#### YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians extended their season-long winning streak to four games as they beat the Tigers 5-1 at Progressive Field...the Tribe maintained its share of the A.L. Central lead with Minnesota and improved to 5-1 on this opening 10-game homestand.

» Cleveland received a dominant start from **CARLOS CARRASCO**, who allowed just one run on three hits in his first complete game of the season...Carrasco struck out six batters and faced just four batters over the minimum.

» The Indians bats erupted in a four-run 4th inning as they sent all nine men to the plate, collecting six hits and matching a season-high for runs in an inning...**MICHAEL BRANTLEY** and **FRANCISCO LINDOR** each recorded multi-hit games, while **YONDER ALONSO** drove in a pair to raise his team-high RBI count to seven.

#### I CAN GO THE DISTANCE

» Just 12 games into the 2018 season, Cleveland is responsible for two of the five complete games thrown by MLB pitchers, as well as two of the three in the American League.

» **CARLOS CARRASCO**'s complete-game effort last night joined an Opening Day performance by **COREY KLUBER**, who tied for the American League lead with five complete games in 2017...they are the first pair of Indians pitchers to record complete games within the Tribe's first 12 games since **David Huff** and **Mitch Talbot**, who did so in Games 9 & 10, respectively, of the 2010 season.

» Since the start of the 2016 season, Indians pitchers have recorded 14 complete games, tied with Boston for the most in Major League Baseball over that span...in that timeframe, Kluber leads the team with nine CGs, followed by Carrasco with three, while **Josh Tomlin** and **Trevor Bauer** have one apiece.

#### OFFENSE ROUNDING INTO FORM

» After recording four hits in each of its last three games, the Tribe offense broke out for a season-high 10 hits in their 5-1 win over Detroit last night.

» Eight different Indians players recorded a hit, with **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** and **FRANCISCO LINDOR** collecting two each...Brantley extended his on-base streak vs. Detroit to 18 games, matching a career-best, while **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** increased his own on-base streak against the Tigers to a career-high 17 games...**Ramírez is batting .479 (34-71) against the Tigers since the start of 2017 with 10 homers and 26 RBI.**

» Four of the Tribe's five runs last night were scored off left-handed pitching, as have 18 of their 36 runs this season...**their 18 runs scored vs. LHP this season ranks 2nd in the A.L. and 5th in MLB.**

#### MOUND MASTERS

» Cleveland pitching has held opposing batters to just six runs total over the first six games of this homestand...**six runs allowed matches the Tribe's best six-game span from 2017, when they also gave up six runs total from September 7-12 (games 15-20 of their historic 22-game winning streak).**

» The Indians pitching staff ranks 2nd in the American League (4th in MLB) with a 2.82 ERA this season...their 2.79 starter ERA is 2nd in the A.L. and MLB, while their 2.90 relief ERA is 4th in the A.L.

» The Indians have allowed two runs or fewer in eight of their 12 games this season, the most of any team in MLB this season...Cleveland has recorded 75 such games since the start of 2017, also the most in the Majors over that span.

#### HOME COOKING

» The Indians have opened their 2018 home slate with a 5-1 record on this 10-game homestand...last season, the Indians posted a 49-32 (.605) record at Progressive Field, the 2nd-best home record in the American League and 4th-best in the Majors.

» **Since the 2017 All-Star Break, Cleveland has gone an MLB-best 33-9 (.786) at home, including wins in 22 of their past 25 regular-season games here.**

» In addition, Cleveland currently leads MLB with a .169 opponent batting average at home, while they also rank 1st with a 1.00 home ERA...**Tribe starters have posted a 1.04 ERA (5ER/43.1IP) on this homestand.**

» This current 10-game homestand (vs. KC, DET & TOR) matches the longest the Tribe will play this season, along with another 10-gamer from July 6-15 (vs. OAK, CIN & NYY).

#### THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

» **1916:** After being traded from the Boston Red Sox, star outfielder Tris Speaker makes his debut in a Cleveland Indians uniform vs. St. Louis...Speaker went on to play 11 seasons for Cleveland, batting .354 with 1,965 hits and 486 doubles...he remains the Tribe's all-time leader in doubles and on-base percentage (.444), while he ranks second in hits, batting average, runs (1,079) and triples (108)...he was elected to the Hall of Fame in 1937.

