CHICAGO CUBS NOTES

KYLE HENDRICKS recorded his fourth-consecutive quality start ... dropped to 3-3 on the season ... 0-2 in his career against the White Sox

- © Did not walk a batter for his second consecutive start ... has recorded two or fewer walks in six of his eight starts this season ... has walked just nine of the 203 batters faced this season.
- © Has faced 52 straight batters without allowing a walk.

JAVIER BÁEZ (1-for-4, 2 RBI, SB) drove in two runs in the first inning ... his 10th multi-RBI game of the season, tied for the third most in baseball behind only Manny Machado (11) and Khris Davis (11).

- © The first Cub to have 10 multi-RBI games in his first 37 games since Derek Lee in 2005.

IAN HAPP (1-for-3, 2B, RBI, BB) hit an RBI-double in the fourth inning.

NOTES: The Cubs had their season-high tying five-game winning streak snapped.

- © The Cubs stole four bases in the first inning, the first time they have stolen at least three bases in an inning since April 28, 2015 vs. Pittsburgh ... first time with four stolen bases in the first inning since August 23, 1997 vs. Montreal ... Anthony Rizzo and Willson Contreras each stole their first base of the season.
- © Kyle Schwarber (0-for-2, 2 BB, 2 SB) had his first career game with multiple stolen bases ... now has six career stolen bases in his career.
- © Brian Duensing allowed his first run of the season, was the only qualifying reliever prior to today's game to have not allowed an earned run this season.
- © The Cubs finished with five stolen bases in a game for the first time since September 16, 2015 at Pittsburgh.
- © The Cubs scored two or more runs in the first inning in every game this series ... the second time they have done that this season (April 20-22 at Colorado).
- © Have scored 34 runs in the first inning, their most in any inning this season.

CHICAGO WHITE SOX NOTES

LUCAS GIOLITO made his first-career start against the Cubs and earned his second win of the season and first since April 26 at Kansas City.

- © Walked a season-high tying seven batters over 5.2 innings ... Tyler Chatwood is the only other MLB pitcher to walk seven batters in a game this season.
- © Is the first White Sox pitcher since Dan Wright in 2001 to walk at least seven batters and allow two or fewer hits in an outing.

MATT DAVIDSON (2-for-3, HR, 2 RBI, R) hit a solo-home run in the second inning ... has homered in consecutive games for the second time this season (April 26-27) ... hit a go-ahead sacrifice fly in the sixth inning.

NICKY DELMONICO (1-for-4, 3B, RBI, R) hit an RBI-triple in the sixth inning, his first-career triple ... first RBI since April 29, 2018.

NOTES: The White Sox snapped their seven-game losing skid ... won their first Interleague game of the season (0-6 previously).

- © Yolmer Sanchez (1-for-4, RBI), hit an RBI-single in the third inning to tie the score at two ... hitting .307 (12-for-39) with two RBI in 13 career games against the Cubs.
- © José Abreu (1-for-4, R) has recorded a hit in five consecutive games against the Cubs
