BLUE JAYS NOTES:

- ✦ Fall to 9-5 in extra-inning contests...Matched a season high with 17 hits allowed (also 5/10 vs. SEA)...Were swept in a 3+ game series for the 4th time this year...Finished the season series at 2-4 vs. the Twins...Have lost 4 straight games against Minnesota for the first time since a 4G skid in 2005...Have dropped back below .500 at home (27-28).
- ✦ **SAM GAVIGLIO** gave up 3 runs on 6 hits over 5.0 innings...Allowed 3 walks while recording 4 strikeouts...Now holds a 2.82 home ERA (14 ER/44.2 IP) at home this season (7.92 ERA on the road).
- ✦ **LOURDES GURRIEL Jr.** extended his career-best hitting streak to 8 games with a 5th-inning double...**Added a single in the 9th to extend his multi-hit streak to 8 games, the longest all-time by a Blue Jays rookie (Al Woods-7G in 1977) - the longest multi-hit streak in the Majors this season and one shy of a franchise record (Fernandez-9G in 1986)**...Has gone 17-for-35 (.486) with 2 doubles and a home run over that stretch...Has hits in each of his last 14 starts, batting .407 (24-for-59) with 3-2B, 3-HR and 9-RBI over that span...Is now batting .297 for the year...Coming into today, led all rookies with a .295 AVG (min. 100 PA).
- ✦ **KENDRYS MORALES** opened the scoring with an RBI double in the 1st inning...Tied the game, 3-3, in the 5th inning with a sac fly...Added 2 more singles for a three-hit day, his 3rd 3-hit game this season (last: 7/4 vs. NYM)...Has reached base multiple times in 5 straight games, one shy of a career-long streak (6G in 2009, 6G in 2016)...Has gone 18-for-47 (.383) with 3-2B, 3-HR, 7-RBI and 10-BB over his last 15 games (.483 OBP, 1.121 OPS).
- ✦ **LUKE MAILE** went 3-for-5 for his 3rd career 3-hit effort (last: 5/11 vs. BOS)...Picked up 2 RBI, giving him 23 for the year...Notched his 8th double of the season to set a new career high (7 in 2016)...Also threw out the only stolen base attempt against him...Has now caught 12 of 35 (34.3%) attempts this season (65.7 SB%)...His 67.6 SB% coming into today was 4th best among all catchers (min. 40G).
- ✦ **RANDAL GRICHUK** doubled twice, singled and scored a run...Was his 4th 3-hit game this year (last: 6/1 vs. WAS)...Has 7 extra-base hits in his last 7 games (5-2B, 2-HR)...Coming into today's game, his 22 XBH since 6/3 were 9th most in the AL.
- ✦ **JUSTIN SMOAK** singled 3 times and drew a walk...Has gone 21-for-60 (.315) with 5-2B, 5-HR, 11-RBI and 8-BB over his last 15 games (.426 OBP).
- ✦ **JAIME GARCIA** retired all 6 batters he faced (2K)...Has retired all 15 faced over his last 2 appearances (5K).

TWINS NOTES:

- ✦ Are now 5-6 in extra-inning games...Recorded season-highs in runs and hits...Scored 6 runs in the 10th, their most in an extra frame since 8/24/14 at KC (6R 10th)...Completed their 3rd sweep of the season (last: 7/5-8 vs. BAL) and their first of Toronto since 4/11-13/03...Finished the season series, 4-2, vs. Toronto...Improved to 15-12 vs. AL East opponents this season...Evened their road-trip record at 3-3...Have gone 11-5 since 7/5...Have homered in 12 straight games vs. Toronto (21 HR).
- ✦ **ERVIN SANTANA** was activated off the 60-day DL prior to the game to make his season debut...Allowed 3 runs on 7 hits over 5.0 innings of work...Threw 97 pitches (60 strikes), his most in any outing in 2018 (7 rehab starts, high of 86 pitches)...Struck out 5 batters and issued 1 walk...Is now 6-7 with a 3.89 ERA (59 ER/136.1 IP) over 20 career starts against the Jays.
- ✦ **MITCH GARVER** got the Twins on the board with a 2nd-inning RBI single...He then gave them a 4-3 lead in the 6th inning with a solo home run, his 5th HR of his career...4 of his 5 HR have either tied the game or given the Twins the lead...**Drove in 3 more runs to set a new career high with 5-RBI...Finished the day 4-for-6 for his 1st career 4-hit game**...Has back-to-back 3+ hit efforts for the 1st time in his career...Over his last 27 games, has gone 26-for-74 (.351) with 4-2B, 1-3B, 3-HR and 12-RBI.
- ✦ **EDDIE ROSARIO** singled 3 times and walked as part of a 3-for-5 effort...Is now hitting .324 (24-for-74) in his last 16 games...Has hit .302 (26-for-86) with 13-R, 2-2B, 5-HR, 10-RBI in 23 career games vs. TOR...Now has 40 multi-

- ✦ **JAKE CAVE** had 2 doubles and recorded his 13th and 14th RBI...Has gone 19-for-55 (.345) this month, including 7-2B, 2-3B, 1-HR and 9-RBI...Now boasts a .292 AVG through his first 31 MLB games.
- ✦ **JOE MAUER** doubled twice and drove in a trio of runs in a 3-for-7 afternoon...Since 6/29 (22G), has gone 32-for-94 (.340) with 8-2B, 2-HR and 20-RBI, including 10 multi-hit games.
- ✦ **JORGE POLANCO** singled twice, walked and scored 3 times...Has reached base safely in 18 of his 19 starts...Is now hitting .295 (13-for-44) with 3-2B, a 3B and 4-RBI vs. AL East opponents this season.
- ✦ **MAX KEPLER** doubled, walked and brought in the go-ahead run in the 11th as he was hit by a pitch...Is hitting .279 (17-for-61) with 13 RBI over his last 17 games.
