RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals are 36-22 post All-Star Break and 37-22 under manager **Mike Shildt** since he took the post on July 15. The Cardinals have the most wins in the majors since the All-Star Break (36), while St. Louis .621 winning percentage ranks 4th in MLB over that period. Entering July 15, the Cardinals had T9th-most wins in the NL (47) and currently have the T3rd-most wins (84) in the NL.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals won their 8th-consecutive game in Atlanta (5-0 at SunTrust) since 2016 last night and moved 1.5 games in front of Colorado for the final NL Wild Card...the Cardinals currently reside in 3rd place in the NL Central, 5.5 games out of first place, and are 2.0 games back of Milwaukee...the Cardinals have six games (MIL-3, CHI-3) remaining against teams ahead of them in the standings.

THE ROAD TO SUCCESS: The Cardinals' 44 road wins are 2nd in the N.L., trailing only the Braves (45). It's the club's most since 48 road victories in 2016 (they had 39 last season). In road games since July 15, the Cardinals lead the National league in wins (20) and are 2nd in win pct. (.645).

WINNING SEASONS: The Cardinals have posted their 11th consecutive winning season, something they'd done just once previously in franchise history, when they compiled 15 consecutive winning seasons from 1939-1953.

THE HUNT FOR A RED OCTOBER: Seven of the Cardinals 10 remaining games (at ATL-1, MIL-3, at CHI-3) are with teams currently in contention for playoff positions...the SF Giants (3 games) are the only remaining team on the Cardinals slate that is under .500.

DEALING IN DIXIE: The Cardinals have won eight-consecutive games in Atlanta since 2016, something they hadn't done since the 1967-68 seasons when they won 11-straight in Atlanta...**A BRAVE NEW WORLD:** The Cardinals are making just their second series visit to the Braves new SunTrust Park, their first since last May when they swept the Braves in three games, including a 14-inning win in the series finale...the Cardinals (5-0), Red Sox (3-0) and Astros (2-0) are the only undefeated teams at SunTrust Park.

BASH BROTHERS: **Yadier Molina** belted his 144th career HR Mon. night to tie his older brother **Bengie** for the family lead...**José Molina** had 39 career round-trippers...Yadier's 18 HR's this season match his total from 2017 and are four shy of his career high 22 in 2012.

MEMPHIS WINS NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP GAME: The Memphis Redbirds (AAA) defeated the Durham Bulls (Tampa Bay) 14-4 last night to secure their first ever National Championship title...infielder **Alex Mejia** had 5 hits & 5 RBI and was named he game's MVP...Memphis repeated as Pacific Coast League Champions in 2018 under Manager **Stubby Clapp**, using a franchise record 66 players. **TOP ORGANIZATIONS:** The Cardinals 492-402 (.550) overall organizational record placed them 2nd behind Tampa Bay (539-345; .604) in total wins among all minor league systems this year.

POWER PLAY: St. Louis has homered in 110 of 152 games this season, going 75-35 (.682 win pct.) in those games (9-33 when not homering)...their 75 wins lead the NL & rank 5th in MLB (Yankees, 1st-82)...St. Louis' 198 HR's are 2nd in NL behind the Dodgers (216)...**HOMERS AWAY FROM HOME:** St. Louis is an NL-best 41-19 (.683) when homering on the road, and trails only Oakland (123) in road homers (121) among all Major League teams.

ATLANTA CONNECTIONS

Pitcher **Adam Wainwright** was born in Brunswick, Ga. and resides in St. Simon's Island, Ga...attended Glynn Academy in Brunswick...selected by Atlanta in the first round (29th overall) of the 2000 MLB draft...acquired by St. Louis from Braves with pitchers **Jason Marquis** and **Ray King** for outfielder **J.D. Drew** and catcher **Eli Marrero** (Dec. 13, 2003).

Outfielder **Dexter Fowler** was born in Atlanta, Ga...graduated from Milton (Ga.) High School.

Catcher **Francisco Pena's** brother, **Tony**, appeared in 46 games with Atlanta during his MLB debut season in 2006.

First baseman **José Martínez** played parts of two minor league seasons (2013-14) in the Braves organization, sandwiched around 28 games with the independent Rockford Aviators at the beginning of the 2014 season.

First baseman **José Martínez** and outfielder **Ronald Acuña Jr.** were both born in La Guaira, Venezuela and are third cousins.

Pitcher **Bud Norris** pitched 22 games (10 starts) for Atlanta in 2016 before traded to the Dodgers along with outfielder **Dian Toscano**, pitcher **Alec Grosser** and cash for pitchers **Caleb Dirks** and **Phil Pfeifer** (June 30, 2016).

Pitcher **Jack Flaherty** was high school teammates with Braves pitcher **Max Fried** and White Sox pitcher **Lucas Giolito** while at Harvard-Westlake High School in Los Angeles, Calif.

