Culberson

Charlie Culberson became the first player in Atlanta-era history with two pinch-hit game-ending home runs in the same season yesterday. In fact, only one Braves player, Brian Hunter, had two such homers over his Atlanta career.

Four of Culberson's eight career home runs have been game-ending shots, including each of his last three.

He is the first player in MLB history to hit three game-ending home runs without any other type of homer inbetween.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Padres begin a three-game set tonight with the first meeting between the clubs this season...San Diego will visit SunTrust Park, June 14-17 for a four-game set to conclude the teams' season series.

A The Braves have lost 14 of their last 16 games at Petco Park, getting outscored 83-40 over this stretch that dates to August 29, 2012...They won consecutive games, June 8, 2016 and June 27, 2017 for their only victories in this span.

A The Braves have hit six total home runs over this 16 game stretch, including none in their last eight games here...The only Braves player to homer in San Diego since the start of the 2014 season was Cameron Maybin on August 17, 2015.

A RHP Julio Teheran has won four consecutive decisions against the Padres, and earned the victory on June 8, 2016 here to stop the Braves' 12-game losing streak at Petco Park...Teheran owns a 2.93 ERA (13 ER/40.0 IP) over the winning streak, which spans six games.

A LHP Clayton Richard is 0-6 with a 6.75 ERA (25 ER/33.1 IP) in nine games, six starts, against the Braves.

NEVER QUIT WITH SNIT: The Braves yesterday earned their ninth last at-bat win this season, which is tied for the most in the National League with Milwaukee's total...Since the team named Brian Snitker interim manager on May 16, 2016, the Braves have 46 last at-bat wins, the most in the major leagues.

A The Braves finished with a NL-high 20 victories in their final at-bat in 2017...The Braves also led the NL with 19 such victories in 2016.

A The Braves also have six walk-off wins this season after they walked off three times on their just completed eight-game homestand...The six such wins are the second most in the majors and one off the lead of the St. Louis Cardinals.

A The Braves scored three of their four runs after the sixth inning yesterday, giving them 109 such runs this season...That total is the third most in the majors...Over the last two seasons, the Braves have scored 384 in the seventh inning or later, or 37.5% of their total runs (1,025)...That percentage is the most in the major leagues.

A The Braves have hit four game-ending home runs already this season, the second most in the baseball and the most by a Braves team since the 2010 hit five.

ON THE ROAD: The Braves begin a six-game road trip tonight and enter tonight having played 31 road games, tied for the fifth most in the N.L. and one off the lead.

A The club's .613 winning percentage (19-12) is tied for the second-best road record in the league.

FREEMAN: 1B Freddie Freeman extended his hitting streak to 16 games yesterday with a third-inning double... Freeman's run is the longest by a National League player in 2018 and three shy of Michael Brantley's run (19 games from May 9-May 30) for the longest in the majors this season...Prior to Freeman, OF Nick Markakis held the longest Braves streak this season, a 12-game run from April 23-May 5.

A After going 1-for-3 yesterday, Freeman is hitting .375 (24-for-64) over the streak, which dates to May 19...He began the streak hitting .319 and is now up to .335.

A Freeman's streak is the longest active run in baseball... He is five games ahead three different players (Los Angeles' Andrelton Simmons, Colorado's Charlie Blackmon and Texas' Shin-Soo Choo).

A Freeman has also reached base safely in 24 consecutive games, the longest active streak in the National League...Only Detroit's Jeimer Candelario has a longer run (28).

A Freeman's on-base run dates to May 10 and a 5-for-5 effort at Miami...He owns a .472 on-base percentage over the 24 games.

A Freeman leads the National League with a .432 on-base percentage, while his .968 OPS is second only to Colorado's Nolan Arenado.

THE ROTATION: RHP Anibal Sánchez tossed 7.0 innings and allowed two hits and two unearned runs... Sanchez's performance marked the sixth straight game the Braves' starting pitcher allowed five hits or less

A Since compiling a 13.14 ERA (18 ER/12.1 IP) and a .459 opponents average against in suffering all three losses in a sweep by San Francisco from May 4-6, the Braves starting rotation has gone 10-6 with a 2.92 ERA (48 ER/148.0 IP) and a .220 average against.

A Since that San Francisco series ended, the Braves starting rotation ranks second in the league in innings (148.0 IP), tied for third in wins (10), fourth in ERA (2.92) and batting average against (.220) and fifth in strikeouts (134).

SCHEDULE: The Braves have played 43 games against a team with a winning record, the most in the majors among any team not in last place...Only Miami (46) and Texas (44) have played more such games...The Braves have gone 26-17 (.605) in these games, the best record in the National League.

A The Braves have played 16 games against teams with a losing record, the second fewest in baseball... Only Miami has played fewer (13)...The Braves' next 20 games are against teams that currently sit below .500...The Braves do not face a team with a winning record again until June 29, when they travel to St. Louis.

