ROAD TRIPPIN' REDBIRDS: The Cardinals continue their nine-game/10-day road trip through Pittsburgh, Miami, and Kansas City tonight with the second of three games against the Pirates. This stretch ties the Cardinals' longest road trip of the season (9 games, July 2-11 - ARI, SF, CWS). St. Louis is 8-8 post All-Star Break and 9-8 under interim manager **Mike Shildt** since he took the post on July 15.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals enter today in 4th place in the NL Central, 7.5 games out of first place and 5.0 games out of the second Wild Card position.

WONG ACTIVATED, FOWLER TO 10-DAY DL: The Cardinals announced prior to tonight's game that they have activated second baseman **Kolten Wong** from the 10-day disabled list and placed outfielder Dexter Fowler on the 10-day disabled list with a left foot fracture, suffered in last night's game.

SECRET SALSA: NL Player of the Month of July **Matt Carpenter** is ranked for 2nd in the National League with 27 home runs, trailing Colorado's **Nolan Arenado** (28). Carpenter is one shy of his career high of 28 home runs in 2015. He's three shy of becoming the 15th Cardinals left-handed hitter to whack 30 home runs in a single season and the first since **Jim Edmonds** hit 42 in 2004. Carpenter's 17 home runs hit on the road this season lead the National League.

LEAD-OFF BLASTS: **Matt Carpenter** slugged his 23rd career lead-off home run last night off **Chris Archer**, extending his single-season franchise mark and Major League lead with eight lead-off homers this season. Carpenter's eight lead-off blasts in 2018 are T12th-most in a single season, most since Houston's **George Springer**'s 9 last season, and trail **Alfonso Soriano**'s Major League record of 13 while with the New York Yankees in 2003.

ON THE ROAD WITH LOU: Last night's lead-off blast was Carpenter's 9th of his career on the road, tying him with Hall of Famer **Lou Brock** for most in franchise history.

DUCKS ON THE POND: The Cardinals stranded a season-high 16 runners on base in last night's loss, four of which that were stranded at third base. The 16 stranded runners in a nine inning defeat represented the most for St. Louis since May 24, 1994 vs. Philadelphia (16 LOB)...current bullpen coach and former Redbirds left-hander **Bryan Eversgerd** recorded St. Louis' final two outs in that night's 4-0 loss. Only two other MLB teams this season have stranded at least 16 runners in a nine inning game: Texas (17) in a 4-3 loss to Houston on June 9, and Miami (17) in a 10-2 win on July 8 at Washington.

TAKING CARE OF BUSINESS: The Cardinals are 31-25 against the NL Central this season (17-17 on the road), with only Atlanta (33-16 vs. NL East) sporting more divisional wins in the NL. St. Louis has 52 games remaining on their schedule with 20 against NL Central opponents (CIN 3; PIT 8; CHI 3; MIL 6).

NEW FACES: Only six Cardinal players have been active for every game this season (**Jordan Hicks**, **Bud Norris**, **Miles Mikolas**, **Francisco Peña**, **Matt Carpenter**, **Marcell Ozuna**), while six coaches remain from St. Louis' Opening Day roster.

PITTSBURGH CONNECTIONS

Pitcher **Carlos Martínez** was teammates with Pirates pitcher **Ivan Nova** and outfielders **Starling Marte** and **Gregory Polanco** for the Dominican Republic in the 2017 World Baseball Classic.

Infielder **Paul DeJong** was originally selected by the Pirates in the 38th round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

Pitching coach **Mike Maddux** signed with the Pirates in April 1995 and pitched in eight games before being released in May.

Pitcher **Miles Mikolas** spent one month as a Pirate during the 2013 offseason...traded by San Diego with infielder **Jaff Decker** to Pittsburgh in exchange for outfielder **Alex Dickerson** (November 25, 2013), then traded by Pittsburgh to the Rangers in exchange for infielder **Chris McGuinness** (December 30, 2013).

Infielder **Jedd Gyorko** was born in Morgantown, WV...played at West Virginia University (2008-10).

First base coach **Oliver Marmol** was originally selected by the Pirates in the 31st round of the 2004 MLB draft, but did not sign.

Pitcher **Tyler Webb** was claimed off waivers by the Pirates from the Yankees in the 2016 Rule 5 Draft...pitched in eight Spring Training games for Pittsburgh in 2017, but was returned to the Yankees before the regular season began.

