LEADING OFF: Angels play the third game (1-1) of their initial home stand of 2018 vs. **Cleveland** (April 2-4; 1-1) and **Oakland** (April 6-8)...**Club is off tomorrow**...Halos have won four of last five games...Angels are 4-2 after six games for a second straight season and look for a 5-2 opening for first time since 2007...Following this home stand, LAA sets out on its second trip of 2018 to **Texas** (April 9-11) and **Kansas City** (April 12-15).

COZART'S START: In March/April-May across last two seasons, **Zack Cozart** ranks second in all of MLB batting .339 (66/195)...Only **Ryan Zimmerman** (.352; 70/199) has a higher clip...**Cozart** is also the third Angels player to "hit for the cycle" with his first four career hits with the team, joining **Fred Lynn** and **Cliff Pennington**. (STATS LLC).

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The 13-2 win snapped a 12-game skid to Indians matching the longest losing streak vs. one team in Club history...**Garrett Richards** (5.2 IP, 1 H, 2 ER, 4 BB, 9 SO) is the first Angels starter to finish with two runs allowed on one hit since **Chuck Finley** on September 5, 1999 at Seattle...First LAA combined one-hitter since **Alex Meyer** (7 IP), **David Hernandez** (1 IP) and **Jose Alvarez** (1 IP) on July 19, 2017...First time scoring six runs in the first inning since September 3, 2016 at Seattle and first time scoring six runs in the first inning at home since April 20, 2013 vs. Detroit (scored nine runs)...13 runs scored were most for Angels at home since July, 26 2015 vs. Texas...HRs by five different players matches franchise record (15th time)...**Mike Trout** is now two runs shy of 700 for career...One hit shy of 500 in career at Angel Stadium...**Luis Valbuena's** three runs scored are his most since June 23, 2015 with Astros (at Angels)...**Rene Rivera** tallied his fourth career game with at least four RBI.

TWO-WAY SHOHEI: **Shohei Ohtani** (3-4, 2 R, 1 HR, 3 RBI, 1 SO) is the first player to earn a win and then hit a home run in a start as a non-pitcher in his next game since **Babe Ruth** on June 13-14, 1921...First rookie with 3+ hits and 1+ wins in his team's first 6 games of a season since **Dutch Stryker** for 1924 Boston Braves (STATS LLC)...First player with 4+ hits, a home run, and a win in his team's first six games since **Wes Ferrell** in 1937 for Red Sox (STATS LLC)...With Sunday's start, **Ohtani** became the first player to start as a non-pitcher on Opening Day and then start as a pitcher within his team's first 10 games since **Babe Ruth** (BOS) in 1919 (STATS LLC).

SO FAR, SHO GOOD: **Shohei Ohtani** is the first Angels pitcher with at least six strikeouts in MLB pitching debut since **Kevin Gregg** in 2003...**Ohtani** is the second Japanese-born pitcher with 6+ IP, 6+ SO and four-or-fewer baserunners allowed in MLB pitching debut, joining Mets' **Masato Yoshii** (4/5/98 vs. PIT).

OHTANI = BASEBALL RARITY: Prior to **Ohtani**, the last time a player started as a pitcher and a non-pitcher in the first 10 games of a season was 1920, when both **Bullet Joe Bush** (Red Sox) and **Clarence Mitchell** (Dodgers) started as pitchers and outfielders (STATS LLC).

THE MANAGER: **Mike Scioscia** is the longest tenured manager in the Majors (19th season) and the only active manager to collect over 1,000 victories with current club...His current .539 (1,574-1,348) winning percentage and 1,570 wins are both tops in franchise history... **Scioscia is one of just three active managers with at least 1,500 career wins (Bochy & Showalter)**.

ONLY ONE: Entering 2018, there have been 19,183 people to play Major League Baseball (entering 2018). Of those players, just one of them has 200 HR, 150 SB, and a .400 OBP through his first seven seasons. His name is **Mike Trout**.

ANOTHER TROUT NIBBLE: **Mike Trout** has four 9+ WAR seasons through his 26 year-old campaign. Only others to do so? **Rogers Hornsby** (4) and **Ty Cobb** (4).

