-per-9.0 innings (10.0)...also struck out six-or-more batters in 22 of his 31 starts, good for 6th in the American League...made one relief appearance, in the 8th inning of the second game of a DH on August 17 at Minnesota (0.2IP, 1H, 1K).
 » **Struck out a career-high 14 batters in 7.0 innings on May 30 vs. Oakland, equaling the highest single-game strikeout total by a Tribe starter last season.**
 » Dominated after the All-Star Break, going 10-2 with a 3.01 ERA (28ER/83.2IP) in his final 15 appearances (14 starts) of the season...his 10 second-half wins ranked T2nd in the A.L. and his 3.01 ERA ranked T5th among A.L. starters (min. 80.0IP).
 » **Won a career-best nine consecutive decisions from July 21 to September 10, spanning 11 starts**...posted a 2.51 ERA (18ER/64.2IP) in that span...streak marked the longest by an Indians pitcher last season.
 » **POSTSEASON RECAP:** Started Games 1 & 4 of the 2017 ALDS against New York AL...won the first game at home with 6.2 shutout innings (2H, 1BB, 8K)...took the loss in Game 4 in NYC, allowing four unearned runs over 1.2 innings (4H, 2BB/1IBB, 3K).

CAREER SNAPSHOT

» Right-hander is in his sixth season with the Indians organization after being acquired from the Arizona Diamondbacks on December 11, 2012, along with RHP Matt Albers, RHP Bryan Shaw (from Arizona) & Drew Stubbs (from Cincinnati), in a 3-team trade...at time of trade, was ranked as Arizona's No. 1 prospect by **Baseball America** and had just earned Dbacks Minor League Pitcher of the Year honors.
 » Made his Major League debut with Arizona on June 28, 2012, becoming the first player from the 2011 Draft Class to reach the Majors...did not factor into the decision after allowing two runs on five hits in 4.0 innings of work.
 » In 2017, recorded his best Major League season to date in the Tribe rotation, posting career-highs in wins (17), strikeouts (196) and innings pitched (176.1), while recording his lowest full-season ERA (4.19).
 » The 2018 season marks his eighth overall in professional baseball after being selected by Arizona in the first round of the 2011 draft out of UCLA, where he went 38-4 with a 2.36 ERA across three seasons for the Bruins...finished his college career holding a number of school records, including a Pac-10 record with 203 strikeouts in 2011.
 » The Southern California native graduated from Hart High School in Santa Clarita, the same HS that produced Kevin Millar, James Shields, Bob Walk and Todd Zeile.
