**ALL GOOD THINGS MUST COME TO AN END:** The Padres' three-game winning streak was snapped last night, falling 7-2 to Rob Butcher's Cincinnati Reds in the first of the three-game set...the Friars are now 0-11 in series openers at home this season and are 4-15 overall in the first game of a series.

- **Walker Lockett** made his Major League debut, working 3.2 innings of four-hit and four-run ball and becoming the seventh Padres pitcher to make their debut this season and the third to do so as a starter.
- **Hunter Renfro** is now riding a four-game hitting streak, batting .500 (6-for-12) with two doubles in that time...it's the longest active hitting streak on the club.
- **Freddy Galvis** belted his team-leading third triple of the season, and he has reached base via hit or walk in eight of his last nine games, posting a .343 OBP in that time.

**ROSTER MOVES:** Today, the Padres optioned RHP **Walker Lockett** to El Paso (AAA) and recalled LHP **José Castillo** from El Paso...LHP **Kyle McGrath** cleared waivers and was outrighted to El Paso...Castillo will wear number 65.

**DEBUT IN DIEGO:** **José Castillo's** debut will mark the ninth Padre to debut this season (seventh pitcher)...joins Adam Cimber, Kazuhisa Makita, Joey Lucchesi, Colten Brewer, Eric Lauer, Javy Guerra, Franmil Reyes and Walker Lockett.

**LET'S GIVE HIM A HAND:** Today, **Brad Hand** was awarded his second-career NL Reliever of the Month accolade (also: July 2017)...in May, he posted a 0.61 ERA (1 ER, 14.2 IP) with a 0.89 WHIP, 22 strikeouts and a .120 opponent average... he was 11-for-11 in save opportunities (tied with BOS's Craig Kimbrel for the most in the majors), and of the eight runners he inherited, none of them scored.

**HAPPY BIRTHDAY! ¡FELIZ CUMPLEAÑOS!** Join the Padres in wishing a happy birthday to **David Longley** (dah-VEED), the Padres Major League Translation & Baseball Operations Coordinator.

**THIEVERY!** When the Padres swipe two-or-more bases in a game, they have an 8-1 record...their 19 stolen bases in the month of May led all of the National League and ranked fourth in the majors, behind BOS, CWS and SEA (22 each).

**RANKING RELIEF:** Padres relievers have posted a 3.24 ERA this season (81 ER, 225.0 IP), good for the fourth-best mark among all NL bullpens...opposing bats have hit just .231 against them.

**EXTRA-BASE CONNOISSEUR:** SS **Freddy Galvis** has seven extra-base hits in his last nine games (five doubles, a triple and a homer), and he's slugging .581 in that time...his seven extra-base hits are the most of any NL shortstop in those nine games (since May 23) and tie with CWS Tim Anderson for most of any SS in that span.

**VS. THE REDLEGS:** The Padres' 20-13 record against Cincinnati since 2013 (a .606 winning percentage) is San Diego's best record versus any NL opponent in that time...the Padres hit .233 with 85 extra-base hits in those 33 games while the Reds batted .232 with 83 extra-base hits...the largest difference came in one-run games, which the Padres have gone 5-2 against the Reds since '13.

**PADRES ON DECK:** For Fort Wayne (A), Tijuana native **Tirso Ornelas** (the Padres' 13th-ranked prospect by MLB Pipeline) went 2-for-4 with a homer and three RBI...the 18-year-old outfielder is hitting .267...CF **Michael Gettys**, the No. 28 prospect, was 2-for-4 with a homer and two RBI for San Antonio (AA), and C **Austin Allen** went 2-for-4 with a homer to raise his average to .318 for San Antonio.

## STARTING PITCHER NOTES

**#46 LHP ERIC LAUER (1-3, 7.67)**

**LAUER HOUR:** 22-year-old **Eric Lauer** is set to make his eighth career start and first against the Cincinnati Reds in Game 2 of this three-game tilt.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Tied his career low for innings pitched (2.1) in his last outing, allowing five runs on a career-high-tying seven hits (4x).

**ERIC'S ARSENAL:** Lauer has relied on four pitches this season: four-seamer (62.1%), cutter (22.1%), curve (8.3%) and a changeup (7.4%).

**PICKOFF ARTISTS:** **Lauer** (four) and fellow rookie lefty **Joey Lucchesi** (three) have combined for seven pickoffs this season... it's the first time the Padres have had two rookie starters combine for six-or-more pickoffs in the same season since 2009, when **Clayton Richard** and **Josh Geer** combined for six pickoffs.

- Lauer's four pickoffs rank tied for second in the majors with SEA Marco Gonzales behind only ATL Julio Teheran's five.
- The Padres 10 pickoffs are tied with ATL for the ML lead...the Blue Jays and Nationals have seven apiece.

**LEARNING LESSON:** Allowed a career-high seven runs (six earned) on seven hits and a walk in the Padres' 9-5 defeat on 5/11 vs. STL.

- Became the first Padres starting pitcher since Ben Howard on Sept. 14, 2003 at LAD to allow three home runs in an inning, which occurred in the top of the third.

**HISTORIA:** Earned his first career win on 5/6 vs. LAD in Monterrey, Mexico, tossing 6.0-shutout innings behind a career-high 102 pitches and five strikeouts against one walk in the Padres' 3-0 victory.

- Became the first and only SD pitcher to get his first career MLB win in a game played outside the US and Canada...also just the second starting pitcher to get such a win and the fifth pitcher (starter or reliever) to do so.
- At 22 years and 337 days old on 5/6, he became the fifth-youngest pitcher in the NL to record a win this season.

**ROCKY DEBUT:** Lauer made his MLB debut on 4/24 at COL, working 3.0 IP and allowing seven runs (six earned) on a rain-delayed, 37-degree evening.

- Lauer was just the 27th pitcher to make their big league debut as a starter at Coors Field...20 Rockies have made their big league debut as a starter at Coors, making Lauer just the seventh opponent to do so.
- Only one other Padre has made their ML debut at Coors (Anthony Bass on June 13, 2011)...no other visiting team has made more than one big league starting debut at Coors.

**TYSON'S TURN:** RHP **Tyson Ross** is scheduled to make his 12th start of the season in Game 3 of the three-game tilt tomorrow afternoon.

- Owns a career 4-0 record and a 1.20 ERA (4 ER, 30.0 IP) in five appearances (four starts) vs. Cincinnati... Reds bats have hit just .167 against him with a .254 OBP and a .186 SLG.
- In his last time out on May 29 vs. MIA, he snapped his five-start streak of tossing 100-or-more pitches...he has now worked five-or-more innings in 10 of his 11 starts this season.

- Is just the fourth reliever in Padres history to tally 11 saves in a single month, joining Craig Kimbrel (July 2015), Trevor Hoffman (May 2007, September 2006, May 2005, July 2004, July 1998) and Mark Davis (September 1989, April 1989).
- According to Statcast data, 50.4% of his pitches this season have been sliders.
