FISH BITES

Miami continues the first series of this six-game homestand with the final of this three-game set against the Toronto Blue Jays this afternoon at 1:10 p.m. RHP **Jeff Brigham** will be making his Major League debut for Miami after combining to make 17 starts between three levels of the Marlins organization. The Blue Jays are countering with RHP Sean Reid-Foley, who is making just his third career start. Miami returned home Wednesday after suffering a two-game sweep at the hands of the Boston Red Sox. Prior to that series, the Marlins split a six-game homestand against the Yankees (1-1) and Braves (2-2). **Programming note:** the Marlins will have four remaining games moved to 610AM WIOD; September 8 vs. Pittsburgh, Sept. 15 vs. Philadelphia, Sept. 22 vs. Cincinnati, and Sept. 29 vs. Mets.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

Miami snapped a four-game slide to the Blue Jays, and a four-game slide overall, with a 6-3 win. **Wei-Yin Chen** tossed another gem by a Marlins starting pitcher, limiting Toronto to one run on three hits, while striking out seven and walking none. Miami scored in the opening frame, as each of the first three batters reached base via hit or walk. **Brian Anderson** followed with a sac fly to right for his first RBI of the night. The Marlins pushed their lead to two in the third when **J.T. Realmuto** homered to straightaway center. After the Blue Jays cut the lead to one in the fourth, Anderson walked with the bases loaded to record his second RBI. **Martin Prado** followed with a bases-clearing double to make it 6-1. **JT Riddle** finished with two hits in his third career appearance in the leadoff spot, and Realmuto also added two hits.

UP NEXT

The Marlins will welcome the Philadelphia Phillies to Marlins Park for a three-game series beginning with tomorrow's 1:10 Labor Day affair. Miami trails the season series, 5-8, however they have a 4-2 advantage at Marlins Park. The Marlins are 111-103 overall in South Florida (33-29 at Marlins Park), yet trail the all-time series, 192-237.

BRIGHAM YOUNG UNIVERSITY

With his start today, **Jeff Brigham** will become the 10th freshman to make his Major League debut for the Marlins this season, the third starter. The 10 players making their debut ties the 1996 team for the sixth-most in a single season in Club history. The most players to make their debut in one season for the Marlins was 16 in 2010. The 10 debuts by Marlins this season are tied with Tampa Bay for the sixth-most among Major League clubs; San Diego has had 15, followed by the Angels (14), Baltimore (12), Atlanta (11), and Texas (11).

MULTIPLES OF 8

Wei-Yin Chen tossed 8.0 innings last night to mark his longest start since July 12, 2015 vs. Washington. His start followed an 8.0 inning start by **Dan Straily** on Friday night, marking his longest start since going 8.1 innings on July 7, 2017 at San Francisco. The back-to-back starts with 8.0 innings pitched by a Marlins starter is the first such occurrence since May 6 & 7, 2014. Henderson Alvarez tossed a shutout at Marlins Park against the Mets on May 6, and Tom Koehler tossed 8.0 shutout innings the following night, also against the Mets..

CATCH AND (HOME)RUN

J.T. Realmuto connected for his 18th home run of the season last night, which established a single-season career high. His previous best was 17 last season. The 18 home runs are the second-most in a single season by a Marlins catcher, tied with Charles Johnson, who connected for 18 in 2001. Johnson owns the most home runs in a single season with 19 in 1997. His 56 career home runs are second-most by a catcher in Club history, behind Johnson's 75.

PUTTING IT TOGETHER

Over their last 16 home games since July 28, the Marlins have posted a 2.64 ERA (150.0 ip/44 er) to mark the lowest ERA among National League staffs (third in MLB) at home in that span. They have limited opponents to a .214 average against, tops in the NL and third in the Majors. Starters have allowed three-or-fewer runs 14 times, including 11 starts of two-or-less runs allowed, and posted a 2.19 ERA (94.1/23), while the bullpen has allowed 21 earned runs over 55.2 innings pitched for a 3.40 ERA.

HOT CORNER TO THE SIX

The left side of Miami's infield has combined on a .981 fielding percentage (943 TC/18 E), the second-highest combined fielding percentage of any Major League third base/shortstop combo, behind only the Arizona Diamondbacks, who have fielded at a .981 clip (914 TC/17 E). Miami third basemen rank second in the Majors with a .979 fielding percentage (326/7), percentage points behind Arizona (.981; 332/7). Among shortstops, Miami's .982 mark ranks fourth in MLB, behind San Diego (.986; 564/8), Arizona (.983; 583/10), and the Angels (.983; 582/10).

ALL AROUND ANDY

Brian Anderson leads all Major League rookies in games (135), at-bats (516), runs (76), average with RISP (.383), and on-base percentage (.361); tied for the lead in hits (143); ranks second in doubles (30), walks (55), and multi-hit games (42); ranks third in RBI (58) and average (.277); is tied for third in triples (3); fourth in slugging (.405); and tied for 12th in HR (10). On the defensive side, he leads all rookie outfielders with a .994 fielding percentage, committing just one error in 176 total chances. He also owns eight outfield assists, most among all ML rookie outfielders and just four off the Major League lead held by Billy Hamilton. His five total errors this season are fifth-fewest by a NL rookie (min. 60 GS), and he is the only rookie on that list to spend significant time at two different positions (44 GS at 3B; 89 GS in RF).

