RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals are 39-23 post All-Star Break and 40-23 under manager **Mike Shildt** since he took the post on July 15. The Cardinals & Oakland co-lead the majors with the most wins (39) since the All-Star Break, while St. Louis' .629 winning percentage ranks 4th in MLB over that period. Entering July 15, the Cardinals had 19th-most wins in the NL (47) and currently have the 14th-most wins (87) in the NL.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals have won six of their last seven after sweeping the San Francisco Giants this past weekend and they've won four-straight at home...St. Louis enters play today as the N.L.'s 2nd Wild Card, 2.0 games back of Milwaukee and 1.5 games in front of Colorado...the Cardinals are currently in 3rd place in the NL Central, 4.5 games out of first place...the Cardinals have six games (MIL-3, CHI-3) remaining against teams ahead of them in the standings.

FAN-TASTIC: The Cardinals have surpassed the 3 million mark in season attendance (3,288,384) for the 15th-straight season (2004-18) and the 22nd time overall...the Cardinals, Dodgers & Yankees as the only MLB teams to have reached the 3 million mark in attendance this season...St. Louis has posted sellouts in 27 of their 78 home dates.

TIE-BREAKERS: In the event of postseason tie-breakers, the Cardinals have won their season series with Los Angeles (4-3) & Colorado (5-2), lead their series with the Cubs (9-7) and are even with Milwaukee (8-8).

WINNING SEASONS: The Cardinals have posted their 11th consecutive winning season, something they'd done just once previously in franchise history, when they compiled 15 consecutive winning seasons from 1939-1953.

BIRD SEED: Among their 43 home wins this season, the Cardinals have won 11 in walk-off fashion...the 11 walk-off wins are their most since 2008 (11) and are two shy of their single-season record of 13 in both 1991 & 1992 (Elias).

THE HUNT FOR A RED OCTOBER: The Cardinals final six regular season games (MIL-3, at CHI-3) are against teams currently in contention for playoff positions...St. Louis is home for this week's Milwaukee series, is off on Thursday, and then finishes out the regular season this coming weekend at Wrigley Field.

POWER PLAY: St. Louis has homered in 113 of 156 games this season, going 77-36 (.681 win pct.) in those games (10-33 when not homering)...their 77 wins lead the NL & rank 5th in MLB (Yankees, 1st-85)...St. Louis' 202 HR's are 3rd in NL behind the Dodgers (225) & Brewers (206)...**HOMERS AWAY FROM HOME:** St. Louis is an NL-best 41-20 (.672) when homering on the road, and trails only Oakland (123) in road homers (122) among all Major League teams.

CARPENTER CHASING N.L. HR TITLE: **Matt Carpenter** hit his NL-leading 36th home run yesterday and is trying to become just the 8th Cardinal (12th instance) to lead the league in round-trippers: **Albert Pujols** (2009-10); **Mark McGwire** (1998-99); **Johnny Mize** (1939-40); **Joe Medwick** (1937); **Rip Collins** (1934); **Jim Bottomley** (1928) and **Rogers Hornsby** (1922 & 1925).

TRIPLES TRIVIA: The Cardinals have hit a Major League low nine triples this season and just four at Busch Stadium...the Cardinals have never finished a season in single-digits in three-baggers...their fewest triples in a single season at Busch Stadium III was seven in 2007.

GAMES THAT MATTER: The Cardinals tonight will play their 1,288th regular season game out of 1,290, dating back to Opening Day of 2011, during which they still maintain playoff aspirations and have yet to be eliminated. **"MO" - MENTUM:** In their 11 seasons under President of Baseball Operations **John "Mo" Mozeliak**, the Cardinals have won 984 regular season games, trailing only the Yankees (1,005) & Dodgers (987), while they & the Yankees are the only teams to have posted 11 consecutive winning (+.500) seasons in that time period.

FARM SYSTEM: The Cardinals 492-402 (.550) overall organizational record placed them 2nd behind Tampa Bay (539-345; .604) in total wins among all minor league systems this year...Memphis (AAA) won its 2nd-consecutive Pacific Coast League title and the Triple-A National Championship Game and Peoria (A) reached the Midwest League Championship Series.

MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

Brett Cecil and **Eric Thames** were Blue Jays teammates for parts of two seasons (2011-12).

Paul DeJong graduated from nearby Antioch (Ill.) High School.

Marcell Ozuna was previously a Marlins teammate of Brewers outfielder **Christian Yelich** (2013-17) and pitcher **Dan Jennings** (2013-14).

Bud Norris and **Josh Hader** were traded for each other during the 2013 Trade Deadline (July 31, 2013)...Orioles sent Hader, outfielder **L.J. Hoes** and a 2014 Competitive Balance Round A pick to the Astros for Norris).

