NEW YORK YANKEES NOTES

- At 48-22, the Yankees are a season-high 26 games over .500...in the last 65 seasons (since 1954), is the second-earliest they reached the mark (37-11).
 - Are 15-4 in their last 19 games (since 5/29)...was their 22nd come-from-behind win of the season.
 - Are 27-11 (.711) at Yankee Stadium, the Majors' best winning percentage and most home wins...are 22-6 in the Bronx since 4/21.
 - Are 19-7 in series openers this season, including a 10-3 mark in home series openers.
 - Improved to 39-4 (.907) this season when allowing 4R-or-fewer, and 35-3 (.921) when allowing 3R-or-fewer.
- The Yankee are 14-6 in 20 games vs. AL West opponents this season, matching their win total against the division from all of 2017 (14-19)...improved to 30-12 vs. all non-AL East divisions (are 18-10 vs. the AL East).
 - Have won eight of their last 10 games against Seattle...are 17-6 vs. the Mariners in 23 games since 6/10/14.
- At 2 hours, 28 minutes, matched their shortest game of the season (also 6/8 at the Mets)...each of their last five, and seven of their last eight, home games have been under three hours.
- **Yankees pitchers** have posted a Major League-low 1.97 ERA (155.0IP, 34ER) in 17 games in June.
 - **Yankees relievers** have allowed just 2ER in 42.0IP over their last 15 games, posting a 0.43 ERA with 56K over the span.
- **RHP Domingo Germán** (7.0IP, 2H, 2R/1ER, 0BB, 9K, 1HR) made his longest career start and earned his second win...did not allow a hit or walk to 20 consecutive batters between a double by Dee Gordon to lead off the game and a seventh-inning homer by Nelson Cruz...was the second time this season a Yankees starter tossed at least 7.0 innings without issuing a walk (also Luis Severino in Game 1 on 6/4 at Detroit, 8.0IP, 4H, 2R/1ER, 0BB, 10K).
 - Has at least 9K in each of his last three starts, matching Luis Severino (3G, 8/28-9/9/17) for the longest such streak by a Yankee since 2012.
- **RHP A.J. Cole** (2.0IP, 3K) made his first appearance since 5/28 vs. Houston.
- **Yankees batters** hit 4HR tonight and lead the Majors in season homers (118) and home runs at home (63).
- **CF Aaron Hicks** (3-for-4) hit a two-run HR in the fifth...has homered in a career-high three straight games and four of his last six.
 - Has reached the 10HR plateau in consecutive seasons and for the third time in his career (11HR in 2015 and 15HR in 2017).
 - Of his 33HR since joining the Yankees, 23 have come at Yankee Stadium.
 - Is hitting .321 (18-for-56) with 5HR in 16 games in June...had a season batting average of .230 (32-for-139) with 5HR in 39 games through the end of May.
- **3B Miguel Andújar** (2-for-4, 2R) hit a two-run HR in the fifth, snapping an 0-for-14 stretch...has 35 extra-base hits (24 doubles, 2 triples, 9HR), the third-most by a Yankee through his 65th career game in franchise history (Joe DiMaggio-47, Bob Meusel-41).
- **2B Gleyber Torres** (2-for-4) hit his 14th career home run in the eighth inning...came in his 50th career game, matching Aaron Judge for third-most through a player's first 50 career games in franchise history (Gary Sánchez-19HR, Kevin Maas-15HR)...since his Major League debut on 4/22, leads all rookies with 14HR and 35RBI.
- **SS Didi Gregorius** (1-for-4) played in his 700th career game, surpassing Hall of Famer Bert Blyleven (699) for most games played by a Netherlands-born player in Baseball history...is just the 12th Europe-born player who made his Major League debut since 1900 to reach 700 career games played.
- **LF Clint Frazier** (1-for-3, 1R) has hit safely in each of his four games with an at-bat this season...has scored a run in each of his five games played, extending his career-long stretch.
- **RF Aaron Judge** (1-for-4, 1RBI) has hit safely in eight of his last nine home games...is batting .351 (47-for-134) with 33R, 11 doubles, 12HR, 35RBI and 35BB in 38 games at Yankee Stadium this season.

SEATTLE MARINERS NOTES

- The Mariners dropped the first game of their 11-day, 10-game, three-city road trip...have lost consecutive games for the first time since 5/29-30.
 - Have lost eight of their last 10 games vs. the Yankees (since 8/23/16)...have lost their last three games in the Bronx (since 8/26/17), their longest losing streak at Yankee Stadium since dropping four straight from 8/21/10-7/26/11.
- **LHP Marco Gonzales** (6.1IP, 8H, 6ER, 1BB, 5K, 3HR) started and took the loss...snapped a six-start undefeated streak and a four-game winning streak, marking his first loss since 5/12/18 at Detroit...allowed a career-high 6R and 6ER (previous: 5R/5ER, 5x, last on 8/28/17 at Baltimore).
 - His 3HR tied his career high (also 6/11/17 vs. Milwaukee).
 - Allowed 6ER tonight after allowing 6ER total over his last six starts (38.1IP, 1.41 ERA)
- **2B Dee Gordon** (1-for-4, 1R, 1 double) hit a leadoff double, extending his hitting streak to seven games...is hitting .400 (12-for-30) over that span.
 - In five career games vs. the Yankees, is 8-for-22 (.364) with 4R, 2 doubles, 1 triple and 1RBI.
- **DH Nelson Cruz** (1-for-3, 1HR) hit his 144th career home run with the Mariners tonight...breaks a tie with Bret Boone (143 HR) for eighth-most home runs in club history...Raul Ibanez ranks seventh in club history with 156 home runs as a Mariner.
 - Has homered in consecutive games for the third time this season (3G from 6/9-11 and 2G from 3/29-31).
 - Has 7HR in his last 10 games and 8HR in his last 13 games.
 - Is hitting .311 (23-for-74) with 13R, 2 doubles, 10HR, 20RBI and 10BB in his last 21 games (since 5/28).
- **Mariners batters** were held to 2H, tied for their fewest in a game this season (also 4/9 at Kansas City and 4/15 vs. Oakland)...were held hitless in 20 straight at-bats after Gordon's leadoff double until Cruz's HR in the seventh.
