BASEBALL AT A DISCOUNTED PRICE PER INNING The Padres fell to the San Francisco Giants 5-4 last night in extra innings, pushing their record this season vs. SF to 7-11...the Padres have won 3 of their 14 extra-inning games this season, and tonight's rubber match will decide the penultimate series for both clubs (the Padres are 7-12 in rubber games in 2018)...**Robbie Erlin** made his career-high 12th start of the season, working 5.0 innings of 4-hit ball, allowing just 2 runs (1 earned) on 4 strikeouts and no walks...**Freddy Galvis** doubled twice and went 4-for-5 in the contest, and **Franmil Reyes** went 3-for-5 with 1 2b.

GOODBYE YELLOW BRICK ROAD Tonight's contest marks the Padres final road game of the 2018 campaign...in '18, the Padres have hit .239 on the road and slugged 80 home runs, in contrast to their .231 clip and 77 homers @ home...SD hit .240 on the road with RISP and .227 w/RISP at home...opposing batters had a collective .252 clip against Padres, while pitching on the road, and .263 vs. SD while pitching at home.

PERD PERD PERD. PERD IS THE WORD Across 9 appearances (7 starts) vs. San Francisco, **Luis Perdomo** is 2-0 with a 3.80 ERA (19 er, 45.0 ip)...@ AT&T Park, he has posted a 1-0 record with a 3.10 ERA (10 er, 29.0 ip) in his 7 games (4 starts)...among all ML parks in which he has made more than 1 start, his 3.10 ERA is the lowest... this season, Luis has relied on primarily four pitches: sinker (45%), slider (26.1%), four-seamer (17.3%) and split finger (11.5%).

SINCE THE BREAK: SD's bullpen has a 3.48 ERA since the All-Star break (91 er, 235.2 ip), a mark that headlines the NL and ranks 4th in baseball (behind OAK's 3.06, HOU's 3.40 and CLE's 3.43)...their 1.16 WHIP in the 2nd half of the season also ranks 4th in the majors, and they have the 4th lowest run support average of any club in that time of 3.40...the Giants bullpen since the break have the worst RSA of any team (3.08).

CHICKEN BACON FRAN **Franmil Reyes** had his contract purchased by SD on May 14 vs. COL, and through his first 2 stints in the majors, he hit .221 (23-for-104) through 38 games with 3 2b, 6 hr, 8 rbi, 7 bb, a .270 OBP and a .423 SLG...after being recalled for the second time, he has hit .333 (47-for-141) in 45 games with 5 2b, 10 hr, 22 rbi, 14 bb, a .394 OBP and a .582 SLG...he recently snapped a career-high 12-game hitting streak, in which he hit .405 from Sept. 7-21, the longest hitting spree this season by a Padre.

IN HALF A FORTNIGHT After going 4-for-5 last night @ SF with 2 doubles, **Freddy Galvis** has logged a pair of 4-hit games in a week's time (both vs. SF), hitting .500 (14-for-28) in his last 7 games with 4 2b and 2 hr...Galvis has also hit in 9 of his last 10 games, going 18-for-39 (.462) with 6 2b, 2 hr and 6 rbi.

DON WELKE ON DECK CLASSIC Tomorrow, the Padres will host the Texas Rangers for the annual prospect game...renamed yesterday as the "Don Welke On Deck Classic," (in honor of the late VP of Scouting Operations who passed away last week at the age of 75), the top prospects from the Padres organization will take on those from the Rangers org...on Friday, a group of Padres prospects will participate in various community events throughout the city...the 70+ Padres prospects will be divided between volunteer opportunities with Hancock Elementary School, Harborside Elementary School, the Monarch School, Rady Children's Hospital and Feeding San Diego.

AT&T SUBSCRIBERS The Padres have logged 80 hits @ AT&T Park this season, which is the most they've had this year at any stadium besides Petco Park, and it ranks as the 2nd-most of any visiting club behind COL's 82...their 6 homers tie with CIN, MIL and PIT for the most of any team @ SF...since the inception of the 2017 season, the Padres have hit 19 homers and logged 183 hits, the most HR and hits @ AT&T of any visiting team.

#61 RHP Luis Perdomo (1-6, 7.56)

LONGING FOR LUIS: 25-year-old **Luis Perdomo** is set to make his 10th start and 12th appearance of the season in the club's final road game of 2018 tonight @ SF.

COMFY IN THE BAY: Tonight will mark his first appearance of the season against SF, but the 10th of his career...his 10 appearances against the Giants will tie with the Dodgers for the second most he's made against any opponent and his eight starts will match the nine he's made against the Diamondbacks for the most starts against any opponent.

