TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 2** (1-0) of a 4-game series vs **Lauren Douglas' Dodgers** and **Game 2** (1-0) of a 7-game West Coast road trip that includes an upcoming visit to SF's **AT&T Park**...the Reds on Wed completed a **3-6 homestand** vs the **Brewers** (0-3), **Marlins** (1-2) and **Mets** (2-1) and a **7-9 stretch** in which they played **13 of 16 games** at **Great American Ball Park** (2-2 vs Atl, 2-1 at Min, 0-3 vs Mil, 1-2 vs Mia, 2-1 vs NYM)...following this road trip return to **Great American Ball Park** for **7 games** vs the **Cubs** (4g) and **Pirates** (3g), including a day/night doubleheader on **Sat, 5/19**.

SERIES NOTES: Last night's **4-1 Reds win** snapped their **8-game losing streak** to the Dodgers and their **9-game losing streak** at **Dodger Stadium**...in the **previous 6 series** over the **last 3 seasons**, the Reds went **0-5-1 vs LAD** (1-3 at LA, 0-3 at Cin, 0-3 at LA, 2-2 at Cin, 0-3 at LA, 0-3 at Cin)...Cin has lost **17 of its last 20 games vs LAD**, including **8 of the last 9 games**, and **9 of their last 10 games** at **Dodger Stadium**...since a **3-game series sweep** in **June 2011**, the Reds have lost the **last 6 series** at **Dodger Stadium** (1-2 in 2012, 1-3 in 2013, 1-2 in 2014, 1-3 in 2015, 0-3 in 2016, 0-3 in 2017)...**Reds vs Dodgers** information is on media guide **Page 322**.

FRONT OFFICE NEWS: Reds President of Baseball Operations **Dick Williams** yesterday announced the promotion of **Nick Krall** to General Manager...**Krall** had been the club's Vice President, Assistant General Manager since November 2015...**Williams** will remain the club's President of Baseball Operations and will continue to oversee the organization's entire baseball operations department.

RISPY BUSINESS: With a minimum of 30 plate apps with runners in scoring position, **Joey Votto** ranks sixth in the **Major Leagues** and second in the **National League** in **hitting with RISP** at **.424** (14-33)...**Votto** leads all **NL** batters in **on-base percentage with RISP** (.556), third in the majors only to **LAA's Mike Trout** (.613) and **Bal's Manny Machado** (.556).

REHABBING: RHP **Michael Lorenzen** (right shoulder strain) and RHP **Anthony DeSclafani** (left oblique strain) are scheduled to be rehabilitation assignments **Monday** for Class AA **Pensacola**...**DeSclafani** will start for the **Blue Wahoos** (4ip, 60-65 pitches), while **Lorenzen** will throw 1.0 inning (20 pitches)...**Lorenzen yesterday afternoon** threw 1.0 inning (15 pitches) in an extended spring training game at the team's player development complex in **Goodyear**...**DeSclafani on Wed** in an extended spring training game in **Goodyear** threw **3.0 innings** (39 pitches) and finished with a **9-pitch bullpen**.

HOME COOKIN': In the 9-game homestand completed Wednesday, **Eugenio Suárez** became the first Reds batter to produce **15 RBI** in a homestand since **Jay Bruce** had **15 RBI** in 7 games from **8/8-8/14, 2011**...in his 9 apps vs the **Brewers, Marlins** and **Mets** at **Great American Ball Park**, **Suarez** hit **.313** (10-32, 3 2b, 3hr, .688slg, .395obp)...courtesy Elias.

25 IN 20: With a team-high **25 RBI** in his **first 20 apps**, **Eugenio Suárez** tied the franchise record for **most RBI** by a player in his **first 20 games** of a season...he played in his **20th game** on **Tue vs NYM** and produced **4 RBI** to give him **25** on the season...**George Crowe** (1958), **Vada Pinson** (1962) and **Ken Griffey Jr.** (2006) each produced **25 RBI** in his **first 20g**.

APRIL 19: The Reds are **8-12** since **4/19**, when they replaced manager **Bryan Price** and pitching coach **Mack Jenkins**...bench coach **Jim Riggleman** became interim manager, Class AAA Louisville manager **Pat Kelly** (#60) was promoted to serve as interim bench coach, and Class AA Pensacola pitching coach **Danny Darwin** (#52) joined the Reds' Major League staff as interim pitching coach...later in the year, the team will conduct a thorough managerial search for a permanent replacement...**Price** went **279-387 (.419)** in his 5 seasons as manager, including **3-15 this year**.

