Ben Gamel is batting .340 (34x100) with 15 runs scored, 6 doubles, 2 triples, 1 home run, 8 RBI and 10 walks in 36 home games this season...his .340 home batting average is currently the 7th-highest in the Majors this season (min. 100 PA).

The Mariners are 33-8 (.805) this season when not allowing a home run, which is the 4th-highest winning percentage in the Majors...Seattle trails only Cleveland (39-7/.848), New York-AL (36-8/.818) and Colorado (38-9/.809).

The Mariners and Orioles meet for the 5th (4-0) of 8 games in 2018...the Mariners recorded their first 4-game sweep of the Orioles at Baltimore earlier this season, June 25-28...the Mariners are 14-5 in the last 19 meetings between these two clubs (8/11/15-c):

**TONIGHT'S TILT**...the Mariners begin their penultimate homestand of the season - a 10-day, 8-game, 3-team - with the first of 3 games vs. the Baltimore Orioles...will also face the New York Yankees (Fri-Sun) and the San Diego Padres (Tue-Wed) during this homestand...went 4-5 on a recently-concluded 10-day, 9-game, 3-city road trip to Arizona (2-1), San Diego (0-2) and Oakland (2-2)...tonight's game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS NW** and broadcast live on **710 ESPN Seattle** and the Mariners Radio Network.

**ODDS AND ENDS**...Mariners have won 11 of their last 22 and 13 of their last 26 games...are 21-30 (7/4-current) since winning a season-high 8 straight games (6/25-7/3)...the Mariners have won 36 of their last 73 games, 43 of their last 82, 47 of their last 88 and 54 of their last 98...Seattle is 62-50 in its last 112 games, 67-53 over its last 120 games...Seattle is 23-24 during the day and 53-37 at night...Seattle is 38-28 at Safeco Field, 38-33 on the road.

- **Close Games** - the Mariners are 49-22 (.690) this season in games decided by 1 or 2 runs, the highest winning percentage in the Majors...the Mariners are 33-18 (.647) in 1-run games (most 1-run wins in MLB) and 16-4 (.800) in games decided by exactly 2 runs (best 2-run winning percentage in MLB).
- **Four Score** - the Mariners are 55-18 when scoring 4-or-more runs, but are 21-43 when scoring 3-or-fewer runs.
- **Get Through 8** - the Mariners are 1 of 2 Major League clubs with a 1.000 winning percentage (65-0) when leading after 8 innings this season, joining Oakland (67-0).
- **1,000 RBI** - **Nelson Cruz** (295) is 5 doubles away from 300 in his career...Cruz (998) is also 2 RBI away from 1,000 in his career...he will become the 12th active Major League player with at least 1,000 RBI.
- **Milestone** - **Kyle Seager** (534) trails Raúl Ibañez (540) by 6 for 8th-most runs scored in club history.
- **K's** - the Mariners pitching staff has combined for 1,124 strikeouts, ranking 9th-most in club history...is 32 strikeouts out from trying the 1998 Mariners pitching squad with 1,156...the club record is 1,318 set in 2016.
- **Heating Up** - Dating back to Aug. 11, **Ryon Healy** is batting .379 (22x58) with 7 runs scored, 2 doubles, 3 home runs, 11 RBI and 3 walks in 16 games...during this stretch his .379 average ranks 5th in the Majors (min. 50 AB)...teammate **Jean Segura** leads the Majors during this time frame with a .426 (26x61) average.

**LABOR DAY**...the Mariners are 16-22 all-time when playing on Labor Day...have played at home on Labor Day the last 3 consecutive seasons (1-2), after playing only 1 in the previous 10 seasons (off day in 2009).

**BIRD HUNTING**...**Nelson Cruz** has reached base safely in 56 of 60 career game (w/AB) vs. the Orioles, including 53 games with at least 1 hit...overall he is batting .349 (62x177) with 45 runs scored, 18 doubles, 1 triple, 12 home runs, 51 RBI, 3 HBP, 25 walks and 4 stolen bases...among all active players, **Cruz's** .349 average vs. Baltimore is the 3rd-highest, while teammate **Robinson Canó's** .328 (200x597) average ranks 11th (min. 150 PA)...**Cruz** also ranks 5th in on-base percentage (.417), 5th in OPS (1.011), 7th in slugging percentage (.594), while **Canó** ranks 1st in hits (232), runs scored (125), doubles (50) and RBI (111), 4th in home runs (29) and 8th in walks.

