WASHINGTON NATIONALS (45-45) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (42-48)

July 10, 2018 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA --- GAME #91/HOME #47

RHP JEREMY HELLICKSON (2-1, 3.81 ERA) vs. RHP JOE MUSGROVE (3-3, 3.79 ERA)

THE PIRATES... have won back-to-back games after losing five in a row...Won four-of-six before the five-game skid...Have gone 16-31 in their last 47 games since their record was a season-high nine games over .500 on 5/17 (26-17)...Won a season-high five straight games on two occasions (4/25-29 & 5/6-12)...Were 43-47 after 90 games in 2017 (44-47 after 91).

THE BOOK ON JOE: Joe Musgrove began the 2018 season on the D.L. due to a right shoulder muscle strain...He went 7-8 with a 4.77 ERA in 38 games (15 starts) for the World Champion Astros last season; began the campaign in the starting rotation, but finished the season posting a 1.44 ERA in 23 relief appearances...Musgrove was one of the four players acquired by the Pirates on 1/13/18 in exchange for pitcher Gerrit Cole (the Bucs also picked up Colin Moran, Michael Feliz and minor league outfielder Jason Martin in the deal)...He tossed 7.0 scoreless innings in his last start on 6/29 at San Diego.

OFFENSIVE OUTFIELD: Pittsburgh's outfielders have combined to produce the second-highest batting average (.280) and OPS (.810) among National League teams, trailing the Cubs (.286 and .823 respectively)...The Bucco outfielders are pacing the senior circuit in total bases (502) and they also share the league lead in assists (18) with the Cubs.

LEADING THE WAY: Corey Dickerson went 2-for-5 with two runs scored and an RBI Monday night in his first game of the season from the leadoff spot...He hit .285 with 15 homers, 31 RBI and 39 runs in 57 games from the top spot last year while playing with Tampa Bay...Dickerson has six career home runs leading off the first inning (all coming in 2017).

FACEBOOK LIVE TOMORROW: The Pirates and Nationals will be the feature game tomorrow afternoon on Facebook (no other TV outlets will carry the game)...The show will not have any commercial breaks and the announcers for the event will be Rich Waltz, Sean Casey, F.P. Santangelo and Stephen Nelson.

MONTHLY HONOR: West Virginia Power shortstop Oneil Cruz captured South Atlantic League Player-of-the-Month honors for June after leading the league in hits (39), extra-base hits (15) and total bases (63)...He also ranked second in average (.375) and OPS (1.025) while finishing third in runs (18), RBI (19) and slugging (.606) during the month...The 19-year-old Cruz is currently hitting .304 with 11 homers, 53 RBI and an .876 OPS in 79 games overall.

RECORD BREAKER: All-Star closer Felipe Vázquez has converted 19 of his 23 save opportunities this season and has recorded 40 saves in his two seasons as the Pittsburgh closer, establishing the club record for most saves by a left-handed pitcher (previous mark of 39 saves was held by Ramon Hernandez)...The single-season club record for most saves by a LHP was set by Mike Gonzalez in 2006 (24)...Vázquez had a career-high 21 saves with the Bucs last season.

ALL-STAR PERFORMANCE: Felipe Vázquez has made 11 straight scoreless appearances (11.2ip) and has been scored upon just once in his last 15 outings (16.0ip/2er) while converting each of his last nine save chances...Vázquez' 19 saves rank seventh among the National League leaders and fourth among all southpaws in MLB behind Aroldis Chapman (24), Brad Hand (24) and Sean Doolittle (22).

SWATTING THE NATS: Corey Dickerson has gone 7-for-21 with two home runs and six RBI in his five games played against Washington this season and is hitting .348 (16-for-46) with five doubles, a triple and three homers in 12 career games against the Nationals...He has reached base safely in all 12 games while hitting safely in 11 of the 12 (nine straight).

THE MOVE TO 2: In the last five games while batting second in the lineup, Starling Marte has gone 10-for-19 (.526) with two doubles, a home run, four RBI and five stolen bases while producing four multi-hit efforts.

UP THE CRICK: Kyle Crick has made 11 consecutive scoreless appearances (11.0ip), dating back to 6/15...Crick has held opposing hitters to a .200 average in his 35 appearances this season and to a .154 (6-for-39) clip over his last 11 games.

PIRATING: The Bucs have swiped 10 bases in their last four games and have been successful 17 times in their last 18 stolen base attempts...Starling Marte currently shares the National League lead with 23 stolen bases.

ON THE SHORT LIST: Jordy Mercer is currently tied with Bones Ely for seventh place in club history with 735 games played at shortstop...Frederick "Bones" Ely played with the Pirates between 1896 and 1901...Gene Alley, who played 11 seasons with the Bucs between 1963-1973, ranks sixth with 977 games played at short.

GOLDEN ARM: Bucco Gold Glove outfielder Starling Marte collected his ninth assist of the season on Monday and is now tied for the Major League lead in assists among all outfielders this season...Dating back to the 2014 season, Marte's 54 assists are tops among all Major League outfielders.

RIGHT ON: Gregory Polanco leads all National League right fielders with 35 extra-base hits...Polanco also ranks fourth among N.L. right fielders in total bases (126) behind Nick Markakis (162), Andrew McCutchen (137) and Bryce Harper (127)...In addition, Polanco's .447 OBP and 1.104 OPS since 6/10 each rank third among all National League players.

FIRING BLANKS: Pittsburgh's pitching staff has posted nine shutouts this season, trailing only the Giants and Cubs (10 apiece) among all Major League teams...The Bucco staff had a total of 12 blankings last season.

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

July 10, 1929: The Pirates homered five times while beating the Phillies 15-9 at the Baker Bowl in Philadelphia. George Grantham led the way with a pair of homers while finishing the day with five RBI. Lloyd Waner, Pie Traynor and pitcher Fred Fussell also went deep for the Bucs. Fussell also started and earned the win despite allowing nine runs on 12 hits, including four home runs, in his 6.1 innings of work.
