### TRIBE HEADLINES

» Cleveland's "magic number" to clinch its third consecutive American League Central title currently stands at four.

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** has assumed the American League in stolen bases with his 32 thefts this season...he is seeking to become the sixth different Indians player to lead the A.L. in steals...he is also two RBI away from becoming the first Cleveland third baseman with 100 RBI since **Travis Fryman** (106) in 2000.

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** leads Major League Baseball with 119 runs scored this season, the most by an Indians player since **Grady Sizemore** scored 134 in 2006...he is also tied with Boston's **J.D. Martinez** for the MLB lead with 55 multi-hit efforts.

» **SHANE BIEBER** leads all MLB rookie pitchers (min. 70.0IP) with 1.58 walks per 9.0 innings and a 5.81 K/BB ratio (highest by an Indians rookie in club history)...Bieber's nine wins this season are the most by a Tribe rookie since **Mitch Talbot** had 10 in 2010.

### YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians suffered their 11th walk-off loss of the season, as they opened their three-game set at Tampa Bay with a 6-5 defeat.

» Trailing 4-1 through two innings, the Tribe offense clawed back to take a 5-4 lead into the 9th inning...**BRANDON GUYER** tied the game at 4-4 with a pinch-hit, two-run double in the top of the 6th inning...**JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** went 1-for-3 with an RBI-double, stole two bases, and scored the go-ahead run on a fielder's choice in the top of the 7th inning...**FRANCISCO LINDOR** (2-5) and **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** (2-4) each contributed multi-hit efforts.

» **COREY KLUBER** allowed four runs on five hits over just 1.2 innings of work, matching his shortest start of the season (also June 26 at STL)...seven relievers held the Rays scoreless on one hit over the next 7.0 innings before **BRAD HAND** allowed two hits, including the game-winning homer, with two outs in the bottom of the 9th.

» The eight Indians pitchers combined for 16 strikeouts on the evening...marked the most pitchers ever used in a 9.0-inning game with 16-or-more strikeouts (out of 412 such games in MLB history).

### GETTING CLOSER

» The Indians enter play tonight with a 15.5-game lead over second-place Minnesota in the A.L. Central...thanks to the Twins' 7-2 loss vs. New York-AL last night, the club's "magic number" to clinch a third consecutive division title currently sits at 4.

» Cleveland has 81 wins this season, one shy of clinching their sixth straight season with a record above .500...will mark the 5th-longest streak of winning seasons in franchise history.

### RAIN O'ER ME

» **JOSH DONALDSON** has been activated from the 10-day Disabled List, and is set to appear in his first MLB game since May 28.

» Donaldson made four rehab appearances with Columbus and Akron since his acquisition on August 31, batting .250 (3-12) with two homers, six RBI and three runs scored.

» Across his three full seasons with Toronto (2015-17), Donaldson batted (46-169) .272 against Tampa Bay with 15 home runs, five doubles, 27 RBI and 34 runs scored...his 15 homers vs. the Rays in that span are the most of any player.

### SMOOTH SAILING

» **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** recorded his 47th multi-hit game of the season last night, T7th-most in the American League.

» Over his past 13 games, Brantley is batting .373 (19-51) with a homer, four doubles, three RBI and six runs scored...he currently ranks 6th in the A.L. with a .307 (158-514) season batting average.

### RAYS 'EM UP

» Cleveland is concluding its six-game season series vs. Tampa Bay this week with a three-game set at Tropicana Field.

» In the clubs' first matchup at Progressive Field from August 31-September 2, the Rays won two out of three contests, narrowly outscoring the Tribe 11-10...Tampa Bay holds a 3-1 advantage in the season series despite an even runs scored margin of 16-16.

» The Tribe went 4-3 in their season series vs. Tampa Bay in 2017, going 1-2 at Progressive Field (May 15-17) and 3-1 at Tropicana Field (August 10-13)...Cleveland holds an all-time record of 94-61 (.606) against the Rays in a matchup that dates back to 1998.

### THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

**1952: Mike Garcia** tossed a two-hit shutout (2BB, 3K) at Cleveland Municipal Stadium, as the Indians defeated the Philadelphia Athletics, 1-0...marked Garcia's 20th win of the season, making him one of three Tribe pitchers to reach the milestone that season (along with Hall of Famers **Early Wynn** and **Bob Lemon**)...the lone run of the contest was scored on a **Bobby Avila** solo homer in the bottom of the 4th inning.

### THE SHANE EVENT

» **SHANE BIEBER** is set to make his second career start and appearance against the Tampa Bay Rays tonight...faced them previously on September 1 at Progressive Field, taking the loss after allowing four runs on four hits over 5.1 innings of work (0BB, 4K).

» Bieber is starting on regular four days' rest after making his last outing on September 6 at Toronto...earned his ninth win of the season in a quality start, allowing four runs (three earned) on seven hits over 6.1 innings of work (1BB, 6K) in the Tribe's 9-4 victory.

» His nine wins this season are the 5th-most by a Tribe rookie since 2000, and the most since **Mitch Talbot** won 10 games in 2010 (see chart below).

» Bieber has walked just 16 batters over his first 16 career Major League starts, good for a rate of 1.58 walks per 9.0 innings that leads all MLB rookie pitchers (min. 70.0IP)...currently ranks as the second-lowest rate for an Indians rookie pitcher (min. 70.0IP) in club history, trailing **Tom Brennan** (0.97) in 1982.

» He has also posted a 5.81 K/BB ratio (93K/16BB), the highest ratio among MLB rookies (min. 70.0IP) this year and the top single-season mark among rookie pitchers in club history (min. 70.0IP).

» Bieber enters play tonight among the American League rookie leaders in a number of categories, including strikeouts (3rd, 93), wins (3rd, 9), innings pitched (4th, 91.1) and ERA (7th, 4.63).

### J-RAMPAGE ON THE BASEPATHS

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** powered the Tribe offense last night, going 1-for-3 with an RBI-double, a hit-by-pitch and two stolen bases.

» Ramirez now leads the American League with 32 steals this season...he is seeking to become the sixth different Indians player to hold or share the A.L. in stolen bases (12th instance), and the first since **RAJAI DAVIS** (45 SB) did so in 2016.

» His 5th-inning RBI-double gave him 98 RBI on the season (3rd-most in the American League)...Ramirez sits two RBI away from becoming the first Tribe third baseman to record 100 RBI since **Travis Fryman** (106 RBI) reached the milestone in 2000.

### HIT, SCORE, SMILE

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** collected his 55th multi-hit game of the season last night, matching Boston's **J.D. Martinez** for the Major League lead...marks the most multi-hit efforts in a season by a Tribe batter since **Michael Brantley** had 59 in the 2014 campaign.

» Lindor also scored his Major League-leading 119th run of the season yesterday, the most by an Indians player since **Grady Sizemore** scored 134 in 2006.

### RUNNING MEN

» The Indians currently lead the Major Leagues with 121 stolen bases this season, 12 more than any other club...Cleveland is seeking to lead MLB in stolen bases for the first time in its 118-year franchise history.

» Last night marked the Tribe's MLB-leading 15th game this season with three-or-more stolen bases, Cleveland's most in a year since also recording 15 such contests in 1998.

» **RAJAI DAVIS** stole his 19th base of the season yesterday...he sits one steal away from joining **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** (32 SB) and **FRANCISCO LINDOR** (23 SB) at the 20-steal milestone...Cleveland has not had three players reach 20 stolen bases since 2000 (**Roberto Alomar**, **Kenny Lofton** and **Omar Vizquel**).

### OLLIE OOP

» **OLIVER PÉREZ** worked 1.1 scoreless innings with three strikeouts last night, lowering his season ERA to 0.95 (3ER/28.1IP).