**RISP**...dating back to Aug. 8, the Mariners are batting .291 (53x182) with 8 doubles, 1 triple, 4 home runs, 65 RBI, 6 HBP and 17 walks with runners in scoring position...during this stretch the Mariners .291 batting average with RISP rank 4th in the American League, trailing only Boston (.344/67x195), Houston (.306/49x160) and Kansas City (.303/32x175)...during this stretch, the Mariners have 8 players batting over .300 with RISP: **Denard Span** (.600/6x10, 2B, HR, 6 RBI, 3 BB), **Chris Herrmann** (.500/1x2, 3B, 2 RBI), **Ryon Healy** (.467/7x15, 7 RBI, BB), **Jean Segura** (.438/7x16, 2B, 8 RBI, 2 BB), **Ben Gamel** (.375/3x8, 2B, 4 RBI, BB), **Mitch Haniger** (.350/7x20, 2B, HR, 9 RBI, BB), **Robinson Canó** (.313/5x16, 2B, HR, 6 RBI, 2 BB) and **Nelson Cruz** (.304/7x23, 2B, 9 RBI, 4 BB)...overall this season **Span** is batting a combined .337 (30x89) with 9 doubles, 3 triples, 3 home runs, 46 RBI and 13 walks with RISP...his .339 batting average currently ranks 10th in the American League.

**WE'RE GOING STREAKING**...**Mitch Haniger** currently has a season-high 14-game hitting streak (8/18-current), batting .317 (19x60) with 12 runs scored, 4 doubles, 4 home runs, 6 RBI, 2 HBP and 7 walks...his active 14-game hitting streak is currently the longest in the Major Leagues and also the longest hitting streak by a Mariners player this season...Haniger's 14-game hitting streak is also the longest in his career (previous: 13, April 6-19, 2017)...dating back to July 31, Haniger has hit safely in 27 of his last 31 games, including 12 multi-hit contest, batting .336 (44x131) with 21 runs scored, 14 doubles, 5 home runs, 16 RBI, 2 HBP and 10 walks...his 14 doubles during this stretch lead the Major Leagues...also among American League leaders, he ranks T1st in hits (44), T2nd in extra-base hits (19), 7th in average (.336), 9th in OPS (.946), T9th in runs scored (21) and 10th in slugging percentage (.557) and 11th in on-base percentage (.389).

**JEAN, JEAN, THE HITTING MACHINE**...dating back to Aug. 5, **Jean Segura** has hit safely in 15 of his last 20 games, including 11 multi-hit contests, batting .386 (32x83) with 10 runs scored 2 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run, 9 RBI, 2 HBP, 4 walks and 5 stolen bases...during this stretch his .386 average is the 2nd-highest in the Major Leagues, trailing only Justin Turner-LAD (.411/39x95), while ranking ahead of J.D. Martinez (.385/37x96).

**MINOR LEAGUE RECAP**...the Mariners have 5 affiliates wrapping up their 2018 regular seasons today (Rookie AZL Mariners and Rookie DSL Mariners already finished): AAA Tacoma, AA Arkansas, High-A Modesto, A Clinton and Short-A Everett...Arkansas and Everett both won their first half division titles and will begin postseason play...the Travelers will host the first two games of Texas League North Division Championship Series (best of 5 series) vs. Tulsa Drillers on Wednesday and Thursday...the AquaSox will host the first (of 3 game series) of the NWL North Divisional Series in Everett on Wednesday against Spokane.

**THE DÍAZ REPORT**...in 65 games this season, **Edwin Díaz** is 51-for-55 (92.7%) in save opportunities with a 1.93 ERA (14 ER, 65.1 IP) with 112 strikeouts and 16 walks...here are some notes on Díaz's standout season:

- Leads the Major Leagues with 51 saves...Wade Davis-COL & Craig Kimbrel-BOS are T2nd with 37.
- Is the 14th pitcher (done 17x) in ML history to record at least 50 saves in a season.
- Ranks 2nd among Major League relievers with 112 strikeouts...Josh Hader-MIL is 1st with 113.
- Leads the Major Leagues with 25 one-run saves...Blake Treinen-OAK is 2nd with 16.
- Has struck out 45.3% (112 K, 247 BF) of batters faced this season, the 5th-best single-season strike-out rate by a reliever in Major League history.
- Has struck out his 1st batter faced 30 times this season, tied for most in the ML (Adam Ottavino-COL, 30).
- His 51 saves are a franchise record, passing Fernando Rodney (48, 2014).
- His 112 strikeouts are most as a reliever in club history, passing Bill Caudill (111, 1982).
- The Mariners are 60-0 when he enters with a lead, including 28-0 when he enters with a 1-run lead.

**AS YOU KNOW**...**Nelson Cruz** is 2 RBI away from 1,000 in his career...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...with 2 more RBI, Cruz will become the fifth active player with at least 350 home runs and 1,000 RBI in his career?...Cruz will join Albert Pujols (633 HR, 1982 RBI), Adrian Beltre (470 HR, 1690 RBI), Miguel Cabrera (465 HR, 1635 RBI) and Edwin Encarnacion (377 HR, 1141 RBI).

