WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have lost five straight games, nine of 10, 11 of 15 and 18 of 23 as they open a five-game, six-day trip this afternoon vs. the Cubs at Wrigley Field.
- RHP Carson Fulmer, who has allowed two runs or less in two of his last three starts, takes the mound for the White Sox.
- The Sox went 1-5 on their last homestand, losing three of four to Minnesota and being swept by Pittsburgh in a brief two-game set ... four of the games were decided by two runs or less.
- The White Sox 9-25 (.265) record is the worst in baseball, behind Baltimore (10-27, .270) and Cincinnati (11-27, .289).
- Following this three-game series and an off day Monday, the Sox will conclude the trip with two games at PNC Park.
- The White Sox went 3-4 on their last trip at Kansas City and St. Louis from 4/26-5/2.

TODAY'S STORYLINES

- Chicago is a season-high 16 games under .500 ... the club's 9-25 start is its second-worst in club history (8-26 in 1948) ... the Sox worst 35-game win-loss mark was 9-26 in 1948.
- The White Sox have lost four consecutive games, eight of the last 11 and 10 of the last 14 on the road.
- The Sox are 14-9 over the last 23 games at Wrigley Field ... they have allowed three runs or less 15 times during that span.
- Yolmer Sánchez is hitting .419/.419/.645 with three doubles, two triples and four RBI during his seven-game hitting streak.
- José Abreu has hit safely in eight of his last 10 games vs. the Cubs, batting .361 (13-36) with three homers and six RBI.

WEDNESDAY'S RECAP

- Colin Moran capped a ninth-inning rally with a game-winning, two-run home run off Nate Jones in Pittsburgh's 6-5 win.
- The White Sox led 5-2 entering the ninth before Jones surrendered two singles to Starling Marte and Josh Bell and a two-run double to Elias Diaz before Moran's homer.
- Jones (4 ER/1.0 IP) was charged with his first loss and second blown save ... Reynaldo López received a ND despite allowing just two runs on three hits in 7.1 IP ... he retired the first 10 Pirates of the game, and allowed a pair of homers in the sixth.
- Daniel Palka went 3-3 with a home run (No. 3), and Tim Anderson connected on his seventh homer of the season.
- The game marked the Sox second home loss of the season when leading by three runs in the ninth (also 4/5 vs. Detroit).

FRIENDLY CONFINES

- The White Sox have won five of the last nine games, eight of 14 and 14 of 23 at Wrigley Field ... they are 28-28 all-time.
- Sox pitchers own a 2.70 ERA (24 ER/80.0 IP), .201 opp. average and 82 strikeouts in the last nine games at the Cubs ... they have allowed three runs or less seven times and one or less five.
- José Abreu is a career .323 hitter (20-62) with five doubles, three homers, eight RBI, three HBP, five walks, six multihit efforts and .943 OPS in 17 overall games vs. the Cubs.

HIP HIP ELOY!

- Class AA Birmingham OF Eloy Jiménez currently owns a 14-game hitting streak, the longest in the Southern League this season ... he is hitting .410 (25-61) with nine doubles, five homers, 19 RBI and a .429 on-base percentage in the 14 contests.
- Jiménez has hit safely in 17 of his 21 games with the Barons this season, including 11 multihit efforts ... he recorded nine consecutive multihit efforts from 4/30-5/9.
- He ranks among SL leaders in slugging (1st, .694), RBI (T1st, 24), homers (2nd, 7), AB/HR (12.14), and average (6th, .341).

MINOR LEAGUE MENTIONS

- Below is a breakdown of notable performances, accomplishments and rankings from White Sox minor leaguers:
 - ◆ Class AA Birmingham C Zack Collins leads the Southern League in walks (33) and ranks third in OBP (.447) ... is hitting .372 (19-51) with three doubles, three HRs, 10 RBI and 20 walks in his last 16 games.
 - ◆ Birmingham C Seby Zavala, who has homered in three of his last four games, leads the SL in home runs (nine) and AB/HR (11.78), is tied for the lead in RBI (24) and ranks fifth in slugging pct. (.566)
 - ◆ Barons' RHP Dane Dunning is tied for eighth among all minor-league pitchers with 46 strikeouts this season.
 - ◆ Class A Winston-Salem RHP Dylan Cease is scheduled to start tonight vs. Down East ... he ranks among the Carolina League leaders in strikeouts (2nd, 42), strikeouts per 9.0 IP (3rd, 11.69), opponents average (T4th, .200) and ERA (5th, 1.95).

NO RISP, NO REWARD

- The White Sox rank 15th in the American League and 29th in MLB with a .211 (57-270) average with RISP this season.
- Chicago is hitting .214 (12-56) with RISP in the last nine games, compared to .305 (18-59) in the previous eight ... the Sox have been limited to two hits or less w/RISP 26 times in 2018.

