**THE LOSS:** The Royals have lost seven straight and 25 of 29, falling to 37 games under .500 (25-62) for the first time since ending the 2006 season 62-100.  
 + Dropped to 1-3 vs. Boston this season, after going 8-4 from 2016-17, the best record in the Majors vs. the Red Sox during that time (min. 4 games).  
 + Scored more than four for the second time in the last 27 games, including a club-record 19-game run from June 5-26...held to five or fewer in all 27 games since June 5, the second-longest streak in the American League within one season in the last 46 years (since 1973), trailing the 2000 Tampa Bay Devil Rays (29).  
 + Recorded double-digit hits for the second time in three games, on the heels of a club-record 24-game drought from June 5-July 2 in which they had nine or fewer.  
 + Have lost 13 of 14 at home, falling to 11-33 (.250) through 44 games, and are on pace to surpass 1998 (29-51) for the worst home record in club history.

**JASON HAMMEL:** He's winless in his last seven starts (0-6, 8.03 ERA (33 ER in 37.0 IP)) and has lost each of his last six, two behind **Kyle Davies** (2011) and **Jeff Suppan** (2002) for the longest such streak in the 50-year history of the Royals...it's one shy of teammate **Jakob Junis** for the longest active streak in the Majors.  
 + Suffered his Major League-leading 11th loss, matching **Dick Drago** (1972), **Dennis Leonard** (1978) & **Zack Greinke** (2005) and one shy of **Mark Gubicza** (1996) for the Royals record before the All-Star break...he's two shy of his career high of 13 done last season (32 starts) and in 2011 with Colorado (27 starts).  
 + Remains winless in his last 10 starts at Kauffman Stadium, going 0-7 with a 6.05 ERA (37 ER in 55.0 IP) since his last home win on Aug. 20, 2017 vs. Cleveland.  
 + He's issued two walks or fewer in 39 of 50 starts since the beginning of 2017, trailing only **Corey Kluber** (43), **Chris Sale** (43) & (**Rick Porcello**, 41) in the AL.  
 + Failed to record a strikeout for just the fifth time in 298 career starts and for just the second time in his 50-start Royals career (also: May 16, 2017 vs. Yankees).  
 + Allowed six of nine batters to reach on five hits in Boston's four-run first inning, including a leadoff HR (**Mookie Betts**), a two-run single (**Brock Holt**) and an RBI single (**Sandy Leon**)...yielded four straight hits in Boston's four-run second, going: single, two-run HR (**J.D. Martinez**), double, two-run HR (**Xander Bogaerts**), before exiting after 2.0 innings, trailing 8-1...it was his shortest start since May 30, 2016 vs. the Dodgers with the Cubs (also 2.0 IP).

**BULLPEN:** **Jackie Bradley Jr.'s** RBI double in the eighth inning snapped the bullpen's scoreless innings streak at 19.2 IP dating back to the eighth inning on June 29...it was also the first *earned* run charged to **Brian Flynn** since June 1 vs. Oakland, snapping his streak of innings without an *earned* run allowed at 9.1...Flynn now has 13 multi-inning outings, fourth most in the American League behind only: **Austin Pruitt** (15), **Jesse Chavez** (15) and **Matt Andriese** (14).  
 + **Burch Smith** recorded a season-high 4.0 scoreless innings, extending his scoreless streak to 10.0 innings over his last five appearances since June 19.

**MIKE MOUSTAKAS:** Hit a two-run HR in the eighth inning, his team-leading 17th of the season and third in his last six games...after recording a franchise-record 38 HR last season, he needs just 13 HR in the Royals' last 75 games to become the first player in team history with back-to-back 30-HR seasons.

**ALCIDES ESCOBAR:** Put Kansas City on the board with a two-out RBI single in the second inning, his first RBI since June 17 vs. Houston, snapping a career-long 15-game drought...it also snapped **Chris Sale's** scoreless streak at 16.0 innings and was his 25th career hit vs. Sale, more than any other player.

**LUCAS DUDA:** Tripled in the seventh for the first time since July 17, 2011 (791 games in between), after hitting three in his previous 14 games.  
 + Eleven of his last 17 hits have gone for extra bases (4 of his first 24 were XBH)...of his 92 hits in 2017, 58 were XBH (63%), second most in the Majors.

