IT TAKES TWO | YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» A dominant start by **COREY KLUBER** and a two-run homer by **BRADLEY ZIMMER** were all the Indians needed to secure a 2-0 victory over Detroit in the first contest of this four-game set.

» Kluber tossed 8.0 shutout innings, allowing just two hits and striking out 13 batters, the most by any Indians pitcher this season... **ANDREW MILLER** worked a scoreless 9th inning to collect his first save of the year...marked the Tribe's second team shutout of 2018, as no Tigers batter advanced past first base all evening.

» After the Tribe was held hitless by Francisco Liriano for the first 4.2 frames, **YAN GOMES** singled to left for Cleveland's first hit and Zimmer homered to right-center in the next at-bat...**RAJAI DAVIS** also doubled for the Indians, while **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** was 1-for-2 with a pair of walks.

» The Indians have now recorded consecutive wins for the first time this season and have moved into a tie for 1st place in the A.L. Central division with Minnesota (4-4).

BLANK SPACE | SHUTOUTS

» On the strength of **COREY KLUBER's** dominant start, the Indians recorded their second team shutout of 2018 last night, following a 6-0 blanking of the Angels on April 2 at Angel Stadium.

» The Tribe led MLB with 19 shutouts in the 2017 season, the team's most since spinning 23 in 1968...the two hits allowed in last night's win were Cleveland's fewest since a one-hit shutout on May 7, 2017 at Kansas City.

» Yesterday also marked the Tribe's eighth shutout of a divisional opponent since July 8, 2017, four of which have come against the Tigers...12 of the Tribe's 19 shutouts last season were at the hands of A.L. Central Teams (KC 6x, DET 4x, CWS 2x).

EARLY BIRTHDAY PRESENT

» **COREY KLUBER, who turns 32 today**, collected his 40th career game of 10-or-more strikeouts (3rd-most in franchise history, 5th among active MLB pitchers) as he tossed 8.0 shutout innings in last night's contest...also marked the right-hander's 10th career start striking out at least 13 batters, T3rd among active pitchers.

» Improved his career strikeout total to 1,228, seven shy of matching **Charles Nagy** for 6th on the all-time Indians leaderboard...**Kluber now leads the American League with 27 strikeouts and 23.0 innings pitched this season.**

» Kluber has now won each of his last seven decisions against A.L. Central opponents, posting a mark of 7-0 with a 1.59 ERA (13ER/73.2IP) since June 9, 2017...**has gone 18-3 with a 2.36 ERA (47ER/179.1IP) against the division since the start of 2016.**

» Becomes the first Tribe pitcher to work at least 7.0 innings, strike out at least six batters and allow two-or-fewer runs in each of his first three starts of the season since **Sam McDowell** did so in his first four starts of the 1964 season.

MILLER'S CROSSING

» **ANDREW MILLER** worked a hitless 9th inning last night to pick up his first save of the season, as well as his 6th since joining the Indians in 2016.

» Continued a trend of hot starts for Miller, who has not allowed a run in March or April during his tenure with Cleveland (14 appearances, 16.0 innings, 24 strikeouts)...dating back to the start of 2015, Miller has worked 36.1 scoreless innings in 33 appearances during March and April, **allowing an opponent OPS of .533 in the first month of the season.**

» The Indians have posted a record of 71-16 (.816) when Miller appears since joining the team in 2016, including a mark of 11-3 (.786) in March/April games.

HOME COOKING

» The Indians have opened their 2018 home slate with a 3-1 record on this 10-game homestand...last season, the Indians posted a 49-32 (.605) record at Progressive Field, the 2nd-best home record in the American League and 4th-best in the Majors.

» Since the 2017 All-Star Break, Cleveland has gone an MLB-best 31-9 (.775) at home, including wins in 20 of their past 24 regular-season games here.

» This current 10-game homestand (vs. KC, DET & TOR) matches the longest the Tribe will play this season, along with another 10-gamer from July 6-15 (vs. OAK, CIN & NYY).

THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

» **1998:** Cleveland defeats the Anaheim Angels, 8-5, in the Tribe's home opener...with two on and two outs in the bottom of the 10th inning, Jim Thome hit a walk-off three-run homer to improve the Indians' record to 7-1.

TIGER BY THE TAIL

» The Indians and Tigers are in the middle of the first of six scheduled series between the clubs this season, including a 10-game slate at Progressive Field.

» During the 2017 campaign, the Indians posted a 13-6 record against Detroit, winning the season series for a second consecutive year (first time doing so since 2007-08).

» Since the start of 2016, the Tribe has gone 28-10 against the Tigers, including 11 straight victories from April 22 - July 5, 2016.

» **The Tribe enters tonight on an eight-game winning streak against Detroit, holding the Tigers to three-or-fewer runs in each of those contests with a 0.75 ERA (6ER/72.0IP) in that span.**

» Cleveland owns an overall franchise record of 1085-1118 (.493) against the Tigers in a 118-year-old rivalry (1901-)...the two clubs have combined for six of the last seven A.L. Central division titles.

