RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals are 33-19 post All-Star Break and 34-19 under manager **Mike Shildt** since he took the post on July 15. The Cardinals have the most wins in the NL since the All-Star Break (33), while St. Louis .635 winning percentage ranks 3rd in MLB over that period. St. Louis has won 23-of-its-last-33 games overall. Entering July 15, the Cardinals had 19th-most wins in the NL (47) and currently have the 4th-most wins (81) in the NL.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals are 16 games over .500 entering play today (have been season-high 17 games over twice) and currently reside in 3rd place in the NL Central, 3.5 games out of first place, and hold the 2nd spot in the NL Wild Card standings, trailing Milwaukee by 2.5 games. The Cardinals have six games remaining against teams ahead of them in the standings.

THE YEAR WAS 2006: When the Cardinals swept the Dodgers last month (Aug. 20-22) in Los Angeles, it was their first series sweep of the Dodgers since July of 2006...St. Louis swept their 7-game season series from LA in 2006 by also taking all four games in St. Louis that year.

GULF COAST HONORS: Outfielder **Austin Warner**, the Cardinals 40th round selection this year out of Columbia College (Columbia, Mo.), was today named Gulf Coast League MVP after batting .342, 4 HR, 27 RBI in 31 games for the GCL Cardinals...GCL Cardinals Manager **Erick Almonte** was named GCL Manager of the Year after leading the rookie league club to a league-best 40-16 mark.

THE HOME STRETCH: The Cardinals, who have matched the Cubs & Braves for fewest home games played (71) amongst all N.L. teams, will be home for 10 of their remaining 16 regular season games...St. Louis is 39-32 (.549) at home.

WINNING SEASONS: The Cardinals need one win to record their 11th consecutive winning season, something they've done just once previously in franchise history, when they compiled 15 consecutive winning seasons from 1939-1953.

THE HUNT FOR A RED OCTOBER: The Cardinals have 13 games (LAD-4, at ATL-3, MIL-3, at CHI-3) remaining with teams currently in contention for playoff positions...the SF Giants (3 games) are the only remaining team on the Cardinals slate that is under .500.

FAN-TASTIC: The Cardinals will surpass the 3 million mark in season attendance tonight for the 15th-straight season (2004-18) and the 22nd time overall...the Cardinals will join the Dodgers & Yankees as the only MLB teams to have reached the 3 million mark in attendance this season.

THE BIG BEAR: In nine games since Sept. 3, **Marcell Ozuna** leads the National League in total bases (30), slugging pct. (.789) and go-ahead RBI (6), is 2nd in home runs (5), ranks 5th in OPS (1.148) and 7th in batting average (.368)...Ozuna has 11 home runs and is slugging .531 in 43 games since the All-Star Break (10 home runs w/ .385 slugging pct. in 90 games before).

POWER PLAY: St. Louis has homered in 105 of 146 games this season, going 72-33 (.686 win pct.) in those games (9-32 when not homering)...their 72 wins lead the NL and rank 5th in MLB (Yankees, 1st-80)...St. Louis' 190 HR's are 2nd in the NL to the Dodgers (204).

BACK TO THE FUTURE: With his 2nd save in as many days on Monday, **Carlos Martínez** upped his save total to three (5 career)...Tsunami closed out a 7-6 win at Washington with 2.0 scoreless IP last Wed. (9/5) and since joining the bullpen last month, Martínez is 1-0 with a 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP/2 ER) with 3 saves & 4 holds...Carlos appeared in 20 games as a reliever during his rookie season (2013) and appeared in 12 games during the Redbirds postseason run, going 0-1 with a 3.55 ERA (12.2 IP/5 ER), appearing in five of the six games during the 2013 World Series.

LOS ANGELES CONNECTIONS

Jack Flaherty was born in Burbank...graduated from Harvard-Westlake High School, where went 23-0 with a 0.63 ERA over his final two seasons and 35-3 overall throughout his high school career...led Harvard-Westlake to the 2013 state title, pitching a complete-game shutout and driving in the lone run in a 1-0 win in the CIF Championship at Dodger Stadium...resides in Sherman Oaks.

Daniel Poncedeleon was born in Anaheim...graduated from La Mirada High School, where he played baseball and also quarterbacked the Matadores to the CIF-SS Southern Division crown...pitched his sophomore season of college at Cypress College in 2012.

Jedd Gyorko and **Yasmani Grandal** were teammates in San Diego for two seasons (2013-14).

