SAN DIEGO NOTES

- **Tyson Ross** and ARI's Patrick Corbin are the first pair of pitchers each with two hits in the same game since May 26, 2016 when Patrick Corbin and Gerrit Cole had two apiece...the last time a Padres pitcher and the opposing pitcher each had two hits in a game was July 25, 2010 (Wade LeBlanc, SD and Brad Lincoln, PIT).
 - Having received four runs of support in his start tonight, it's the third time in his last five starts in which he's received four-or-more runs of support...his run support average entered the day as the fourth lowest among ML starters...he's received two runs or less in nine of his 20 outings this season and three runs or less in 14 of those outings.
- **Manuel Margot** extended his hitting streak to a career-long nine-consecutive games...is the second-longest streak of any Padre this season behind Christian Villanueva's 11-game streak (April 13-28).
 - Over that span, he is hitting .406 (13-for-32) with three doubles, a triple, a home run and nine runs scored.
- **Wil Myers** has gone .333 (10-for-30) vs. ARI this year and his 10 hits are his most vs. any single team this season.
 - Is hitting .400 (10-for-25) in his career against Patrick Corbin with four doubles, one homer and four walks.
- **Eric Hosmer** has hit in five straight games and has hit in six of his last seven games.

ARIZONA NOTES

- **Patrick Corbin** has not surrendered a home run in seven straight starts, the longest streak of his career and longest by a Diamondback starter since Trevor Cahill (seven; Sept. 5, 2013-April 2, 2014)...over his last seven starts, has pitched to a 1-1 record 2.76 ERA with 49 strikeouts.
 - Has allowed four runs or fewer in 12 of his 13 starts against the Padres.
- **Paul Goldschmidt** has reached base in 28 games on the road to tie his career-long streak (also: Sept. 10, 2013-May 7, 2014)...is the second-longest active on-base streak in the Majors.
 - Is batting .309 (30-for-97) with five home runs and 14 RBI in his last 25 games.
- **Jon Jay** matched his season-high three RBI tonight (also: June 12 vs. PIT)...has reached base safely in 12 of his last 15 games.
- **Eduardo Escobar** went 2-for-4 with two runs scored in his first game as a Diamondback.
- Tonight's game marked the first time the Diamondbacks had two switch hitters in the starting lineup (Ketel Marte and Eduardo Escobar) since Aug. 6, 2015 at WAS (Cliff Pennington and Jarrod Saltalamacchia).