3000/600: **Albert Pujols** is 26 hits shy of 3,000...When he reaches the mark, he will become just the fourth player in MLB history with at least 3,000 knocks and 600 HRs joining **Hank Aaron**, **Willie Mays** and **Alex Rodriguez**.

MORE ALBERT: **Pujols** is vying to become the 32nd player all time with 3,000 hits, the sixth foreign born player to accomplish the feat and the second player to do so in an Angels' uniform (**Rod Carew** in 1985).

NEW HALOS: Angels Opening Day active roster features seven players new to the organization: **Luke Bard**, **Jim Johnson**, **Shohei Ohtani**, **Rene Rivera**, **Zack Cozart**, **Ian Kinsler** and **Chris Young**.

Vs. INDIANS: Last night's 13-2 win snapped a 12-game skid to Cleveland...Streak matched longest in Club history vs. one team (also to Baltimore from 1979-80 and Kansas City in 1975)...LAA has dropped 16 of last 18 overall to Cleveland...Club has lost last 10 games in Cleveland (9-20 last 29 there)...Halos are 7-7 in last 14 G at the Big A.

RECENT SUCCESS vs. TRIBE: In his last 14 games vs. Cleveland, **Andrelton Simmons** is batting .354 (17/48)...Across last 19 games vs. Tribe, **Zack Cozart** is batting .301 (22/73) with 10 XBH and 11 RBI...In 30 games vs. Tribe, **Mike Trout** is batting .294 (30/102) with 13 XBH & 16 RBI.

ATHLETICS ON DECK: Halos lead 2018 series 3-1...Last Thursday marked the sixth Opening Day meeting between the Angels and A's, tied for second-most openers vs. one opponent (CWS)...**Halos claimed 2017 series 12-7 (5-5 on road) and have won eight of last 10 meetings**...LAA has won four consecutive season series vs. A's (2014-17)...Since 2013, **Mike Trout** is batting .326 (113/347) with 24 HR & 59 RBI in 90 games vs. Oakland.

April 4

(1997) **Tim Salmon** connects for an 11th inning walk-off grand slam vs. Cleveland...He becomes just the 9th major leaguer to hit a game-ending grand slam in extra innings when his team trailed; (1989) **Claudell Washington** homers in his first at-bat with the Angels vs. White Sox.

April 5

(1997) **Shigetoshi Hasegawa** made his major league debut, becoming the fourth Japanese-born player (all pitchers) to appear in the major leagues...He joined **Hideo Nomo** (Los Angeles, 1995), **Makoto Suzuki** (Seattle, 1996) and **Masanori Murakami** (San Francisco 1964).

Worked 6.1 scoreless frames in season debut Friday at Oakland

- Making second start of the season and first at home...Is in sixth Major League season (fourth with Angels)...Made Opening Day roster for third time in career (also, 2014 & 2017).
- **LAST TIME OUT:** Earned the win in last start Friday at Oakland after working 6.1 scoreless innings, allowing three hits with no walks and five strikeouts.
- **WINNING SEASON DEBUTS:** With win on Friday, is now 5-1 with a 1.60 ERA (39.1 IP – 7 ER) in his six career season debuts.
- **2018 SPRING TRAINING:** In four Cactus League appearances, went 0-1 with a 9.00 ERA (11 IP – 11 ER) and 13 strikeouts...Also appeared in intrasquad and minor league games for Angels this Spring.
- **EARLY SUCCESS:** In 11 career regular season starts during March/April, is 4-1 with a 3.31 ERA (70.2 IP – 26 ER) and 56 strikeouts...The 3.31 ERA is his best ERA for any month.
- **VS. CLEVELAND:** In three career starts vs. Cleveland, is 0-2 with a 6.23 ERA (17.1 IP – 12 ER)...Took loss in only start vs. Tribe last year on Sept. 19, 2017 at Angel Stadium after tossing 5.1 innings and allowing two earned runs on eight hits.
- **AT ANGEL STADIUM:** In 21 career starts at the Big A, is 3-7 with a 4.72 ERA (114.1 IP – 60 ER)...In eight home starts last season, was 2-3 with a 4.78 ERA (43.1 IP – 23 ER)...Angels have won 12 of his 21 career home starts.
- **COMMUNITY SPOTLIGHT:** During the offseason, represented Angels at the annual Kids Holiday Party event for the Angels Baseball Foundation at the ESPN Zone in Downtown Disney.
- **2017 RECAP:** Made 16 starts for Angels last year and pitched to a 2-6 record and 4.55 ERA (85 IP – 43 ER) with 76 strikeouts...Missed 85 games on disabled list with a right oblique muscle strain suffered on Apr. 28 at Texas...Allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in seven of 11 contests following return from disabled list.

