FISH BITES

The Marlins open a six-game homestand with the first of three against the St. Louis Cardinals tonight at 7:10 p.m. LHP **Wei-Yin Chen**, making his 18th start of the season, is facing the Cardinals for the third time in his career, owning no record and a 5.23 ERA (10.1 ip/6 er); allowed two runs in 4.1 innings on June 6 at Busch Stadium in only start against Cardinals this year. St. Louis is countering with RHP Luke Weaver, who in two career relief appearances against Miami has tossed 3.0 scoreless innings with three hits allowed. The current homestand will continue following Thursday's off-day with a three-game set against the New York Mets. Miami just returned from a six-game road swing to Atlanta (0-2) and Philadelphia (0-4). The final game of the Atlanta series was rained out and will be made up as part of a split doubleheader on August 13. Broadcast note, FOX Sports Florida will carry both games of the doubleheader. Miami plays 31 of their remaining 49 games (63%) against division foes.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

Miami dropped a 5-3 decision and were swept in a four-game series against the Philadelphia Phillies at Citizens Bank Park. The Phillies broke a scoreless tie with three runs in the sixth, but the Marlins rallied to tie the game in the top of the seventh on home runs by **Derek Dietrich** (2R) and **Justin Bour** (solo). Brian Anderson finished with three hits to lead the offense. **Dan Straily** allowed one hit and two runs, with five walks and seven strikeouts, over 5.1 innings, while **Drew Steckenrider** took the loss.

GOOD TO BE HOME

Since June 8, Miami has gone 16-13 over its last 29 games at Marlins Park. That is a drastic improvement over a 10-18 record over the first 28 games at home. The Marlins have posted a 3.59 ERA (281.0 ip/112) over the current stretch, which is the third-best among National League teams behind the Dodgers (3.38) and Milwaukee (3.42). The staff has limited opponents to a .240 average against, which ranks sixth. On offense over that same span, Brian Anderson (34) and Starlin Castro (33) rank third and fourth in total hits at home, behind Charlie Blackmon and David Peralta, who have 35 each.

SPLITTING HAIRS

Wei-Yin Chen is making his ninth start of the season at home tonight, where he has gone 2-2 with a 2.18 ERA (45.1 ip/11 er). That is in stark contrast to what he has done on the road, where he has pitched to a 1-6 record and 10.27 ERA (37.2/43). According to the *Stats LLC*, he has the largest differential between home and road ERAs (8.29) in the Majors this season (min. 15 GS), ahead of Sam Gaviglio (8.10 on road/2.82 at home), Lance Lynn (4.48; 7.08/2.60), Ryne Stanek (3.96; 4.35/0.39) and Felix Hernandez (3.56; 7.58/4.02). Chen's home ERA ranks fourth among National League starters with at least eight starts, while his road ERA ranks as the highest.

GIVE ME A SECOND

Starlin Castro has recorded 125 hits in 110 games played this season, leading all Major League second basemen in games played. He ranks second in hits (Jose Altuve-128), tied for second in multi-hit games (36), fourth in runs scored (63), and tied for fourth in doubles (23).

HIT TO THE NINES

With five more hits this season, **Starlin Castro** will reach the 130 hit mark for the ninth time in his Major League career. He would join a list of five others who debuted in the last 20 years to record 130+ hits in each of his first nine Major League seasons. See list at right provided by *Stats LLC*.

HOME COOKING

As a team, Miami ranks sixth in the National League in total hits at home with 476, trailing Pittsburgh (529), the Cubs (499), Colorado (487), San Francisco (483), and Cincinnati (480). Individually, **Starlin Castro** (65) and **Brian Anderson** (63) rank second and fifth in the NL, behind Nolan Arenado (68). Anderson is tied with Bryce Harper for fifth in runs scored with 39, and **Justin Bour** is tied for 10th in the NL with 11 home runs.

WEEKLY AWARD WINNERS

Two Marlins Minor Leaguers earned their respective league's Player of the Week. **JB Shuck** was named the Pacific Coast League POW after batting .688 (11x16) with two doubles, one home run, four RBI, two stolen bases and four runs scored in five games played. RHP **Taylor Braley** was honored as the South Atlantic League's Pitcher of the Week after tossing 5.0 innings in the Grasshoppers combined no-hitter at Kannapolis yesterday. On the season, Braley is 5-5 with a 4.28 ERA in 13 starts with Greensboro.

PROVING HIS WORTH

In his final game before the break, **Brian Anderson** recorded his sixth three-hit game of the season to run his season hit total to 109. His hit total prior to the break tied Rocco Baldelli for the second-most by a Major League rookie since 2003, behind only Hideki Matsui (114 in 2003). He is the only Marlins rookie in franchise history to record 100+ hits prior to the break.