Tonight's Game

- A* Set to make his 13th start of the season and the 175th (178th appearance) of his career.
- A* Is 4-2 with a 3.76 ERA (22 ER/52.2 IP) in eight career starts against San Diego.... Padres batters have hit .236 (46-for-195) against him in his career.
- A* Riding a four-game winning streak against San Diego dating to 7/26/14, going 4-0 with a 2.93 ERA (13 ER/40.0 IP) over six total starts...Has logged "quality" outings in each of those six turns.
- A* His four-game winning streak against the Padres is his longest active run against any one team.
- A* Faced the Padres once last season, tossing 6.0 innings of two-run ball to earn the win on 4/14/17 in the first game at SunTrust Park.
- A* Has made 12 career starts in the state of California, going 3-6 with a 4.79 ERA (39 ER/73.1 IP)...Atlanta as a team is 5-7.
- A* Made three career starts at San Diego's Petco Park, going 1-1 with a 3.60 ERA...Tossed 8.0 innings and allowed five hits and two runs in his last start here, 6/8/16.
- A* Set for his seventh start on the road this season...Is 3-2 with a 3.18 ERA (12 ER/34.0 IP) in six starts to open the season away from home, compared to a 1-1 mark and a 4.91 ERA at SunTrust Park.
- A* Has 11 wins on the road since the start of 2017, tied for eighth most in the majors.

2018 Recap

- A* Lost his second consecutive start despite allowed five hits and two runs over 7.0 innings, 5/30 vs. NYM...Has gone 7.0 innings three times this season, and all three have come against the Mets.
- A* Snapped his scoreless streak against the Mets at 22.0 innings after allowing a run in the fourth inning...His streak was the longest in the majors against the Mets since Teheran also had a 29.0-inning run from June 21, 2015 to September 9, 2016.
- A* Turned in a "quality" start in his last turn, 5/25 at BOS, allowing four hits and three runs over 6.0 innings of work...Threw a season-most 109 pitches.
- A* Took the loss after Atlanta fell 6-2....The loss snapped a career high-tying four-game winning streak that dated to 4/16 vs. PHI...Went 4-0 with a 2.06 ERA (8 ER/35.0 IP) over the run, which spanned six total starts.
- A* Allowed a season-high six runs over 5.0 innings, 5/20 vs. MIA...Left the game trailing 6-0 before Atlanta rallied for a 10-9 win...The Braves are 8-3 in his 11 starts this season.
- A* All six runs scored in the fourth inning, the third time in his career he's allowed six or more runs in one inning...Also did so on 7/28/17 at PHI (5th) and 5/26/15 at LAD (4th).
- A* Won his third consecutive start, 5/14 at CHI, after holding the Cubs to four hits and four runs over 6.0 innings...All four runs scored on a pair of two-run homers.
- A* Allowed two runs in the bottom of the second to snap a 16.0-inning scoreless streak, the second-longest such stretch of his career...Tossed a career-most 23.0 consecutive scoreless innings in 2016.
- A* Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings, 5/9 at TB...Allowed four hits and fanned seven...Logged consecutive scoreless starts for the fifth time in his career and the first since his final start of 2016 (10/2 vs. DET) and his first turn in 2017 (4/3 at NYM).
- A* The outing vs. TB snapped a streak of 11 consecutive starts within the N.L. East, dating to 9/6/17...According to STATS, LLC, Teheran was the first Braves pitcher to make 11 consecutive starts against his own division since RH Phil Niekro also made 11 straight in 1979-80.
- A* Held the Mets to two hits and two walks over 7.0 scoreless innings, 5/3 at Citi Field...Fanned six.
- A* Took a no-hitter into the seventh inning before Asdrúbal Cabrera doubled with two outs...Was his longest no-hit bid since holding Pittsburgh without a hit for 7.2 innings on 6/5/13.
- A* Allowed two hits and three runs over 3.0 innings, 4/27 at PHI...Left the game after 3.0 innings with right upper trap tightness.
- A* Earned his first win of the season, 4/16 vs. PHI...Tossed 6.0 innings and allowed just five hits and one run, striking out a season-best nine.
- A* Snapped a six-start winless stretch with the victory, which dated to 9/17/17...Went 0-3 with a 5.18 ERA (19 ER/33.0 IP) during his winless spell.
- A* Made his fifth consecutive Opening Day start, which set the Atlanta era (since 1966) record for a pitcher...Only two other Atlanta pitchers (Greg Maddux from 1993-96 and Rick Mahler 1985-88) went four straight...Only Phil Niekro (8), Maddux (7) and Mahler (5) made at least five Opening Day starts in total for Atlanta.

- A* Signed a six-year contract through 2019, with an option for 2020, on February 14, 2014.... Is a two-time National League All-Star (2014, '16).

