WAY BACK IN THE WINDY CITY: The Padres split the four-game series vs. the Chicago Cubs at Wrigley, posting a 2-5 record vs. CHC this season...on Sunday, **Joey Lucchesi** went 5.2 innings of seven-hit ball, allowing three runs (two earned) with nine strikeouts and without issuing a walk...**Hunter Renfro**, **Freddy Galvis** and **Franmil Reyes** each homered in the contest...**Travis Jankowski** collected his career-high 14th RBI of the season, and he extend his hitting streak to five games, the longest active spree on the team.

WE LIKE TO MOVE IT MOVE IT: Today, the Padres selected RHP **Brett Kennedy** to the Major League roster...he will make his ML debut in his start tomorrow vs. right-handed veteran (and former Padre) **Jhoulys Chacín**...Kennedy, who just celebrated his 24th birthday on August 4, will wear number 60.

RISP IT FOR THE BISCUIT: In their past four games @ CHC, the Padres hit .300 with RISP (9-for-30) with four doubles, a triple, one homer and 17 RBI...in those four games, Padres hurlers held the Cubs to just a .208 clip in such scenarios (5-for-24) with just one extra-base hit (a double).

TURNING THE TIDE: **Clayton Richard's** 6.10 ERA on the road this season (49 er, 72.1 ip) is the second-highest ERA among NL starters (has a 3.76 ERA at home in 2018)...Richard is in search for his first winning decision since June 22 @ SF...since then, the Padres have gone 1-6, and he's averaged 82.1 pitches per game, the second-lowest average of any pitcher (with at least seven starts in that time) behind WSH's Jeremy Hellickson (77.7 pitches per game).

ROLLIN' ROLLIN' ROLLIN': Starter **Clayton Richard** leads the majors in ground ball percentage (57.6) and tops the NL and ranks second in the ML behind HOU's Dallas Keuchel for total ground balls induced (238)...Padres hurlers have a 46.0 overall grounder percentage, tying for the third-highest mark this season of any team with CHC, behind just COL's 46.3 and ARI's 47.9 percent.

TRAVIS JANKOWSTREAK: **Travis Jankowski** is riding a five-game hitting streak, batting .467 (7-for-15) with a double...he's now hit safely in three-straight games with an at-bat vs. a left-hander, the longest streak vs. southpaws in his career...his two RBI in his last game on Sunday @ CHC put him at 14 RBI, setting a new career high in a season (previously was 12 in '15 and '16).

NEW MONTH, SAME CHRISTIAN: In his four games in August, **Christian Villanueva** has a .462 average (6-for-13), which is the third-highest clip among NL players in the month behind WSH's Bryce Harper (.471) and ARI's David Peralta (.500)...in those four games @ CHC, he accrued three multi-hit efforts with a double and a homer.

DESIGNATED FOR AFL: Today, the Arizona Fall League Director Steve Cobb announced organization and staff (manager, pitching coach, hitting coach, athletic trainer) assignments for the 2018 season that begins Tuesday, October 9...the Padres (who will play on the Peoria Javelinas), will also be represented by Lake Elsinore's (A) pitching coach **Pete Zamora** (who will also serve as the Javelinas pitching coach).

PADRES ON DECK: In his El Paso (AAA) debut last night, RHP **Cal Quantrill**, the Padres' first pick (eighth overall) in the 2016 draft, gave up two runs on seven hits and no walks with four strikeouts... 2B **Luis Urias**, the Padres' No. 4 prospect, was 2-for-3 with a double, a homer and a walk...tonight, Tri-City's (A) SS **Owen Miller** and 2B **Olivier Basabe** are scheduled to form the starting double play combination for the Northwest League in the Short-Season Single-A All-Star Game against the Pioneer League in Grand Junction, CO...also on the Northwest League team will be Fort Wayne (A) pitchers **Henry Henry**, **Jordan Guerrero** and **Dan Dallas**.

STARTING PITCHER NOTES

#3 LHP CLAYTON RICHARD (7-10, 4.99) @crthrees

READY FOR RICHARD: 34-year-old LHP Clayton Richard is set to make his club-leading 24th start of the season tonight in his second tilt of the season against the Brewers...tonight will mark his ninth road start in his last 11 outings since 6/10...made a career-high six consecutive starts on the road from 6/10-7/8.