- Anderson recorded 101 hits over his first 92 games of the season, becoming the 142nd rookie since 1958 to record 100+ hits in 92-or-fewer games. Of those, 34 went on to win Rookie of the Year honors, including most recently Aaron Judge (2017), Corey Seager (2016), Carlos Correa (2015), José Abreu (2014), Mike Trout (2012) and Buster Posey (2010). - *Stats LLC*
- He leads all MLB rookies in games (112), at-bats (434), hits (125), multi-hit games (37), three+-hit games (8), average with RISP (.400), runs (63), on-base percentage (.369), and RBI (52); ranks second in doubles (25), and slugging (.422); ranks third in average (.288) and walks (45); is tied for third in triples (3); and tied for 10th in HR (9).
- He is on pace for 179 hits this season, which would rank as the second-most by a National League rookie since 2010, behind Corey Seager's 193 in 2016, and would rank as the fifth-most by an NL rookie since 2000. He is also on pace to score 90 runs, which would rank as the 11th-most by a rookie since 2000.

THIS DAY IN MARLINS HISTORY

AUGUST 6

The Marlins rallied from two runs down in the bottom of the eighth to earn a 7-6 win over the Brewers in **2004**. Jeff Conine cut the deficit to 6-5 with an RBI single in the bottom of the eighth, and Paul Lo Duca sealed the win with a two-run, walk-off single to score pinch-runner Chris Aguila and Juan Pierre in the ninth.

Wei-Yin Chen will make his 18th start of the season in the opener of this three-game set against the St. Louis Cardinals.

In two career starts against the Redbirds has no record and a 5.23 ERA (10.1 ip/6 er). Faced St. Louis at Busch Stadium on June 6, surrendering two runs on six hits and two walks, with two strikeouts, over 4.1 innings.

On July 24 vs. Atlanta, tossed season high 101 pitches in 9-3 win. His pitch total in the game was the most since throwing 104 on June 13, 2016 at San Diego. Has broken 100-pitch plateau six times dating back to the start of 2016 (44 starts). Over his first four Major League campaigns, eclipsed 100-pitch mark 54 times in 117 starts.

Has 2.18 ERA (45.1 ip/11 er) in eight home starts, compared to 10.27 (37.2/43) in nine road starts. According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, the 8.09 difference in home/road ERA is by far the largest gap for any pitcher in the Majors this season (min. 5 GS at home and on road). The second-biggest gap between a home and road ERA is 5.96 by Sam Gaviglio (8.78 road/2.82 home), and the third-largest is a 5.47 for Jake Faria (8.14/2.67).

Opponents are batting .228 (31x136) first time through lineup, .283 (36x127) second time through, and .383 (23x60) third time through.

Began season on DL (left elbow strain). Made two rehab appearances at Single-A Jupiter, allowing just one run over 7.2 innings, with just one walk and 11 strikeouts. In first appearance, April 17 vs. Lakeland, allowed one run and three hits over 2.2 innings. In second start, April 22 vs. St. Lucie, tossed two-hit, 5.0-inning complete game. Struck out seven without issuing a walk.

Made season debut on April 28 vs. Colorado, earning a win after allowing just one run on four hits (one home run), two walks, and a hit batter over 5.1 innings, with three strikeouts.

His start on May 26 vs. Washington marked 150th of career. Among pitchers born in Taiwan, Chen leads all in innings pitched (946.0), starts (161) and strikeouts (734). He ranks second in career wins with 56, behind Chien-Ming Wang (68). Wang ranks second in innings pitched (845.2), starts (126), and strikeouts (394).

Opened 2017 on 25-man roster, but made just five starts before beginning DL stint on May 5. Reinstated on September 4, after which he made just four relief appearances before being shut down with left elbow discomfort following outing on Sept. 22. Finished with 2-1 record and 3.82 ERA (33.0/14).

Best start of the year came on April 18 at Seattle, holding Mariners hitless over 7.0 innings while striking out two and issuing just two walks. Marked first start of career holding an opponent hitless. Previous low-hit start was one, done on June 2, 2016 vs. Pirates (6.0 ip).

Allowed season-high tying seven hits, with four runs and two walks, along with three strikeouts, over 5.0 innings on April 26 at Philadelphia. Loss marked first and only defeat of season.

Recorded season-high seven strikeouts in final start, on May 1 vs. Tampa Bay. Did not receive a decision despite allowing just two runs and two hits over 6.0. Also walked a season-high four.

Upon reinstatement from DL, made first career relief appearance on September 4 vs. Washington, tossing 1.0 perfect inning. Allowed one run on two hits over 6.0 innings (1.50 ERA) in four relief outings to close out season.

Picked up first career hit, an infield single, off of Zack Wheeler on April 7 at the Mets.

The pair became the first set of teammates to earn wins in their first career starts in consecutive days since April 9-10, 2012, when Yu Darvish and Neftali Feliz each made their first career starts with the Rangers. The last National League team to have such a duo was the Reds on April 15-16, 1967 with Gary Nolan and Mel Queen. - *Stats LLC*

Earned second win of season/career on July 21 at Tampa Bay. Limited Rays to two hits and one run (home run) with a walk and six strikeouts over 6.0 innings. Tied season high in innings pitched and strikeouts.