WHITE SOX VS. CHICAGO CUBS

- The White Sox and Cubs meet six times this season, with three games each at Wrigley Field and Guaranteed Rate Field.
- The Sox have lost five of the last six games and eight of 12 ... the club is 1-4 in the last five and 5-6 in the last 11 at the Cubs.
- The White Sox went 1-3 last season, splitting two games at Wrigley Field and losing both contests at Guaranteed Rate Field ... the Sox scored three runs or less in all four games, and were outscored, 22-11, in the season series.
- The White Sox are 1-2-2 in season series since 2013 after winning four straight from 2009-12.
- The Sox lead the all-time series, 58-54, going 30-26 at Guaranteed Rate Field and 28-28 at Wrigley Field.

CROSTOWN CONNECTIONS

- Below is a breakdown of Crosstown Cup connections for members of the White Sox roster, coaches and broadcasters:
 - ◆ Manager Rick Renteria led the Cubs to a 73-89 record in 2014.
 - ◆ C Wellington Castillo played for the Cubs from 2010-15 after signing with the club as an international free agent on 12/8/04.
 - ◆ RHP Chris Volstad appeared in 21 games for the Cubs in 2012.
 - ◆ TV analyst Steve Stone and radio analyst Darrin Jackson played for both clubs ... Stone spent 20 years as a Cubs TV analyst.
- A breakdown of Crosstown Cup connections for members of the Cubs roster, coaches and broadcasters:
 - ◆ Pitching coach Jim Hickey is a Chicago native, graduate of Kennedy High School and was selected by the White Sox in the 13th round of the 1983 draft ... he pitched in the Sox system from 1983-87.
 - ◆ LHP José Quintana pitched for the White Sox from 2012-17, and was named an American League All-Star in 2016.
 - ◆ Quintana was acquired by the Cubs from the Sox in exchange for four prospects, including OF Eloy Jiménez and RHP Dylan Cease on 7/13/17 ... it marked the teams' 15th trade involving MLB players.
 - ◆ TV analyst Ron Coomer is a Chicago native and Lockport H.S. grad.

INTERLEAGUE INSIGHT

- The White Sox are 0-4 during interleague play this season, with three of the losses coming by one run.
- Chicago has lost five straight and 13 of the last 15 road IL games ... its last road IL win came on 7/24/17 at the Cubs.
- The Sox went 6-14 during IL play last season and have not recorded a winning record since 2014 (11-9).
- The Sox are 206-181 (.532) all-time during IL (since 1997).
- José Abreu owns an 11-game, IL hitting streak, batting .429/.444/1.000 with four doubles, six home runs and 12 RBI.

PUT AWAY THE SUITCASE

- The White Sox currently are in a stretch playing 17 of 19 games in Chicago, including 14 at Guaranteed Rate Field, from 5/3-24.
- In addition to the just completed six-game homestand and this weekend's series at Wrigley Field, the Sox will play four-game series vs. Texas (5/17-20) and Baltimore (5/21-24).
- The club's only road games are at the Pirates from 5/15-16.
- Chicago has been outscored, 104-62, at home in 2018.

STOP! THIEF!

- The White Sox lead the American League and rank second in baseball with 32 stolen bases ... the club ranks fourth in the major leagues with an 82.1 (32-39) success rate.
- Tim Anderson (2nd, 10), Leury García (T8th, 6) and Adam Engel (T10th, 5) rank among AL leaders this season.
- The Sox are on pace to steal 152 bases this season ... by comparison, they stole 71 bases in 2017 and 77 in 2016.

ONE (RUN) AND DONE

- Chicago has gone 4-10 in one-run games in 2018, tied for the third-most in the major leagues behind Tampa Bay (5-12) and Boston (11-4) this season ... the 10 one-run losses are the second-most in MLB.
- The Sox were 21-23 in one-run games in 2017.

QUALITY AND QUANTITY

- The White Sox have made a major-league leading 1,328 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, three more than the second-place New York Mets (1,325) and 44 more than Oakland (1,284), the next-closest American League team.
- The Sox are 5-8 when receiving a QS this season.

DANNY FARQUHAR UPDATE

- RHP Danny Farquhar on Tuesday visited teammates and coaches in the home clubhouse at Guaranteed Rate Field.
- The club announced on Thursday that Farquhar, who suffered a brain hemorrhage from a ruptured aneurysm during a home game on 4/20, has been discharged from RUSH University Medical Center and is resting at home with his family.
- Farquhar's neurosurgeon expects Danny to be able to pitch again in the future, but he will not be medically released to pitch in a competitive game during the 2018 season.

FULMER AT A GLANCE

- The 24-year-old makes his eighth appearance (seventh start) of the season, fourth start on the road and first vs. the Chicago Cubs.
- Is 2-1 with a 3.24 ERA (6 ER/16.2 IP) and .222 (14-63) opponents average over his last three starts.
- Made his first career Opening Day roster.
- Was drafted by the White Sox in the first round (eighth overall) of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt University.
- Led Vanderbilt to the 2014 College World Series Title ... started the deciding Game 3 of the finals against Virginia on three days rest, allowing two runs (one earned) on five hits over 5.1 IP of a no decision.
- Bio is on pages 81-82 of the 2018 White Sox media guide.

