NATIONALS NEWS

MOVING ON

The Washington Nationals fell to the Atlanta Braves, 2-0, on Friday night...They were shut out for just the second time this season (also: 4/21 at LAD) while collecting just two hits along the way, matching a season-low (3x; last: 5/5 vs. PHI).

- Following the final two games of this road trip today and tomorrow, the Nationals will enjoy a day off at home on Monday before welcoming the Tampa Bay Rays to Nationals Park on Tuesday.

STREAKING

Trea Turner is in the midst of a career-best 13-game hitting streak...During the streak, he is hitting .281 (16-for-57) with four doubles, one homer, seven RBI, two walks, three stolen bases and six runs scored.

- On the season, Turner leads National League shortstops in on-base percentage (.357), runs scored (32), walks (30) and stolen bases (16).
- Turner leads National League shortstops in Wins Above Replacement (1.6) according to FanGraphs.com.

With 97 in hand, **Trea Turner** is approaching 100 career stolen bases...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, here is the list of quickest active players in terms of games (Turner: 255 games) to reach 100 stolen bases:

ANT'S BAT

Anthony Rendon has hit safely in eight of his last 11 games dating to May 21, going 13-for-42 (.310) with six doubles, two homers, six RBI, four walks and four runs scored over this stretch...Rendon entered play on the 21st with a .247/.342/.433 slash line...He is now hitting .266/.348/.482.

WINNING WAYS

Since April 29, the Nationals are 21-8 and have outscored their opponents, 123-78...The 21-8 (.724) record is the best in Major League Baseball during this stretch.

- At 20-10 (.667), the Nationals own the best road record in Major League Baseball.

START ME UP

Washington's starting rotation leads the National League in ERA (2.89), strikeouts (386), opp. AVG (.213), opp. OBP (.277), hits per 9.0 IP (7.00), WHIP (1.07)...The staff ranks second in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.78), opp. SLG (.359), and opp. OPS (.635).

- Since April 28, Nationals starters have allowed three earned runs or fewer in 29 of 31 starts.

RELIEVERS ARE PEOPLE, TOO

Over the last 11 games, **Henry Blanco's** bullpen has tossed 27.0 innings of relief, striking out 29 batters, walking just five and surrendering just two earned runs along the way (0.67 ERA)...Nationals relievers have inherited 17 runners during this stretch and have not allowed any to score.

- Washington's 0.67 bullpen ERA is the best in Major League Baseball since May 21.
- On the season, Washington relievers rank among National League 'pens in strikeout-to-walk ratio (2nd, 2.90), strikeouts per 9.0 IP (2nd, 9.65), and inherited runners scored percent (2nd, 18.8%).

DINGERS OF THE DAY

The Nationals lead the National League with 72 home runs...**Bryce Harper** (1st, 18) and **Matt Adams** (T6th, 12) rank in the top 10 in the National League...Harper's 18 home runs are tied for second in Major League Baseball.

- Since joining the Nationals on May 13, **Mark Reynolds** ranks tied for second in the NL (T5th in MLB) with six home runs.

NATIONALS HISTORY

June 2 (7-4 on this date)

2005 - Trailing 6-3 heading to the bottom of the eighth inning, the Nationals plated five runs off Braves' relievers to take the 8-6 lead. **Chad Cordero** locked it down in the ninth inning for his 14th save of the season. The win kicked off a 10-game winning streak that still stands (along with a 10-game streak from Aug. 12-21, 2014) as the longest winning streaks in Nationals history (2005-pres.).

OPPONENT

ATLANTA BRAVES

Dave Martinez capped his 16-year Major League career with Atlanta in 2001, hitting .287 in 12 games...**Matt Adams** clubbed 19 home runs in 100 games for the Braves in 2017...The Braves made Nationals pitching coach **Derek Lilliquist** their first-round selection (6th overall) out of the University of Georgia in the 1987 Amateur Draft.

THE SERIES

DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.
