**NEW YORK YANKEES NOTES**

- The Yankees are 3-2 on their six-game homestand...have alternated wins and losses over their last seven games...are a Major League-best 32-13 (.711) at home, including 27-8 in 35 games since 4/21.
  - Are 8-6 in Interleague play this season, including 3-3 at home.
  - Are 27G over .500, 1G shy of their season high.
  - Are 39-5 (.886) when scoring first this season.
- With Aaron Hicks hitting his 15<sup>th</sup> home run of the season, the Yankees now have five players with at least 15HR prior to the All-Star break for the first time in franchise history (also Judge-23HR, Stanton-20HR, Gregorius-15HR and Torres-15HR).
- **CF Aaron Hicks** (1-for-3, 2R, 1HR, 2RBI, 2BB) hit his 15<sup>th</sup> home run of the season, tying his career high (15HR in 2017)...has 4HR in his last 3G, 5HR in his last 7G and 8HR in his last 14G...has 9HR in his last 17G (since 6/14) after hitting 6HR in his first 49 games of the season (3/29-6/13)
  - Has 6XBH in the last 3G (2 doubles, 4HR).
  - Of his 38HR since joining the Yankees in 2016, 27 have been hit at Yankee Stadium.
- **C Kyle Higashioka** (1-for-3, 1R, 1HR, 2RBI) is the third Yankee in franchise history to have his first two Major League hits go for home runs, joining Alfonso Soriano (first 3H were HRs from 9/24/99-4/9/00) and Joe Lefebvre (first 2H were HRs from 5/22-23/80)...is one of two Yankees since 2009 to homer for his first two hits with the club (also Ji-Man Choi in July 2017)...is the second player since the start of 2017 whose first two MLB hits were home runs (also Los Angeles-AL's Nolan Fontana).
- **RF Giancarlo Stanton** (2-for-5, 2R, 1HR, 2RBI) hit a two-run HR in the eighth, his 20<sup>th</sup> home run this season...became the 11th player ever to hit at least 20HR in at least each of his first nine Major League seasons...joins Mark Teixeira (first 13 seasons, 2003-15) and Albert Pujols (first 12 seasons, 2001-12) as the only ones to have accomplished the feat since 2000.
  - Is one of two players with at least 20HR in each of the last nine seasons (since 2010), joining Nelson Cruz.
  - Is hitting .390 (16-for-41) with 6R, 4 doubles, 2HR, 6RBI and 4BB in his last 10 games (since 6/23).
- **DH Aaron Judge** (2-for-4, 2R, 1BB) is hitting .320/.422/.587 (24-for-75) with 16R, 5 doubles, 5HR, 11RBI and 14BB in 20G since 6/12.
  - Is batting .358/.483/.728 (58-for-162) with 41R, 12 doubles, 16HR, 42RBI and 40BB in 45G at home this season.
  - His 2SB marked a career high.
- **Miguel Andújar** (1-for-3, 1 double, 1BB) has 40XBH through his first 78 career games, third-most in Yankees history through 78G (Joe DiMaggio-57XBH and Bob Meusel-47XBH).
- **RHP Domingo Germán** (4.1IP, 6H, 3ER, 3BB, 6K, 2HR, 1BK) started and did not record a decision...allowed back-to-back home runs to Inciarte and Albies in the third inning, tying his career high in HR (also 2HR on 5/22/18 at Texas and 6/9/18 at the Mets)...has failed to toss 5.0IP in each of his last two starts after doing so in six of his first seven career starts.
- **Yankees batters** recorded 5BB in the third inning, their most in an inning since 8/2/14 at Boston (also 5BB).
- **RHP A.J. Cole** (1H, 4K) stranded two inherited runners and tossed 1.2 scoreless innings to earn his second win as a Yankee and third of the season.
- **RHP Adam Warren** (1.1IP, 4H, 2ER, 1K, 1HR) allowed a two-run HR to Markakis in the seventh, his first run allowed since coming off the D.L. on 6/4...also snapped a 13.1-inning scoreless streak (4/20-6/30).
- **LHP Chasen Shreve** (0.2IP, 1K) entered with two men on in the eighth and retired both his batters faced.
- **LHP Aroldis Chapman** tossed a perfect ninth inning to record his 24<sup>th</sup> save of the season (1.0IP, 2K).

## ATLANTA BRAVES NOTES

- The Braves fell to 4-1 on their current 10-game road trip...are 26-18 on the road this season...are 14 games over .500, 1G shy of their season high.
  - Are now 13-20 all-time vs. the Yankees, including a 3-2 mark at the current Yankee Stadium.
  - Fell to 6-6 in Interleague games this season...are 14-8 over their last 22 games in American League parks, including 5-4 this season.
  - Dropped to 43-14 when scoring four-or-more runs this season and 31-8 when scoring at least 5R.
- **LHP Sean Newcomb** (2.2IP, 3H, 5ER, 5BB, 2K, 2HR) recorded the loss in the shortest start of his career...walked a season-high five batters, including four in the third inning...allowed a two-run HR to Hicks in the first inning after allowing just 4R/3ER in the first inning over his first 16 starts of the season...surrendered multiple home runs for the second time this season (2HR on 6/10 at Los Angeles-NL)...has given up at least 1HR in a career-high three straight games.
- **RHP Evan Phillips** (2.1IP, 1H, 2ER, 2BB, 1K, 1HR) made his Major League debut, entering with one on and two out in the bottom of the sixth...walked his first batter faced (Hicks), but got Gregorius to pop out to end the inning and strand both runners...his strikeout of Kyle Higashioka (looking) in the seventh inning was his first career strikeout.
- **CF Ender Inciarte** (2-for-4, 1BB, 1SB) hit a two-run HR in the fifth to give the Braves their first runs of the game...was the first of back-to-back HRs with **2B Ozzie Albies** (2-for-5), marking the Braves' third set of back-to-back homers this season (also 4/8 at Colorado, Markakis and Swanson and 5/2 at New York-NL, Camargo and Flaherty)...was **Albies'** first career Interleague home run...has hit safely in 12 of his last 13 games.
- **RHP Nick Markakis** (2-for-4, 1BB) hit his 10<sup>th</sup> home run of the season in the seventh...has reached the 10HR plateau in 11 of his 13 Major League seasons (since 2006)...recorded his Major League-leading 36<sup>th</sup> multi-hit game of the season...is just the second Braves batter since 1975 to record 36 multi-hit games through the team's first 84 games in a season (also: Martin Prado-39 multi-hit games in 2010).
  - Is hitting .343 (60-for-175) in 44 road games this season, the NL's second-highest road batting average (Cincinnati's Scooter Gennett - .354).
- **C Tyler Flowers** (0-for-4) matched his career high with 4K (seventh time, first since 5/15/16 at Kansas City).