Pitcher **John Gant** pitched in 20 games (seven starts) for Atlanta in 2016, where he made his MLB debut...became a Cardinal via trade with the Braves, packaged with pitcher **Chris Ellis** and infielder **Luke Dykstra** for pitcher **Jaime Garcia** (Dec. 1, 2016).

Mike Maddux's brother, **Greg**, was a Hall of Fame pitcher for Atlanta for 11 seasons (1993-2003), winning three Cy Young and 10 Gold Gloves Awards, named to six NL All-Star Games, and a member of the 1995 World Series team.

Ron Washington (manager) and **Mike Maddux** (pitching) were on the Texas Rangers coaching staff that faced St. Louis in the 2011 World Series.

Manager **Brian Snitker** was born in nearby Decatur, Ill...graduated from Macon (Ill.) High School.

Pitcher **Sam Freeman** was drafted by the Cardinals in the 32nd round in 2008...made his MLB debut and pitched in 81 games over three years for St. Louis (2012-14), including the 2014 NLDS.

Pitcher **Dan Winker** is born in Effingham, Ill...graduated from St. Anthony High School in Effingham.

Former Cardinals coach **Chris Maloney** (2012-17) is currently the Mississippi Braves (AA) manager in the Braves organization.

Cardinals rookie outfielder **Adolis García** is the younger brother of former (2015-17) Braves infielder **Adonis García**

Braves Senior Director of Media Relations **Brad Hainje** worked six seasons (1998-2003) as a member of the Cardinals Media Relations Department.

Braves Senior Coordinator, Media Relations **Jonathan Kerber** began his pro career with the Rookie Level New Jersey Cardinals (2004).

Cardinals Broadcaster **Rick Ankiel** played in 47 games for the Braves in 2007...traded by Kansas City with pitcher **Kyle Farnsworth** to the Braves for outfielder **Gregor Blanco** and pitchers **Jesse Chavez** and **Tim Collins** (July 31, 2010).

Cardinals broadcaster **Al Hrabosky** pitched his final three seasons with Atlanta (1980-82).

Braves broadcaster **Chip Caray** was born in St. Louis in 1965...graduated from Parkway West High School in 1983...briefly broadcast Cardinals games in the early 1990s...his father, **Skip Caray**, was born in St. Louis in 1939...graduated from Webster Groves High School and the University of Missouri...previously broadcast for the Tulsa Oilers (AA-Cardinals), and basketball for Saint Louis University and St. Louis Hawks...his grandfather, **Harry Caray**, was born in St. Louis in 1914 and graduated from Webster Groves High School...was a Cardinals broadcaster for 25 years (1945-1969).

Braves broadcaster **Brian Jordan** was selected by the Cardinals in the first round (30th overall) of the 1988 MLB Draft...played first seven professional seasons in St. Louis.

TODAY'S GAME

- Rookie makes his 26th start of the season & 32nd career app. (31st start). The 26 starts are the most by a Cardinals rookie since Shelby Miller started 31 games in 2013.
- Leads all MLB rookies and the Cardinals with his 168 strikeouts (12th in the N.L.). Next closest rookie in strikeouts is Walker Buehler (LAD) with 131.
- Needs one strikeout to tie Shelby Miller (169 in 2013) for 3rd all-time in Cards single-season history for rookies. Only Dizzy Dean (191) and Rick Ankiel (194) are ahead.
- Has struck out 81 batters post All-Star Break, 5th among National League pitchers.
- His 188 strikeouts in first 31 career games are the most ever by a Cardinal.
- Averages 10.93 strikeouts/9 IP this season, ranking 4th all-time for rookie pitchers behind Kerry Wood (12.58 in 1998), Dwight Gooden (11.39 in 1984) and Hideo Nomo (11.10 in 1995), all who went on to win Rookie of the Year awards.
- Held opposition to one run or fewer in 15 of 25 starts, ranking T3rd among N.L. pitchers (M. Foltyniewicz & J. deGrom - 16). Held opposition to 4 ER or less in all 25 starts.
- Leads NL rookies in win pct. (.533), opponent BA (.193) and strikeouts (168). Ranks in the Top 10 in wins (8, T1st), ERA (2.86, 2nd), innings (138.1, 2nd) and starts (25, 2nd).
- 11 of the 17 runs he's allowed over his last 11 starts have come via home run.
- Has the 2nd-lowest ERA in the N.L. of pitchers who have allowed 18 or more home runs this season, behind Max Scherzer (2.53, 21 HR).
- In eight day game starts this season, is 4-1, 2.14 ERA over 42.0 IP with 53 strikeouts.
- Looking to earn his first career win in September in seven career starts (8 app.).

LAST TIME OUT

- Took the loss after holding the Dodgers to one run (Yasiel Puig solo HR) while striking out eight in a 3-0 defeat opposite Walker Buehler at Busch Stadium on Sept. 14. Was his first lost since July 31 vs. COL (spanning 7 starts).
- Passed Dick Hughes (161, 6th) and Harvey Haddix (163, 5th) among Cardinals rookie strikeout leaders during that game.