» Pérez owns the 2nd-lowest relief ERA in MLB this season (min. 40 appearances), trailing only Oakland's **Blake Treinen** (0.87)...not including Treinen and Pérez, there have been just 11 sub-1.00 ERAs in MLB history posted by relievers with at least 40 outings.

**TONIGHT'S START**

» The 23-year-old rookie is set to make his 17th career start in tonight's contest at Tampa Bay...will mark his second career start vs. the Rays.

» Will be pitching tonight on regular four days' rest after making his last start on September 6 at Toronto...notched his ninth win of the season, holding the Blue Jays to four runs (three earned) on seven hits, with one walk and six strikeouts across 6.1 innings...became the fourth Indians pitcher with nine-or-more wins in his first 16 career games in the *Baseball Reference* Play Index era (1908-), joining **VEAN GREGG** (10), **JOSH TOMLIN** (9) and **LUIS TIAnt** (9).

» He is due to face the Rays for the second time in his career, after taking the loss on September 1 at Progressive Field (5.1IP, 9H, 4R/ER, 0BB, 4K).

» **Bieber enters tonight's start with nine wins (3rd-most among A.L. rookies)...needs one more victory to become the first Indians rookie pitcher with 10-or-more wins in a single season since Mitch Talbot won 10 games in 2010.**

» **Bieber has posted a 5.81 K/BB ratio, the top mark among MLB rookie pitchers this season (min. 70.0IP), as well as the best single-season ratio by an Indians rookie hurler (min. 70.0IP).**

» He enters play tonight averaging 1.58 BB/9 (16BB/91.1IP), the lowest mark among Major League rookie pitchers (min. 70.0IP), as well as the 2nd-lowest single-season mark by an Indians rookie pitcher (min. 70.0IP) (**Tom Brennan**, 0.97 in 1982).

» He has struck out 93 batters in his first 16 career outings, the 3rd-most in Indians franchise history, behind **Herb Score** (126) and **DANNY SALAZAR** (102)...Bieber needs seven more strikeouts to reach 100 on the season and would become the first Indians rookie pitcher with 100+ punchouts in a season since **TREVOR BAUER** in 2014 (143K).

» Bieber is also averaging 90.0 pitches per start, the 2nd-highest mark among American League rookie pitchers (min. 70.0IP), 7th-highest in MLB...**he has thrown 67.4% of his pitches (971/1440) for strikes, the highest strike percentage among MLB rookies (min. 70.0IP).**

» Entering tonight's contest, Bieber also ranks among the American League rookie pitching leaders in wins (3rd, 9), strikeouts (3rd, 93), games started (T4th, 16), innings pitched (4th, 91.1), ERA (7th, 4.63) and opponent batting average (9th, .294).

**EASTERN PROMISES**

» Bieber is due to face the Tampa Bay Rays for the for the second time in his career in tonight's contest...took the loss on September 1 at Progressive Field (5.1IP, 9H, 4R/ER, 0BB, 4K).

» Tonight marks his fifth career start and appearance vs. an opponent from the A.L. East, compiling a 3-1 record and 4.68 ERA (13ER/25.0IP) in his four prior starts.

**WALK THIS WAY...OR NOT**

» Bieber walked one batter in his last start and has allowed two-or-fewer walks in each of his first 16 career starts, which is the longest streak by an Indians starting pitcher to begin his career in the *Baseball Reference* Play Index era (1908-).

» Overall, he has allowed 16 walks in his 16 Major League starts (91.1IP)...**his 1.58 BB/9 is the lowest among all MLB rookie pitchers this season (min. 70.0IP)**, as well as the 2nd-lowest single season mark by an Indians rookie hurler (min. 70.0IP), behind **Tom Brennan** (0.97 in 1982).

» Has also posted a 5.81 SO/BB ratio (87SO/15BB), the highest mark among all Major League rookie pitchers (min. 70.0IP) and the highest single-season mark by an Indians rookie pitcher (min. 70.0IP).

**ROAD WARRIOR**

» Tonight will mark Bieber's 10th road start of the season and of his career...has yet to lose a road decision, compiling a 5-0 record and 4.42 ERA (26ER/53.0IP) in nine starts away from Progressive Field.

