WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have lost seven of the last eight games, 11 of 13, 13 of 18 and 20 of 26 as they continue a five-game, six-day trip tonight at Pittsburgh.
- RHP Reynaldo López, who is winless despite owning a 2.44 ERA (12 ER/44.1 IP) this season, takes the mound for Chicago.
- The White Sox 10-27 (.250) record is the worst in baseball, behind Kansas City (13-28, .317) and Baltimore (13-28, .317) ... they were the last club to reach 10 wins this season.
- Following this brief two-game set at PNC Park, the Sox will return to Guaranteed Rate Field for an eight-game homestand vs. Texas (5/17-20) and the Orioles (5/21-24).
- The White Sox went 1-5 on their last homestand vs. Minnesota and Pittsburgh from 5/3-9 and 3-4 on their last trip at Kansas City and St. Louis from 4/26-5/2.

TODAY'S STORYLINES

- Chicago's 10-27 start matches its worst 37-game win-loss mark in franchise history (also 1948) ... the White Sox worst 38-game win-loss mark was 10-28 in 1948.
- The Sox are trying to win consecutive games for the first time since winning three straight from 4/26-28 at Kansas City.
- The White Sox have lost six of the last seven games, 10 of the last 14 and 12 of the last 17 on the road ... they have been outscored, 38-21, over the last seven road games.
- Reynaldo López owns a 2.45 ERA (5 ER/18.1 IP) and .232 opponents average (16-69) with 18 strikeouts over three road starts ... he has received a total of six runs of support (2.95 RSA).
- José Abreu has hit safely in seven of his last eight games, batting .375 (12-32) with three doubles, one homer and eight RBI.

ROSTER MOVES

- Prior to tonight's game at Pittsburgh, the White Sox reinstated 2B Yoán Moncada from the disabled list (left hamstring tightness) ... he takes the roster spot of INF José Rondón, who was optioned to Class AAA Charlotte following Sunday's win at the Cubs.
- Moncada, who has been on the DL since 5/5, is hitting .263 (30-114) with eight doubles, one triple, six homers, 15 RBI, 17 walks, four steals and a .359 on-base percentage over 29 games.

SUNDAY'S RECAP

- Bruce Rondón retired Ben Zobrist with the tying run on first base to end the game as the White Sox avoided a three-game sweep with a 5-3 win over the Cubs at Wrigley Field ... the Sox became the final MLB team to reach 10 wins in 2018.
- Trailing 3-2 entering the sixth, Nicky Delmonico tied the game with a RBI triple and Matt Davidson gave the Sox the lead with a sacrifice fly ... Leury García added a RBI single in the seventh.
- Lucas Giolitto earned the win after allowing three runs on two hits with a career-high seven walks and three wild pitches in 5.2 IP ... he also allowed the Cubs to steal five bases.
- Three Sox relievers combined to allow one hit with four strikeouts in 3.1 scoreless IP ... Jace Fry retired all four hitters faced.
- Davidson homered (No. 11) in his second consecutive game and recorded the Sox only multihit and multiRBI effort.

LOOK AT THOSE NUMBERS!

- Below is a breakdown of key rankings and statistics for tonight's White Sox starter Reynaldo López:
 - ♦ Ranks eighth in the American League in ERA (2.44) and opponents average (.196) ... his 3.25 run support average (16 RS/44.1 IP) is the fifth-lowest in the AL ... teammate Lucas Giolitto (3.46) is sixth.
 - ♦ Has allowed two runs or less in five of his seven starts, and one run three times ... limited the opponent to four hits or less five times.
 - ♦ Is 0-1 in three road starts (all quality) despite owning a 3.24 ERA (5 ER/18.1 IP) and allowing two earned runs or less three times.
 - ♦ Opponents own the following averages in 2018: .169 (15-89) vs. right-handers, .180 (9-50) with runners on base, .143 (4-28) with RISP and .154 (2-13) with RISP/two outs ... the RISP mark is the sixth-lowest in MLB, and the average vs. righties is 13th-lowest.

TROTting AND WALKING

- Matt Davidson hit his 11th home run of the season on Sunday at Wrigley Field, tied for the eighth-most in the American League and 10th-most in the major leagues.
- He is on pace to hit 48 home runs in 2018, which would be the second-most in club history behind Albert Belle (49 in 1998).
- Davidson has walked 22 times in 34 games this season, surpassing his total of 19 in 118 games in 2017 ... he ranks sixth in the AL in PA/BB ratio (6.41) and is tied for 10th in walks.

NATIONAL EXPOSURE

- ESPN has selected the White Sox at Cleveland game on 5/28 for a national broadcast ... the contest will be part of the network's Memorial Day schedule ... first pitch remains at 3:10 p.m. CT.
- The game will air on WGN-TV in the Chicagoland area and will be blacked out locally on ESPN.

