TODAY'S GAME: The Dodgers and Giants play the final regular season game of the 2018 season...the Giants enter today having lost eight of their last nine while the Dodgers have won 12 of their last 16.

ON THE MOUND: LHP Andrew Suárez, who leads all rookie pitchers in innings pitched this year (158.0), will face the Dodgers for the second time in his career...he last faced them Aug. 14 at LA and threw 6.0-shutout innings while allowing two hits in a 2-1 Giants win...Suárez is 1-3 with a 4.38 ERA (12er, 24.2ip) in his past four starts.

HUNTER PENCE: Is slated to play his 772nd game for the Giants today...the three-time All-Star owns a batting line of .268/.325/.433 in his Giants career...Pence played all 162 games for the Giants in 2013 and 2014 and has two World Series rings with San Francisco (2012, 2014)...while **Madison Bumgarner** stole the spotlight in the 2014 postseason, Pence's performance should not be forgotten as he hit .333 with a .405 on-base percentage that October...he was on base in all 17 games and recorded at least one hit in 15 of them...in the 2014 World Series, he went 12-for-27 (.444) (Baseball Info Solutions).

PENCE AT THE PLATE: Pence is 12-for-35 (.343) with seven runs scored, three doubles, two homers and five RBI in his past nine games.

INSIDE THE SERIES: The Giants need just one more win against the Dodgers to win the season series over LA for the third time in the last four years and for the sixth time in the last nine seasons.

THANK YOU FANS: The Giants have topped three million in attendance for the ninth-straight season and for the 17th time in 19 years at AT&T Park.

DRIVING IN RUNS: No Giant has driven in 10 runs this month (**IF Evan Longoria** leads the club with nine RBI)...since RBI became an official stat in 1920, there has never been a September when no Giant reached double figures in RBI...the departed Andrew McCutchen still leads the club with 55 RBI this season, which is the lowest for a Giants team leader in a full season as long as RBI have been an official statistic...**IF Brandon Crawford** and **IF Evan Longoria** each have 54 RBI (Stats, LLC).

BRUCE BOCHY: Will complete his 24th season as a manager in MLB and his 12th with San Francisco...Bochy's 1,926 managerial victories are the 11th-most all-time.

BETTER D: The Giants' 23 defensive runs saved this year are the ninth-most in NL...last season, SF had -44 defensive runs saved, 25th in MLB (per Fangraphs).

ROUGH MONTH: The Giants are just 5-20 (.200) this month, posting the lowest winning percentage in the month of September of any MLB team...their five wins this month are their fewest in any full calendar month (non-strike year) in SF-era history (since 1958)...SF had six wins in April 1972 and April 1980.

HOW LOW CAN YOU GO: Beginning June 1, the Giants have posted a 3.51 ERA, which ranks as the third-best figure in the Majors behind Los Angeles-NL (3.32) and Houston (3.36).

SEE YOU NEXT YEAR: The Giants open the 2019 season at San Diego on March 28...their first Cactus League game is slated for Feb. 23 against the Angels in Tempe, AZ.

The Giants won the Western division title by one game over the Dodgers, beating the Pirates, 5-1...**Juan Marichal** allowed five hits in the win.

6-0, 187, 26 years old (September 11, 1992)
7-12 Record, 4.22 ERA

- The 26-year-old is slated to make his 29th career Major League start...has gone 7-12 with a 4.22 ERA (74er, 158.0ip) in 28 outings, with the Giants going 12-16 in those games.
- Among NL rookie leaders he ranks first in innings pitched (158.0), fifth in strikeouts (130) and sixth in ERA (4.22).
- Suffered the loss in the Giants' 9-2 defeat at St. Louis last Sunday...allowed two runs on six hits over 5.0 innings.
- Has struck out 130 batters while issuing just 43 walks in his first 28 career Major League starts.
- Has posted a 3.18 ERA (28er, 79.1ip) in 13 starts overall at home...over his last three outings at AT&T Park he's 2-1 with a 1.35 ERA (3er, 20.0ip) and a .167 opponents average.
- Has received three or fewer runs of support in 21 of his 28 starts.
- Is holding opponents to a .188 average (9-for-48) with RISP and two outs.
- Lefties are hitting .209 (32-for-153) off him with seven extra-base hits (four doubles, two triples, one home run).
- Has faced the Dodgers once in his career and threw 6.0-scoreless innings, allowing two hits and three walks with four strikeouts...did not receive a decision in the Giants' 2-1 victory on Aug. 14 at LAD.
- With one out in an inning opponents are hitting .307 off him with an OBP of .347 and a SLG pct. of .535...however, with two outs in an inning opponents are hitting .213/.276/.388 (*Baseball Info Solutions*).
- Was selected in the second round of the 2015 MLB Draft by San Francisco (No. 61 overall).
