TRIBE TOP THREE

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** homered for a second consecutive game yesterday, giving him a team-high 13 on the season...he enters play tonight tied for the Major League lead, making him the first Tribe batter to hold the MLB home run lead through 40 games since **Albert Belle** in 1996 (17 HR, also T1st in MLB).
» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** extended his hit streak to a career-long 15 games with a 9th-inning RBI-single last night...marks the longest active streak in MLB and the longest by a Tribe shortstop since an 18-game streak by **Omar Vizquel** from July 14 - August 1, 2002.
» **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** celebrates his 31st birthday today...he is batting .368 (7-19) in four starts out of the second spot in the lineup with two homers, six runs scored and nine RBI...has also hit .545 (6-11) with three doubles and two RBI in four birthday games.

TRANSACTIONS

» The Indians today placed **BRADLEY ZIMMER** on the 10-day Disabled List (retroactive to May 12) with a left rib contusion...in a pair of corresponding moves, Cleveland has selected the contract of **RHP NEIL RAMÍREZ** from Columbus and transferred **LHP RYAN MERRITT** from the 10-day to the 60-day Disabled List.
» Zimmer has batted .224 (22-98) in 32 games for Cleveland with two homers, five doubles and nine RBI...he initially sustained the injury in a collision with the outfield wall on May 5 at New York-AL.
» Ramirez, 28, has pitched in four Major League seasons and has now appeared on the active roster of seven different MLB clubs...he was signed to a Minor League contract by Cleveland on November 30, 2017 and began his season with Columbus, where he has gone 2-0 with three saves, 31 strikeouts and a 2.55 ERA (5ER/17.2IP) in 13 relief appearances.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Tribe opened their eight-game, 10-day road trip with a 6-3 defeat at Detroit...snapped their 11-game win streak against the Tigers and dropped them back to .500 on the season.
» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** opened the scoring in the top of the 1st with a solo homer, his team-high 13th of the season (T1st in MLB)...**GREG ALLEN** was responsible for three of the Tribe's seven hits, collecting his first career triple and and first career three-hit effort...**FRANCISCO LINDOR** extended his career-long hit streak to 15 games with an RBI-single in the top of the 9th inning...**EDWIN ENCARNACION** extended his own hit streak to five games with an RBI-double in the 8th inning.
» **CARLOS CARRASCO** worked his sixth quality start of 2018, but was saddled with the loss after allowing three runs on six hits over 6.2 innings of work (2BB, 4K).

TIGER TALK

» The Indians and Tigers are squaring off in the second of six scheduled series between the clubs; the first here in Detroit.
» Cleveland enters play tonight with a 4-1 record this season against the Tigers...the teams previously met from April 9-12 at Progressive Field, where Cleveland recorded a four-game sweep.
» The Tribe's loss last night snapped their 11-game win streak against Detroit which extended back to September 1, 2017...despite the loss, Cleveland has still held the Tigers to three-or-fewer runs in 13 of their last 15 matchups with a 1.61 team ERA (24ER/134.0IP) over that span.

CENTRAL HEATING

» The Tribe is in the midst of its fifth series against a divisional opponent, having gone 9-4 in their first 13 games against the A.L. Central (8-2 at Progressive Field, 1-2 on the road).
» **Since July 1, 2017, the Indians have posted a 40-12 record (.769) against A.L. Central teams...Cleveland has gone 15-0-1 in its last 16 completed series against the A.L. Central**, including an outright 14-series win streak against intra-divisional opponents from July 1, 2017 - April 12, 2018, the longest by any team in MLB's divisional era (1969-, *STATS LLC*)...Cleveland has not lost a series against an A.L. Central team since being swept at home by the Minnesota Twins from June 23-25, 2017.
» **Dominant pitching has been key to the Tribe's success against the A.L. Central, as Cleveland pitchers have posted a 1.91 ERA (72ER/339.0IP) in their last 37 divisional games.**

Tyler Krieger's RBI-single tied the game in the 9th...Todd Hankins drove in Akron's other run on a double in the 7th.