Jesse Biddle • LHP • 6-5 • 220 • 26 yrs • #63

Saves/Opp: 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 16/10 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 4/3

- Right-handed batters have just five hits in 46 at-bats (.109) against him...Lefties are hitting .407/.484/.704 with 11 hits, three walks, two doubles, two home runs and six RBI.
- Set career highs in innings (3.0) and strikeouts (8), 6/2 vs. WSH... Became the first Braves reliever in 110 seasons to strike out at least eight batters in that few innings...Milwaukee's Josh Hader struck out eight batters to earn a 2.2-inning save on 4/30 of this season at CIN.
- Five of his 16 appearances this season have been multi-inning efforts, most among Braves relievers.
- Opponents are hitting just .125 (4-for-32) with runners on base (.182 with RISP), compared to a .293 (12-for-41) average with the bases empty.
- Made his major league debut, 4/21 vs. NYM, and tossed 1.0 scoreless inning...Earned the win when Atlanta walked off in the bottom of the ninth...Became the first Atlanta reliever to earn the win in his debut since Jed Bradley on 9/3/16 at PHI.

Shane Carle • RHP • 6-4 • 210 • 26 yrs • #51

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 8 **1st Batter/Retired:** 25/16 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 12/3

- Tossed 1.0 clean inning with two strikeouts, 6/2 vs. WSH, to snap of streak of four consecutive appearances allowing a run... Allowed five earned runs in 4.0 innings pitched during the skid, after yielding just two earned runs in his first 26.0 frames
- Went 14 consecutive outings without allowing an earned run (15.1 innings), 4/16 to 5/19.
- Holding batters to a .157 (8-for-51) average with men on base and has allowed just three hits (3-for-31, .097) with runners in scoring position...Batters are hitting .277 (18-for-65) with no one on base.
- Holding right-handed batters to a .239 (16-for-67) average...Lefties are hitting .204 (10-for-49).

Sam Freeman • LHP • 5-11 • 180 • 30 yrs • #39

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 5 **1st Batter/Retired:** 29/20 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 23/5

- Blew his second save, 6/2 vs. NYM, after allowing a leadoff homer to lefty Juan Soto...Left-handed batters are hitting just 4-for-32 (.125) against him this season.
- Fanned the side in 1.0 perfect inning of relief, 5/28 vs. NYM [1]...Was just the second time in his career he struck out the side without allowing a baserunner in a 1.0-inning stint (also 6/29/15 at BAL).
- Ranks tied for eighth in the majors with 29 appearances this season...Made a career-most 58 appearances last year.
- Inherited the bases loaded, 5/30 vs. NYM, and allowed one run to score before stranding the remaining two runners...Has inherited 23 runners on the season, and has stranded 18 (78%)...Inherited just 19 runners last season.
- Took the loss, 4/23 at CIN...The loss snapped a streak of 190 consecutive games without a loss, the longest such active streak in the majors at the time...Freeman's run, which is the third-longest in MLB history, dated to 10/3/12...Only Trevor Miller (240 games, 2006-09) and Peter Moylan (present) had a longer streak in MLB history.

Luiz Gohara • LHP • 6-3 • 265 • 21 yrs • #53

Saves/Opp: 1/1 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 3/3 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 1/0

- Reinstated from the Restricted List yesterday, 6/3...Was originally placed on the Bereavement/Family Medical Emergency List on 5/25...Last appeared in a game on 5/23 at PHI in a 4.0-inning start.
- Has tossed 7.0 innings of one-run relief (1.29 ERA) over three relief appearances...Allowed just 4 total baserunners.
- Made his season debut and tossed 3.0 innings of one-run relief, 5/10 at MIA, to earn his first professional save.
- Recalled from Triple-A Gwinnett, 5/8, for his first appearance on the active roster this season...Opened the season on Atlanta's disabled list (left ankle sprain), before being returned from his rehab and optioned to Gwinnett on 4/27.
- Made four starts between Mississippi (AA) and Gwinnett (AAA), combining to go 0-3 with a 6.89 ERA (12 ER/15.2 IP) and 15 strikeouts.
- Made five starts with Atlanta last season, going 1-3 with a 4.91 ERA...Spent time at three different levels of the Braves farm system before making his major league debut last September.

A.J. Minter • LHP • 6-0 • 215 • 24 yrs • #33

Saves/Opp: 2/2 **Holds:** 7 **1st Batter/Retired:** 25/16 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 7/2

- Took his first loss of the season after allowing career highs in hits (4) and runs (3), 5/28 at NYM [2]...Has pitched to a 5.65 ERA (9 ER/14.1 IP) over his last 17 games after opening his season with eight scoreless app. (8.1 IP).
- Logged his second save of the season, 5/14 at CHI...Two saves lead all rookie relievers in the majors (tied)...Is a perfect 7-for-7 in hold chances and has converted his only two save opportunities.
- Has earned the win in three of his last eight appearances after picking up a victory, 5/20 vs. MIA...Three wins are tied for seventh in the majors among relievers.
- Inherited the bases loaded, 5/9 at TB, and allowed two runs to score...The runs were the first inherited runners he has allowed to score in his career...Has stranded five of seven runners this season and nine of 11 in his career.
- Earned the first save of his major league career with a scoreless ninth inning, 4/25 at CIN...Became the first left-handed pitcher to record a save for Atlanta since Jonny Venters logged five in 2011.
- Appeared on consecutive dates five times this season...His back-to-back outings on 4/3 and 4/4 vs. WSH marked the first time doing so in his career...Underwent "Tommy John" surgery in 2015.