**TONIGHT'S START**

» The 27-year-old right-hander is due to make his third start of the season in tonight's series finale against the Detroit Tigers...will mark his 126th career start and 135th appearance, as well as his second home start of the season.  
 » Will pitch on regular four days' rest after starting earlier this homestand on April 7 against Kansas City...took the loss (8.0IP, 3H, 1R/ER, 1HR, 2BB, 7K).  
 » Has faced the Tigers 12 times in his career, making 11 starts...owns a career 4-5 record and 7.82 ERA (51ER/58.2IP), and went 0-2 with a 13.00 ERA in two starts against Detroit last season.  
 » Was solid in the Indians rotation last year, posting his lowest full-season ERA (4.19) while also recording career highs in wins (17), strikeouts (196) and innings pitched (176.1).

**LAST TIME OUT | HOMESTAND RESULT**

» Bauer took his first loss of the season in his first home start of the year against the Kansas City Royals on April 7...held the Royals to one run on three hits (one home run), walking two and striking out seven batters in the Tribe's 1-0 loss.  
 » Reached 100 pitches and struck out seven batters for the second consecutive start... in 2017, reached the 100-pitch mark in 23 of his 31 starts (74.2 percent), and has thrown 100-or-more pitches in 75 of his 125 career starts (60 percent).

**NIGHTTIME, DAYTIME**

» Tonight will mark Bauer's first nighttime start of the season...both of his prior starts were in afternoon games.  
 » The majority of his starts last season were at night...went 11-7 with a 4.50 ERA (62ER/124.0IP) in 22 games (21 starts) at night and 6-2 with a 3.44 ERA (20ER/52.1IP) in 10 starts during the day.  
 » In his career, generally has done better in day games, with a career 16-13 record and 3.62 ERA (104ER/258.1IP) in day games (48G/42GS), in comparison to a 31-29 record and 4.69 ERA (252ER/483.1IP) in 86 appearances (83 starts) at night.

**FIGHTING TO THE END | SERIES FINALE RECORD**

» Made 10 starts in series finales last season, compiling a 6-2 record and corresponding 4.01 ERA (23ER/51.2IP)...this included a 4-0 record and 3.03 ERA (11ER/32.2IP) at Progressive Field.  
 » Four of those starts - April 20 at Minnesota, June 18 at Minnesota, July 27 vs. Los Angeles-AL and September 10 vs. Baltimore - led to the completion of a Tribe sweep.

**VS. DETROIT | DIVISION RECORD**

» Today marks Bauer's 12th career start against the Tigers (13th appearance)...has compiled a career 4-5 record and 7.82 ERA (51ER/58.2IP), all with Cleveland...made two starts against Detroit last season, going 0-2 with a 13.00 ERA (13ER/9.0IP) in those outings.  
 » Last faced the Tigers on May 1, 2017...took the loss after allowing seven earned runs in 4.0 innings (7H, 5BB, 1HR).  
 » Eight of his 11 prior starts against Detroit have come at Progressive Field...is 2-4 with a 8.48 ERA (38ER/40.1IP) across those starts.  
 » Bauer made 12 appearances and 11 starts against the A.L. Central division in 2017, finishing the year with a 6-4 record and 4.55 ERA (31ER/61.1IP) against the division...his 9.0 innings pitched against Detroit were his fewest against any divisional opponent.  
 » Owns a 16-17 career record in 53 games (49 starts) against the A.L. Central...also has posted a 4.72 ERA (152ER/290IP) across those outings.

**PROGRESSIVE SUCCESS | HOME RECORD**

» In 2017, Bauer's 10-4 record and 3.93 ERA (45ER/103.0IP) at Progressive Field were markedly better than his numbers away from Cleveland (7-5, 4.54 ERA)...**his 10 wins at home were tied with Corey Kluber for the team lead, and T2nd in MLB.**  
 » Last year, also won a career-best five consecutive home decisions from July 21 to September 10, posting a 5-0 record and 3.13 ERA (11ER/31.2IP) with 34 strikeouts during the streak.  
 » From July 21 to the end of the season, went 6-1 with a 3.06 ERA (17ER/50.0IP) in his final eight home starts.  
 » Overall in his career is 27-21 with a 4.38 ERA (205ER/421.1IP) in 72 outings (68 starts) at home, across his time with both Cleveland and Arizona...that includes a 26-20 career record and 4.35 ERA (199ER/412.0IP) at Progressive Field.  
 » **Since the start of the 2015 season, Bauer's 21 home wins rank 6th in the American League and 9th in MLB, among starting pitchers in that timeframe...his 304 home strikeouts rank 5th in the A.L. and 11th in MLB.**