The Hillcats were off yesterday and begin a six-game homestand tonight, with Micah Miniard (0-1, 5.16) starting.

The Captains split a doubleheader with South Bend...Will Benson (1-3) hit his league-leading 8th homer in Game 1.

JOSÉ CAN YOU SWING

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ'S** solo homer last night gave him 13 on the season, the most by an Indians batter and **T1st in MLB this season...** Ramirez is the first Tribe batter to hold a share of the Major League lead in homers through 40 games since **Albert Belle** in 1996, when **Belle and Barry Bonds** had 17 longballs each.
» **Ramírez's 13 homers through 40 team games are also tied for the 3rd-most in franchise history**, trailing only **Albert Belle** (17 in 1996) and **Ken Keltner** (14 in 1948)...there have been eight other instances in club history of 13 homers through 40 team games, most recently **Travis Hafner** in 2006.
» He also went deep in Sunday's game vs. Kansas City and has now homered in consecutive games on three occasions this season (also April 21-22 & May 3-4).
» Ramirez's six home runs in May are T4th in MLB, while his 12 extra-base hits rank T2nd...both of those categories are currently led by **Francisco Lindor**...overall on the season, Ramirez also ranks T9th in the A.L. in runs scored (28), 5th in total bases (94), 5th in slugging percentage (.614) and T3rd in extra-base hits (24).

TRAIN KEPT A-ROLLIN'

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** collected a 9th-inning RBI-single in last night's ballgame to extend his career-long hit streak to 15 games...continues to serve as the longest active streak in MLB.
» The two-time reigning American League Player of the Week now boasts the longest hit streak by an Indians batter since **Mike Napoli's** 16-game streak from July 30 - August 16, 2016...it is also the longest streak by a Tribe shortstop since **Omar Vizquel's** 18-game run from July 14 - August 1, 2002.
» **Overall across the 15-game streak, which dates back to April 29, Lindor is batting .456 (31-68) with eight homers, eight doubles, 16 RBI and 19 runs scored.**
» Lindor is also batting .450 (27-60) in 13 May games, ranking 1st in MLB in batting average (min. 40 PA)...also holds the MLB monthly lead in homers (8), extra-base hits (16) and doubles (8).
» Enters play tonight in the American League's Top 10 in several categories, including multi-hit games (17, T2nd), extra-base hits (26, 2nd), homers (12, T4th), runs scored (34, 2nd), hits (54, T2nd), total bases (104, 3rd), doubles (14, 4th), slugging percentage (.612, 6th) and batting average (.318, 10th).

ANOTHER YEAR OLDER, ANOTHER YEAR SMOOTHER

» **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** celebrates his 31st birthday today, riding an impressive run in the month of May.
» In 12 games this month, Brantley is batting .314 (16-51) with three homers, five doubles and 17 RBI...currently ranks T2nd across MLB this month in RBI.
» Brantley has started each of his last four games in the second spot of the Tribe lineup...has hit safely in all four of those contests, batting .368 (7-19) as Cleveland's #2 hitter with two homers, a double, nine RBI and six runs scored...has recorded multiple RBI in three of those four games.
» Has appeared in four games for the Tribe on his birthday, batting .545 (6-11) with three doubles, a triple, two RBI and six runs scored...Cleveland is 4-0 across those games.
» **Brantley enters play tonight ranked T5th in the American League with his .331 (40-121) batting average, while he leads the A.L. with a .375 (30-80) average against right-handed pitching.**

J.T. IN MOTOWN

» **JOSH TOMLIN** is set to make his 6th start (7th appearance) of the 2018 campaign in tonight's contest.
» Tomlin worked a season-high 7.0 innings in his last start, which came on May 4 at New York-AL...did not factor into the decision as he allowed five runs (four earned) on eight hits (2BB, 4K) as the Tribe fell, 7-6, in walk-off fashion.
» Has made one previous start against Detroit in 2018, **throwing 5.0 scoreless innings on four hits (2BB, 3K) in an April 10 Tribe win at Progressive Field.**

THE BOMB SQUAD

» The Indians continue to pace MLB with 61 homers this season...ranks as the club's 4th-most home runs ever through 40 games, as well as their most since the 1999 campaign (63 HR).

THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

1981: Len Barker throws the 8th perfect game in baseball's modern era, striking out 11 batters as he blanks the Blue Jays at Cleveland Municipal Stadium...Barker became the first pitcher to achieve the feat in a game featuring designated hitters, and he did not reach a three-ball count on any batter...marked the second perfect game in Tribe franchise history (**Addie Joss** - October 2, 1908 vs. CWS), and no Indians pitcher has tossed a no-hitter since.

TONIGHT'S START

» The 33-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his sixth start of the season (seventh appearance overall) in tonight's matchup at Detroit...marks Tomlin's 141st career start and 158th appearances overall.
 » Will be pitching on 10 days' rest, having not pitched for Cleveland since a start on May 4 at New York-AL...did not factor into the decision but threw a season-high 7.0 innings, allowing five runs (four earned) on eight hits (2BB, 4K, 3HR).
 » Tomlin will be making his second start against Detroit this season, after tossing 5.0 scoreless innings on April 10 at Progressive Field...owns a lifetime record of 7-6 in 13 starts (17 appearances) vs. the Tigers with a 4.87 ERA (44ER/81.1IP).

LAST TIME OUT | 2018 RECAP

» Last started on May 4 at New York-AL...worked a season-high 7.0 innings, allowing five runs (four earned) on eight hits (2BB, 4K)...did not factor into the decision, as the Yankees went on to beat the Tribe, 7-6, in walk-off fashion...Tomlin surrendered three home runs, and has allowed an MLB-high 13 longballs this season.
 » Tomlin made his 2018 season debut on April 3 at Los Angeles-AL, allowing eight runs on eight hits over just 3.0 innings as the Tribe fell 13-2 to the Angels...the eight runs allowed matched a career-high (done five other times), while the four home runs he allowed were the most in his career.
 » After experiencing lower back soreness during his start at Los Angeles-AL, Tomlin was given an extra two days of rest before making his second start on April 10 vs. Detroit...did not factor into the decision, but threw 5.0 scoreless innings (4H, 2BB, 3K) in the Tribe's eventual 2-1 win over the Tigers...took the loss in relief on April 18 against Minnesota in Puerto Rico after allowing an unearned run in the bottom of the 16th inning.
 » Started on April 29 vs. Seattle, where he fell to 0-4 after allowing six runs on 10 hits in the Indians' 10-4 loss to the Mariners...worked a season-long 6.0 innings, and retired 12 out of 14 batters after allowing five runs in the top of the 2nd inning.

VS. DETROIT | A.L. CENTRAL

» Tomlin will be making his second start this season against Detroit, as well the 14th start (18th appearance) in his career...owns a lifetime record of 7-6 vs. the Tigers with a 4.87 ERA (44ER/81.1IP).
 » Previously started vs. Detroit on April 10 at Progressive Field...tossed 5.0 scoreless innings on just four hits (2BB, 3K), but did not factor into the decision in a game eventually won by the Indians, 2-1.
 » Picked up the win in his most recent start at Comerica Park on September 3, 2017, where he held the Tigers to one run on six hits over 5.2 innings (1BB, 2K).
 » Tomlin holds an 0-1 record with a 0.00 ERA (0ER/6.0IP) in one start (two appearances) against the A.L. Central this season...took the loss in Puerto Rico against the Twins on April 18 after allowing an unearned run in the 16th inning...has gone 2-0 over his last six starts against the A.L. Central with a 2.45 ERA (8ER/29.1IP).