CENTRAL FOCUS

» The Tribe is playing their second consecutive series against a divisional foe as they open their 76-game divisional slate.

» **Since July 1, 2017, the Indians have posted a 34-9 (.791) against A.L. Central teams, taking wins in each of their last 13 series vs. divisional opponents...per STATS LLC, this streak is tied with the 1993 Atlanta Braves and the 2004-05 Chicago White Sox for the longest of its kind in the divisional era (1969-)...thanks to Mike Pocha of STO for research assistance.**

» Dominant pitching has been critical to the Indians' divisional success, as the team has posted a 1.78 ERA (50ER/253.0IP) in its last 28 divisional games, allowing two-or-fewer earned runs in 22 of those contests.

» Cleveland's win last night moved them into a tie with Minnesota (4-4) for 1st place in the A.L. Central, marking the team's first day this season with possession of the division lead...the Indians spent 132 days in 1st place last season, including every day from June 26 onward.

LOOKING FOR A SPARK

» After recording 10-or-more hits in 59 games last season (51-8 in those contests), the Indians are now the only team in MLB yet to reach double-digits.

» The Indians rank last in MLB with a .158 team average (51-for-322) and 51 hits...they rank T8th in the American League with 10 home runs this season, while they lead the A.L. with 10 steals (T2nd in MLB).

» All three of the Indians' wins on this homestand have come with the team recording exactly four hits...in 2017, the Indians recorded just one victory with less than five hits, which came vs. Kansas City on September 17 (3H, won 3-2)...Cleveland is the first team in the *Baseball Reference* Play Index era (1908-) to record three wins over the first 10 games of the season in which they collected four-or-fewer hits.

EYES ON THE TRIBE

» In addition to the sellout crowd in the stands, the Indians' home opener against Kansas City on Friday, April 6 reached over 245,000 homes in Northeast Ohio on SportsTime Ohio in simulcast with WKYC, according to Nielsen. The game's 16.46 HH rating makes it the 2nd-highest rated Indians home opener ever on STO simulcast with WKYC, behind the Tribe's 2017 home opener (19.58 HH).

» Between Saturday's game (9.24 HH) and Sunday's walk-off winner (9.85) the three-game opening weekend series averaged a 11.85 HH rating on STO, just behind last year's opening series, which averaged 12.22 HH.

MISC. NOTES

» Four Tribe relievers (most in A.L., T2nd in MLB) have worked 3.0-or-more innings this season without surrendering a run: **CODY ALLEN** (5.0IP), **NICK GOODY** (4.2IP), **ANDREW MILLER** (4.1IP) and **MATT BELISLE** (3.0IP)...collectively on the season, 20 of the Indians' 25 relief appearances have been scoreless.

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** reached base safely three times last night and collected his 500th career hit, becoming the 7th current Indians player to reach the milestone.

» Tonight's starter **JOSH TOMLIN** has won each of his last two decisions against divisional opponents, including a win on September 3, 2017 at Detroit...for more on Tomlin, please see Page 2.

TONIGHT'S START

» The 33-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his second start of the 2018 season tonight in the second game of this four-game set vs. Detroit...marks the 137th start and 153rd appearance of his career.
 » Will be pitching on six days' rest after making his 2018 debut on April 3 at Los Angeles-AL...surrendered a career-high four home runs and matched another career-high with eight runs allowed over just 3.0 innings in a 13-2 loss to the Angels.
 » Tomlin will be making his 13th career start (17th appearance) against the Detroit Tigers...owns a career record of 7-6 vs. the Tigers with a 5.19 ERA (44ER/76.1IP), including a 1-0 mark with a 4.35 ERA (5ER/10.1IP) in two 2017 starts.

LAST TIME OUT

» Tomlin made his 2018 season debut on April 3 at Los Angeles-AL, allowing eight runs on eight hits over just 3.0 innings as the Tribe fell 13-2 to the Angels.
 » The eight runs allowed matched a career-high (done five other times), while the four home runs he allowed were the most in his career.
 » Tomlin will be pitching tonight on six days' rest...he experienced lower back soreness during his start at Los Angeles-AL and was given an extra few days to recuperate...his turn in the rotation was passed over to keep the other Tribe starters on regular rest.

VS. DETROIT | A.L. CENTRAL

» Tomlin will be making his 13th career start (17th appearance) against the Detroit Tigers this evening...owns a lifetime record of 7-6 with a 5.19 ERA (44ER/76.1IP) in his previous outings vs. Detroit
 » Made two starts against the Tigers in 2017, going 1-0 with a 4.35 ERA (5ER/10.1IP)...first faced Detroit in the first game of a doubleheader at Comerica Park on July 1, taking a no-decision after allowing four runs on eight hits over 4.2 innings of work (2BB, 3K)...earned the win on September 3 at Progressive Field after limiting the Tigers to one run on six hits over 5.2 strong innings (1BB/2K).
 » Tomlin made 14 starts against divisional foes in 2017, posting a record of 4-5 with a 4.13 ERA (35ER/76.1IP)...has gone 2-0 over his last four starts against the A.L. Central with a 1.74 ERA (4ER/20.2IP).