7-YEAR ITCH: The **10-4 Reds victory** on **4/23 vs Atl** was the first for **Jim Riggleman** as his team's full-time manager since a **1-0 Nationals win** vs the **Mariners** on **6/23/11**...since 1900, he is **1 of 14 managers** to work for at least **5 Major League teams** (SD, Chc, Sea, Wsh, Cin)...**Jimmy Dykes, John McNamara** and **Dick Williams** each managed **6 teams**...the others who managed **5 teams** are **Chuck Dressen, Bucky Harris, Rogers Hornsby, Davey Johnson, Billy Martin, Bill McKechnie, Jack McKeon, Lou Piniella, Jeff Torborg** and **Joe Torre**.

THE NEW GUYS: Interim manager **Jim Riggleman** managed in all or parts of **12 Major League seasons** with the **Padres, Cubs, Mariners** and **Nationals**, leading the **1998 Cubs** to the **NL Wild Card** game...the Reds' **4-1 win** on **5/4 vs Mia** was his **1,500th game** as a Major League manager...interim bench coach **Pat Kelly** was in his first season as manager at Class AAA Louisville after spending the previous 3 years at Class AA **Pensacola**...he also managed in the Reds' system at Class A **Bakersfield** in 2014 and from 2011-2013 at **Rookie Billings**...interim pitching coach **Danny Darwin** was in his third season as **Pensacola's** pitching coach.

YOUNGSTERS: The Reds' **33 Major League debuts** over the **last 3 seasons** are the most of any team in either league and include **4 this season** (**3B Alex Blandino** on 4/10 at Phi, **RHP Tanner Rainey** on 4/10 at Phi, **RHP Zack Weiss** on 4/12 vs StL, **IF/OF Rosell Herrera** on 4/26 vs Atl)...have **5 rookies** on the active roster (**Blandino, Herrera, OF Jesse Winker, RHP Tyler Mahle, RHP Jackson Stephens**)...the Reds' **Opening Day roster** included **5 rookies** (**Mahle, Stephens, Weiss, Ervin, Winker**), **21 players age 30 & under, 17 players age 27 & under** and **11 players age 25 & under**...according to **Elias Sports Bureau**, the average age for the Reds' 25-man **Opening Day roster** (**27 years, 196 days**) was the second-youngest in the Major Leagues behind the **Phillies** (**26.334**) and ahead of the **Marlins** (**27.351**).

Matt Harvey tonight will become the **21st pitcher** and **seventh starter** to appear for the Reds this season...began the season with the **Mets** and went **0-2, 7.00** in **4 starts** and **4 relief apps** before he was **designated for assignment** on **Saturday**...on **Tuesday** was acquired by the Reds in exchange for **C Devin Mesoraco** and **cash**...he reported to the team here yesterday...from **2012-2018** for the **Mets** went **34-37, 3.66** in **104 starts** and **5 relief apps**...will be making his **fifth career** appearance and start vs the **Dodgers** and his **third career** appearance at **Dodger Stadium**.

Tomorrow's Pitcher - #34 Homer Bailey, RHP

RED HOTS

Homer Bailey tomorrow night will make his team-high **ninth start of the season** and the **201st appearance** and **start of his career**...will be his **11th career appearance** and **start** vs the **Dodgers**, his first since **August 2016**, and his **sixth career start** at **Dodger Stadium**...his **3 quality starts** are **1 QS** shy of staff leader **Tyler Mahle**...Reds batters have scored **24 runs** in his **8 starts**, including **12 runs** while he is in the game...**Mon vs NYM** made the **200th appearance** and **start** of his career...in the 3-2 loss on **4/15 vs StL**, following a rain delay of 2 hours, 36 minutes, threw the **100th quality start** of his career (196th appearance)...in the 2-0 loss on **3/30 vs Wsh** made the first **Opening Day start** of his Major League career...has the **third-longest tenure** of any Major League pitcher with his current team (June 2007), trailing only Sea's **Felix Hernandez** (August 2005) and StL's **Adam Wainwright** (September 2005)...was on the Reds' **Opening Day roster** for the first time since **2014**...is approaching **1,200 innings** (1,167.1) and **1,000 strikeouts** (951).

- From 4/9-4/25 was disabled with a fractured right thumb...suffered the injury on 4/8 at Pit, when in the fourth inning he was hit by a Jameson Taillon pitch...missed 16 games (3-13).
- In the 14-3 loss on 4/6 vs Pit started at 3B but moved to SS in the eighth inning...was his only game at SS since 8/20/17, when he made his only appearance of last season at that position...in his career has made 181 apps and 167 starts at SS.
- On 3/16 signed a 7-year contract extension through the 2024 season with a club option for 2025...following last season was eligible for arbitration for the first time while under team control through 2020.
