TONIGHT'S GAME: The Giants' two-city, six-game road trip continues with game one of a three-game set against the Milwaukee Brewers...the Giants have lost five straight games and six of their last seven...San Francisco enters tonight's game a season-high 10.0 games behind the Colorado Rockies.

INSIDE THE SERIES: Dating back to 2015, San Francisco has won seven of their last 10 games against the Brewers at Miller Park...during that stretch the Giants have hit .289 with 15 home runs and posted a 3.17 ERA at this facility.

ON THE MOUND: LHP Derek Holland has posted a 2-0 record with a 2.42 ERA (12er, 44.2ip) and a .224 opponents average over his last eight starts...since June 4, his 2.65 ERA ranks as the seventh-best figure in the Majors (min. 85.0ip)...he's made one career start against the Brewers, allowing one run on 10 hits in 7.0 innings of work at Miller Park on May 8, 2013.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: Both of tonight's starters, **LHP Derek Holland** and RHP Chase Anderson, are undefeated since the All-Star Break...the only other National League pitchers who are undefeated since the break with a minimum of eight starts are COL's Jon Gray and ARI's Robbie Ray (Stats, LLC).

GIANT BIRTHDAY: Happy Birthday to Giants' **OF Gorkys Hernandez**, who turns 31-years-old today.

ON THE ROAD: The Giants have dropped nine of their past 11 road games, during that stretch they are hitting .204 and have posted a 4.62 ERA...the Giants' .408 (29-43) winning percentage overall on the road is the third-lowest in the league.

VS. THE BREW CREW: Several Giants' players have enjoyed success against the Brewers over their careers, including **IF Joe Panik** who has reached base safely (via hit or walk) in each of his 20 career game against the Brewers, batting .370 (30-for-81) with 16 runs, eight extra-base hits and 11 RBI, **OF Gorkys Hernandez** who is 12-for-34 (.353) with three doubles, two homers, five RBI and eight runs scored in 15 career games vs. Milwaukee and **IF Brandon Belt** who has reached base safely in 11 consecutive games against the Brewers, hitting .325 (13-for-40).

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN: The Giants have been successful in 20 of their last 22 stolen base attempts, including each of their last 16 attempts...the last time the Giants were successful in 16+ consecutive stolen base attempts was in 2012 when they were successful in 16 straight from June 5-18 (Stats, LLC).

CLOSE CALLS: Both the Giants and Brewers have played in a number of close games this season...San Francisco has played in 49 one-run games, posting a 24-25 (.490) record, while the Brewers have played in 46 one-run games, going 28-18 (.609).

QUALITY COUNTS: Giants starting pitchers have tossed a quality outing in 12 of their last 16 starts, posting a 2.41 ERA (27er, 100.2ip)...San Francisco has gone 7-9 during that stretch.

SOLID PITCHING: Beginning June 1, Giants pitchers have posted a 3.37 ERA, which ranks as the third-best figure in the Majors, behind the Dodgers: 3.31 ERA and Astros (3.37 ERA).

TODAY'S GIANTS STARTER

#45 LHP Derek Holland
6-2, 215, 31 years old (October 9, 1986)
7-8 Record, 3.56 ERA

- The 31-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 27th start (31st appearance) this season...has posted a 7-8 record with a 3.56 ERA (58er, 146.2ip) over his 30 outings.
- The Giants have won five of his last seven starts and are 14-12 in his starts overall this season.
- Has made the most starts of any Giants' starting pitcher (26) and tossed the most innings on the club (146.2ip).
- Took a no-decision in the Giants' 2-1, 11-inning loss vs. the Mets on September 1...allowed one run on four hits in 6.0 innings.
- Over his last four outings, Holland owns a 1.23 ERA (3er, 22.0ip).
- Has posted a 2-1 record with a 2.14 ERA (13er, 54.2ip) and a .215 opponents average over his last 12 games (nine starts)...his 2.14 ERA since July 7 is ninth-best in the NL (min. 50 IP).
- Has allowed two-runs-or-fewer in eight of his last nine starts, posting a 2.29 ERA (13er, 51.0ip).
- Lefties are hitting just .178 (21-for-118) off him, which ranks as the sixth-lowest figure in the National League...has allowed just three extra-base hits to left-handers (all doubles)...left-handed opponents have just a .203 slugging percentage off him, which is the second-lowest in the Majors.
- Has pitched better in day games, going 5-1 with a 2.54 ERA (16er, 56.2ip) in 11 games, compared to a 2-7 record with a 4.20 ERA (42er, 90.0ip) in 19 night games.
- Opponents are hitting just .200 (24-for-120) off him with runners in scoring position and are 7-for-their-last-46 (.152).
- Has received two-or-less runs of support in 16 of his 26 starts this season.
- Has made four relief appearances and allowed two runs on five hits (one home run) with 14 strikeouts in 7.0 innings of work...has struck out 14 of the 28 batters he's faced as a reliever.
- Has made only one career appearance vs. Milwaukee, earning the win with Texas in the Rangers' 4-1 win on May 8, 2013 at Miller Park...worked 7.0 innings and allowed one run on 10 hits while striking out six.
- Signed by the Giants to a minor league contract in Feb. and made the team as a non-roster invitee.

NOTES: The 28-year-old right-hander is making his 24th appearance (23rd start) of the season...was recalled from double-A Richmond Aug. 21, the second time he's been recalled in 2018...since his most recent recall from the minors, he's made two starts with the Giants, going 1-1 with a 1.77 ERA (4er, 20.1ip) and .194 opponents average against...his career-high of nine wins are the most on the Giants' starting staff...last time out, Stratton suffered the loss in the Giants' 4-1 defeat vs. the Mets on September 2...allowed two runs in the second inning on a Michael Conforto home run but then retired 15 of the final 16 batters he faced, including 10 straight to end his outing...will be making his second career start, fourth appearance, against Milwaukee...spun 6.0 shutout innings and allowed four hits in his only other career start vs. the Brewers on August 21, 2017 at AT&T Park.