**RED SOX:** Improved their Major League-leading record to 60-29 (.674) to mark the first time they've been 31 games over .500 since ending the 2013 season 32 games over (.674)...the 60 wins are the fourth most through 89 games in the 118-year history of the Red Sox, trailing only 1946 (63-26), 1912 (62-27) & 1978 (61-28).  
 + Are now 5-2 on this nine-game, 10-day road trip to New York (1-2), Washington (3-0) and Kansas City (1-0), and are 32-17 (.653) away from Fenway Park.  
 + Improved to 3-1 vs. Kansas City in 2018, after going 4-8 vs. the Royals from 2016-17, their worst record vs. any opponent during that time (min. 4 games).  
 + Had a four-run first inning for the second time on this road trip (Saturday at NYY) and batted around in the first for the second time in 2018 (June 22 vs. SEA).  
 + Improved to 44-7 when scoring at least five runs, including 24-1 since May 16...they're 24-1 when hitting multiple HR, including 15-0 since June 2.

**CHRIS SALE:** He's 4-1 with a 1.10 ERA (5 ER in 41.0 IP), .148 opponents' average (21-for-142) and 66 strikeouts (14.5 K/9) in his last six starts.  
 + Earned his 100th career win, including 96 since 2012, breaking a tie with teammate **David Price** for most wins in the American League during that time.  
 + Recorded his eighth double-digit strikeout game of the season, third straight and fifth out of six starts, second most in the Majors behind only **Max Scherzer** (10).  
 + His 12 strikeouts are most by an opposing pitcher at Kauffman Stadium since **Carlos Carrasco** (15 in 1-hit shutout) on Sept. 25, 2015 and match **Randy Johnson** (Sept. 22, 1992) for the most in the 46-year history of this park by an opposing *left-handed* pitcher...Royals entered with a Major League-low 645 strikeouts.  
 + He's had double-digit strikeouts in his last three starts here, becoming the first in the 46-year history of Kauffman Stadium with three straight 10-strikeout games.  
 + Matched **Blake Snell** (12) for the most starts with one or no earned runs in the American League this season, but had his scoreless streak snapped at 16.0 innings on **Alcides Escobar's** RBI single in the second inning...it was the second-longest streak by a Red Sox in 2018, trailing **Steven Wright** (24.2 IP).  
 + Retired 13 of 16 batters following Escobar's RBI single in the second...pitch count by inning: 14 (1st), 28 (2nd), 13 (3rd), 14 (4th), 11 (5th), 19 (6th), 99 total.  
 + Hasn't allowed a HR since the third inning on June 1 (**George Springer**), extending his homerless streak to a career-high 44.0 innings, the third-longest active streak in the Majors, according to **Elias**, trailing only **Brad Keller** (49.0 IP) and **Trevor Bauer** (46.0 IP).

**TYLER THORNBURG:** Made his first appearance in the Majors since Oct. 2, 2016 in Colorado (with Milwaukee), 642 days ago.

**MOOKIE BETTS:** Led off the game with a home run, his 16th career leadoff HR and fifth this season, matching **George Springer** for most in the Majors...it was his 100th career HR, making him the fourth Red Sox with 100 HR before his 26th birthday, joining: **Tony Conigliaro** (160), **Jim Rice** (133) and **Ted Williams** (127).  
 + He's batting .369/.395/.676 (41-for-111) with nine HR and 19 RBI in 26 career games vs. Kansas City, including the best average among actives (min. 100 PA).

**J.D. MARTINEZ:** Hit his Major League-leading 27th HR in the second inning and extended his league-leading RBI total to 73...it's the third-most HR by a Red Sox before the All-Star break, trailing only **David Ortiz** (31 HR in 2006) and **Carl Yastrzemski** (29 HR in 1969)...he's the first Red Sox since **Ted Williams** (1946) with more HR before the All-Star break than any member of the team had in the entire previous season, besting **Mookie Betts'** 24 HR in 2017.

**XANDER BOGAERTS:** Hit a two-run HR in Boston's four-run second inning, his 14th of the season (70th) game, four more than he had in 2017 (10 HR in 148 games)...he's now homered in consecutive games three times this season (also: June 14-15 and May 16-17), matching his HR-streak total from 2013-17.
