Since May 9, **Jean Segura** is batting .369 (73x198) with 37 runs, 14 doubles, 1 triple, 4 home runs, 22 RBI, 1 HBP, 11 walks, a .399 on-base percentage and a .510 slugging mark (.909 OPS) in 48 games...during that span, Segura leads the Majors in batting and hits.

The Mariners have the 2nd-best ERA in Interleague history with a mark of 3.79 (1,451 ER, 3,443.0 IP)...they trail only New York-AL (3.76/1,491 ER, 3,564.2 IP).

**James Paxton's** 145 strikeouts are 8th-most in club history prior to the All-Star Break...he is 4 strikeouts shy of moving into 7th place (Mark Langston, 148, 1987), 6 shy of 6th-most (Randy Johnson, 150, 1994), 8 shy of 5th-most (Johnson, 152, 1995) and 10 shy of 4th-most (**Félix Hernández**, 154, 2014).

The Mariners and Rockies meet for the 2nd (0-1) of 6 games this season...the Mariners will travel to Colorado for a 3-game series July 13-15...since 2012, Seattle is 9-5 against the Rockies:

**TODAY'S TILT**...the Mariners continue a 10-day, 9-game homestand with the second (0-1) of 3 games vs. Colorado...began the homestand by sweeping a 3-game series from Kansas City and taking 2-of-3 from Los Angeles-AL...following this series, will embark on a 7-day, 6-game, 2-city road trip to Los Angeles-AL (3 G) and Colorado (3 G)...today's game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS NW** and broadcast live on **710 ESPN Seattle** and the Mariners Radio Network.

**ODDS AND ENDS**...the Mariners have won 9 of their last 11 games, including a season-high 8-game winning streak (6/25-7/3)...the Mariners are 10-8 over their last 18 contests...they have also won 16 of their last 25 games, 23 of their last 34, 27 of their last 40, 32 of their last 46 and 34 of their last 50...Seattle is 42-22 in its last 64 games, 47-25 over its last 72 games and 52-29 in its last 81 games...Seattle is 16-15 during the day and 40-18 at night...Seattle is 30-16 at Safeco Field, 26-17 on the road.

- **Whiff** - according to Statcast, left-handed batters have swung and missed 47.6% of the time vs. **Edwin Díaz**, the highest whiff-per-swing rate against lefties in the Majors...Díaz ranks ahead of Ryan Pressly-MIN (40.9%), Hector Neris-PHI (39.8%), Kazuhisa Makita-SD (38.6%) and David Robertson-NYY (38.5%)... Statcast also notes that lefties have missed on 66.7% of their swings against Díaz's slider this season.
- **Corner of Edgar & Dave** - the Mariners are 30-16 (.652) at Safeco Field this season, tied for the 4th-best home winning percentage in the Majors...they trail New York-AL (.717/33-13), Boston (.700/28-12) and Cleveland (.683/28-13), while tied with Philadelphia (.652/30-16)...the Mariners have won 14 of their last 18 home games (5/31-c) and are 21-6 (.778) at home since May 18.
- **First Things First** - **Dee Gordon** is batting .324 (24x74) when leading off a game this season.
- **Herrmann's Hits** - **Chris Herrmann** has reached base safely via hit or walk in 5 of his 7 starts this season... he has reached base twice via hit or walk in 3 of those 7 starts...the Mariners are 5-2 in Herrmann's 7 starts.
- **Four Score** - The Mariners are 41-11 when scoring 4-or-more runs, but are 15-22 when scoring 3-or-fewer runs.

