TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners begin a 2-state, 3-city, 10-day, 10-game road trip with the first of 3 games at Texas...will also travel to Houston (4 G) and Oakland (3 G)...went 2-5 on a recently-concluded 2-team, 7-day, 7-game homestand vs. Houston (1-2) and Toronto (1-3)...tonight's game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS NW** and broadcast live on **710 ESPN Seattle** and the Mariners Radio Network.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners are 9-17 (7/4-current) since winning a season-high 8 straight games (6/25-7/3)...the Mariners have won 24 of their last 48 games, 31 of their last 57, 35 of their last 63, 40 of their last 69 and 42 of their last 73...Seattle is 51-36 in its last 87 games, 56-39 over its last 95 games and 61-43 in its last 104 games...Seattle is 21-18 during the day and 43-30 at night...Seattle is 36-24 at Safeco Field, 28-24 on the road.

- **Whiff** - Edwin Díaz has struck out his first batter faced 25 times this season, tied with Adam Ottavino-COL for the Major League lead...Díaz has struck out his first batter in 46.3% (25x54) of his appearances this season.
- **As Easy as 1-2-3** - Edwin Díaz retired the Blue Jays in order in the 9th inning yesterday for his 41st save of the season...in 25 of his 41 saves, he has faced the minimum 3 batters in an outing of exactly 1.0 inning, the most such saves in the Majors...Craig Kimbrel-BOS is 2nd with 17 saves of 1.0 inning and 3 batters faced.
- **First Things First** - Dee Gordon is batting .355 (33x93) with 21 runs scored, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 1 walk and 2 HBP when leading off a game this season...his 33 hits to lead off a game are the most in the Majors.
- **Close Games** - the Mariners are 41-17 (.707) this season in games decided by 1 or 2 runs, the highest winning percentage in the Majors...the Mariners are 27-14 (.659) in 1-run games (most 1-run wins in MLB) and 14-3 (.824) in games decided by exactly 2 runs (best 2-run winning percentage in MLB).
- **Four Score** - the Mariners are 45-13 when scoring 4-or-more runs, but are 19-35 when scoring 3-or-fewer runs.
- **Get Through 8** - the Mariners are 1 of 2 Major League clubs with a 1.000 winning percentage (57-0) when leading after 8 innings this season, joining Oakland (54-0).
- **Bullpen Bullies** - Edwin Díaz has not allowed an earned run over his last 15.0 innings spanning 14 appearances (6/25-c), while Alex Colomé has an active 13.2 scoreless innings streak over 14 games (6/30-c).

WE MEET AGAIN...four active Mariners are batting at least .300 in their career vs. Rangers starter Martin Pérez: Guillermo Heredia (.444/8x18, 2 2B, RBI), Mitch Haniger (.400/6x15., 2 2B, RBI), Kyle Seager (.348/16x46, 2B, 4 HR, 7 RBI) and Nelson Cruz (.320/8x25, 2B, 3 HR, 5 RBI)...Seager's 16 hits are the most of any player against Pérez...Seager (4) also leads all players in home runs vs. Pérez, followed by Cruz (3) and 10 players with 2 homers, including Mike Zunino...among all players with at least 15 plate appearances vs. Pérez, Heredia's .444 average ranks T3rd (also: Yunel Escobar), while Haniger's .400 average is T6th (also: Chris Carter and Jed Lowrie)...Seager's .348 average is 3rd-best among players with at least 25 plate appearances vs. Pérez, trailing only Lowrie (.400/12x30) and Khris Davis (.381/8x21).

HOMER HAPPY...this series features the top-2 home run leaders in the Majors since July 27...during that span, Nelson Cruz leads all of baseball with 7 home runs, while the Rangers Rougned Odor is 2nd with 6; Javier Báez-CHC and Aledmys Diaz-TOR each have 5 homers over that span...since July 27, Cruz leads the Majors with 14 RBI, followed by Báez (12) and Odor (12).

GLOBE TROTTER...in 65 career games at Globe Life Park in Arlington, Kyle Seager is batting .306 (79x258) with 48 runs, 23 doubles, 12 home runs, 48 RBI, 22 walks, a .370 on-base percentage and a .535 slugging percentage (.905 OPS)...Seager has hit safely in 20 of his last 28 games in Globe Life (8/17/15-c)...he has homered in 3 of his last 7 games at Globe Life...overall, Seager has 20 multi-hit games and 15 multi-RBI games at Globe Life...his 15 multi-RBI games are T4th-most by a visiting player in the 25-year history of the ballpark (also: Miguel Tejada and Paul Konerko), trailing Garret Anderson (21), Tim Salmon (20) and Torii Hunter (16).