**A TREMENDOUS TRIO**

» Last season, Bauer, **COREY KLUBER** (18 wins, 265K) and **CARLOS CARRASCO** (17 wins, 226K), were part of the **first Indians pitching staff since 1956 to feature three 17-game winners, and the first staff in MLB since the 2003 Yankees.**  
 » The trio are also the second in franchise history to each record at least 190 strikeouts in the same season, after **KLUBER** (245), **CARRASCO** (216) and **DANNY SALAZAR** (195) in 2015...**Bauer, Carrasco and Kluber are also the only trio in MLB history with at least 17 wins and 190-plus strikeouts in the same season.**

**SPRING STRIKEOUT KING**

» Bauer went 2-1 with a 3.99 ERA (13ER/29.1IP) in seven Spring Training starts, and **led MLB with a career-best 39 strikeouts and 29.1 innings pitched, representing the most punchouts in Spring Training by any Indians pitcher since the team returned to Arizona in 2009.**

**2017 REGULAR SEASON HIGHLIGHTS**

» Had a career year in the Indians rotation last year, posting his lowest full-season ERA (4.19) while also recording career highs in wins (17), strikeouts (196), innings pitched (176.1) and strikeouts-per-9.0 innings (10.0)...also struck out six-or-more batters in 22 of his 31 starts, good for 6th in the American League...made one relief appearance, in the 8th inning of the second game of a DH on August 17 at Minnesota (0.2IP, 1H, 1K).  
 » Lost two of his first three decisions and went 2-2 with a 6.24 ERA in April, marking his highest ERA in the first month of the season, but rebounded as the season continued.  
 » **Struck out a career-high 14 batters in 7.0 innings on May 30 vs. Oakland, equaling the highest single-game strikeout total by a Tribe starter last season.**  
 » Dominated after the All-Star Break, going 10-2 with a 3.01 ERA (28ER/83.2IP) in his final 15 appearances (14 starts) of the season...his 10 second-half wins ranked T2nd in the A.L. and his 3.01 ERA ranked T5th among A.L. starters (min. 80.0IP).  
 » **Won a career-best nine consecutive decisions from July 21 to September 10, spanning 11 starts...**posted a 2.51 ERA (18ER/64.2IP) in that span...streak marked the longest by an Indians pitcher last season.

**2017 POSTSEASON RECAP**

» Started Games 1 & 4 for Cleveland of the 2017 ALDS against New York-AL...won the first game at home with 6.2 shutout innings (2H, 1BB, 8K)...eight strikeouts in Game 2 marked his most in a postseason start...took the loss in Game 4 in NYC after allowing four runs (all unearned) over 1.2 innings (4H, 2BB/1BB, 3K).

**CAREER SNAPSHOT**

» Right-hander is in his sixth season with the Indians organization after being acquired from the Arizona Diamondbacks on December 11, 2012, along with RHP Matt Albers, RHP Bryan Shaw (from Arizona) & Drew Stubbs (from Cincinnati), in a 3-team trade... at time of trade, was ranked as Arizona's No. 1 prospect by **Baseball America** and had just earned Dbacks Minor League Pitcher of the Year honors.  
 » Made his Major League debut with Arizona on June 28, 2012, becoming the first player from the 2011 Draft Class to reach the Majors...did not factor into the decision after allowing two runs on five hits in 4.0 innings of work.  
 » In 2017, recorded his best Major League season to date in the Tribe rotation, posting career-highs in wins (17), strikeouts (196) and innings pitched (176.1), while recording his lowest full-season ERA (4.19).  
 » The 2018 season marks his eighth overall in professional baseball after being selected by Arizona in the first round of the 2011 draft out of UCLA, where he went 38-4 with a 2.36 ERA across three seasons for the Bruins...finished his college career holding a number of school records, including a Pac-10 record with 203 strikeouts in 2011.  
 » The Southern California native graduated from Hart High School in Santa Clarita, the same HS that produced Kevin Millar, James Shields, Bob Walker and Todd Zeile.

**TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTER**

**MIKE CLEVINGER (1-0, 0.71)**  
 » The 27-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his third start of the season and second of the year at Progressive Field in tomorrow's series opener against the Toronto Blue Jays...will mark his 47th career appearance and 34th start.
