MONDAYS...: In Game 1 of the brief two-game stint vs. the San Francisco Giants, the Padres fell 5-3 in extra-innings and are now 2-7 in extra-inning contests this season...SD is 1-17 in series openers at home, and they are in danger of sustaining their second-consecutive sweep...the Friars and Marlins are the only teams to have not swept another club this year...yesterday, starter **Eric Lauer** worked 5.0 innings and allowed three runs (earned) on seven hits...**Hunter Renfro**e homered for the eighth time this season.

MOVES: Today, the Padres placed LHP **Eric Lauer** on the 10-day disabled list with a left forearm strain and recalled RHP **Walker Lockett** from El Paso (AAA).

SNAP THAT STREAK: The Padres have now lost six consecutive games since July 24, tied for the longest losing streak the club has sustained this season...the other losing stretch occurred a few games prior (July 11-20)...the last time the Friars lost seven-straight games was when they dropped 10 straight from June 29-July 8, 2013...the longest losing streak in club history was 13 games from May 8-21, 1994.

STAYING GROUNDED: **Clayton Richard's** 58.2 ground ball percentage leads all qualifying pitchers...his 2.88 ground ball to fly ball ratio also leads the majors and his 230 grounders induced leads the NL and ranks second in the majors behind only HOU Dallas Keuchel's 240.

QUITE THE INHERITANCE: This season vs. the Giants, the Padres have inherited 18 runners, allowing just three of them to score for a 16.7 inherited runner scoring percentage...SD's percentage vs. SF is the lowest of any club against the Giants this season (among teams that have played more than four games vs. SF this year).

SINCE THE BREAK: The Padres bullpen has fostered a 2.68 ERA (13 er, 43.2 ip) since the All-Star break, which is the third-best ERA in baseball in that time (behind just PHI's 2.64 and OAK's 2.48).

SAYING GOODBYE TO JULY: The Friars are looking forward to August, having accrued a 5-19 record in the month of July (.208 winning percentage)...prior to today's game, their .208 percentage is the seventh-worst percentage in a month (with at least 15 games played) in Padre history...a loss tonight would put them at a .200 winning percentage, making it the second-worst month in SD history (behind just August of 1969, when they had a 5-22 record and a .185 winning percentage).

TURN THE TABLES: The Padres have a 5.59 ERA in the month of July, which is the highest mark the Friars have accrued in a calendar month since they posted a 6.40 ERA in May of 2003...their .224 average in July is the lowest in a month since their .219 clip in May of last season.

PADRES ON DECK: For El Paso (AAA), RHP **Colin Rea**, 28, had his best outing since undergoing Tommy John surgery in 2016, allowing two hits and two walks with 10 strikeouts in 5.0 shutout innings...LHP **Logan Allen** allowed two runs on five hits and a walk with four strikeouts over 6.0 innings for San Antonio (AA), and LHP **Ben Sheckler**, 23, allowed one run on three hits and a walk with three strikeouts in 5.0 innings for Fort Wayne (A).

DATE IN PADRES HISTORY: On July 31, 2005, Padres broadcaster **Jerry Coleman** was formally inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown, N.Y., as the winner of the Ford C. Frick Award.

STARTING PITCHER NOTES

#3 LHP CLAYTON RICHARD (7-10, 5.05) @crthrees

READY FOR RICHARD: 34-year-old LHP Clayton Richard is set to make his club-leading 23rd start of the season today in his third tilt of the season against the Giants...today will mark just his second start at home in his last 10 outings since 6/10...made a career-high six consecutive starts on the road from 6/10-7/8.

- Today marks his 21st career start versus San Francisco, trailing only the 24 he's made against the Dodgers.
- Is 2-4 with a 3.40 ERA in his nine career starts vs. SF at Petco compared to his 5-4 record and 5.49 ERA at AT&T Park.

LAST TIME OUT: Richard was perfect through his first four frames on 7/25 at NYM, but eventually allowed six runs over 5.0 IP in the Padres' 6-4 defeat.

ALL GOOD STREAKS MUST COME TO AN END: Has been saddled with the loss in four of his last six outings after earning the win in a career-high-tying four consecutive starts from 6/4-22 (also: 6/22/11-4/8/12).

- Had his streak of tossing 6.0 innings-or-more in 11 consecutive starts snapped on 7/8 at ARI, which was the longest streak of any left-handed pitcher since the 2016 season when seven lefties (**Jon Lester, Chris Sale, Jose Quintana, Danny Duffy, Madison Bumgarner** and **Clayton Kershaw**) had 11-or-more consecutive start streaks...Bumgarner and Kershaw did so twice in '16.
- Over his final 13 starts to close out the first half from 5/8 to 7/13, Richard posted a 6-4 record with a 3.65 ERA (35 ER, 86.1 IP), 1.14 WHIP and limiting opposition to a .227 average.