STREAKING...Alex Colomé has an active season-high 13.2 scoreless innings streak...during this stretch, dating back to June 30, he is 1-0 with 10 holds in 14 relief appearances...he has limited opponents to a .200 (10x50) average, while walking 5 and striking out 16...his 13.2 scoreless innings streak is the 6th-longest active streak in the Majors, while also ranking the 5th-longest by a Mariners pitcher this season...his active scoreless inning streak is the 3rd-longest in his career, trailing only a 21.2 innings streak (16 G, 8/4-9/5/15) and a 21.0 innings streak (19 G, 5/4-6/15/16).

THE EDWIN DÍAZ FILE...Edwin Díaz recorded his Major League-leading 41st save of the season yesterday...he is 1 of 4 pitchers in single-season club history to notch at least 40 saves, joining Fernando Rodney (48, 2014), Kazuhiro Sasaki (45, 2001) and J.J. Putz (40, 2007)...Díaz has 89 strikeouts this season, equaling his single-season career-high; he had 89 strikeouts last season after recording 88 punchouts in his rookie campaign of 2016 (appeared in 49 games after being called up to the Majors in June)...Díaz joins Dick Radatz (1962-64 w/BOS) as the only primary relievers in Major League history to record at least 88 strikeouts in each of their first 3 seasons.

WHAT A RELIEF...the Mariners lead the Major Leagues in saves (43) and rank T1st in holds (79)...since 1973, only 6 clubs have led the Majors in saves and holds in the same season, most recently the 1992 Oakland Athletics...Edwin Díaz leads the Majors with 41 saves, while Alex Colomé and Juan Nicasio are T9th in MLB with 19 holds each (also: Amir Garrett-CIN).

ELECTRIC EDDIE...Edwin Díaz leads the Majors with 41 saves, while ranking 2nd among all relievers with 89 strikeouts (Josh Hader-MIL, 101)...of Díaz's 41 saves, 21 have come in 1-run games, most in the Majors this season (Craig Kimbrel-BOS, 12, and Blake Treinen-OAK, 12)...his 21 1-run saves are only 2 shy of equaling the Major League single-season record, set by Francisco Rodriguez in 2008 (23)...the Mariners are 49-0 when Díaz enters with a lead this season, including 23-0 when he enters with a 1-run lead...Díaz is 21-for-23 in 1-run save opportunities (91.3%) with a 0.77 ERA (2 ER, 23.1 IP) with 43 strikeouts and 5 walks.

AS YOU KNOW...Wade LeBlanc is averaging 1.83 walks-per-9.0-innings (19 BB, 93.1 IP) in 17 starts this season, 6th-lowest among AL starters...**AND AS YOU MAY KNOW**...Marco Gonzales is 5th among AL starters (1.70/25 BB, 132.2 IP) and Mike Leake is 7th (1.86/29 BB, 140.2 IP)...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...that the Mariners have never had 3 qualified starters finish a season averaging fewer than 2.0 BB/9.0 IP?

ABOUT LEBLANC...

- 33-year-old left-hander is making his 23rd appearance and 18th start of the season, his 199th career appearance, 97th career start and 2nd start (3rd appearance) vs. the Rangers today.
- Signed with Seattle on March 25 after being released by New York-AL at his request.
- Previously played with Seattle in 2016...acquired on June 22, 2016 from Toronto in exchange for a player to be named later or cash considerations...was traded to Pittsburgh on Sept. 13, 2016 in exchange for a player to be named later or cash considerations.
- Selected by San Diego in the 2nd round of the 2006 MLB First-Year Player Draft.
- Native of Lake Charles, LA...attended Alfred M. Barbe High School.
- Made his Major League debut with the Padres on Sept. 3, 2008 at Los Angeles-NL (L, 4.0, 8.5, 5.3, 1, HR-2).
- Pitched for the University of Alabama, 2004-06...was 24-9 with a 2.81 ERA (100 ER, 320.1 IP) and 334 strikeouts in 46 career G/45 GS...holds Alabama's all-time record for strikeouts with 334...National Freshman of the Year (*Baseball America*) and SEC Freshman of the Year in 2004 after going 8-4 with a 2.08 ERA (26 ER, 112.2 IP) with 98 strikeouts in 16 G/15 GS while posting 8 complete games, including 2 shutouts.
- Went 2-5 with a 4.23 ERA (21 ER, 44.2 IP) in 8 starts with the Seibu Lions in the Japan Pacific League in 2015.
- Is 8-9 with a 5.59 ERA (87 ER, 140.0 IP) in 35 career games/23 starts in August.

