### OAKLAND NOTES

- The A's have a season-high tying six-game winning streak and are a Major League best 12-4 since the All-Star Break...also have the best record since June 16 (33-10) and the fourth best record overall (67-46).
- The A's did not allow an earned run this series and have a streak of 32 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run...the last time the A's did not allow an earned run in a three-game series was April 19-23, 1918 at Washington.
- **Matt Chapman** has reached base a career high 21 consecutive games...currently tied for the longest active streak in the American League with Jose Ramirez, CLE
- **Khris Davis** hit his 31st home run of the season..he is now second in the League with 86 RBI and third with 31 home runs.
- **Ramon Laureano** collected three base hits for the first mulit hit game of his career...Laureano recorded his first career stolen base in the bottom of the seventh inning.
- **Trevor Cahill** won three straight starts for the first time this season...the last time he did this was 9/5/12-9/19/12 when he was a member of the Arizona Diamondbacks
- **Matt Olson** leads American League first baseman in home runs with 22.

### DETROIT NOTES

- The Tigers have lost 12 consecutive games vs. the Athletics...this 12 game skid is the longest streak against the franchise.
- **Francisco Liriano** started today for the Tigers and threw 5.0 innings, allowing two runs with three strikeouts. With Liriano's three strikeouts today, he now has 1,715 in his career and is five strikeouts away from tying Ubaldo Jimenez (1,720) for the fifth-most strikeouts by a Dominican-born pitcher in Major League history.
- **Victor Alcántara** worked a scoreless sixth inning with one strikeout. Alcántara has not allowed a run in eight-of-nine appearances this season, posting a 0.84 ERA (10.2IP/1ER) and limiting opponents to a .205 (8x39) batting average.
- **Mike Gerber** led off the game with a single and has now hit safely in all three games since being recalled from Triple A Toledo on July 31. Gerber added a second hit to lead off the eighth inning to notch his first Major League multi-hit game.
- The Tigers were shut out for the Major League leading 15th time today. It marks the most shutouts Detroit has had in a season since 2003, when the Tigers were blanked 17 times.