Michael Wacha and **Ross Stripling** pitched together for three seasons (2010-12) and were roommates at Texas A&M University...led the Aggies to the 2011 College World Series...both were selected in the 2012 MLB draft.

Bud Norris played college baseball California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo (2004-06)...pitched in 13 games for the Dodgers during the 2016 season...originally traded to the Dodgers with outfielder **Dian Toscano**, pitcher **Alec Grosser** and cash considerations from the Braves in exchange for pitchers **Caleb Dirks** and **Phil Pfeifer** (June 30, 2016).

Cardinals pitching coach **Mike Maddux** pitched parts of the 1990 (11 games) and 1999 (49 games) seasons with the Dodgers...his younger brother, Hall of Famer **Greg Maddux**, pitched parts of the 2006 and 2008 seasons with the Dodgers.

Mike Mayers made his Major League debut vs. the Dodgers at Busch Stadium (July 24, 2016) on ESPN Sunday Night Baseball.

Patrick Wisdom was born in Murrieta...graduated from Murrieta Valley High School.

Cardinals bench coach **Ron "Pop" Warner** was born in Alhambra, Calif...graduated from Redlands High School.

Cardinals hitting coach **Mark Budaska** graduated from Granada Hills High School...played college baseball at Los Angeles Pierce College in nearby Woodland Hills...appeared in the 1991 feature film "Talent for the Game" as a first base coach for the California Angels.

David Freese played parts of five seasons in St. Louis (2009-13)...member of the 2011 World Series Champions...hit only walk-off home run in Cardinals WS history in Game 6...recognized as 2011 WS and NLCS MVP...selected to 2012 NL All-Star...later traded by St. Louis with RHP **Fernando Salas** to the Angels for OF **Peter Bourjos** and OF **Randal Grichuk** (November 22, 2013)...graduated from Lafayette (Mo.) High School in Wildwood.

Hall of Famer **Lou Brock** served as a baserunning consultant for the Dodgers in 1988.

Hall of Famer **Bob Gibson's** son, **Chris Gibson**, played in five games for Inland Empire (High-A) in the Dodgers minor league system in 2009.

Cardinals Director of Player Personnel **Matt Slater** worked for the Dodgers for nine years (1998-2006) as Director of Scouting Operations, Director of Baseball Operations and Director of Professional Scouting.

Cardinals Scouting Director **Randy Flores** was born in Bellflower...graduated from El Rancho High School in Pico Rivera...pitched four years at the University of Southern California (1994-97).

Cardinals Director of Player Development **Gary LaRocque** worked 19 years with the Dodgers as a minor league coach (1979-80) and manager (1981-88), area scout (1989-91) and regional scouting supervisor (1992-97).

Dodgers pitching coach **Rick Honeycutt** pitched parts of two years in St. Louis (1996-97).

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** pitched in 35 games over parts of two seasons (1988-89) for the Dodgers between stints with St. Louis.

Dodgers broadcaster **Fernando Valenzuela** became the first Mexican to throw no-hitter in MLB history (June 29, 1990 vs. St. Louis)...made five starts for St. Louis in his final pro season (1997).

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Rookie makes his 9th career Major League start and 26th appearance tonight.
- Ranks T7th in the National League with five wins post All-Star Break; one of five Major League pitchers with at least five wins without a loss in that period (Blake Snell, David Price, J.A. Happ, and Mike Fiers).
- His five-game winning streak is (August 1-present) is T2nd-longest active in the NL, trailing Colorado's Scott Oberg (7 games).
- He's one of 11 different pitchers (lone lefty) to make a start for St. Louis this season.
- Can become the first Cardinals left-hander to begin his career 6-0 since Allen Watson started 6-0 in his rookie season of 1993.
- Is 3-0, 2.13 ERA in 14 games (25.1 IP) at Busch Stadium, limiting opp. to .237 BA.
- Owns a 4-0 mark with 2.78 ERA in his eight starts (45.1 IP).

LAST TIME OUT

- Hurled his 5th quality start in a no-decision in last Friday's 5-3 walk-off loss to the Tigers at Comerica Park.
- Became only the 2nd Cardinals rookie pitcher to start a game in Comerica Park, joining Rick Ankiel on June 10, 2000 (6.0 IP, 7 H, 4 R, 4 BB, 3 K - Loss); and the 4th Cardinals rookie to start a game in Detroit (Paul Dean 10/8/1934 - Game 6 & José Jimenez 6/4/1999 at Tiger Stadium) in the regular or postseason.
