WASHINGTON NATIONALS (11-15)

-In his tenth career start against the Diamondbacks, **RHP Stephen Strasburg** hurled 6.1 IP, allowing five earned runs on six hits with seven strikeouts and two walks.

-With a walk in the first and third inning, **RF Bryce Harper** has now reached base safely in his last 12 games...He has now walked 34 times in March/April 2018...The record for walks during this period is held by Barry Bonds, who walked 39 times in March/April 2004.

-In the bottom of the third, **2B Howie Kendrick** hit a two-run home run, his third home run of the season, to tie the game up at 2-2...Additionally, with a double in the first and a single in the fourth inning, they combined for a season-high three hits...He has had at least one hit in 21 of his 25 games to start the season.

ARIZONA DIAMONDBACKS (18-7)

-In his second start at Nationals Park, **RHP Zack Godley** threw 5.0 IP and surrendered four earned runs with four strikeouts and three walks...Godley allowed a season-high 10 hits in his shortest outing of the season.

-**CF A.J. Pollock** went 3-for-4 with a single, triple and home run...He had a season-high three hits tonight...Pollock opened scoring with a solo home run in the top of the second...He smacked a triple in the top of the sixth inning to drive in **1B Paul Goldschmidt**, tying the game 4-4.

-**3B Daniel Descalso** doubled in the top of the fourth inning to drive in **CF A.J. Pollock**...His sacrifice fly in the top of the sixth inning scored Pollock to give the Diamondbacks the 5-4 lead.

-The Diamondbacks are now 4-2 when opponents have 10 or more hits in a game.