LAST OUTING...allowed a season-high 7 runs in the Mariners 3-8 loss to Houston on Aug. 1...tossed 4.1 innings, allowing 10 hits and 0 walks while striking out 3 batters...tied his career-high with 3 home runs allowed...exited the game with 2 on and 1 out in the 5th inning; both baserunners came around to score.

FOR STARTERS...since moving into the Mariners rotation on May 3, is 6-2 with a 3.86 ERA (40 ER, 93.1 IP) with 73 strikeouts and 19 walks in 17 starts...the Mariners are 11-6 in those 17 starts...among American League leaders during that span, ranks 7th in BB/9.0 IP (1.83/19 BB, 93.1 IP), 8th in K/BB (3.84/73 K, 19 BB), 10th in WHIP (1.16/19 BB, 89 H, 93.1 IP) and 17th in ERA.

START IT UP...in 25 career starts with the Mariners, is 9-2 with a 4.04 ERA (62 ER, 138.0 IP) with 107 strikeouts and 28 walks...the Mariners are 18-7 in his 25 starts with the club...made 8 starts with Seattle in 2016, going 3-0 with a 4.43 ERA (22 ER, 44.2 IP) with 34 strikeouts and 9 walks.

HE'S A WINNER...made 21 career starts with the Mariners before suffering a loss...only 1 American League pitcher in the live-ball era had a longer such streak to begin a tenure with a single club (Whitey Ford-NYY, 22, 7/6/50-6/12/53)...among all pitchers in the live-ball era, LeBlanc's streak trailed only Ford and Kirk Ruetter-MON (22, 7/7/93-6/15/94)(STATS).

MAKE YOURSELF AT HOME...signed to a contract extension through the 2019 season with annual club options through 2022 on July 3.

THAT'S NEAT!...turned in one of the best starts of his career June 16 vs. Boston, allowing just 2 hits and striking out 9 across 7.2 scoreless innings...faced just 1 over the minimum, thanks to a 1st inning double play...retired 22 consecutive batters after allowing a leadoff single to Mookie Betts in the 1st inning, ending with Eduardo Núñez's two-out single in the 8th...his 7.2 innings and 9 strikeouts were both his most since 2011 with San Diego.

MAY TO REMEMBER...in 6 starts in the month of May, went 1-0 with a 1.72 ERA (6 ER, 31.1 IP) with 23 strikeouts and 6 walks...among American League leaders for the month of May, ranked 4th in ERA and 9th in WHIP (0.99/6 BB, 25 H, 31.1 IP)...the Mariners went 5-1 in those 6 starts.

WELCOME (BACK) TO SEATTLE...signed with Seattle on March 25 after being released by New York-AL at his request...became the 43rd player in club history to have spent at least two different stints with the Mariners...Mike Blowers (1992-95, 1997, 1999), Raúl Ibañez (1996-2000, 2004-2008, 2013), Norm Charlton (1993, 1995-97, 2001) and Jeff Nelson (1992-95, 2001-03, 2005) are the only players who spent three separate stints with the Mariners.

2017 SEASON...went 5-2 with 1 save and 4 holds in 50 relief appearances with a 4.50 ERA (34 ER, 68.0 IP), 54 strikeouts and 17 walks with Pittsburgh...held right-handed batters to a .217 (38x175) batting average against with a .270 OBP and a .389 slugging percentage (.658 OPS against).

IT HAD BEEN A WHILE...in his Mariners debut on June 24, 2016, LeBlanc made his first Major League appearance since Sept. 28, 2014 at Seattle with Los Angeles-AL, a span of 634 days between appearances...LeBlanc made his first ML start since Sept. 23, 2014 at Oakland with Los Angeles-AL, a span of 639 days between starts...earned his first win with Seattle on July 1, 2016, vs. Baltimore (6.0, 3.2, 2.1, 5, HR-1), his first Major League win since Sept. 23, 2014, with the Angels at the A's, a span of 646 days between Major League wins.

CAREER...10-year MLB veteran with 7 clubs (San Diego, Miami, Houston, Los Angeles-AL, New York-AL, Pittsburgh & Seattle)...overall, is 36-37-3 with a 4.33 ERA (329 ER, 683.2 IP) in 198 career appearances/96 starts...in 96 career starts, is 28-33 with a 4.43 ERA (257 ER, 522.1 IP) with 367 strikeouts and 166 walks...in 102 career relief appearances, is 8-4-3 with a 4.02 ERA (72 ER, 161.1 IP) with 125 strikeouts and 43 walks...appeared in 11 games (8 starts) with the Mariners in 2016, going 3-0-1 with a 4.50 ERA (25 ER, 50.0 IP).