- Took the ball for the Padres on Opening Day on 3/29 versus the Brew Crew, tossing 7.0 IP of one-run ball on six hits, a walk and four strikeouts in the Padres' 2-1 defeat.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the Padres' 3-2 defeat on 7/31 vs. SF, tossing 5.0 IP of two-run ball...the Padres have lost six of his last seven starts since 6/27 after winning seven of his eight starts from 5/13-6/22.

ALL GOOD STREAKS MUST COME TO AN END: Has been saddled with the loss in four of his last seven outings since 6/27 after earning the win in a career-high-tying four consecutive starts from 6/4-22 (also: 6/22/11-4/8/12).

- Tossed 6.0 innings-or-more in 11 consecutive starts from 5/8-7/3, the longest streak of any left-handed pitcher since the 2016 season when seven lefties (Jon Lester, Chris Sale, Jose Quintana, Danny Duffy, Madison Bumgarner and Clayton Kershaw) had 11-or-more such consecutive starts ...Bumgarner and Kershaw did so twice in '16.
- Over his final 13 starts to close out the first half from 5/8 to 7/13, Richard posted a 6-4 record with a 3.65 ERA (35 ER, 86.1 IP), 1.14 WHIP and limiting opposition to a .227 average.

KEEP IT LOW: Richard's 57.6 ground ball percentage leads all qualifying pitchers...his 2.87 ground ball to fly ball ratio also leads the majors and his 238 grounders induced leads the NL and ranks second in the majors behind only HOU Dallas Keuchel's 253.

- Induced four ground ball double plays on 7/3 at OAK, one of only two pitchers to induce four GIDP in a single outing this season (also, SEA James Paxton, 8/4 vs. TOR)...his 19 GIDP rank second in the NL and tied for third in the majors with SEA Marco Gonzales, behind only SEA Mike Leake's 21 and PHI Jake Arrieta's 20.

EFFICIENTLY EFFECTIVE: Richard has had four starts this season in which he pitched at least 7.0 innings and thrown fewer than 100 pitches, one of only 10 NL pitchers this season to make at least four such starts.

- Richard was one of just 11 pitchers to make at least 20 starts and work 124.0 innings-or-more in the first half...his 124.0 IP ranked 11th in the majors and third among all NL arms.

IN GOOD COMPANY: Although he hasn't tasted a victory since 6/22, his 58 wins as a Padre are the second-most wins by a Padre lefty, ahead of Bruce Hurt's 55 and trailing only Randy Jones' 92.

MR 1000.0: With 1028.2 IP as a Padre, Richard joins Randy Jones (1766.0) as the only two lefties in the 1000.0 IP club.

FLIRTING WITH HISTORY: Richard took a no-hitter into the seventh inning on 6/10 at MIA, earning the win after working 7.0 innings and allowing two hits and a run (earned) with five strikeouts.

- He retired 15 straight batters in the contest, tying the longest streak in a game in his career (retired 15 straight on June 27, 2012 @ HOU).

PICKOFF ARTIST: Has one pickoff this season, which contributes to the Padres' MLB-leading 17 pickoffs...his eight pickoffs led all of MLB last season.

BACK ME UP: Received one run of support or fewer in six of his first 12 outings, including 26 total runs of support (runs scored while he's in the game) with a 3.16 run support average

- Has received at least three runs of support in seven of his last 11 outings, including 42 total runs of support with a 6.00 run support average.
- Received a season-high 11 runs of support on 6/4 vs. ATL... it was the most runs he's gotten in support since the 12 he received on 9/8/16 vs. COL.

TOMORROW'S STARTER

GREAT DAY FOR A DEBUT: RHP Brett Kennedy is set to make his ML Debut tomorrow in Game 2 of this three-game set at Miller Park

- Is 10-0 with a 2.72 ERA across his 16 starts with triple-A El Paso this season.
- Over parts of five minor league seasons, he is 31-20 with a 3.36 ERA across 82 minor league appearances (79 starts).