**CANADA'S SON**...since tossing his first career no-hitter on May 8 at Toronto, **James Paxton** is 7-1 with a 2.96 ERA (24 ER, 73.0 IP) with 85 strikeouts and 16 walks in 11 starts...over this stretch, he is averaging 10.48 strikeouts-per-9.0-innings (85 K, 73.0 IP)...his 8 quality starts during that span include 7 outings of at least 7.0 innings pitched...he has worked at least 8.0 frames in 3 of his last 11 starts, including 2 complete games (5/8 at TOR and 5/19 vs. DET)...Paxton has recorded at least 10 strikeouts in 4 of his last 8 starts (5/25-c), including 11 punchouts over 8.0 scoreless frames in his last start, July 1 vs. Kansas City (Canada Day and James Paxton Bobblehead Day)...among American League leaders since May 8, Paxton ranks 2nd in WHIP (0.93/16 BB, 52 H, 73.0 IP), T2nd in wins (also: 4 others), 3rd in opponents average against (.198/52x262), T3rd in innings pitched (also: **Mike Leake** and Chris Sale-BOS), T4th in strikeouts (also: Charlie Morton-HOU), 8th in K/9.0 IP and T10th in ERA (also: Leake).

**JEAN, JEAN THE HIT COLLECTOR**...**Jean Segura** has 36 multi-hit game this season, tied for 2nd-most in the Majors (also: Francisco Lindor-CLE and J.D. Martinez-BOS), trailing only Nick Markakis-ATL (37)... Segura leads the Majors with 15 games of at least 3 hits...Segura has more multi-hit games (36) than games without a hit this season (21)...among Major League leaders, Segura ranks 2nd in hits with 113, trailing only Houston's Jose Altuve-HOU (119)...he also ranks 3rd in the Majors with a .331 (113x341) batting average, behind Altuve (.337/119x353) and Mookie Betts-BOS (.336/89x265).

**SOUTHPAW STATS**...the Mariners are 16-12 vs. left-handed starting pitchers this season, but have won 6 of their last 10 match-ups against southpaw starters (5/31-c)...during that span, the Mariners have won games when opposed by Mike Minor (5/31 vs. TEX), Blake Snell (6/3 vs. TB), Dallas Keuchel (6/5 at HOU), Andrew Heaney (6/11 vs. LAA), Eduardo Rodriguez (6/23 at BOS) and Heaney (7/3 vs. LAA)...**Kyle Seager leads the Major Leagues this season with 28 RBI against lefties**...**Jean Segura** ranks 6th in the American League with a .348 (32x92) average vs. LHP this season; his 32 hits against lefties are tied with Seager and Alex Bregman-HOU for 5th-most in the AL...**Nelson Cruz** has belted 7 home runs off left-handers, tied with 5 other players for 4th-most in the American League...since 2012, Cruz has hit 67 home runs against left-handers, tied with Giancarlo Stanton for the most in the Majors over that span, while Seager's 58 home runs off lefties are 4th-most in that span and most by a left-handed batter.

**AMONG THE BEST**...since May 8, the Mariners have a .661 (37-19) winning percentage, 2nd-best in the Majors over that span...they trail Houston (.698/37-16), while ranking ahead of Boston (.636/35-20), New York-AL (.627/32-19) and Milwaukee (.623/33-20)...the Mariners 37 wins are tied with Houston (37-16) for the most in the Majors since May 8.

**ELECTRIC EDDIE**...**Edwin Díaz** leads the Majors with 34 saves, while ranking 2nd among all relievers with 75 strikeouts (Josh Hader-MIL, 83)...**Díaz is the 2nd pitcher in Major League history with at least 30 saves and 70 strikeouts prior to the All-Star Break**, joining Eric Gagne-LAD in 2003 (31 SV, 76 K)...Díaz's 34 saves rank T2nd-most all-time prior to the All-Star Break (also: John Smoltz-ATL, 2003), behind Francisco Rodriguez in 2008 with the Angels (38)...of Díaz's 34 saves, 20 have come in 1-run games, most in the Majors this season (Craig Kimbrel-BOS, 11)...his 20 1-run saves are only 3 shy of equaling the Major League single-season record, set by Rodriguez in 2008 (23)...the Mariners are 42-0 when Díaz enters with a lead this season, including 22-0 when he enters with a 1-run lead...Díaz is 20-for-22 in 1-run save opportunities (90.9%) with a 0.81 ERA (2 ER, 22.1 IP) with 40 strikeouts and 5 walks.