MAKING THEM EARN IT

» Tomlin walked just 14 of the 585 batters he has faced this season (2.4%), good for a rate of 0.89 walks-per-9.0IP, the lowest mark in Major League Baseball (min. 100.0IP)...since making his MLB debut in 2010, Tomlin has walked just 1.31 batters-per-9.0IP, the fewest among all active pitchers (min. 500.0IP) and 2nd overall (Cliff Lee - 1.24).
 » After allowing three walks in his start on June 25, 2017 vs. Minnesota, Tomlin saw his franchise record streak of 45 consecutive starts allowing two-or-fewer walks come to an end...the streak dated back to September 26, 2015, and was the longest active streak in Major League Baseball...Tomlin last allowed four walks on August 27, 2010, after which he began a still-active streak of 130 straight starts allowing three-or-fewer walks, ranking as the longest streak in club history as well as the 4th-longest stretch in *Baseball Reference's Play Index era (1908-)*.

CACTUS LEAGUE WRAP

» Tomlin went 2-1 with a 5.03 ERA (11ER/19.2IP) in five Cactus League starts this spring, striking out 18 batters against just three walks...his 18 strikeouts this spring ranked 5th on the Indians.

2017 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

» Endured several difficult stretches to post a solid campaign in the back-end of Cleveland's rotation, going 10-9 with a 4.98 ERA (78ER/141.1IP) in 26 starts.
 » Went 2-3 with an 8.87 ERA in five April starts, marking the highest April ERA in his big-league career.
 » Posted a 1-3 mark in the month of May with a 3.58 ERA...lone win came in the 5th complete game of his career, on May 28 vs. Kansas City...allowed one run on six hits with three strikeouts in the Tribe's 10-1 victory over the Royals.
 » After going 1-3 in June with a 6.75 ERA, Tomlin's record sat at 4-9 with a 6.17 ERA (59ER/86.0IP) on July 1...from July 6 to the end of the season however, Tomlin went 6-0 over his final ten starts with a 3.11 ERA (19ER/55.0IP) to secure his third consecutive winning season for the Tribe.
 » Pitched 4.0 hitless innings on July 30 at Chicago-AL before departing with a left hamstring strain...spent the next month (July 31-August 31) on the Disabled List.
 » During the Tribe's 22-game winning streak, Tomlin went 2-0 in three starts with a 2.76 ERA (5ER/16.1IP).
 » Induced 18 ground-ball double plays, T13th in the American League despite not qualifying...opposing baserunners only attempted two stolen bases against Tomlin all season, going 1-for-2.

POSTSEASON RECAP

» Tomlin made two relief appearances for the Indians in their 2017 ALDS loss to the New York Yankees.
 » Entered Game 2 at Progressive Field in the 12th inning and pitched 2.0 perfect innings with three strikeouts...picked up the win after **Yan Gomes** drove in the game's winning run with a walk-off single in the bottom of the 13th.
 » Also appeared in the Tribe's Game 4 loss at Yankee Stadium...closed out the game with a scoreless 8th inning, striking out one batter.
 » Overall in the 2017 Postseason, Tomlin retired all nine batters he faced, going 1-0 with four strikeouts.
 » Across four Postseason starts in 2016, Tomlin posted a 2-1 record with a 4.58 ERA (9ER/17.2IP)...he earned wins in the decisive ALDS Game 3 at Boston and in ALCS Game 2 vs. Toronto...he owns a career Postseason record of 3-1 with a 3.92 ERA (9ER/20.2IP).

CAREER SNAPSHOT

» Tomlin was originally selected by the Indians in the 19th round (581st overall) out of Texas Tech in the 2006 First-Year Player Draft...**he is the longest-tenured player in the Cleveland Indians organization.**
 » Earned the victory in his Major League debut opposite CC Sabathia on July 27, 2010 vs. New York-AL (7.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R-ER, 2 SO); faced the minimum through 7.0 innings before departing in the 8th...according to Elias, the performance by Tomlin (3 baserunners in 7.0 IP) was only the 2nd time in club history a Tribe hurler allowed 3 baserunners or fewer in a ML debut (Scott Lewis, 9/10/08 at Baltimore).
 » Pitched his first CG on September 24, 2010 vs. Kansas City.
 » Tomlin lasted at least 5.0 innings in his first 37 consecutive appearances dating up until his last start of the 2011 campaign; his 37 straight starts of at least 5.0 IP to begin a career matched former Indian John Farrell (87-88) for the most consecutive such starts since 1919 to start a career.
 » After returning from shoulder surgery in August 2015, posted a 7-2 record with a 3.02 ERA (22ER/65.2IP) in 10 starts.
 » Has been on the Disabled List six times in his career...had right shoulder surgery in March of 2015 and was placed on the 60-day disabled list (retro to March 29)...was activated from the 60-day Disabled List on July 31 and optioned to AAA Columbus...made his season debut on Aug. 15...previously underwent season-ending right elbow reconstruction on Aug. 22, 2012 in Anaheim, CA by Dr. Lewis Yokum and was held out of action until July, 2013.