» Bieber's five-decision road winning streak to start his career is the longest such run by an Indians pitcher since **CC Sabathia** won his first six career road decisions from April 13-June 22, 2001.

**2018 CLEVELAND RECAP**

» Entering tonight's contest, Bieber ranks among the American League rookie pitching leaders in wins (3rd, 9), strikeouts (3rd, 93), games started (T4th, 16), innings pitched (4th, 91.1), ERA (7th, 4.63) and opponent batting average (9th, .294).

» Earned his ninth win in his last start on September 6 at Toronto, becoming the fourth Indians pitcher with nine-or-more wins in his first 16 career games in the *Baseball Reference* Play Index era (1908-), joining **VEAN GREGG** (10 in 1911), **JOSH TOMLIN** (9 in 2010-11) and **Luis Tiant** (9 in 1964).

» Won his eighth career game on August 26 at Kansas City, becoming the fifth Indians pitcher with eight wins within his first 14 career games in the *Baseball Reference* Play Index era, joining **JOSH TOMLIN**, **Luis Tiant**, **VEAN GREGG** and **John Farrell**.

» Notched his seventh career win on August 21 at Boston, becoming the seventh Indians pitcher with seven-or-more wins in his first 13 career appearances in the *Baseball Reference* Play Index era (1908-), and first since **Jeremy Sowers** in 2006.

» Won his sixth career game on August 5 vs. Los Angeles-AL, becoming the sixth Indians pitcher with six-or-more wins in his first 10 career appearances in the *Baseball Reference* Play Index era (1908-), alongside **Luis Tiant** (7), **Herb Score** (6), **CC Sabathia** (6), **VEAN GREGG** (6) and **Gene Bearden** (6).

» Earned his fifth win on July 13, marking the first Indians pitcher with five wins in his first seven career starts since **CC Sabathia** did so in 2001.

» Won his fourth career game on July 3 at Kansas City, becoming the third Tribe pitcher in the *Baseball Reference* Play Index era (1908-) with four wins in his first five career starts, joining **John Farrell** (1987) and **Scott Lewis** (2008-09).

» On June 22 vs. Detroit, Bieber became the sixth Indians pitcher since 1908 to record a start with 7.0-or-more shutout innings and four-or-fewer hits allowed within his first three career starts, and the first since **Scott Lewis** did so on September 10, 2008 at Baltimore...at 23.022 years old marked the youngest pitcher in franchise history to achieve that feat, surpassing **Ray Benge** (23.157), who did so on Sept. 26, 1925 at Philadelphia.

» Bieber fanned a career-high nine Tigers hitters in the June 22 outing, becoming the first Indians pitcher since **Luis Tiant** in 1964 with six-or-more strikeouts in each of his first three career appearances...his 22 strikeouts combined across his first three career starts tied him with **DANNY SALAZAR** (also 22) for the 3rd-most strikeouts in a pitcher's first three career appearances in Indians franchise history.

» Earned his first career win in his second career start on June 17 vs. Minnesota...allowed one run on 11 hits in 5.2 innings, with one walk...fanned seven batters, becoming the fourth pitcher in Indians franchise history to strike out six-or-more batters in each of his first two career starts and first since **SALAZAR** did so in his first two appearances from July 11 - August 7, 2013.

» Made his Major League debut against the Twins at Target Field on May 31...did not factor into the decision in the Tribe's 9-8 win (5.2IP, 8H, 4R/ER, 2HR, 1BB, 6K)...struck out six batters, including his first career batter faced (**Brian Dozier**), marking the most punchouts in a Tribe pitcher's first Major League start since **SALAZAR** fanned seven in his MLB debut on July 11, 2013 vs. Toronto.

» Bieber became the first pitcher in Indians franchise history to make his Major League debut on his birthday, as well as the second player after outfielder **Dave Clark** on September 3, 1986 at Toronto.