- He is on pace for 169 hits this season, which would rank as the second-most by a National League rookie since 2008, behind Corey Seager's 193 in 2016, and would be 10th-most by an NL rookie since 2000.
- He recorded 109 hits before the All-Star break, tying Rocco Baldelli for the second-most by a Major League rookie since 2003, behind only Hideki Matsui (114 in 2003). He is the only Marlins rookie in franchise history to record 100+ hits prior to the break.
- Anderson recorded 101 hits over his first 92 games of the season. Since 1958, 34 rookies have recorded 100+ hits in 92-or-fewer games and went on to win Rookie of the Year honors, including most recently Aaron Judge (2017), Corey Seager (2016), Carlos Correa (2015), José Abreu (2014), Mike Trout (2012) and Buster Posey (2010). - *Stats LLC*

INTERLEAGUE NOTABLES

The Marlins' 193 Interleague wins all time rank as the second-most among National League clubs, behind only Washington (195), and they have the fifth-best winning percentage (.496; 193-196), behind St. Louis (.511; 180-172), the Mets (.507; 192-187), the Cubs (.506; 178-174), and the Dodgers (.497; 186-188). Miami's offense is the all-time leader among NL clubs in Interleague runs (1,796) and hits (3,538).

Jeff Brigham, who had his contract selected by Miami today, will make his Major League debut today in the series finale against Toronto. In 17 starts across three levels in the Marlins system, has gone 10-3 with a 2.36 ERA (95.1 ip/25 er).

Began 2018 at Double-A Jacksonville, where he posted a 4-1 record and 1.18 ERA (38.0/5) over seven starts. He walked nine and struck out 41. He missed the entire month of May with a right oblique strain and was activated from the seven-day disabled list on June 22 following a one-start rehab assignment with GCL Marlins.

Earned promotion to Triple-A New Orleans on July 13, and in nine starts at the Triple-A Level, went 5-2 with a 3.44 ERA (52.1/20).

Brigham's 2.36 ERA ranks as the second-lowest among Marlins Minor Leaguers this season, behind only Batavia's Manuel Rodriguez (2.13). His 10 wins rank second organizationally behind Nick Neidert (12).

Made three starts with Jacksonville before going on the seven-day disabled list with a right oblique strain on April 27. Over those three starts, allowed one run in 15.0 innings with three walks and 20 strikeouts.

In second start of season, tied career high with 10 strikeouts.

In his lone rehab start, June 18 at GCL Nationals, tossed 5.0 scoreless frames with just two hits allowed. Upon reinstatement from the DL, tossed 11.0 scoreless innings over next two starts. Including his rehab start, allowed just one run over first six starts of the season (31.0 ip) for a 0.29 ERA.

Took first loss of season on July 3 vs. Montgomery, snapping four-game winning streak. Allowed three runs on six hits and two walks, with for strikeouts, over 6.0 innings.

Promoted to Triple-A New Orleans on July 13 and made first career Triple-A appearance on July 14 vs. Colorado Springs, allowing two runs on six hits and two walks, with six strikeouts, over 5.0 innings.

Allowed exactly two runs in five of his first six starts with New Orleans, tossing 6.0-or-more innings four times. Other start in that span was a 6.2-inning scoreless outing against Reno on July 25.

Of his 17 starts, allowed two-or-less runs 14 times. Reached 6.0 innings pitched nine times and a career-high 7.0 innings twice; July 19 at Oklahoma City and August 22 vs. Memphis.

He will become the 34th player from the University of Washington to appear in a Major League game, the last being Austin Voth earlier this year for the Nationals.

José Ureña will make his team-leading 27th start of the season in the opener of this three-game series against the Philadelphia Phillies. This will mark his 16th start of the season at Marlins Park, where has gone 1-9 with a 4.45 ERA (83.0 ip/41 er).

Suffering from the lowest run support average of any starter in the National League (min. 20 GS) at 3.38 (1.95 at home). He has seven starts this season where he has left the game with more run support than runs allowed, and he has allowed three-or-fewer runs 14 times. His RSA of 3.38 is currently the fifth-lowest among Marlins starters with a min. of 25 starts all-time, higher than only Nathan Eovaldi (2.70 in 2014), Josh Johnson (2.92 in 2012), Anibal Sánchez (3.16 in 2011), and Charlie Hough (3.22 in 1993).

Over his career, has gone 1-4 with a 5.84 ERA (44.2 ip/29 er) in 12 appearances (eight starts) against the Phillies. Has made three starts against the Phils this season, with two at Marlins Park; has allowed seven runs (six earned) over 11.0 innings for a 4.91 ERA. Over career, has gone 0-2 with 3.96 ERA in six games (four starts) against the Phils at home.