**GOING NATIONAL**...today is the 4th of 20 Interleague match-ups for the Mariners this season...Seattle opened Interleague play by going 1-1 at San Francisco on April 3-4 and is 0-1 in this series vs. Colorado...the Mariners are 204-183 all-time in Interleague play, including 108-88 at home...the Mariners have gone .500 or better vs. the National League in 14 of the last 18 seasons since 2000...7 of the Mariners next 13 games will be vs. National League opponents, as they continue a 3-game series vs. Colorado...Seattle will also travel to Colorado, July 13-15 and host San Francisco for a 2-game series at Safeco Field, July 24-25.

**AS YOU MAY KNOW**...the Mariners are 22-10 (.688) following a loss this season...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...that the Mariners .688 winning percentage following a loss is 3rd-highest in the Majors this season?...they trail only New York-AL (.714/20-8) and Boston (.690/20-9), while ranking ahead of Atlanta (.649/24-13) and Philadelphia (.649/24-13)...the Mariners .688 winning percentage following a loss is currently 2nd-best in single season club history...trails only the 2001 club (.689/31-14), while ranking ahead of 1995 (.636/42-24), 2000 (.620/44-27) and 1997 (.620/44-27)...STATS LLC.

**ABOUT PAXTON...**

- 29-year-old left-hander is making his 19th start of 2018, his 93rd career MLB start, and 3rd career start vs. the Rockies today.
- Selected by Seattle in the 4th round of the 2010 MLB June Draft.
- Native of Ladner, BC...attended Delta Secondary School.
- Pitched for the University of Kentucky, 2007-09...was 11-5, 4.91 ERA (81 ER, 148.1 IP) and 168 K's in 55 G/24 GS.
- Originally selected by Toronto in the Supplemental 1st round (39th overall) in the 2009 MLB June Draft, but did not sign.
- Went 1-2 with a 4.08 ERA (8 ER, 17.2 IP) in 4 starts with Grand Prairie in the Independent League in 2010.
- Pitched for the World squad in the 2011 MLB Futures game... named to Midwest League All-Star team in 2011.
- Pitched the 6th no-hitter in Mariners history on May 8, 2018 at Toronto.
- Is 8-2 with a 2.70 ERA (21 ER, 70.0 IP) in 11 career starts in July.

**LAST OUTING...**W#8 in his last start, a 1-0 Mariners win vs. Kansas City on July 1...marked his 3rd scoreless outing and 7th start with double-digit strikeouts this season...allowed just 2 hits and 2 walks while striking out 11 batters across 8.0 innings pitched...retired the last 10 batters he faced.

**HEATING UP...**since May 1, ranks 4th in the Majors with 0.93 WHIP and has held opponents to a .198 batting average against (57x288), the 8th-lowest mark in the Majors...has gone 7-1 with a 2.70 ERA (24 ER, 90.0 IP) with 101 strikeouts since May 1.

**LEADERBOARD...**ranks 5th in the Majors with an 11.69 strikeouts-per-9.0-innings ratio (145 K, 111.2 IP)...his 7 games with 10-or-more strikeouts are tied for 2nd-most in the Majors, trailing only Max Scherzer-WAS (10) and tying Trevor Bauer-CLE (7) and Chris Sale-BOS (7)...Paxton ranks 5th in the American League (6th in the Majors) with 145 strikeouts, trailing Sale (164), Cole (151), Bauer (148) and Justin Verlander-HOU (144).

**THE RIGHT STUFF...**has held right-handed hitters to a .187 batting average (62x331), while lefties have batted .313 (25x80) against Paxton this season.

**NO-NO...**pitched the 6th no-hitter (5th by a single pitcher) in Mariners history in Toronto on May 8...issued 3 walks, struck out 7 batters and needed just 99 pitches to accomplish the feat...recorded his 1st career complete game and 1st career shutout.