NO FREE PASSES

» Tomlin walked just 14 of the 585 batters he faced in 2017 (2.4%), good for a rate of 0.89 walks-per-9.0IP, the lowest mark in Major League Baseball (min. 100.0IP)...since making his MLB debut in 2010, Tomlin has walked just 1.34 batters-per-9.0IP, the fewest among all active pitchers (min. 500.0IP) and 2nd overall (Cliff Lee - 1.24).
 » After allowing three walks in his start on June 25, 2017 vs. Minnesota, Tomlin saw his franchise record streak of 45 consecutive starts allowing two-or-fewer walks come to an end...the streak dated back to September 26, 2015, and was the longest active streak in Major League Baseball...Tomlin last allowed four walks on August 27, 2010, after which he began a still-active streak of 134 straight starts allowing three-or-fewer walks, ranking as the longest streak in club history as well as the 4th-longest stretch in Baseball Reference's Play Index era (1908-).

2017 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

» Endured several difficult stretches to post a solid campaign in the back-end of Cleveland's rotation, going 10-9 with a 4.98 ERA (78ER/141.1IP) in 26 starts.
 » Went 2-3 with an 8.87 ERA in five April starts, marking the highest April ERA in his big-league career.
 » Posted a 1-3 mark in the month of May with a 3.58 ERA...lone win came in the 5th complete game of his career, on May 28 vs. Kansas City...allowed one run on six hits with three strikeouts in the Tribe's 10-1 victory over the Royals.
 » After going 1-3 in June with a 6.75 ERA, Tomlin's record sat at 4-9 with a 6.17 ERA (59ER/86.0IP) on July 1...from July 6 to the end of the season however, Tomlin went 6-0 over his final ten starts with a 3.11 ERA (19ER/55.0IP) to secure his third consecutive winning season for the Tribe.
 » Pitched 4.0 hitless innings on July 30 at Chicago-AL before departing with a left hamstring strain...spent the next month (July 31-August 31) on the Disabled List.
 » During the Tribe's 22-game winning streak, Tomlin went 2-0 in three starts with a 2.76 ERA (5ER/16.1IP).

POSTSEASON RECAP

» Tomlin made two relief appearances for the Indians in their 2017 ALDS loss to the New York Yankees.
 » Entered Game 2 at Progressive Field in the 12th inning and pitched 2.0 perfect innings with three strikeouts...picked up the win after Yan Gomes drove in the game's winning run with a walk-off single in the bottom of the 13th.
 » Also appeared in the Tribe's Game 4 loss at Yankee Stadium...closed out the game with a scoreless 8th inning, striking out one batter.
 » Overall in the 2017 Postseason, Tomlin retired all nine batters he faced, going 1-0 with four strikeouts.

CAREER SNAPSHOT

» Tomlin was originally selected by the Indians in the 19th round (581st overall) out of Texas Tech in the 2006 First-Year Player Draft...he is the longest-tenured player in the Cleveland Indians organization.
 » Earned the victory in his Major League debut opposite CC Sabathia on July 27, 2010 vs. New York-AL (7.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R-ER, 2 SO); faced the minimum through 7.0 innings before departing in the 8th...according to Elias, the performance by Tomlin (3 baserunners in 7.0 IP) was only the 2nd time in club history a Tribe hurler allowed 3 baserunners or fewer in a ML debut (Scott Lewis, 9/10/08 at Baltimore).
 » Pitched his first CG on September 24, 2010 vs. Kansas City.
 » Tomlin lasted at least 5.0 innings in his first 37 consecutive appearances dating up until his last start of the 2011 campaign; his 37 straight starts of at least 5.0 IP to begin a career matched former Indian John Farrell (87-88) for the most consecutive such starts since 1919 to start a career.
 » After returning from shoulder surgery in August 2015, posted a 7-2 record with a 3.02 ERA (22ER/65.2IP) in 10 starts.
 » Has been on the Disabled List six times in his career...had right shoulder surgery in March of 2015 and was placed on the 60-day disabled list (retro to March 29)...was activated from the 60-day Disabled List on July 31 and optioned to AAA Columbus...made his season debut on Aug. 15...previously underwent season-ending right elbow reconstruction on Aug. 22, 2012 in Anaheim, CA by Dr. Lewis Yokum and was held out of action until July, 2013.