Outfielder **Dexter Fowler** and outfielder **Corey Dickerson** were teammates in Colorado in 2013.

Catcher **Francisco Peña's** father, **Tony**, was an All-Star catcher for the Pirates (1980-86)...later traded by Pittsburgh to the Cardinals for pitcher **Mike Dunne**, catcher **Mike LaValliere** and outfielder **Andy Van Slyke** (April 1, 1987.)

Catcher **Yadier Molina** (June 3, 2004), infielder **José Martínez** (September 6, 2016) and pitcher **Austin Gomber** (June 2, 2018) all made their MLB debuts against Pittsburgh.

Infielder **David Freese** played parts of five seasons in St. Louis (2009-13)...member of the 2011 World Series Champions...hit only walk-off home run in Cardinals WS history in Game 6...recognized as 2011 WS and NLCS MVP...selected to 2012 NL All-Star...later traded by St. Louis with RHP **Fernando Salas** to the Angels for OF **Peter Bourjos** and OF **Randal Grichuk** (November 22, 2013)...graduated from Lafayette (Mo.) High School in Wildwood.

Manager **Clint Hurdle** was selected by St. Louis from the Mets in the 1985 Rule 5 Draft and played in 86 games for the Cardinals in 1986.

Infielder **Sean Rodriguez's** father, **Johnny**, is the manager of the Springfield Cardinals (AA) of the Texas League.

Pitching Coach **Ray Searage** was selected by St. Louis in the 22nd round of the 1976 MLB Draft...later traded to the Mets for catcher **Jody Davis** in 1979...began coaching career in the Cardinals minor league system as Pitching Coach with Madison (1994), Peoria (1995-96) & Prince William (1997).

Pirates Baseball Operations Senior Advisor **Nick Leyva** was drafted by St. Louis in the 24th round in 1975...played three minor league seasons in the Cardinals system (1975-77)...managed six minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization (1978-83)...served as St. Louis' First Base Coach (1984-85) and Third Base Coach (1986-88).

Former Cardinals (1983-86) and Pirates (1987-94) All-Star outfielder **Andy Van Slyke** is being honored and celebrated in a pair of bobbleheads this season at Busch Stadium (April 24 vs. New York Mets) and PNC Park (August 4 vs. St. Louis).

Cardinals Baseball Information & Media Services Coordinator **Chris Tunno** graduated from nearby Canfield (Ohio) High School.

Pirates Manager of Business Communications & Social Media **Terry Rodgers** previously worked as a Public Relations Specialist in the Cardinals Communications department (2010-11).

MLB.com Cardinals reporter **Jenifer Langosch** covered the Pirates for parts of five seasons

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Makes his second career Major League start and 19th appearance tonight. Takes the turn of Carlos Martinez (DL) in the rotation.
- Is the 10th different pitcher and only left-hander to make a start for St. Louis this season.
- Made his Major League debut on June 2 vs. the Pirates at Busch Stadium with 3.0 scoreless & hitless innings in relief; became the first Cardinals left-handed relief pitcher to do so...right-handers Dick Hughes (3.0 IP; 9/11/66) & Ray Washburn (4.1 IP; 9/20/61) are the only others to have done so (since 1908).
- Recalled on July 24 from Memphis (AAA) and made his first career Major League start at CIN that night...began that start with 6.1 no-hit innings before Joey Votto singled in the 7th inning.
- He and Daniel Poncedeleon (7/23 at CIN) became the first pair of rookie teammates to carry consecutive no-hitters into the 7th inning since 1964.

LAST TIME OUT

- Earned his first career Major League win in a relief appearance in Wednesday's 6-3 win vs. Colorado at Busch Stadium.
- Retired the side on 14 pitches, striking out a pair over a scoreless 6th inning.

- Limiting opposing right-handers to slash .128/.277/.246 in 49 batters faced.

- Earned his first Major League win in his last appearance (8/1 vs. COL), working a scoreless 6th, striking out two.

- Did not allow a hit to the first 14 right-handed batters he faced until 6/25 vs. CLE (Rajai Davis singled in 9th inning). Holding RH batters to a .091 BA (2-22, 2 singles, 0 RBI).
- Currently ranks T15th among National League rookies with 7 Holds.