WHITE SOX VS. PITTSBURGH

- Pittsburgh leads the season series, 2-0, after winning both games at Guaranteed Rate Field from 5/8-9.
- The Sox are hitting .296/.342/.549 with four homers, own an 8.00 ERA (16 ER/18.0 IP) and have been outscored, 16-11.
- The White Sox have lost six consecutive games to the Pirates after being swept in the four-game season series in 2015 ... they have been outscored, 36-15, during the losing streak ... prior to 2015, the Sox had won eight of nine from 2008-10.
- The White Sox and Pirates met in each of the first three years of interleague play (1997-99) and every season from 2006-10.
- Chicago is 17-15 all-time, going 9-7 at Guaranteed Rate Field and 8-8 on the road (6-5 at PNC Park).

WINDY CITY MEETS THE STEEL CITY

- White Sox manager Rick Renteria was drafted by Pittsburgh in the first round (20th overall) of the 1980 draft.
- Sox RHPs Joakim Soria (29 games) and Chris Volstad (one game) played for the Pirates in 2015.
- Pirates third-base coach Joey Cora was on the Sox coaching staff from 2004-11, and played for the club from 1991-94 ... pitching coach Ray Searage pitched for the Sox from 1986-87.
- Pittsburgh RHP George Kontos is a native of Lincolnwood, Ill., graduate of Niles West H.S. and pitched for Northwestern.

INTERLEAGUE INSIGHT

- The White Sox are 1-6 during interleague play, their worst start vs. the National League in a season in franchise history.
- Chicago has lost seven of the last eight games and 15 of 18 IL games on the road ... the club is looking to win consecutive road IL games for the first time since 8/12-13/16 at Miami.
- The Sox went 6-14 during IL play last season and have not recorded a winning record since 2014 (11-9).
- The Sox are 207-183 (.531) all-time during IL (since 1997).
- José Abreu owns a 14-game, IL hitting streak, batting .426/.448/.889 with five doubles, six home runs and 14 RBI.

HIP HIP ELOY!

- Class AA Birmingham OF Eloy Jiménez is hitting .367 (29-79) with nine doubles, five home runs, and 20 RBI over his last 18 games ... he has hit safely in 16 contests with 11 multihit efforts.
- His 15-game hitting streak from 4/26-5/11 is the longest in the Southern League this season ... he has hit safely in 19 of his 25 games with the Barons in 2018, including 11 multihit efforts.
- He ranks among SL leaders in RBI (T1st, 25), homers (T2nd, 7), SLG (2nd, .612), AB/HR (2nd, 14.71) and average (8th, .320).

STOP! THIEF!

- The White Sox lead the American League and are tied for second in baseball with 32 stolen bases ... the club ranks fourth in the major leagues with an 82.1 (32-39) success rate.
- Tim Anderson (2nd, 10), Leury García (T12th, 6) and Adam Engel (T14th, 5) rank among AL steals leaders this season.
- The Sox are on pace to steal 140 bases this season ... by comparison, they stole 71 bases in 2017 and 77 in 2016.

ONE AND DONE

- Chicago has gone 4-10 in one-run games in 2018, tied for the fifth-most one-run contests in the major leagues ... Tampa Bay (6-12) leads MLB with 18 such games this season.
- The Sox 10 one-run losses are the second-most in baseball.
- The Sox were 21-23 in one-run games in 2017.

NO RISP, NO REWARD

- The White Sox rank 14th in the American League and are tied for 28th in MLB with a .215 (62-288) average with RISP in 2018.
- Chicago is hitting .210 (17-81) with RISP in the last 12 games, compared to .299 (26-87) in the previous 11 ... the Sox have been limited to two hits or less w/RISP 30 times in 2018.

PUT AWAY THE SUITCASE

- The White Sox currently are in a stretch playing 17 of 19 games in Chicago, including 14 at Guaranteed Rate Field, from 5/3-24.
- In addition to their six-game homestand from 5/3-9 and three games at Wrigley Field from 5/11-13, the Sox will play four-game series vs. Texas (5/17-20) and Baltimore (5/21-24).
- The club's only road games are this week at the Pirates.
- Chicago has been outscored, 104-62, at home in 2018.

QUALITY AND QUANTITY

- The White Sox have made a major-league leading 1,328 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, three more than the second-place New York Mets (1,325) and 42 more than Oakland (1,286), the next-closest American League team.
- The Sox are 5-8 when receiving a QS this season ... their 13 quality starts are tied for the 11th-most in the AL.

LÓPEZ AT A GLANCE

- The 24-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his eighth start of the season, fourth on the road, and second consecutive against the Pittsburgh Pirates.
- Ranks eighth in the American League with a 2.44 ERA ... is the only qualifying pitcher in baseball with a sub-3.00 ERA and zero wins
- Is making his third career start during interleague career play ... has gone 0-1 with a 5.40 ERA (6 ER/10.0 IP).
- Went 3-0 with a 4.62 ERA (13 ER/25.1 IP) over his final four starts of 2017 ... made his White Sox debut on 8/11/17 vs. Kansas City, receiving a no decision after allowing two runs with six strikeouts over 6.0 IP.
- Was named the White Sox Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July 2017 after posting a 2.10 ERA (7 ER/30.0 IP) with 38 strikeouts and a .183 (20-109) opponents average over five starts.
- Was acquired from Washington with RHPs Dane Dunning and Lucas Giolito in exchange for OF Adam Eaton on 12/7/16 ... originally was signed by the Nationals as a non-drafted free agent on 6/21/12.