Yadier Molina hit his first Major League home run off Milwaukee's **Matt Wise** (Sept. 23, 2004).

Tyson Ross (Cardinals) and **Jordan Lyles** (Brewers) were both claimed off waivers from San Diego on August 5.

José Martínez recorded his first career Major League hit and RBI (Sept. 8, 2017 vs. Milwaukee) with an infield single off right-hander **Ben Rowen**.

Cardinals pitcher **Tyler Webb** appeared in two games for the Brewers in 2017...claimed off waivers by San Diego in April 2018.

Greg Garcia made his MLB debut against Milwaukee (April 28, 2014) with a pinch-hit at-bat (walk).

Cardinals Pitching Coach **Mike Maddux** previously served as the Brewers Pitching Coach from 2003-08...oversaw Brewers staff that ranked 2nd in the NL with a 3.85 ERA in 2008, lowest mark by a Milwaukee club in 16 years, en-route to securing the Brewers' first postseason berth in 26 years.

Cardinals Director of Player Development **Gary LaRocque** was selected by the Brewers in the 14th round of the 1975 MLB draft.

Cardinals Special Assistant to the GM, Player Procurement **Matt Slater** started in professional baseball serving as the Brewers' Scouting and Player Development Assistant (1991).

Cardinals Hall of Famer and broadcaster **Jim Edmonds** played in 73 games for Milwaukee in 2010.

Brewers Bullpen Coach **Lee Tunnell** pitched in 32 games for St. Louis in 1987...appeared in two games in the 1987 World Series.

Brewers broadcaster **Bob Uecker** played two seasons (1964-65) with St. Louis...won the 1964 World Series...originally traded by the Milwaukee Braves to St. Louis for catcher **Jimmie Coker** and outfielder **Gary Kolb** (April 9, 1964).

Cardinals Hall of Fame catcher **Ted Simmons** played 13 seasons with St. Louis (1968-80), where he was a six-time NL All-Star and 1980 Silver Slugger Award winner...later traded by St. Louis with pitchers **Rollie Fingers** and **Pete Vuckovich** to Milwaukee for outfielders **David Green** and **Sixto Lezcano** and pitchers **Dave LaPoint** and **Lary Sorensen**...played five seasons with the Brewers (1981-85), where he was a two-time AL All-Star and faced off against the Cardinals in the 1982 World Series.

Brewers Hitting Coach **Darnell Coles** played in 63 games for St. Louis (1995).

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Rookie makes his 27th start of the season & 33rd career app. (32nd start). His 27 starts are the most by a Cardinals rookie since Shelby Miller (31) in 2013.
- Leads all MLB rookies and the Cardinals with his 174 strikeouts (12th in the NL). Next closest rookie in strikeouts is Walker Buehler (LAD) with 143.
- Ranks 3rd all-time in Cards single-season history for rookies, trailing only Dizzy Dean (191 in 1932) and Rick Ankiel (194 in 2000) are ahead.
- Has struck out 87 batters post All-Star Break, 5th-most among NL pitchers.
- His 194 strikeouts in first 32 career games are the most ever by a Cardinal.
- Averages 10.95 strikeouts/9 IP this season, ranking 4th all-time for rookie pitchers behind Kerry Wood (12.58 in 1998), Dwight Gooden (11.39 in 1984) and Hideo Nomo (11.10 in 1995), all who went on to win Rookie of the Year awards.
- His .195 average against ranks as the 6th-lowest mark in MLB history among rookies with at least 25 starts. Jose Fernandez (2013) and Hideo Nomo (1995) are first at .182.
- Limited the opposition to one run or fewer in 15 of 26 starts, ranking T3rd among N.L. pitchers (Foltynewicz & deGrom - 16). Held opposition to 4 ER or fewer 25 of 26 starts.
- Leads NL rookies in win pct. (.500), opponent BA (.193) and strikeouts (174). Ranks in the Top 10 in wins (8, T1st), ERA (3.08, 3rd), innings (143.0, 2nd) and starts (26, 2nd).
- 13 of the 22 runs he's allowed over his last 12 starts have come via home run.
- Has the 2nd-lowest ERA in the NL of pitchers who have allowed 18 or more home runs this season, behind Max Scherzer (2.57, 23 HR).
- Looking to earn his first career win in September in eight career starts (9 app.).
- St. Louis has lost his last four starts (9/3-present).

LAST TIME OUT

- Allowed season-high 5 earned runs in 7-3 loss to Atlanta at SunTrust Park in last Wednesday's series finale.
- Three of his five hits allowed were by Freddie Freeman, who also hit two-run home run.
