TONIGHT'S GAME: With last night's loss, the Giants had their four-game winning streak snapped...San Francisco continues this six-game, two-city road trip to San Diego (2-0) and Arizona (1-1) with game three of this four game set tonight.

GOING FOR THE WINNING TRIP: With a win tonight, the Giants could secure their first winning road trip this season and the first since going 4-2 at Pittsburgh and Detroit last year from June 30-July 6...since then, the Giants have had 13 road trips finishing with a record of .500 or below.

ON THE MOUND: LHP Andrew Suárez is scheduled to make his third career start against the Diamondbacks...he's posted a 5.94 ERA (11er, 16.2ip) over his last three outings, all with Buster behind the plate...in fact, in 12 starts this season with **Buster Posey** behind the plate, Suárez has posted a 4.75 ERA (3:1, K/BB), compared to a 2.88 ERA (6:1 K/BB) in six starts with **C Nick Hundley** catching (*Baseball Info Solutions*).

HEATING UP: OF Austin Slater is hitting .429 (12-for-28) with eight runs, six walks and six RBI over his last 10 games...**C Buster Posey** has reached base safely in 11 of his last 18 plate appearances (10 hits, one walk) and is batting .542 (13-for-24) with six runs, three doubles and five RBI over his last six games.

SOLID PITCHING: Beginning June 1, Giants' pitchers have posted a 3.28 ERA, which ranks as the best figure in the Majors over that span.

SIGH OF RELIEF: Over the Giants last seven games, the San Francisco bullpen has posted a 1.61 ERA (5er, 28.0ip) and a .210 opponents average against.

WITH THE GLOVES: The Giants turned three more double plays last night...their 115 double plays overall this season rank as the second-most in the Majors behind the Angels (119)...SF has turned 14 double plays in the last 12 games.

IN NEED OF CLUTCH HITS: San Francisco is hitting .206 with runners in scoring position and two-outs this season, which ranks as the second-lowest figure in the National League (Chicago Cubs: .205).

ROAD WOES: Despite posting a 9-7 record in their last 16 road games, the Giants .421 (24-33) road winning percentage still ranks as the third-lowest figure in the National League behind Miami (20-34, .370) and San Diego (23-33, .411).

INSIDE THE SERIES: San Francisco has posted a 8-6 record against the Diamondbacks this season and has won five of the last six contests...the Giants have posted a 28-25 record against the National League West and have won 12 of their last 18 games in the division.

JUST SCORE FOUR: The Giants are 44-13 (.772) when they score four-or-more runs in a game and are just 12-42 (.222) when they score fewer than three runs.

ON DECK: Following tomorrow's game, the Giants will travel home for a seven-day, six-game homestand against the Houston Astros (Monday-Tuesday) and Pittsburgh Pirates (Thursday-Sunday).

This Date in Giants History: August 4, 1942

The Giants-Dodgers game ends in a 1-1 tie as Pee Wee Reese's grand slam in the top of the 9th is wiped out...as was the case the day before, the game is called because of the government's 9:14 curfew on lights...it is the last twilight game played at the Polo Grounds.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#59 LHP Andrew Suárez
6-0, 187, 25 years old (September 11, 1992)
4-6 Record, 4.11 ERA

- The 25-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 19th career Major League start...has gone 4-6 with a 4.11 ERA (46er, 100.2ip) in 18 outings, with the Giants going 8-10 in those games.
- Among NL rookie leaders he ranks second in innings pitched (100.2), fourth in strikeouts (87) and seventh in ERA (4.11).
- Earned the win in the Giants' 8-5 victory over the Brewers on Sunday...allowed four runs on eight hits with one walk and four strikeouts over 6.0 innings... allowed two home runs for the first time since May 11 at PIT.
- Has a 5.94 ERA (11er, 16.2ip) over his last three starts.
- Has struck out 87 batters while issuing just 24 walks in his first 18 career Major League starts.
- Opponents have 24 hits in 77 at-bats (.312) off him with runners in scoring position...is holding opponents to a .103 average (3-for-29) with RISP and two outs.
- With one out in an inning opponents are hitting .318 off him with an OBP of .350 and a SLUG pct. of .545... however, with two outs in an inning opponents are hitting .217/.280/.357 (Baseball Info Solutions).
- Has received three or fewer runs of support in 12 of his 18 starts.
- Has a 4.66 ERA (24er, 46.1ip) in nine starts on the road.
- Lefties are hitting .211 (20-for-95) off him and are just 11-for-their-last-54 (.204).
- Has faced the Diamondbacks twice this season... is 1-1 with a 3.97 ERA (5er, 11.1ip) over those two starts...has made one start at Chase Field and it was one of his best in his young career...allowed just one run on seven hits over 6.0 innings.
- Was selected in the second round of the 2015 MLB Draft by San Francisco (No. 61 overall).

NOTES: The 31-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 21st start (25th appearance) this season...has posted a 5-8 record with a 3.90 ERA (49er, 113.0ip) over his 24 outings...did not factor into the decision in his last start on July 30 at San Diego...threw 5.0 innings, allowing two runs on four hits and two walks in the Giants' 5-3 extra-inning victory...has made three career starts against Arizona, going 0-1 with a 4.61 ERA (7er, 13.2ip)...his only career appearance at Chase Field came on July 1...threw 3.2 innings, allowing three runs on seven hits and four walks in the Giants 9-6 victory over Arizona.

- Has held opponents to a .145 avg. against (24-for-166)...the only NL relievers with a lower batting average against are MIL's Josh Hader (.119), PHI's Seranthony Dominguez (.134) and WAS's Sean Doolittle (.136).
- Has struck out 59 batters in 49.2ip (10.69 SO/9)...eight of his last 14 outs recorded have been via strikeout.
- His 36 inherited runners lead the team and are tied for the most in the NL...has allowed nine of 36 IR to score.

- His .175 opponents average against is the ninth-lowest among NL relievers.
- His last 13 outings: 1-1 record, 6-for-6 in save chances, 1.32 ERA (2er, 13.2ip), 20 strikeouts, no walks allowed.
- Is holding left-handed batters to a .163 avg. against with 23 strikeouts...LH batters are just 1-for-their-last-13.
- Has not allowed a home run in his last 53.2 innings, dating back to 2016...the only current pitcher with a longer homerless inning streak than Smith is Boston's Chris Sale (63.0ip).
