CARDINALS NOTES (Extra Innings: 1-1)

- Carlos Martinez made his team-leading third start of the season, second against the Brewers in 2018 (1-0) and 14th career start (25th app.) vs. the Brewers (6-4)...recorded his 700th career strikeout fanning Eric Sogard in the 5th inning (21st Cardinals pitcher with 700 career K's)...entered today with a career ERA of 1.98 vs. MIL, 2nd-lowest among active pitchers behind Jose Quintana (0.75)...has allowed nine 1st inning home runs in his career.
- Carlos Martinez tallied his second hit of the season and 27th since the start of 2016, most among MLB pitchers.
- Matt Carpenter hit his 3rd career walk-off home run (5th career walk-off hit) and his 3rd career extra inning home run...his last was a walk-off grand slam vs. TOR (4/27/17) in the 11th inning of Game 1 of a doubleheader...has reached base safely in 11 straight games to begin the season...earned his 101st career multi-walk game.
- Kolten Wong has recorded a bunt single in consecutive games...leads the Cardinals with 14 bunt hits since 2014.
- Marcell Ozuna has hit safely in nine straight games (15-40, .375) with a single in the 6th inning...has hit safely in his last seven straight games vs. MIL.
- Yairo Munoz recorded his first MLB RBI drawing a bases loaded walk off Oliver Drake in the 6th inning.
- Tommy Pham drew a pinch-hit walk in the 9th inning and came around to score the tying run, his team-leading 9th run this season.
- Greg Garcia recorded his first sac bunt of the season, tied the game in the bottom of the 10th inning with his first RBI this season.
- Dexter Fowler reached base safely three times tonight, tying his season-high with two walks...stole his first base of the season.
- The last time the Cardinals and Brewers played consecutive extra inning games was April 28-29, 2014 in which the Brewers won 5-3 in 12 innings (4/28) and 5-4 in 11 innings (4/29).
- *The Cardinals challenged the out call on Harrison Bader's at-bat in the 10th inning. Call stands (Time: 2:22).*
- Jose Martinez recorded a pinch-hit single in the 10th inning, the first Cardinals pinch hit of the season (0-12 to start). Is a career 17-for-33 (.515) in pinch-hit situations.
- Dominic Leone earned his first win as a member of the Cardinals.
- The Cardinals won by walk-off for the first time this season (last walk-off win was 8/26/17 vs. TB; Tommy Pham walk-off 2-run HR) ...entered today with 28 inherited runners, tied with Atlanta for the most in MLB...stranded two more by Jordan Hicks and have now stranded 80% (24/30) on the season...entered today with six infield hits and had four more tonight.

BREWERS NOTES (Extra Innings: 2-1)

- Brent Suter made his third start of the season, first against the Cardinals in 2018 and third career start (7th app.) vs. the Cardinals (0-2)...threw his longest outing of the season with 5.1 innings, also matching his longest career outing vs. STL (8/2/17).

- Orlando Arcia has five RBI this season, four have been in the 9th inning or later.
- Eric Thames has homered in 3-of-his-last-4 games...hit his second home run of the season...all four home runs have come against N.L. Central squads (CHI 2, STL 2)...posted his first game with two extra base hits this season.
- Domingo Santana has hit safely in his last eight games vs. STL (14-31, .452)...the 9th inning go-ahead RBI single was his first hit with runners in scoring position and two outs (1-6, .167) this season.
- Oliver Drake walked a season-high three batters, tying his career-high (5/28/15 vs. CWS).
- *Manny Pina left the game in the 7th inning with right calf tightness.*
- Travis Shaw has hit safely in his last seven games vs. STL (10-24, .417) and has scored nine runs over that period.
- Taylor Williams has struck out three batters in an inning of work in each of his two appearances this season.
- Ryan Braun recorded his first pinch-hit of the season (1-1), is 8-for-32 (.250) in his pinch-hitting career.
- J.J. Hoover has four blown saves in his career vs. the Cardinals, his most against any opponent.
- The Brewers blew two saves tonight for the first time this season and most recent since 6/3/17 vs. LAD (Jared Hughes & Carlos Torres)...had their five-game road win streak to begin the season snapped.