**ABOUT RAMÍREZ...**

- Making his 7th start of the season, his 188th career appearance, 88th career start and his 18th career appearance (8th start) vs. the Orioles.
- Signed with Seattle as a non-drafted free agent on Sept. 1, 2007.
- Made his MLB debut with the Mariners on April 9, 2012 at Texas.
- The native of Rivas, Nicaragua, is one of 14 Nicaraguan-born players in ML history...is one of 3 active players born in Nicaragua, joining Cheslor Cuthbert-KC and JC Ramirez-LAA.
- Is 2-6 with a 3.93 ERA (60 ER, 137.1 IP) in 34 G/20 GS in September.

**LAST OUTING...**allowed a season-high 7 runs on 9 hits and 1 walk in 3.0 innings pitched as the Mariners fell 3-8 at San Diego...marked his shortest appearance as a starter since May 29, 2017 at Texas with Tampa Bay (2.1,6,4,4,1,1,HR).

**NOW THAT'S QUALITY...**since 2012, ranks 5th in quality starts as a Mariner with 23 despite playing two-and-a-half seasons with Tampa Bay during this span...trails only Félix Hernández (118), Hisashi Iwakuma (82), James Paxton (55) and Taijuan Walker (28)...last season, his 7 quality starts with the Mariners were T3rd-most on the club (also: Hernández) despite being acquired midseason.

**WELCOME BACK...**was activated from the 10-day disabled list prior to the game on Aug. 12...was placed on the 10-day disabled list for the second time this season with a right Teres Major strain on May 1 after making 2 starts for the Mariners...opened the season on the 10-day DL with a right shoulder latissimus dorsi strain, March 28 (retro. to March 26) to April 22.

**REHAB RECAP...**made 7 rehab starts in 2018 with High-A Modesto (1), AA Arkansas (1) and AAA Tacoma (5)...across those starts, he was 0-2 with a 2.45 ERA (7 ER, 25.2 IP) with 26 strikeouts and 4 walks...he has allowed just 1 home run in the minor leagues this season.

**WITH THE MARINERS...**making 17th start since his return to Mariners (7/28/17)...was 1-3 with a 3.92 ERA (27 ER, 62.0 IP) with 54 strikeouts and 15 walks with Seattle in 2017...began his career with Mariners and was 7-12, 4.62 (106 ER, 206.2 IP) in 47 games, 35 GS, from 2012-2014...traded to TB in March of 2015.

**2017 SEASON...**went 5-6-1 in 37 appearances (19 starts) with a 4.39 ERA (64 ER, 131.1 IP) with 109 strikeouts and 31 walks...was acquired by the Mariners from Tampa Bay in exchange for RHP Steve Cishek on July 28, 2017...went 1-3 with a 3.92 ERA (27 ER, 62.0 IP) in 11 starts with the Mariners.

**JEKYLL AND HYDE...**in 15 games (9 starts) at his home ballpark last season, was 4-0 with a 2.49 ERA (17 ER, 61.1 IP) with 53 strikeouts and 12 walks...was 1-6 with 1 save and a 6.04 ERA (47 ER, 70.0 IP) with 56 strikeouts and 19 walks in 22 outings (10 starts) on the road...made 4 starts as a Mariner at Safeco Field last season and made 5 starts with the Rays at Tropicana Field earlier that year.

**NICE TO SEE YOU AGAIN...**became the 41st player in club history to have spent at least two different stints with the Mariners...the 44th and most recent to do so was LHP Roesnis Elías (2014-15, 2018-c)...Mike Blowers (1992-95, 1997, 1999), Raúl Ibañez (1996-2000, 2004-2008, 2013), Norm Charlton (1993, 1995-97, 2001) and Jeff Nelson (1992-95, 2001-03, 2005) are the only players who spent three separate stints with the Mariners.

**START IT UP...**as a starter in 2017, was 4-5 with a 4.74 ERA (50 ER, 95.2 IP) with 86 strikeouts and 25 walks in 19 starts combined between Seattle (11 GS) and Tampa Bay (8 GS)...went at least 5.0 innings and allowed 2-or-fewer runs in 10-of-his-18 starts.

**TAMPA BAY RECAP...**was 4-3 with 1 save, 6 holds and a 4.80 ERA (37 ER, 69.1 IP) in 26 games (8 starts)...recorded 55 strikeouts and 16 walks while limiting opponents to a .189 (20x106) average with a .232 on-base percentage...as a reliever, he went 1-1 with 1 save, 6 holds and a 3.23 ERA (11 ER, 30.2 IP) with 23 strikeouts and 6 walks in 18 appearances.

**MLB CAREER...**in seven Major League seasons with Seattle (2012-14, 2017-c) and Tampa Bay (2015-17), he is 31-38 with 3 saves and a 4.29 ERA (296 ER, 620.2 IP) with 483 strikeouts and 176 walks in 188 games (88 starts)...signed with the Mariners as a non-drafted free agent on Sept. 1, 2007.