LAST START

- Received his fifth no decision of the season on 5/9 vs. Pittsburgh after allowing two runs on three hits over a career-high 7.1 IP.
- Held the Pirates scoreless over the first four innings ... gave up two home runs for the first time since 8/11/17 vs. Kansas City ... surrendered solo home runs to Gregory Polanco and Jordy Mercer in the sixth inning.
- Departed with the White Sox leading, 4-2 after tossing a 100 pitches (63 strikes) ... the Pirates scored four times in the ninth as they defeated the Sox 6-5.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

- Is making his 11th career start on the road ... has gone 4-4 with a 4.60 ERA (31 ER/60.2 IP), 55 strikeouts and a .263 (62-236) opponents average in ten starts.
- Has gone 0-1 with a 2.45 ERA (5 ER/18.1 IP) in three road starts this season.

HELP WANTED

- Owns a 3.25 run support average (16 RS/44.1 IP) this season, the fifth-lowest in the American League.
- Has received two runs of support or less in four of his seven starts, including zero runs twice.
- Received a 7.55 RSA (40 RS/47.2 IP) in eight starts last season.

MAKING HISTORY

- Is the first White Sox pitcher with 6.0-plus IP, two-or-fewer hits allowed, and one-or-fewer runs allowed in each of his first two starts of the season (source: Elias).
- Became the first White Sox starting pitcher since at least 1908 to lose a game in which he thre 7.0-plus IP while allowing two or less hits and one run which was unearned (source: Baseball Reference and STATS LLC) ... the last five pitchers to accomplish this feat:

2017 REVIEW

- Made eight starts with the White Sox in his first season with the organization ... went 1-2 with a 3.56 ERA (12 ER/3.0 IP) in five starts at home and 2-1 with a 6.75 mark (13 ER/17.1 IP) over three road starts.
- Five of his seven starts were quality ... went 2-2 with a 3.15 ERA (11 ER/30.1 IP) and 16 strikeouts in those outings.
- Worked a career-high tying 7.0 IP (four runs) in a win on 9/16 at Detroit ... allowed three runs in the second inning before limiting the Tigers to one run on five hits over his final 5.0 IP.
- Suffered his first loss with the White Sox on 8/17 at Texas, allowing six runs on five hits over 4.1 IP before exiting game with soreness on his right side.
- Was placed on the disabled list on 8/19 (retro to 8/18) with a back strain ... reinstated on 9/1, made the start that night vs. Tampa Bay (L; 3 ER/6.0 IP).
- Made 22 starts with Class AAA Charlotte, going 6-7 with a 3.79 ERA (51 ER/121.0 IP) and 131 strikeouts ... allowed two earned runs or less in seven of his final eight starts from 6/29-8/6 before being promoted.
- Entered the season ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 3 Prospect in the White Sox organization and No. 31 in baseball ... was rated by MLB.com as the No. 4 Prospect in the Sox system, No. 38 in baseball and the No. 9 right-handed pitching prospect.

PERSONAL NOTES

- His grandfather sold two cows in the Dominican Republic to buy him a used glove, a pair of cleats and an aluminum bat when he started playing baseball.

VS. PITTSBURGH PIRATES

- Is making his third career appearance (second start) against Pittsburgh ... received a no decision in his only start on 5/9 at Guaranteed Rate Field ... tossed a career-high 7.1 IP, allowing two runs on three hits with two walks and six strikeouts.

VS. NATIONAL LEAGUE

- Has gone 5-2 with a 4.07 ERA (22 ER/ 48.2 IP) in 11 career appearances (six starts) against the National League.
- Went 5-2 with a 4.35 ERA (20 ER/41.1 IP), 40 strikeouts and a .253 (40-158) opponents average in ten appearances (five starts) with Washington in 2016.
- Had his only hit on 9/4/16 at the New York Mets

TOMORROW'S SCHEDULED STARTER

- RHP Carson Fulmer (2-3, 6.23) is scheduled to make his ninth appearance (eighth start) of the season and first start against the Pittsburgh Pirates.
- Suffered the loss in his last start on 5/11 at the Chicago Cubs, allowing a seasons-high tying five runs on three hits with four walks and three strikeouts over 1.2 IP.
- Is making his eight career start on the road ... has gone 2-2 with a 5.45 ERA (21 ER/34.2 IP), 27 strikeouts and a .241 (32-133) opponents average in seven starts.
- Is 1-1 with a 11.25 ERA (10 ER/8.0 IP) ... has allowed ten runs on eight hits with eight walks and 12 strikeouts over three appearances (two starts) during Interleague play.
