## SAN DIEGO NOTES

- **Jacob Nix** tallied career-high tying four strikeouts in today's outing (also: Aug. 10 vs. PHI)...has worked 5.0-innings-or-more in four of his five starts this season.
- **Hunter Renfro** is riding a career-high 10-game hitting streak, which is the longest active streak on the team...is batting .357 (15-for-42) with two doubles, five home runs and 11 RBI since August 23 at COL.
- **A.J Ellis** has three multi-hit efforts in his last four starts...owns a .398 OBP and his .291 average is his highest in a season in his career.
- **Franmil Reyes** extended his hitting streak to a career-high eight games, batting .375 (9-for-24) with four home runs in that time...is hitting .370 (10-for-27) in his career vs. COL.

## COLORADO NOTES

- The Rockies earned their 40<sup>th</sup> road win of the season... the club is one shy of tying the franchise record for wins on the road (had 41 in 2009 and 2017), and have nine road games remaining this season.
- **Kyle Freeland's** 19 quality starts this season are tied for the fifth-most in franchise history and are the most by a Rockies pitcher since Jhoulys Chacin had 19 in 2013...his 19 quality starts are also tied for the most by a left-hander in club history (Jeff Francis in 2007).
  - Has gone 4-0 with a 2.11 ERA (9 ER, 38.1 IP) over six starts since Aug 6. with the Rockies posting a 6-0 record in those games...since July 2, the team has won 11 of his past 12 starts.
- **Trevor Story's** 70 extra-base hits surpass Troy Tulowitzki's 68 extra-base hits in 2011, and set the franchise record for most extra-base hits by a shortstop in a single season...his 39 doubles this season tie Neifi Perez's record (set in 2000) for the most doubles by a Rockies shortstop.
  - His RBI double snapped an 0-for-16 streak with runners in scoring position...his last hit with RISP was Aug. 17 at ATL.
- **David Dahl** belted his eighth homer of the season to set a career-high...since being recalled from Triple-A Albuquerque on Aug. 5, is 19-for-75 (.253) with five doubles, four home runs and 10 RBI.
- **Charlie Blackmon** logged his ninth three-hit game of the season and has reached base safely in 13 of his past 14 games, batting .323 (20-for-62) with five walks.