- Owns a 14-21 career record with a 4.50 ERA (322 IP – 161 ER) and 274 strikeouts in 58 career games (all starts).
- Underwent Tommy John surgery on August 13, 2014 by **Dr. Neal Elattrache** after suffering left forearm strain during start on July 31, 2014 at Baltimore
- Originally drafted by Angels in 1st round (40th overall) of the 2009 amateur draft...Was traded by Angels to D-backs on August 7, 2010 in the deal which brought **Dan Haren** to the Halos...Acquired back by Angels on December 10, 2013 along with LHP **Hector Santiago** in trade which sent OF **Mark Trumbo** and RHP **A.J. Schugel** to Arizona.

Making first start of the season...Recalled from Triple-A Salt Lake on Monday (minor league season has not yet started)...In rookie campaign last season, went 10-3 with a 3.64 ERA (121 IP – 49 ER) and 73 strikeouts across 21 games (20 starts)...Angels went 17-3 in his starts in 2017...In two starts vs. A's last year, went 0-0 with a 19.50 ERA (6 IP – 13 ER); his two starts vs. Oakland were his only games of the year allowing six-or-more runs...In career 12 games (11 starts) at Angel Stadium, is 5-3 with a 3.89 ERA (69.1 IP – 30 ER).

#48 JOSE ALVAREZ (LHP) AGE: 28

- Pitched 1.2 shutout frames in last outing Monday night.
- Worked one scoreless inning across two appearances in the opening series at OAK.
- Is in sixth Major League season and fifth with the Angels...Made Opening Day roster for fourth straight year.
- During Spring Training, appeared in 10 games and boasted a 2.38 ERA (11.1 IP – 3 ER)...Recorded 12 strikeouts and did not allow a home run.
- Appeared in 64 games for the Angels in 2017 going 0-3 with a 3.88 ERA (48.2 IP – 21 ER)...Set new career high with streak of 15 consecutive scoreless appearances (15.1 IP)...Stranded 29 of 35 inherited runners on the season.

#39 KEYNAN MIDDLETON (RHP) AGE: 24

- Earned first save of season Sunday...Appeared in three of four games in Oakland
- Is in second Major League season (first full) with the Angels...Made his first career Opening Day roster.
- Six of 10 Cactus League appearances were scoreless.
- Pitched in 64 games for Angels last season, going 6-1 with three saves and a 3.86 ERA (58.1 IP – 25 ER) while striking out 63 and walking 18 in his rookie campaign.

#53 BLAKE PARKER (RHP) AGE: 32

- In 2017, posted a 3-3 record and eight saves with a 2.54 ERA (67.1 IP – 19 ER)...Led all Halos pitchers with an 11.5 SO/9 inning rate...His 86 strikeouts were second among Angels relievers (Yusmeiro Petit – 96).

#25 NOÉ RAMÍREZ (RHP) AGE: 28

- Worked 1.1 scoreless innings Monday night.
- Charged with loss Thursday after allowing walk-off hit to Marcus Semien in 11th.
- Is in fourth Major League season and second campaign with Angels (first full)...Made an Opening Day roster for second time (also, 2016 with Boston).
- Appeared in 11 Spring Training games and recorded 14 strikeouts in 12.1 innings.
- Between Red Sox and Angels in 2017, appeared in 12 total games and earned a 2.77 ERA (13.0 IP – 4 ER)...Pitched to a 2.16 ERA (8.1 IP – 2 ER) in his 10 September outings for Angels after being claimed off waivers from Boston on Aug. 18, 2017.