LAST START

- Suffered his second loss of the season on 5/4 vs. Minnesota ... allowed four runs on seven hits with two walks and six strikeouts over 3.2 IP.
- Surrendered a career-high four home runs to Eduardo Escobar (solos in the second and third innings), Brian Dozier (solo in the third) and Logan Morrison (solo in the third) ... Escobar and Morrison homered back-to-back with two outs in the third.
- Left the game in the fourth with the White Sox trailing, 5-3, after throwing 86 pitches (54 strikes) ... the Sox lost, 6-4.

TURNING IT AROUND

- Has gone 2-1 with a 3.24 ERA (6 ER/16.2 IP) and 12 strikeouts over his last three starts, compared to 0-1 with a 7.50 ERA (10 ER/12.0 IP) and 12 strikeouts in his first four appearances (three starts).
- Is receiving an 11.24 run support average (21 RS/16.2 IP) since 4/23, the second-highest mark in baseball.

GOING, GOING, GONE!

- Has allowed seven home runs this season (28.2 IP), the most among White Sox pitchers.
- Allowed a career-high four home runs in his last start on 5/4 vs. Minnesota, the most by a Sox pitcher since Carlos Rodón on 7/19/17 vs. Los Angeles-NL (also four).
- Prior to the 2018 season, surrendered six home runs over 35.0 IP from 2016-17.

BETTER ON THE ROAD

- Is 1-0 with a 4.15 ERA (6 ER/13.0 IP) and .250 (13-52) opponents average over three road starts this season, compared to 1-2 with a 5.74 ERA (10 ER/15.2 IP) with a .281 opponents average over four home appearances (three starts) at Guaranteed Rate Field ... has allowed just one homer on the road (six at home).
- Has gone 2-0 with a 2.96 ERA (8 ER/24.1 IP) and .217 (20-92) opponents average in his last six road starts ... has allowed three runs or less in five of those starts.

2017 REVIEW

- Spent most of the season with Class AAA Charlotte before finishing the season in the White Sox rotation.
- Went 2-1 with a 4.34 ERA (9 ER/18.2 IP), .200 opponents average (14-70) and 16 strikeouts over five starts with the Sox ... also made two relief appearances (1-0; 1.93 ERA).
- Earned his first career win as a starter on 9/10 vs. San Francisco, allowing just one run on three hits with a career-high nine strikeouts over 6.0 IP.
- Made his second straight quality start on 9/15 at Detroit but received a no decision (1 ER/6.0 IP).
- Finished the season ranked by MLB.com as the No.9 Prospect in the White Sox system.
- Went 2-0 with a 1.56 ERA (3 ER/17.1 IP), 16 strikeouts, a 1.04 WHIP and .146 (10-61) opponents average over his final four starts of 2017.

MINOR-LEAGUE CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Went 13-19 with a 4.96 ERA (139 ER/252.0 IP) and 226 strikeouts in 55 starts over three minor-league seasons in the White Sox organization.
- Earned his first career win on 4/23/16 at Chattanooga (6.0 scoreless IP) ... struck out 10 batters on 6/9/16 vs. Mobile and again on 7/6/16 at Chattanooga.
- Entering the 2016 season, was rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 2 Prospect and Possessing the Best Curveball in the White Sox system ... was also tabbed by MLB.com as the No. 2 Prospect in the Sox system, the No. 42 in baseball and No. 9 among right-handers.

VS. CHICAGO CUBS

- Is making his second career appearance (first start) against the Chicago Cubs.
- Made his only appearance on 7/27/16 at Wrigley Field, allowing four runs on two hits and one walk over 0.1 IP in relief.

TOMORROW'S SCHEDULED STARTER

- RHP James Shields (1-3, 5.14) is scheduled to make ninth appearance (eighth start) of the season, fourth (third) on the road and first during interleague play.
- Received a no decision in his last start on 5/6 vs. Minnesota, allowing three runs on two hits with two walks and five strikeouts over 6.2 IP ... took a no-hitter into the seventh inning, retiring the first 16 batters he faced ... the White Sox lost, 5-3.
- Is 0-0 with a 2.84 ERA (4 ER/12.2 IP) and .098 (4-41) opponents average over his last two starts after going 0-3 with a 9.00 ERA (12 ER/12.0 IP) and .314 (16-51) opponents average in his previous three outings (two starts) ... has not won since Opening Day on 3/29 at Kansas City.
- Will make his sixth career start vs. the Chicago Cubs, second at Wrigley Field and second as a member of the White Sox ... is 2-1 with a 3.19 ERA (11 ER/31.0 IP) lifetime ... suffered the loss in his last start vs. the Cubs on 7/26/17 (5 R/3 ER/4.0 IP) ... won his only career start at Wrigley on 4/17/15 (4 R/3 ER/6.0 IP).