- Across his nine appearances (seven starts) vs. SF, he is 2-0 with a 3.80 ERA (19 ER, 45.0 IP).
- Here at AT&T Park, he has posted a 1-0 record with a 3.10 ERA (10 ER, 29.0 IP) in his seven games (four starts)...among all ML parks that he has made more than one start at, his 3.10 mark is the lowest.

THE ROAD AIN'T ALWAYS ROUGH: This season, Perdomo has posted a 2.57 ERA on the road compared to a 12.63 ERA at home.

- His career 6.23 ERA since 2016 at home is the highest among all ML pitchers, with the next closest being Jordan Zimmerman's 5.99 mark.

HOW IT'S GONE DOWN: Made four starts with the big league club from 3/31-4/18, going 1-2 with a 8.36 ERA (13 ER, 14.0 IP) before being optioned to El Paso (AAA).

- Made 11 starts for the Chihuahuas from 4/23-6/27, going 6-2 with a 3.10 ERA (24 ER, 69.2 IP)...allowed two runs or less in seven of his 11 outings, including a complete game on three hits and one run on 5/4 at Albuquerque.
- Recalled from El Paso on 7/4 and made five starts from 7/4-22, going 0-4 with a 7.71 ERA (6 ER, 2.1 IP).
- Placed on the 10-day DL with right shoulder inflammation on 7/28.
- Reinstated from the 10-day DL on 9/3...made 2 scoreless relief appearances (9/8 @ CIN and 9/22 @ LAD).

SNAP THE STREAK: Dating back to his stretch of losing four consecutive starts from 7/9-22, tonight would mark his fifth straight loss as a starter, the most by a Padre since Andrew Cashner in 2015 from April 24-May 16.

- Is the third Padre this season to be tagged with a loss in four straight (also: Robbie Erlin and Clayton Richard).
- Mat Latos (2010), Andy Benes (1993) and Dennis Rasmussen hold the franchise record with losses in nine consecutive starts.

STATCASTED: Perdomo relies on primarily four pitches: sinker (45%), slider (26.1%), four-seamer (17.3%) and split finger (11.5%)...opposing bats are just .167 against his split-finger this season and .259 vs. his fastball.

GETTING AHEAD: Perdomo's first pitch strike percentage of 62.6 is the highest in his career.

THE GROUNDER GAMES: Last season, he led all NL pitchers with a 62.0 ground ball percentage, behind only TOR **Marcus Stroman's** 62.9 mark for the Major League lead...this season, he has just 42.7 grounder percentage, the lowest in any season in his career.

- He has a 42.8 ground ball percentage this season.

LET'S TURN TWO: Forced opponents to ground into 32 double plays last season, which ranked tied for first in the National League and tied for second in MLB with teammate Clayton Richard.

- Has forced opponents to ground into five double plays this season.

PITCHERS WHO RAKE: Collected a hit off Clayton Kershaw on 7/9 vs. LAD, becoming the 1st SD pitcher to do so since Tyson Ross on Aug. 21, 2014 in LA.

- Last season, Luis became the first pitcher to hit four triples in a season since PHI's Robin Roberts in 1955... only three pitchers had one triple in 2017, resulting in Perdomo having more triples in his 46 at-bats than all other MLB pitchers in their 4,534 at-bats.
- Is hitting .286 (2-for-7) at the dish this season.

LIMITING THE LONG BALL: Since allowing 1.41 HR/9.0 IP in 2016, his ratios have gone down in 2017 (0.93) and 2018 (0.86).

VERSUS THE CHAMPS: Earned his first and only win of the season in his first career start against the Astros on 4/6, holding the defending World Series champs to one run in his 5.0 innings of work in SD's 4-1 victory.

- Perdomo and the rest of the Padres pitching staff didn't surrender an extra-base hit to the Astros in the first two games of their series...it was the first time HOU was held without an extra-base hit in back-to-back contests since September 17-18, 2014 vs. CLE.

FRIDAY'S STARTER — #46 LHP Eric Lauer (6-7, 4.60) — @e_lauer10

LONGING FOR SOME LAUER: LHP **Eric Lauer** is set to make his 23rd start of the season and second against the Diamondbacks ...it will be his first career start vs. the Diamondbacks at Petco Park...tossed 5.0 IP of one-run ball on 7/5 at ARI in SD's 6-3 victory.

- Is one of just 20 rookies in Padres franchise history to make 20 starts in a single season...along with fellow lefty Joey Lucchesi, it marks just the fifth time the Padres have had two rookies make at least 20 starts in the same season.
- In his last 15 starts since 6/2, Lauer has posted a 3.42 ERA (29 ER, 76.1 IP)...allowed three earned runs or less in 13 of his 15 outings.