KEEP IT LOW: Richard's 58.2 ground ball percentage leads all qualifying pitchers...his 2.88 ground ball to fly ball ratio also leads the majors and his 230 grounders induced leads the NL and ranks second in the majors behind only HOU **Dallas Keuchel's** 240.

- Induced four ground ball double plays on 7/3 at OAK, the only pitcher to induce four GIDP in a single outing this season... his 19 GIDP ranks tied for first in the NL and tied for second in the majors behind only SEA **Mike Leake's** 19.

EFFICIENTLY EFFECTIVE: Richard has had four starts this season in which he pitched at least 7.0 innings and thrown fewer than 100 pitches...that ties STL **Miles Mikolas**, LAD **Kenta Maeda**, ARI **Patrick Corbin** and NYM **Jacob deGrom** for the third-most such starts in the NL, behind only PIT **Joe Musgrove's** five and COL **Jon Gray's** six.

- Richard was one of just 11 pitchers to make at least 20 starts and work 124.0 innings-or-more in the first half...his 124.0 IP ranked 11th in the majors and third among all NL arms.

IN GOOD COMPANY: His 58 wins as a Padre are now the second-most wins by a Padre lefty, ahead of **Bruce Hurt's** 55 and trailing only **Randy Jones' 92**.

FLIRTING WITH HISTORY: Richard took a no-hitter into the seventh inning on 6/10 at MIA, earning the win after working 7.0 innings and allowing two hits and a run (earned) with five strikeouts.

- He retired 15 straight batters in the contest, tying the longest streak in a game in his career (retired 15 straight on June 27, 2012 @ HOU).

PICKOFF ARTIST: Has one pickoff this season, which contributes to the Padres' MLB-leading 17 pickoffs...his eight pickoffs led all of MLB last season.

MR 1000.0: With 1023.2 IP as a Padre, Richard joins **Randy Jones** (1766.0) as the only two lefties in the 1000.0 IP club.

BACK ME UP: Received one run of support or fewer in six of his first 12 outings, including 26 total runs of support (runs scored while he's in the game) with a 3.16 run support average

- Has received at least three runs of support in seven of his last 10 outings, including 41 total runs of support with a 6.36 run support average.
- Received a season-high 11 runs of support on 6/4 vs. ATL... it was the most runs he's gotten in support since the 12 he received on 9/8/16 vs. COL.

THURSDAY'S STARTER

READY FOR ROBBIE: LHP **Robbie Erlin** is set to make his third start of the season and 28th of his career to open the four-game set vs. CHC on Thursday.

- It will be his 30th appearance of the season...is 1-3 with a 3.47 ERA (23 ER, 59.2 IP).
- Is 1-1 with a 2.05 ERA out of the bullpen compared to a 0-2 record with a 14.14 ERA as a starter.
- In his career as a starter, is 8-14 with a 4.95 ERA (81 ER, 147.1 IP)...has been saddled with the loss in each of his last five starts dating back to 10/3/2015.

- Made his MLB debut in a spot start on June 1 vs. CIN, tossing 3.2 innings and recording his first career losing decision...has pitched 2.0 innings-or-more in each of his two major league appearances.
- Back on June 1 vs. CIN, he became the fifth pitcher to debut with the Padres as a starter since the 2017 season...coincidentally, all five have a last name starting with 'L' (joined Dinelson Lamet, Kyle Lloyd, Joey Lucchesi and Eric Lauer).

last outing: 7/29 vs. ARI (1.2 ip, h, bb, 3 so) **vs. LHB:** .185 (22-119) • **vs. RHB:** .319 (46-144)
season-high ip: 7.1 (5/15 vs. COL) **current scoreless streak:** 3.2 IP (2 g)

- Reinstated from the 10-Day DL Sunday after nursing right elbow inflammation...made two starts with El Paso (AAA) during his rehab stint.
- Started in eight games for SD, posting a 2-4 record and a 4.79 ERA as a starter...has pitched to a 3.66 ERA in 13 games as a reliever.
- Threw the second-longest perfect game bid in Padres history on May 15 vs. COL, behind only Chris Young's 7.2 perfect innings on Sept. 7, 2008 at MIL.
- Began the season holding opponents scoreless in nine of his first 11 games, posting a 2.20 ERA while limiting hitters to a .158 clip.