- Is the 2nd Canadian-born pitcher in MLB history to throw a no-hitter, joining Dick Fowler, who tossed a no-no for the Philadelphia Athletics vs. the St. Louis Browns in the second game of a doubleheader on Sept. 9, 1945.
- Became the first American League pitcher to record a 16-strikeout game and a no-hitter in the same season since Nolan Ryan achieved both in the same game on May 1, 1991 vs. Toronto with the Texas Rangers...STATS, Inc.
- Marks the Mariners 4th no-hitter since 2012, tied with San Francisco for most during that span.
- Marks the 3rd no-hitter in the Majors this season (Sean Manaea-OAK, 4/21 vs. BOS; four pitchers-LAD, 5/4 at SD in Monterrey, Mexico).

**KKKKKKKKKKKKKKK...**recorded a career-high 16 strikeouts across 7.0 scoreless innings on May 2 vs. OAK...Paxton's 16 strikeouts are tied for the most in a single game in the Majors this season (also: Gerrit Cole-HOU, 5/4 at ARI)...marks the most strikeouts by a Mariners pitcher since Randy Johnson struck out 19 on 8/8/97 vs. CWS...became the first pitcher in Mariners history to record at least 2 strikeouts in each of the first 7 innings of a start.

**WHIFF...**recorded 49 strikeouts over his 5 starts from April 11 to May 2...is one of 5 Mariners pitchers in club history (done 65x) with at least 49 strikeouts over a span of 5 starts, the first since Félix Hernández also had 49 strikeouts over 5 starts, June 23 - July 14, 2012...Randy Johnson accomplished this feat 56 times while with the Mariners, followed by Mark Langston (4), Mike Moore (3), Hernández (1) and Paxton (1).

**2017 SEASON RECAP...**went 12-5 with a 2.98 ERA (45 ER, 136.0 IP) with 156 strikeouts and 45 walks in 24 starts... led club in wins (12) and strikeouts (156)...earned a career-high 12 wins...logged 136.0 IP, the most in his career (previous: 121.0 IP in 2016)...spent two stints on the 10-day DL (5/3-30/17, 8/11-9/15/17)...went 6-0 with a 1.37 ERA (6 ER, 39.1 IP) with 46 strikeouts and 6 walks in 6 starts in July; named AL Pitcher of the Month...became the first pitcher in club history to earn 2 AL Player of the Week honors in a single season.

**HAVE YOURSELF A MONTH...**in 6 starts in the month of July, went 6-0 with a 1.37 ERA (6 ER, 39.1 IP) with 46 strikeouts and 6 walks...became the first pitcher in club history to earn 6 wins in a calendar month...his 1.37 ERA for July was the lowest in calendar month by a Mariners pitcher since Félix Hernández posted a 1.22 ERA (6 ER, 44.1 IP) in June of 2014...Paxton's 1.37 ERA in July was 7th-lowest in club history by a Mariners left-hander in a calendar month and the lowest since Jamie Moyer posted a 1.01 ERA (4 ER, 35.2 IP) in June of 2002...earned the win in 7 consecutive starts, July 2, 2017-Aug. 4, 2017...equaled the club record for wins in consecutive starts (also: Jamie Moyer, 5/6-6/8/03, and Scott Bankhead, 6/18-7/20/89).

**CAREER...**is 38-22 with a 3.31 ERA (196 ER, 533.2 IP) with 554 strikeouts in 92 career starts...has spent 8 years in the Mariners organization, including parts of 6 Major League seasons, after being selected by Seattle in 4th round of the 2010 MLB Draft...made MLB debut on Sept. 7, 2013 vs. TB.

**TUESDAY'S PROBABLE STARTING PITCHER: LHP WADE LeBLANC (4-0, 3.19 ERA)**

33-year-old left-hander is scheduled to make his 13th start of the season tomorrow vs. Colorado...has not lost a decision in his 12 starts with the Mariners this season...the Mariners are 9-3 in his starts...W#4 in his last start, a 4-1 Mariners win vs. LAA on 7/3 (7.0,3,1,1,1,4,HR-1)...recorded a 4.61 ERA (7 ER, 13.2 IP) with 12 strikeouts and 3 walks in 5 relief appearances this season...signed with the Mariners on March 25 after being released by the Yankees at his request...
